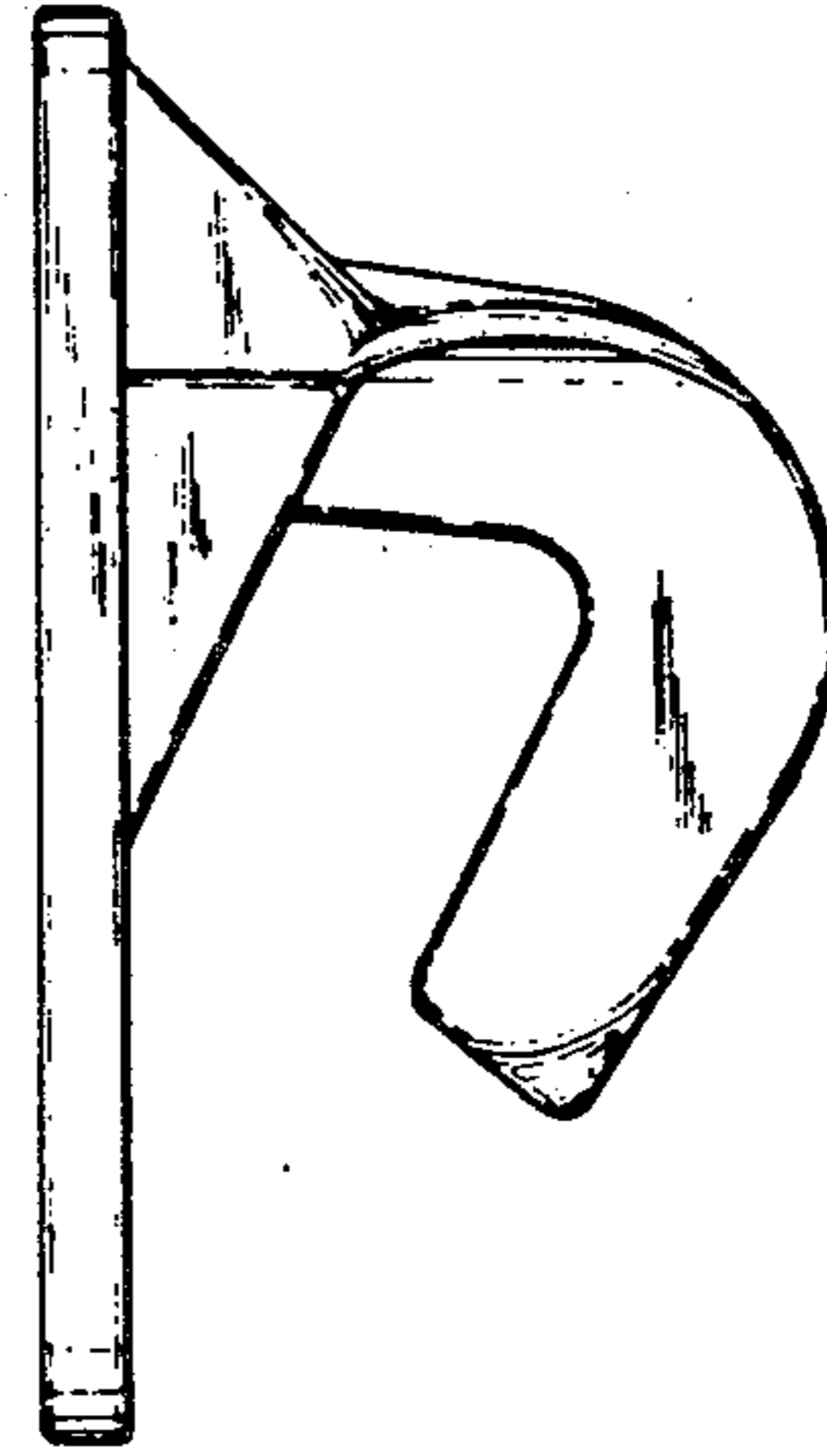
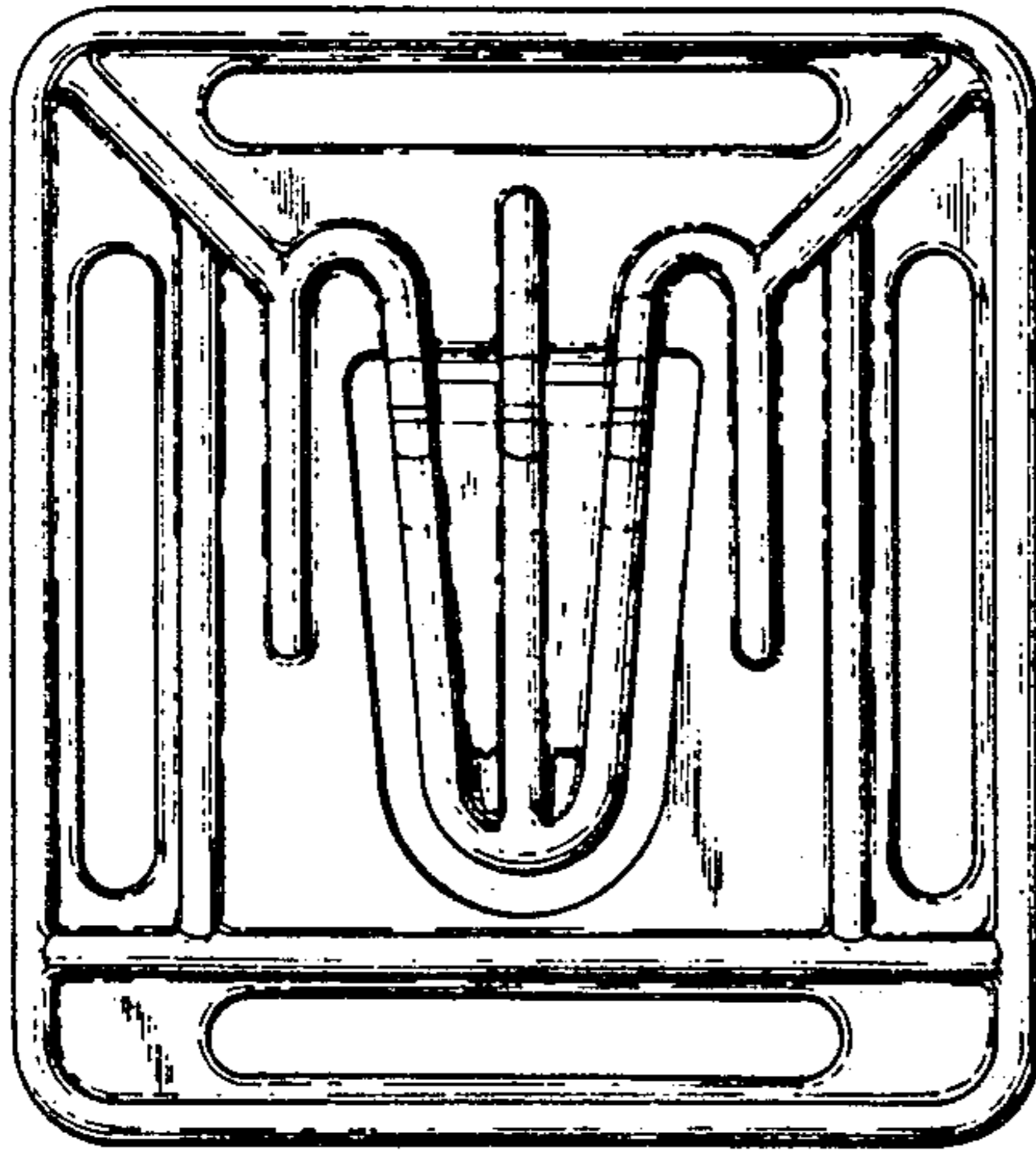
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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a harness hook for a sailboard, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a harness hook for a sailboard, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image of the left side shown; and FIG. 5 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side thereof.



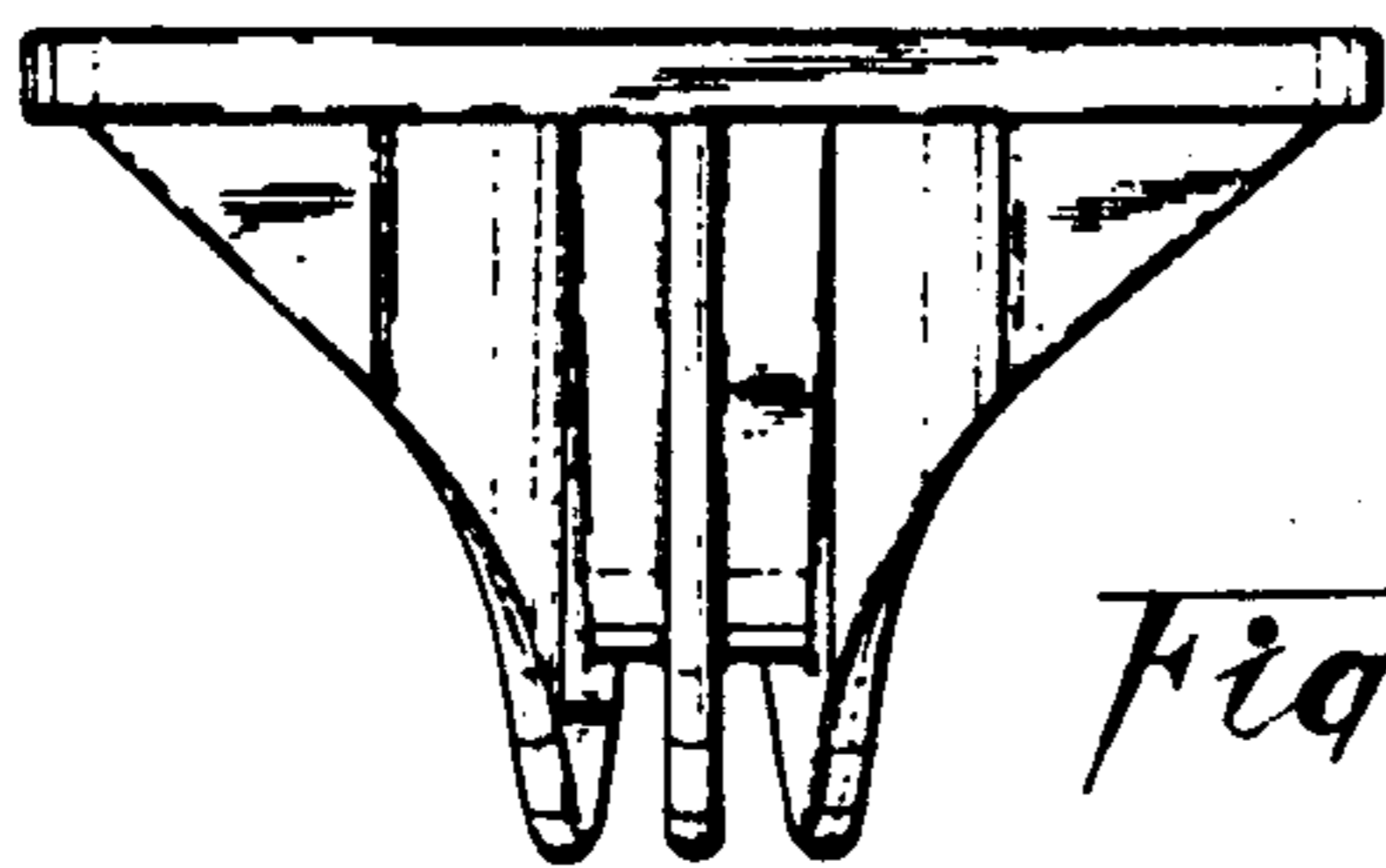

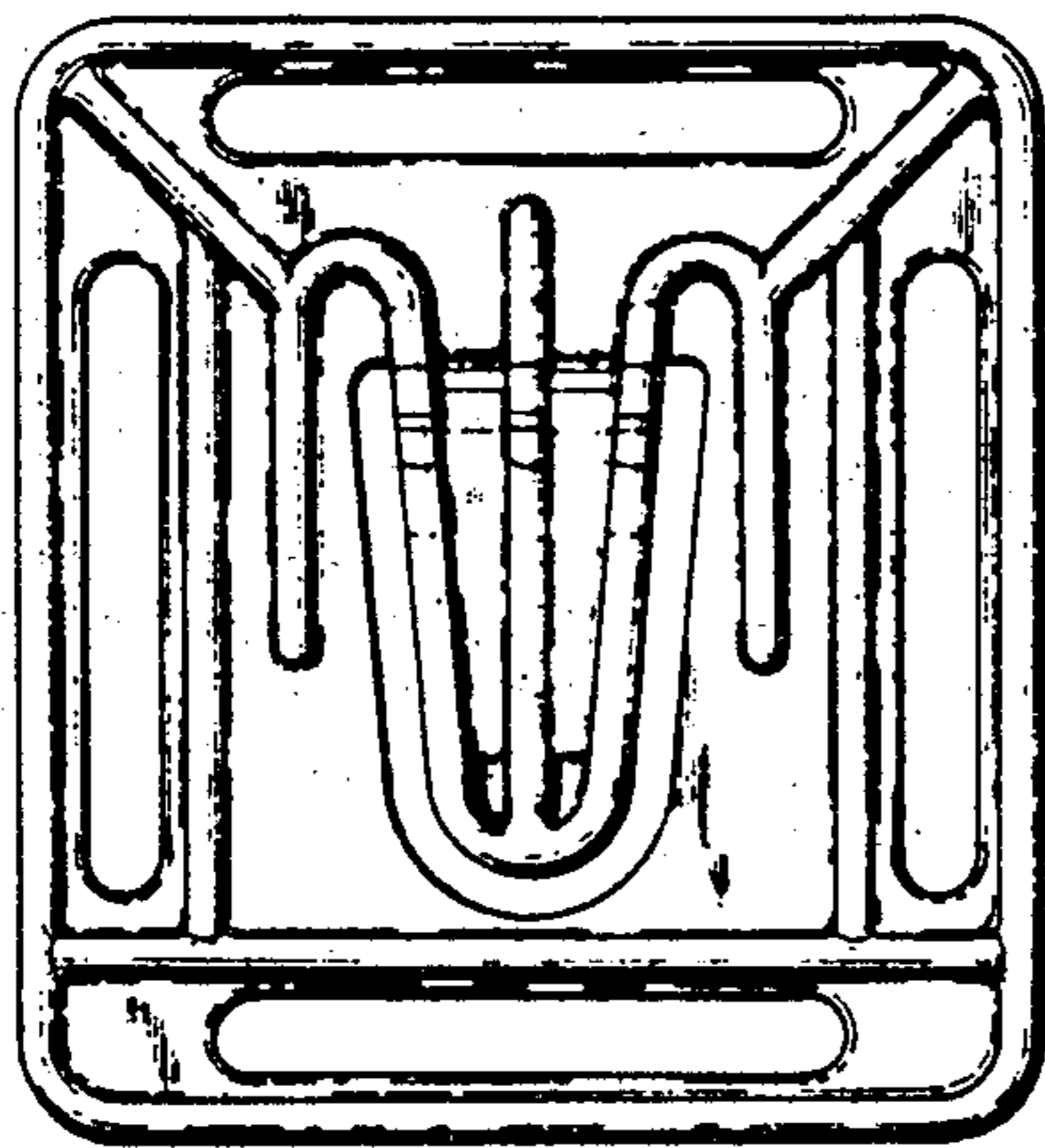

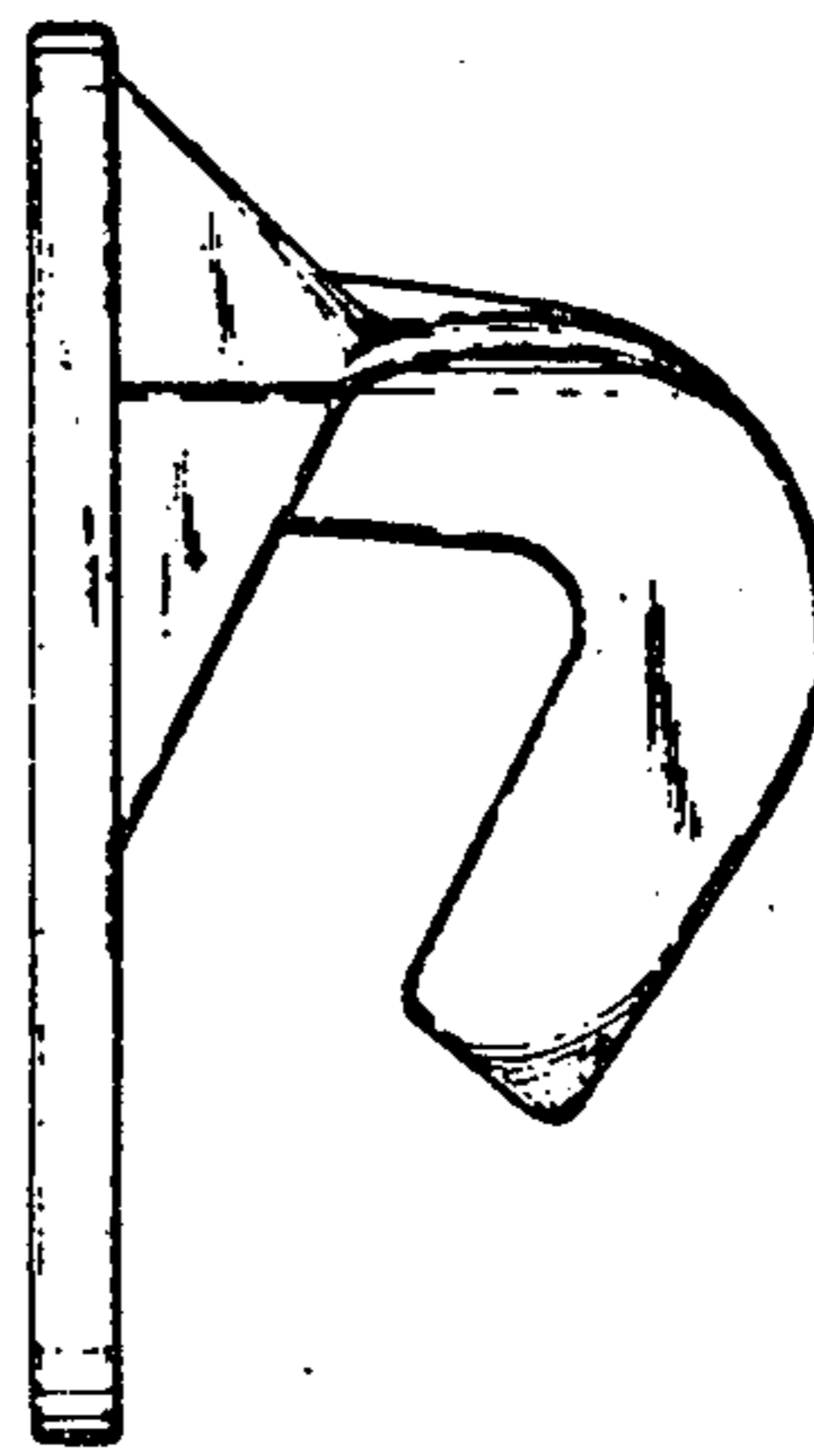

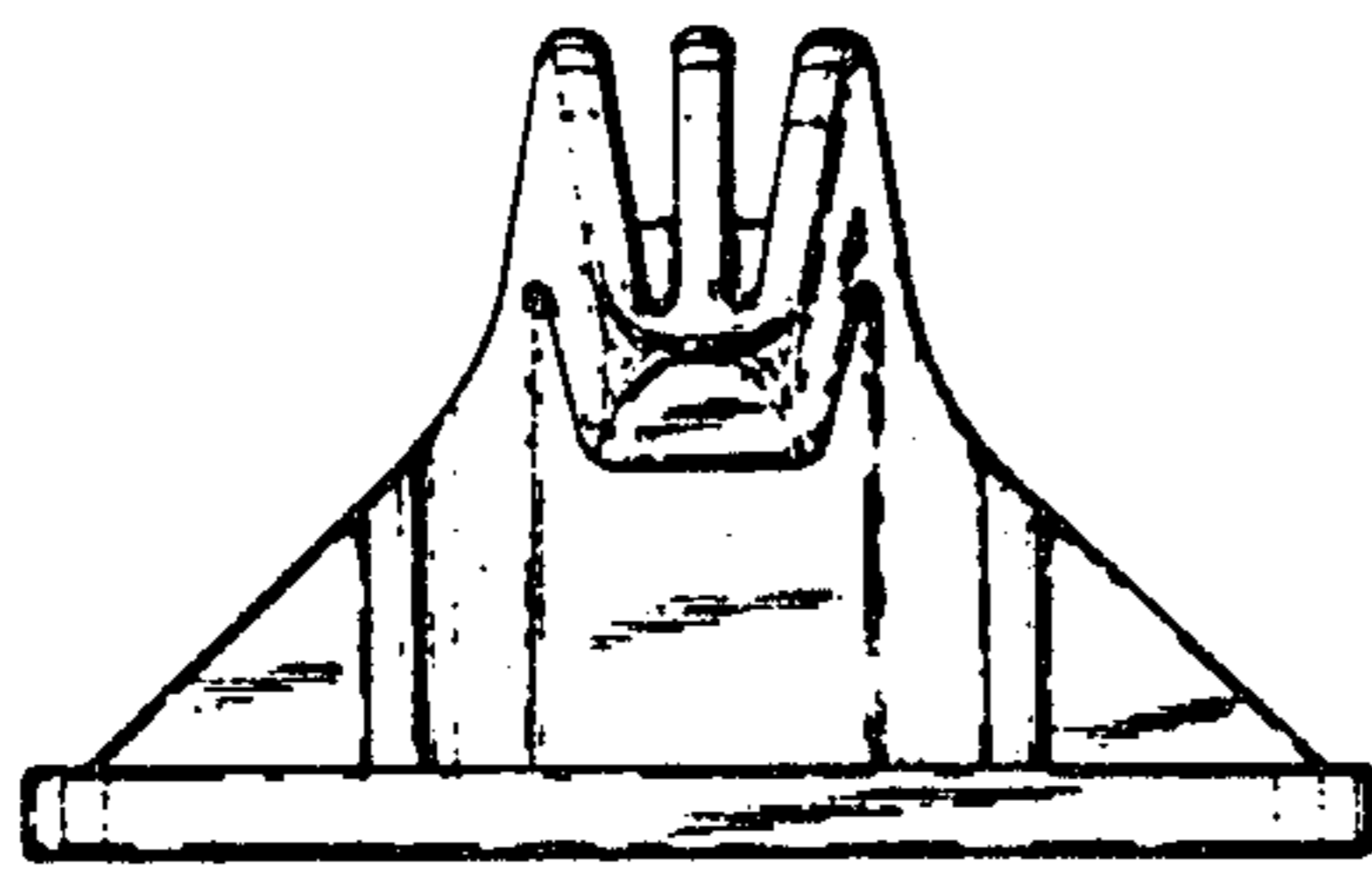

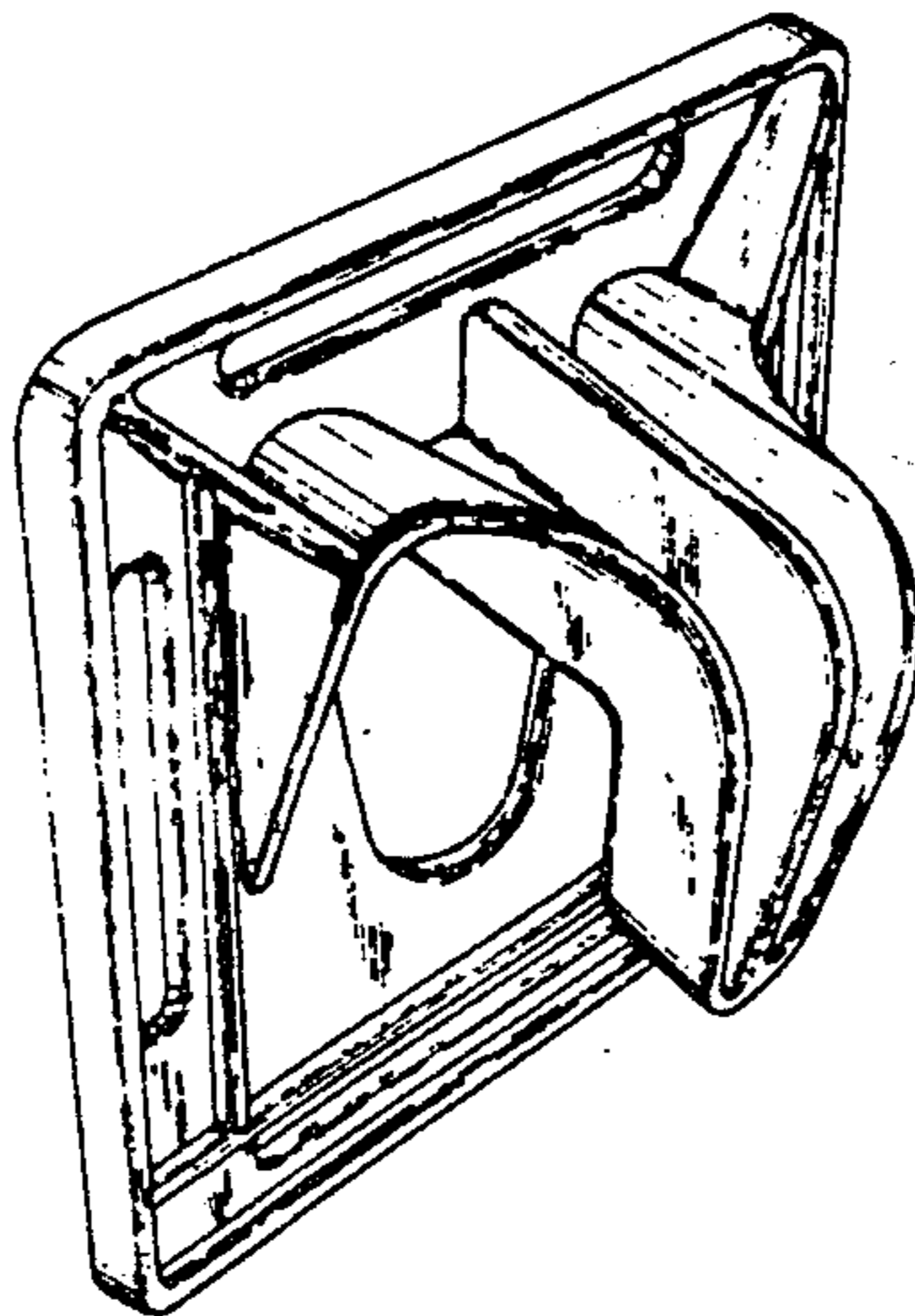
