[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a door chime housing, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the door chime housing showing my new design;

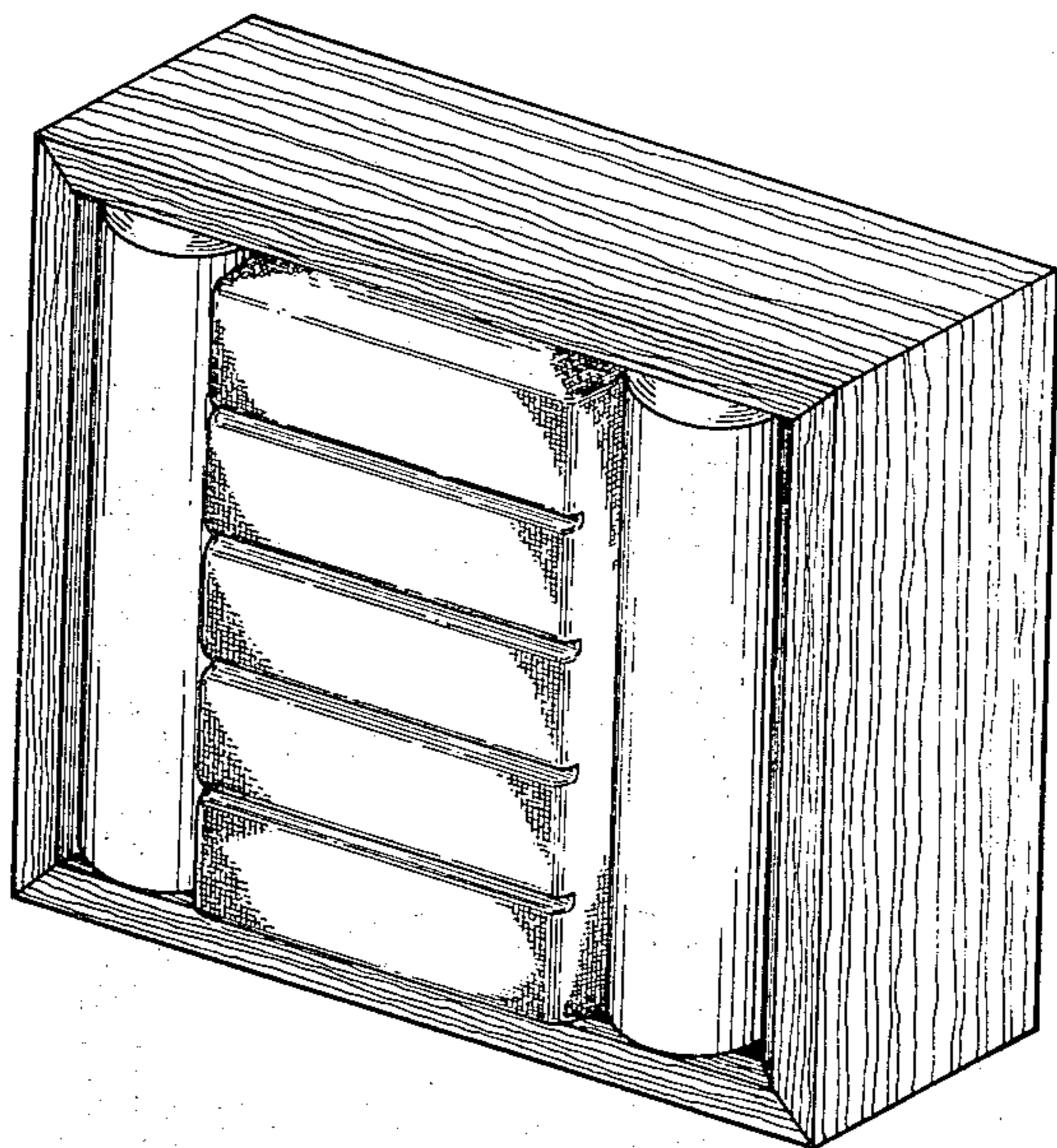
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1.

The mesh-like fabric pattern seen in FIGS. 1, 2, 4 and 5 is understood to repeat uniformly throughout the defined areas.



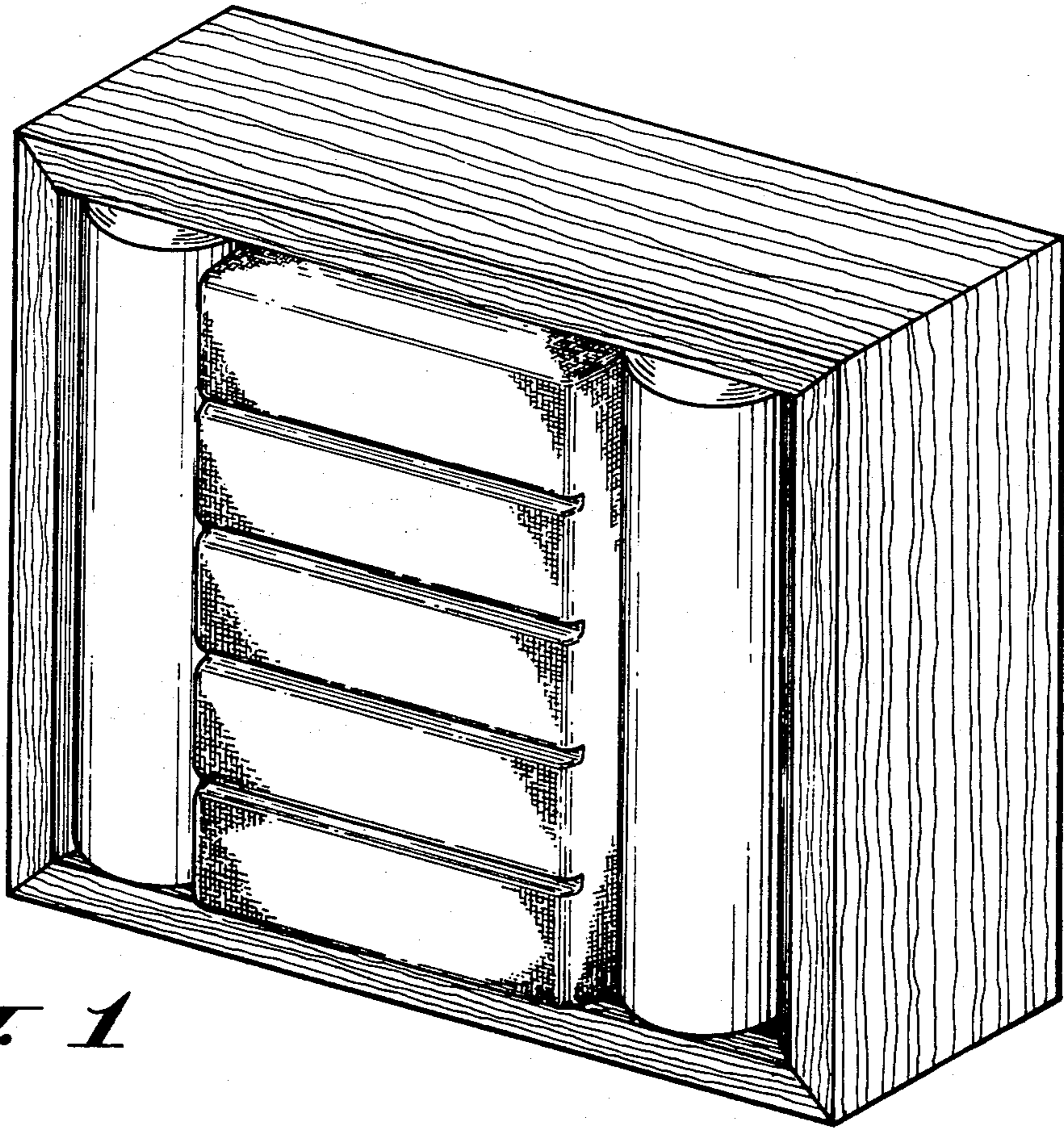

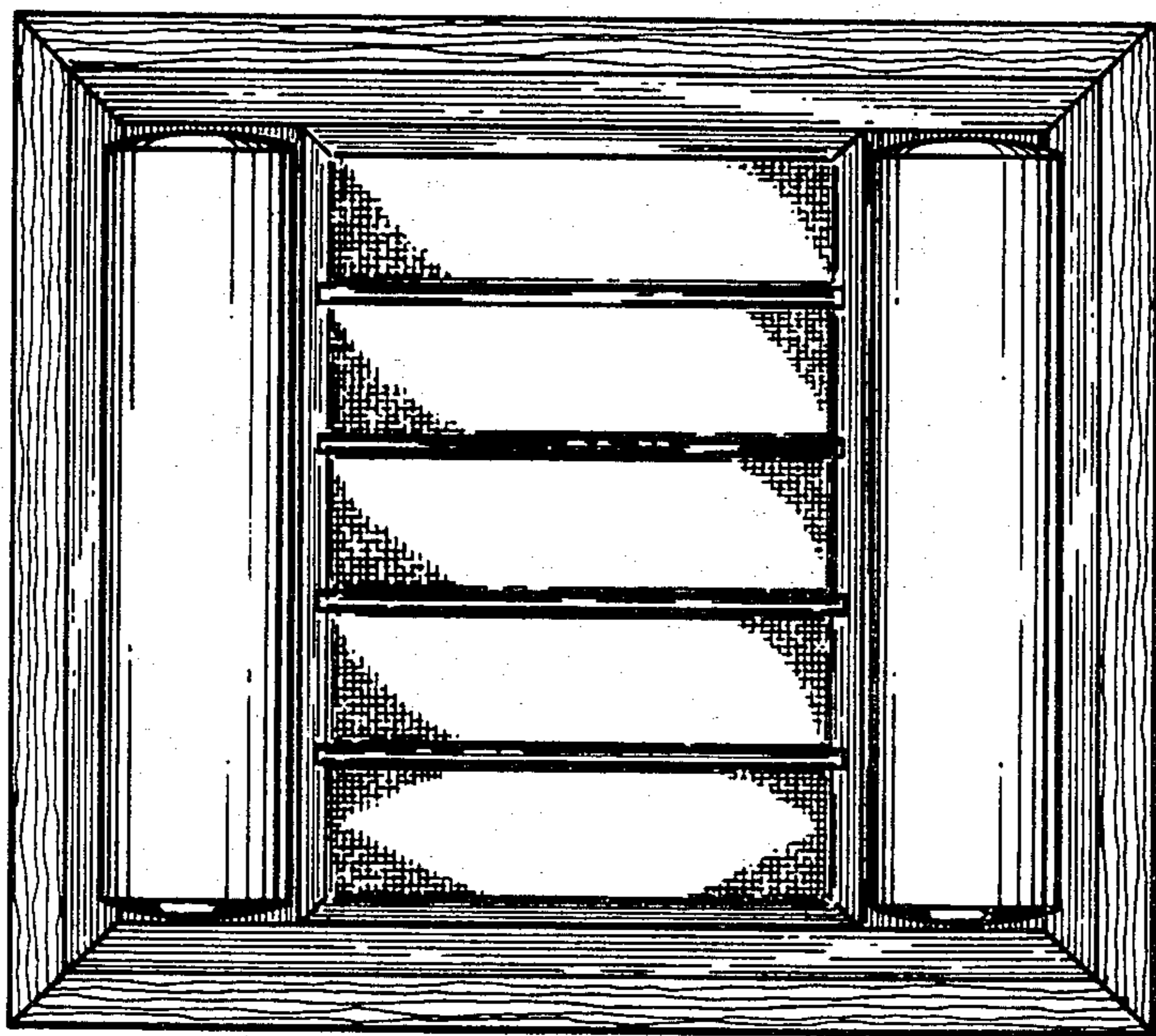

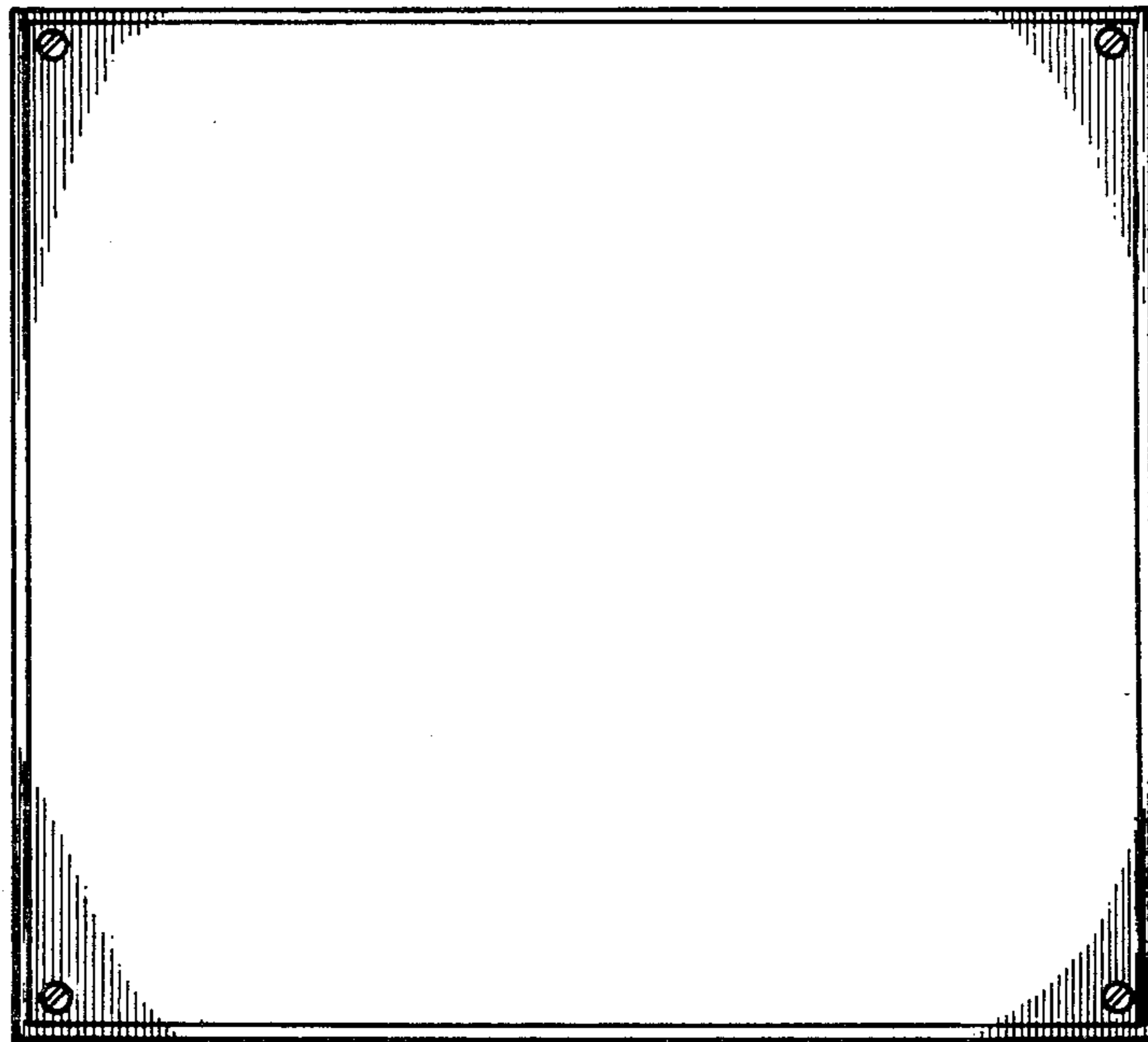

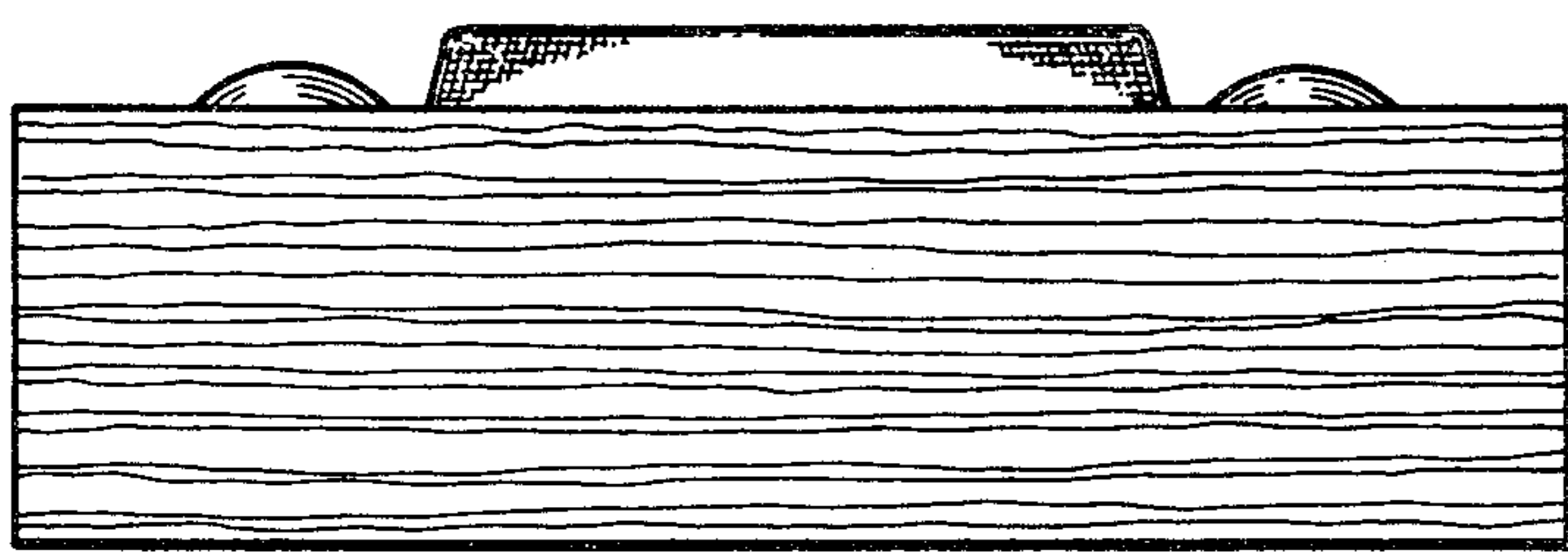

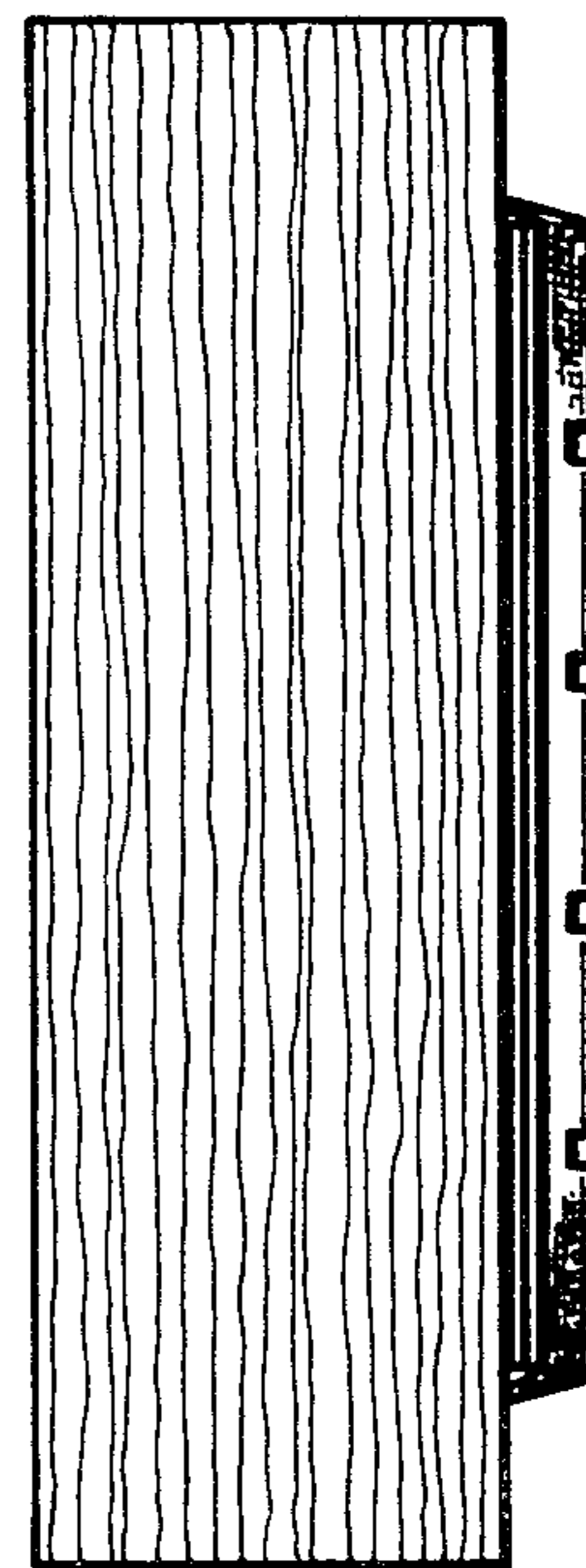
