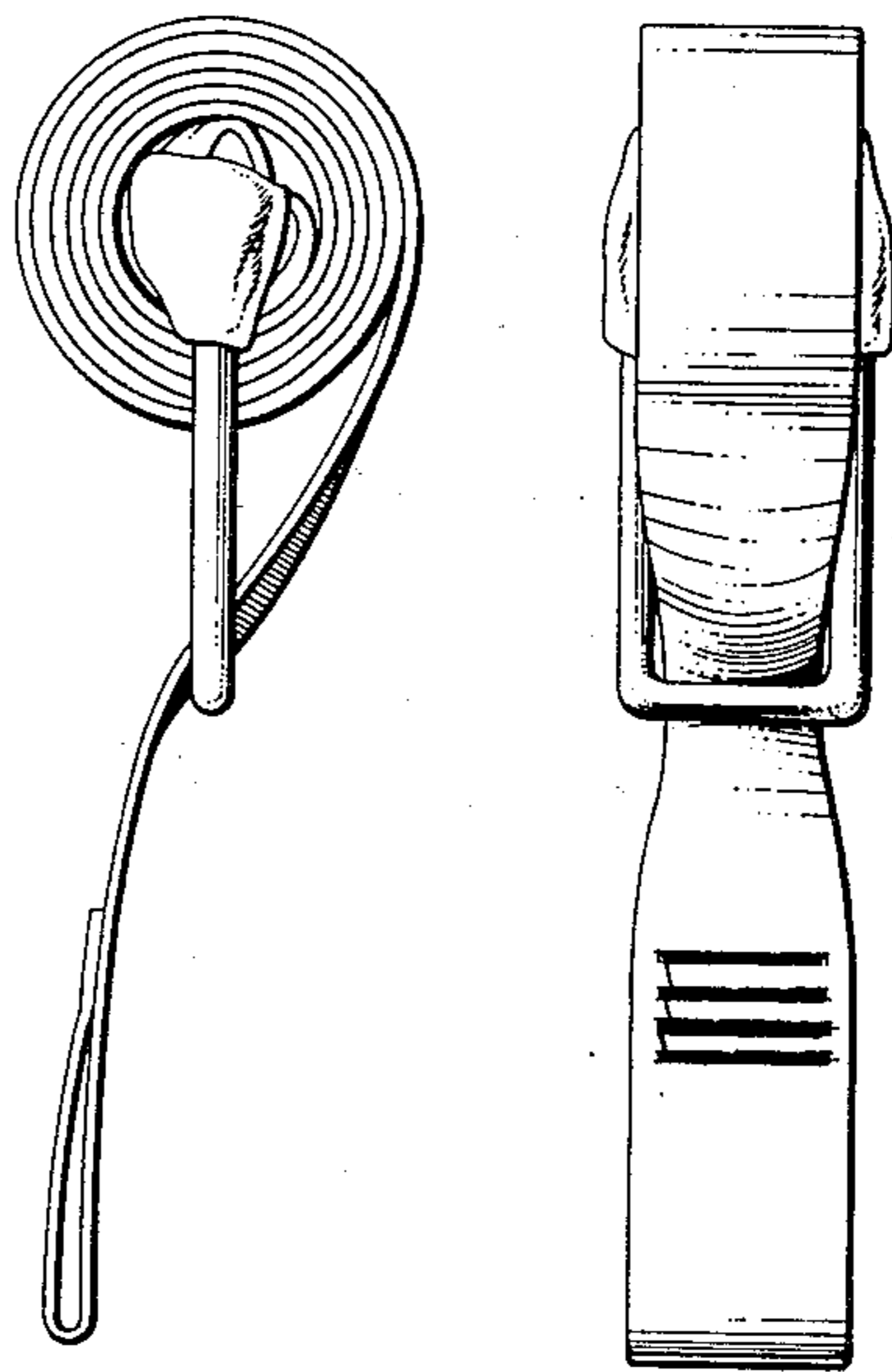

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined adjustable jam nut and web sling for climbers, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevation of a combined adjustable jam nut and web sling for climbers showing my new design in fully unwound condition;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof in fully unwound condition;
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevation thereof in fully wound condition;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof in fully wound condition;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof in fully wound condition;
 FIG. 6 is a front elevation thereof in fully wound condition; and,
 FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof in fully wound condition.



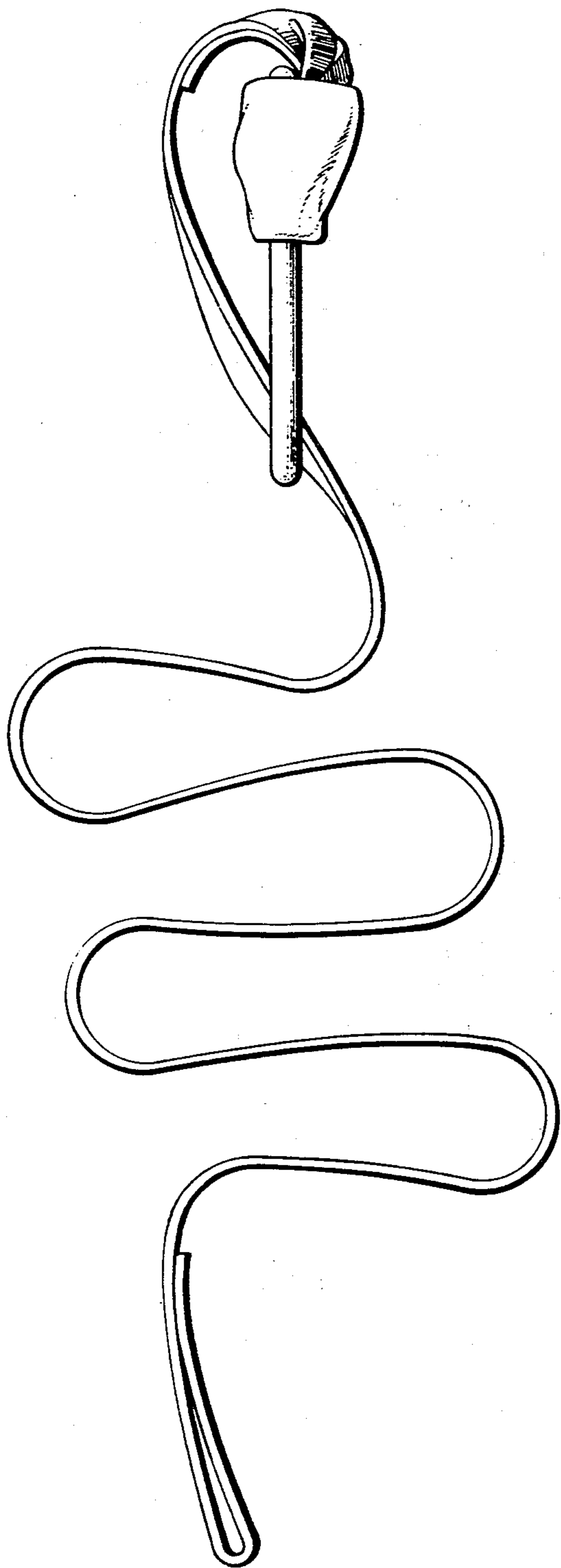

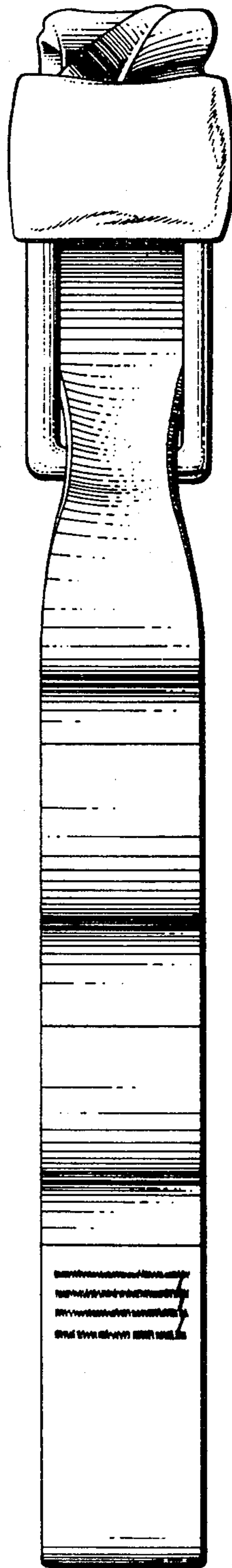

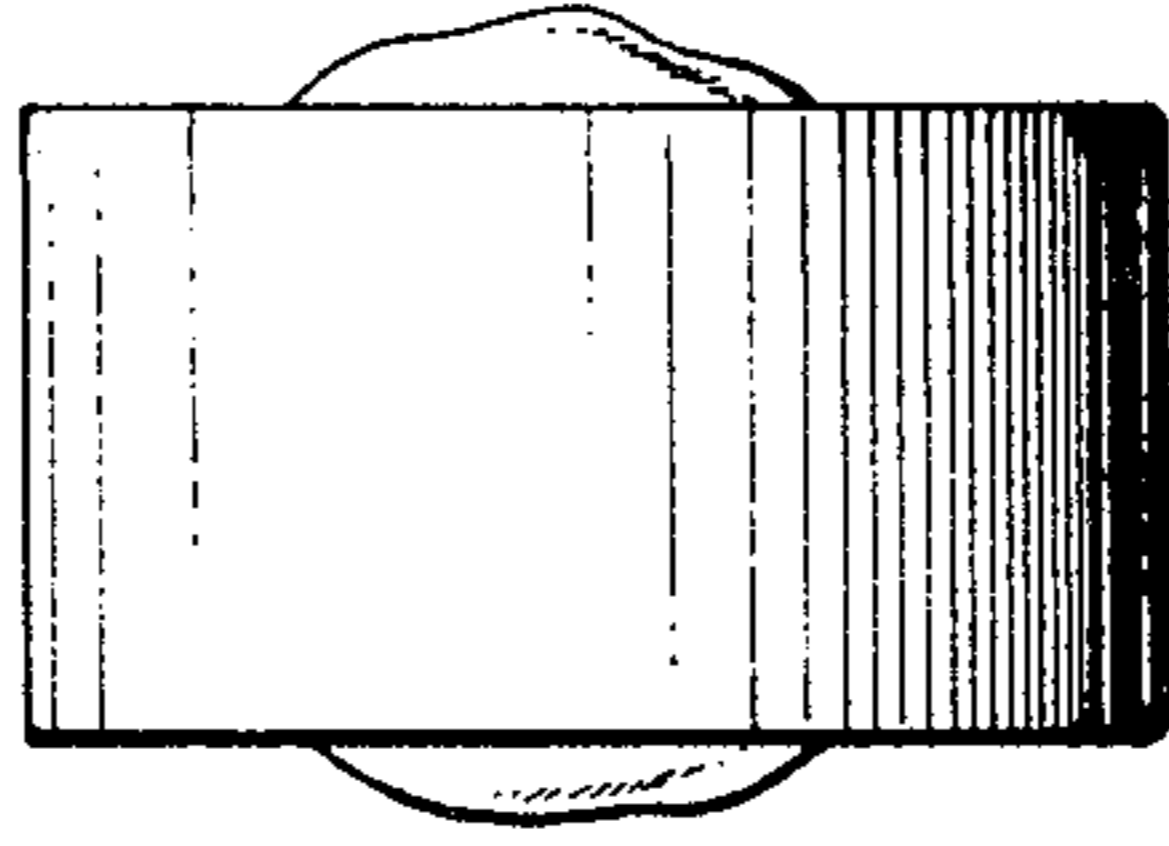

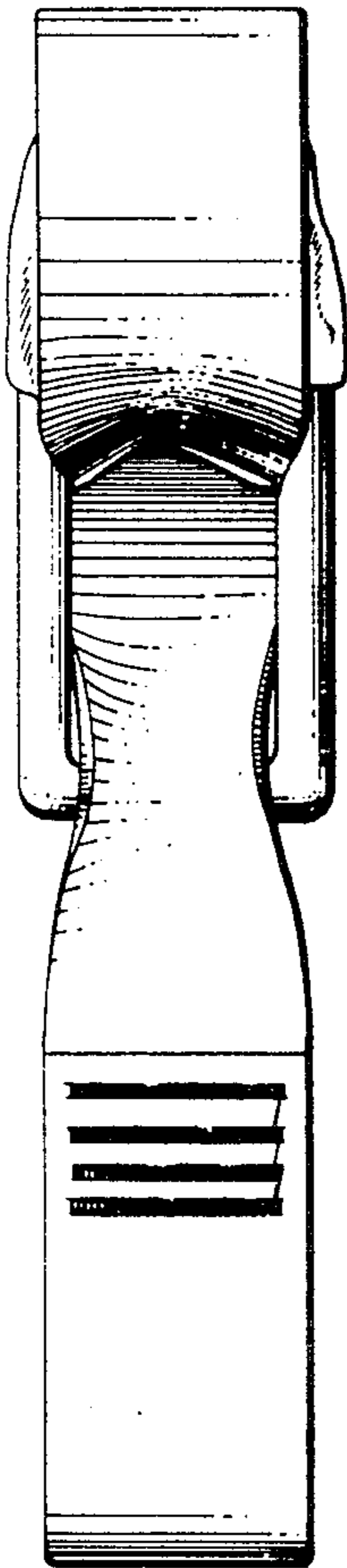

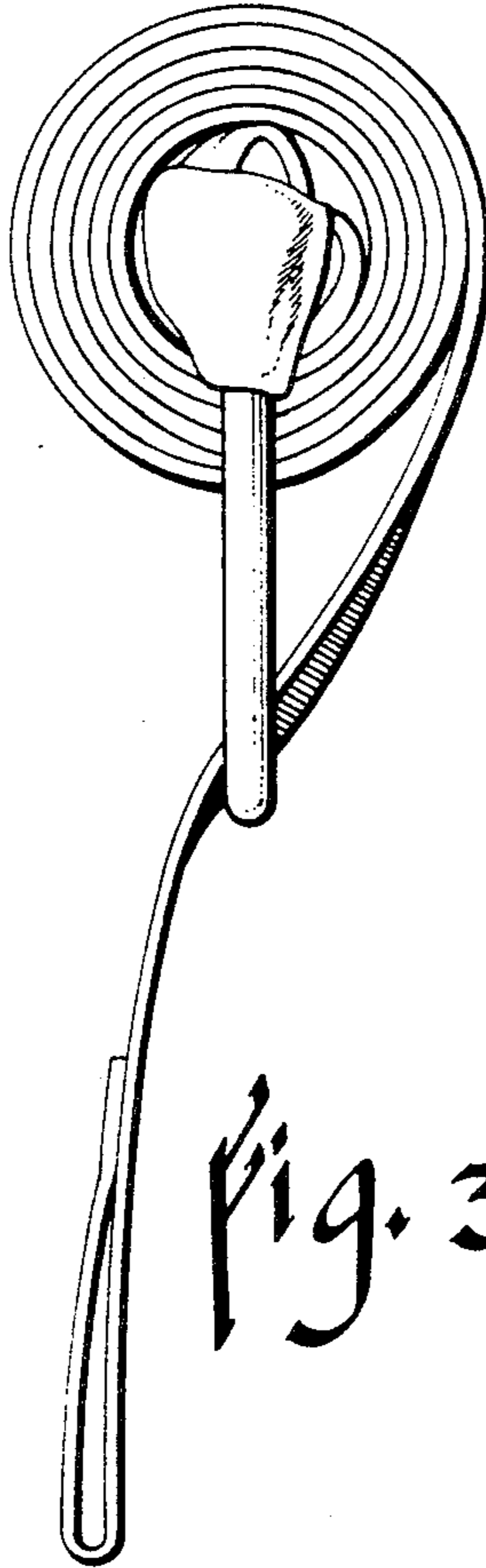

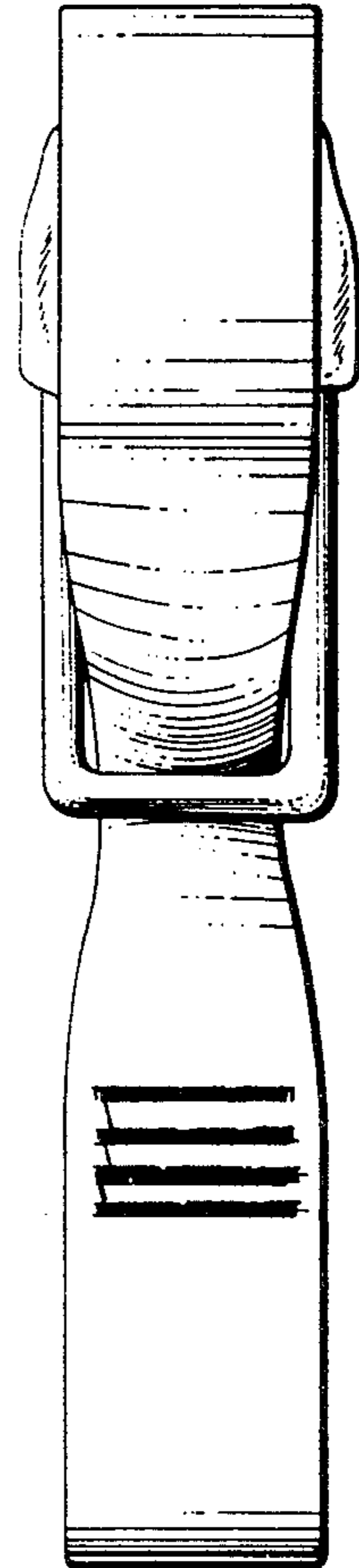

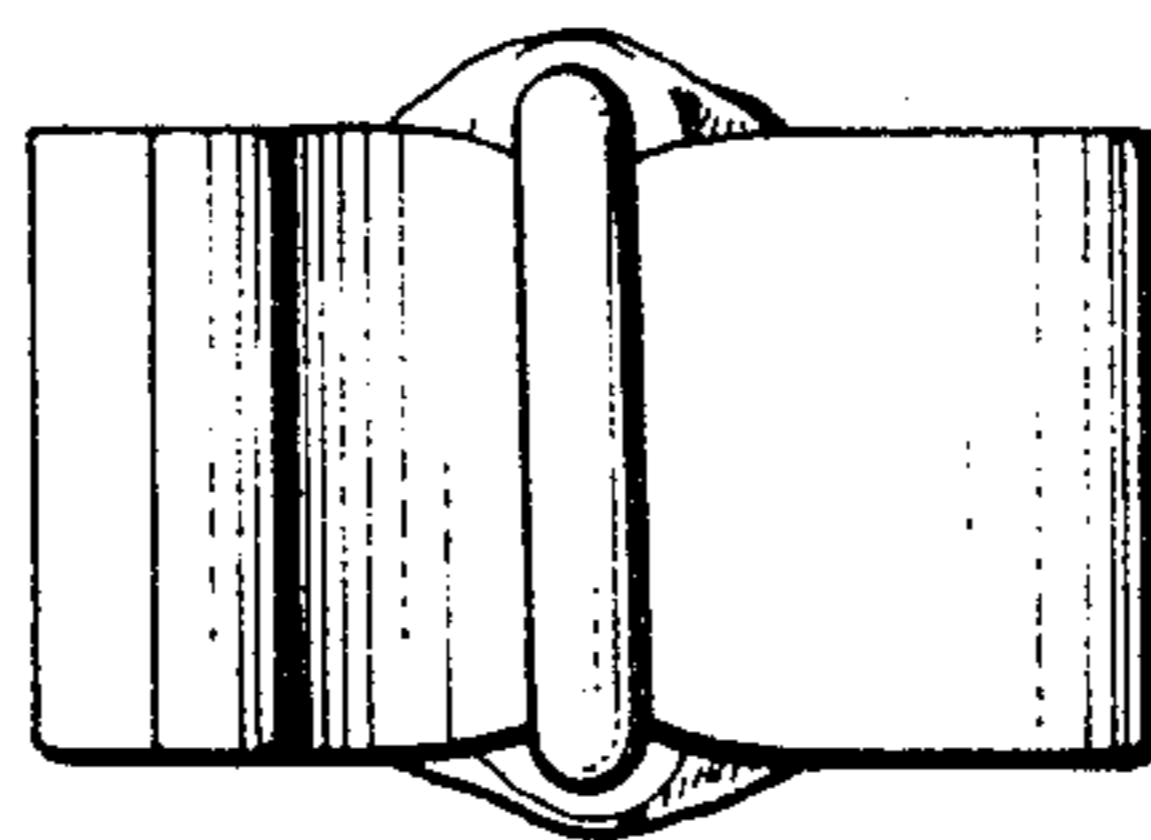
