DESCRIPTION

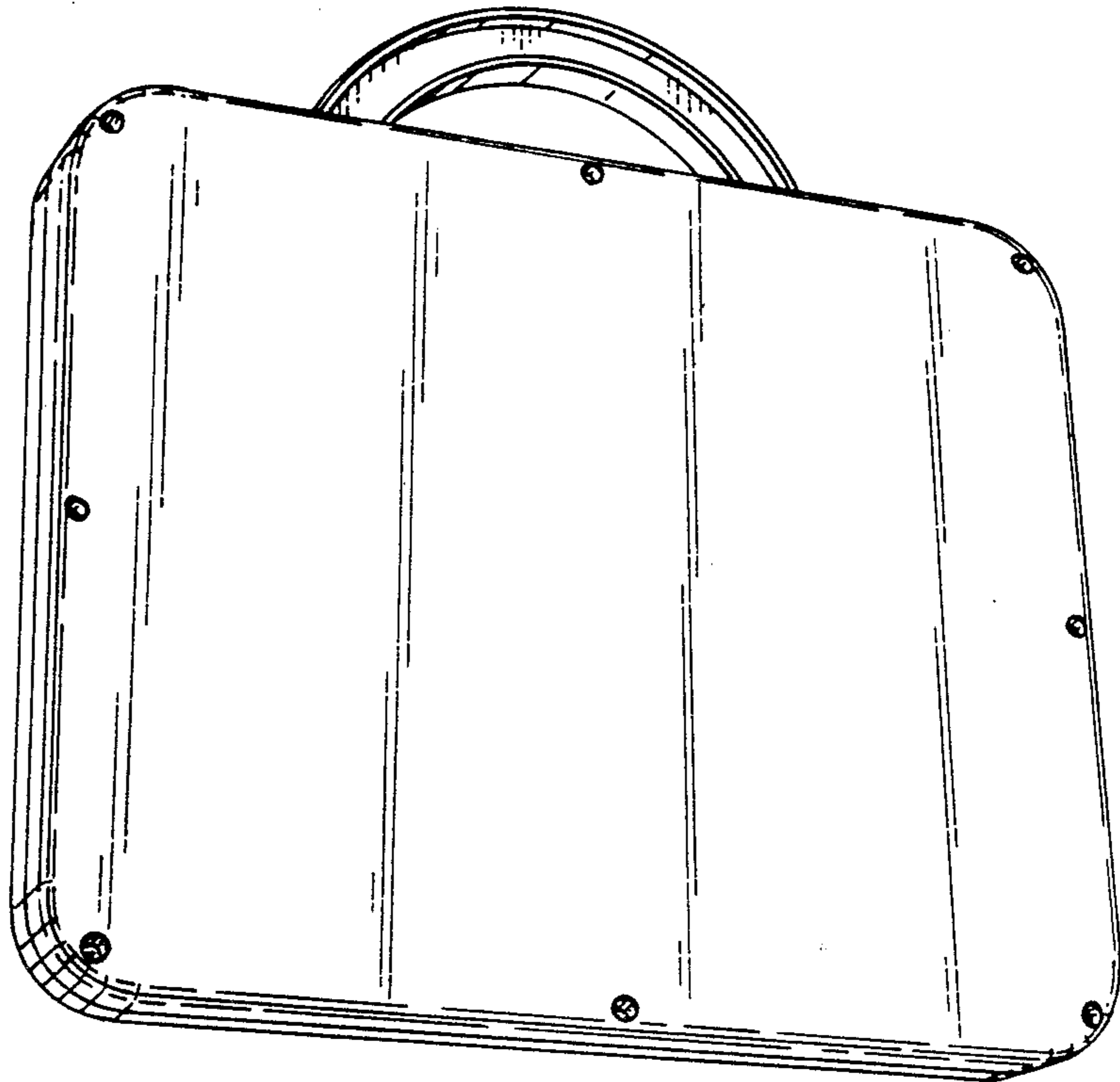
