FIG. 5 is a rear end view thereof.

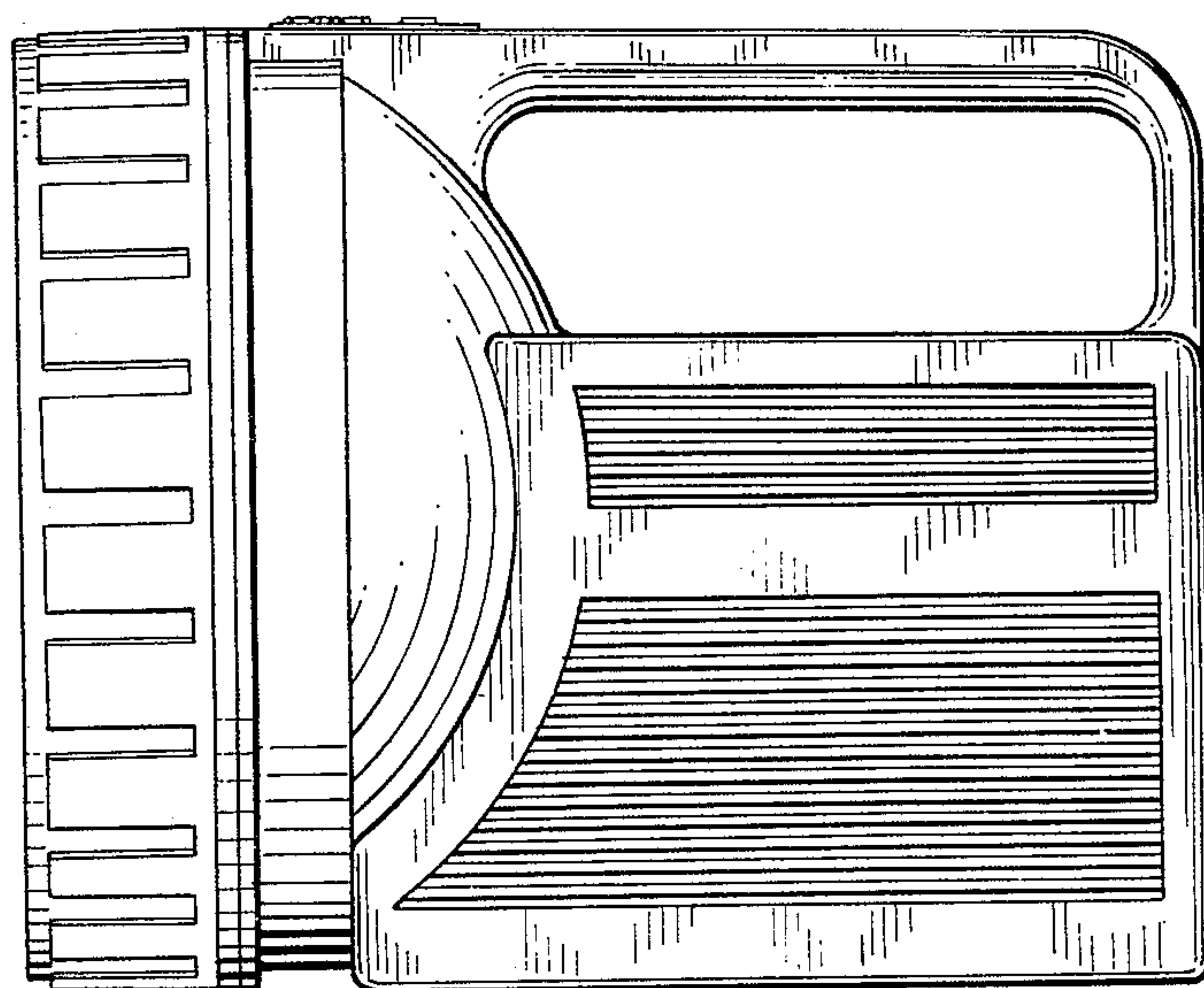

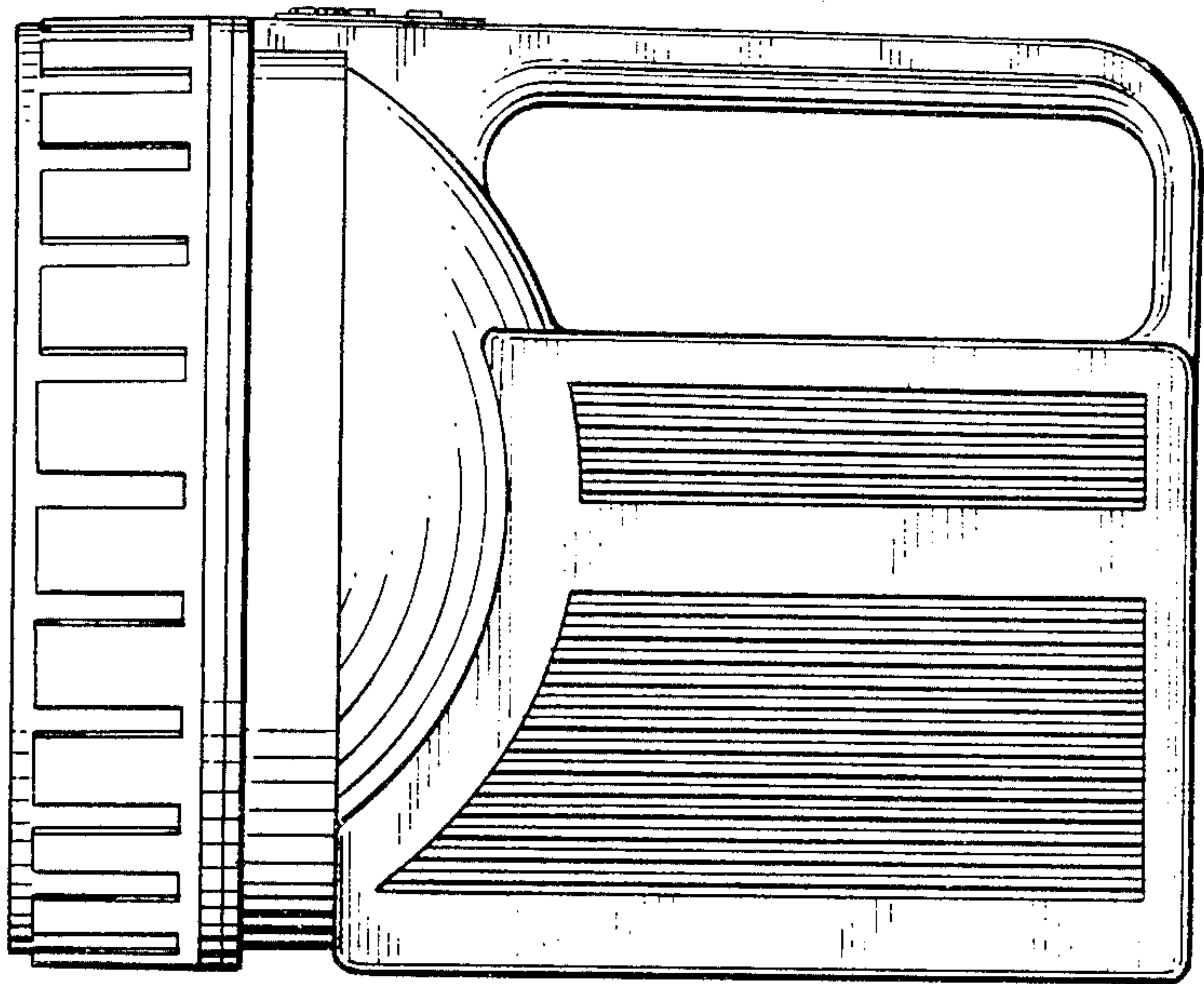
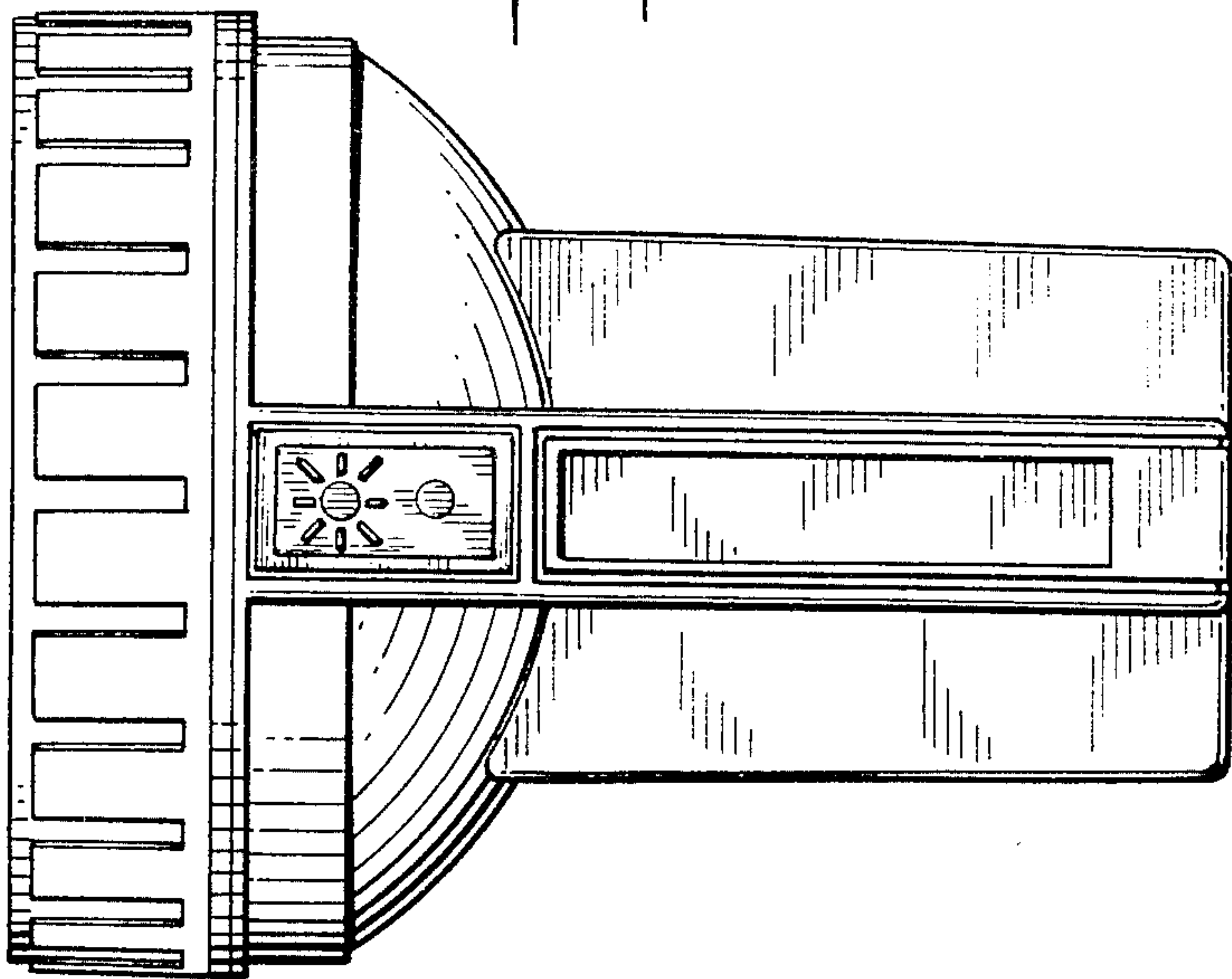

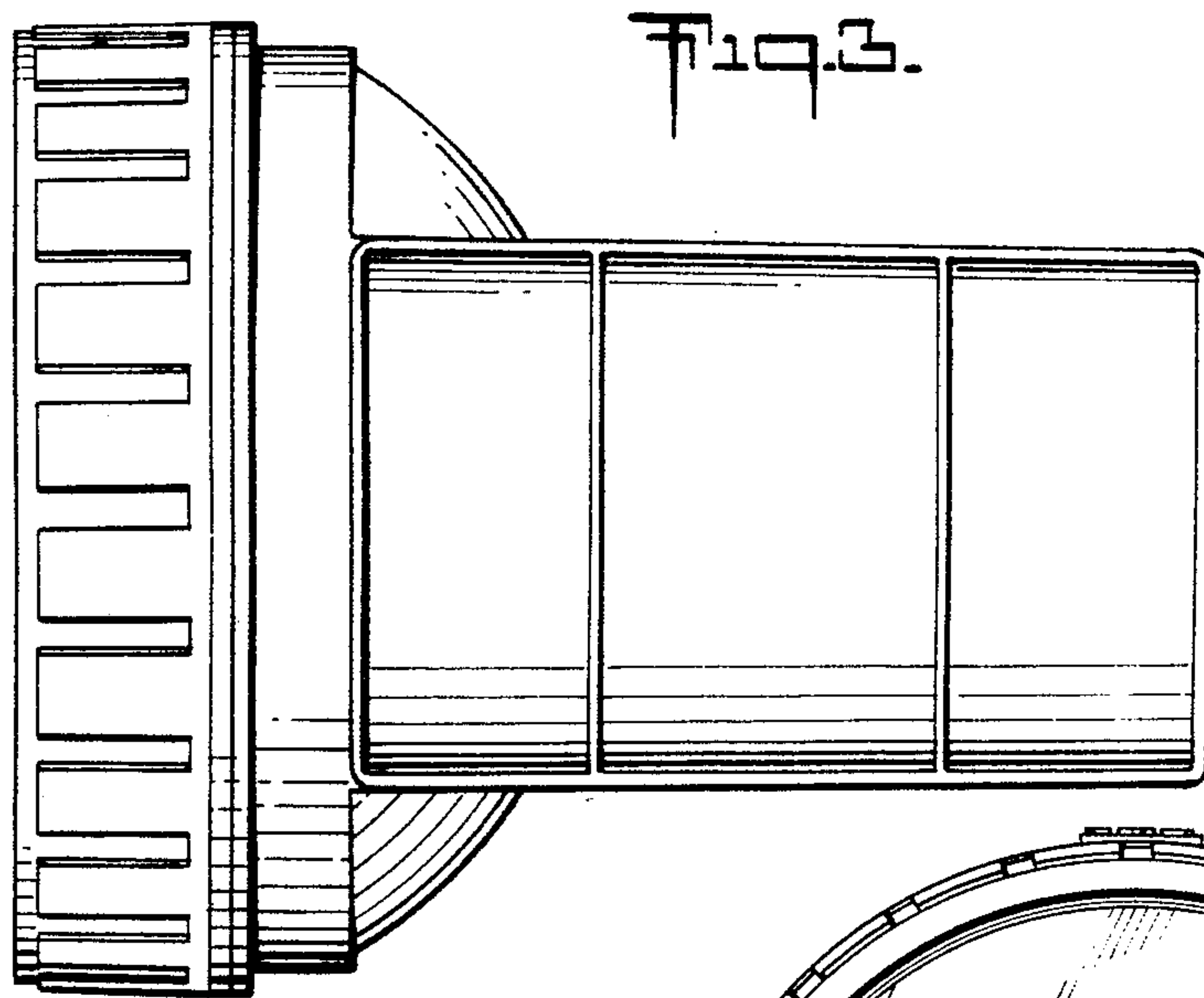

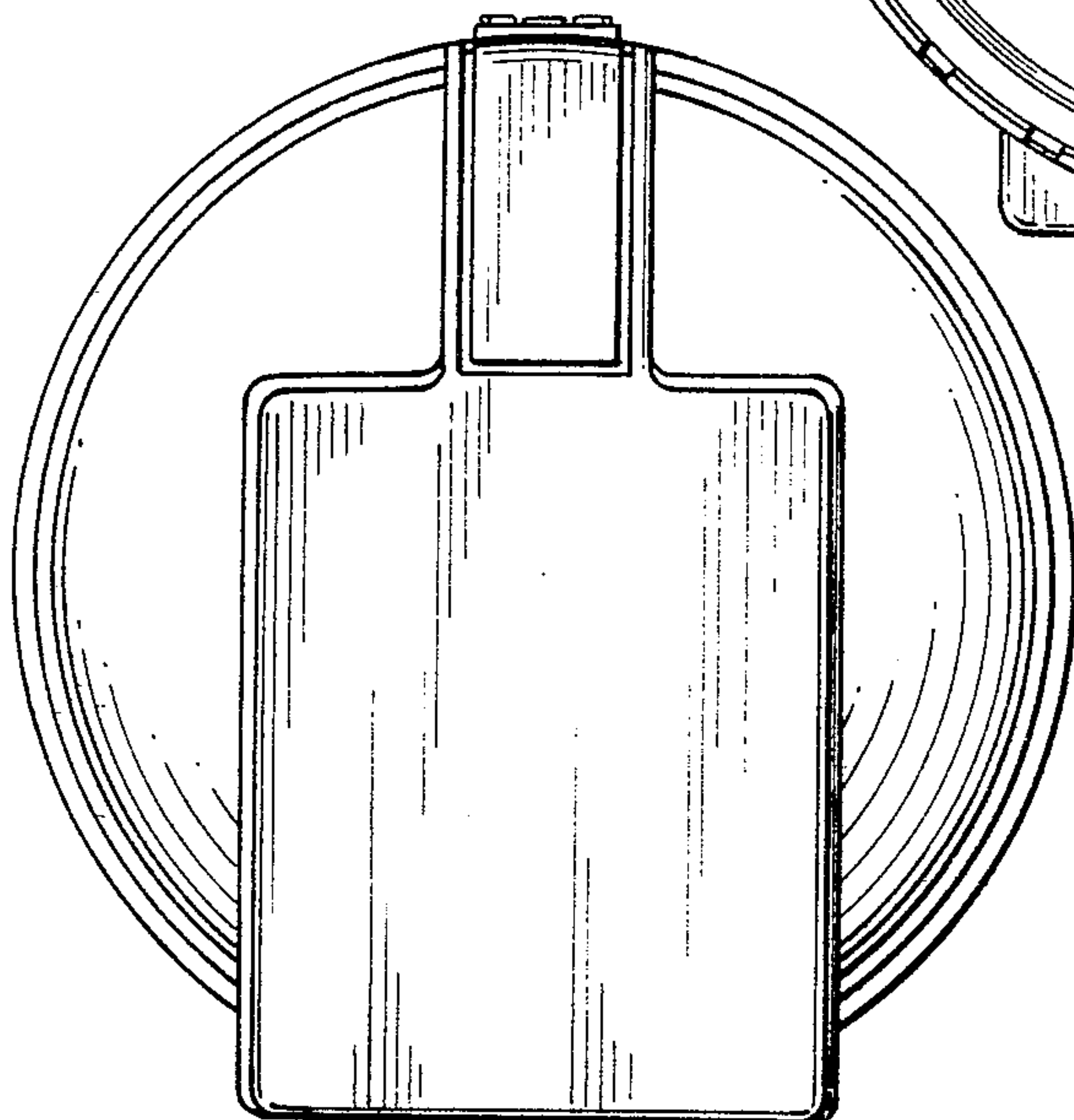
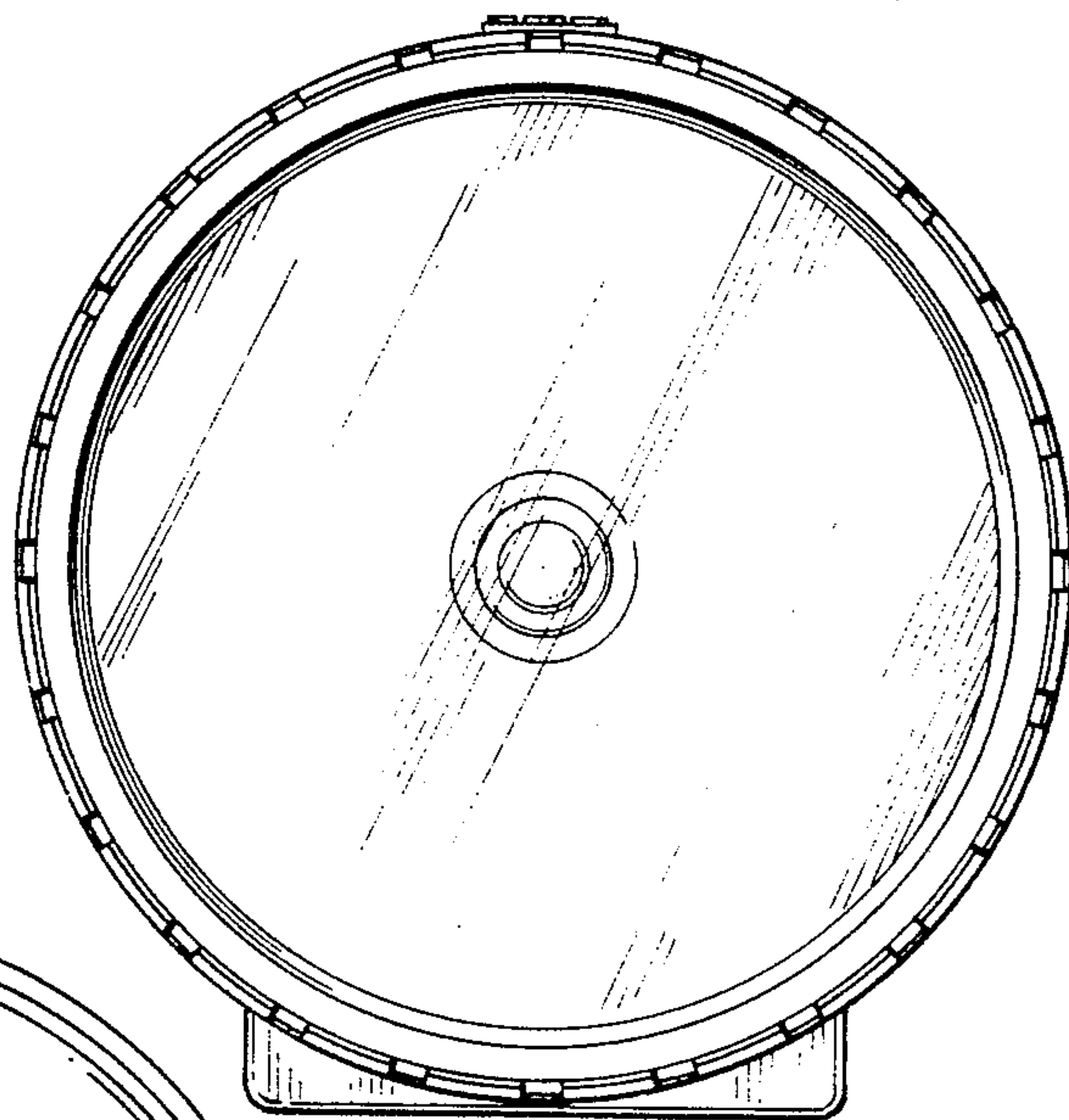
