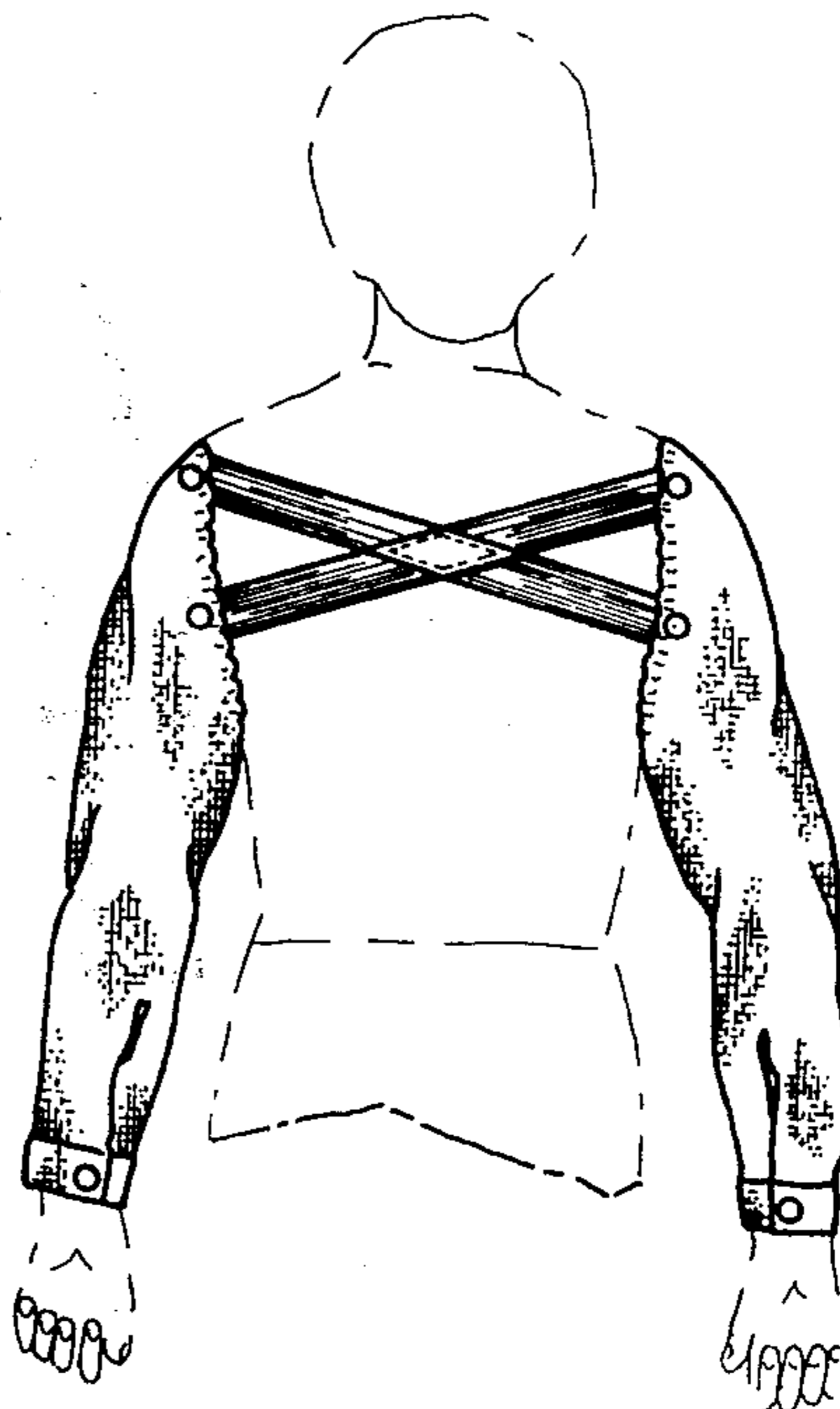
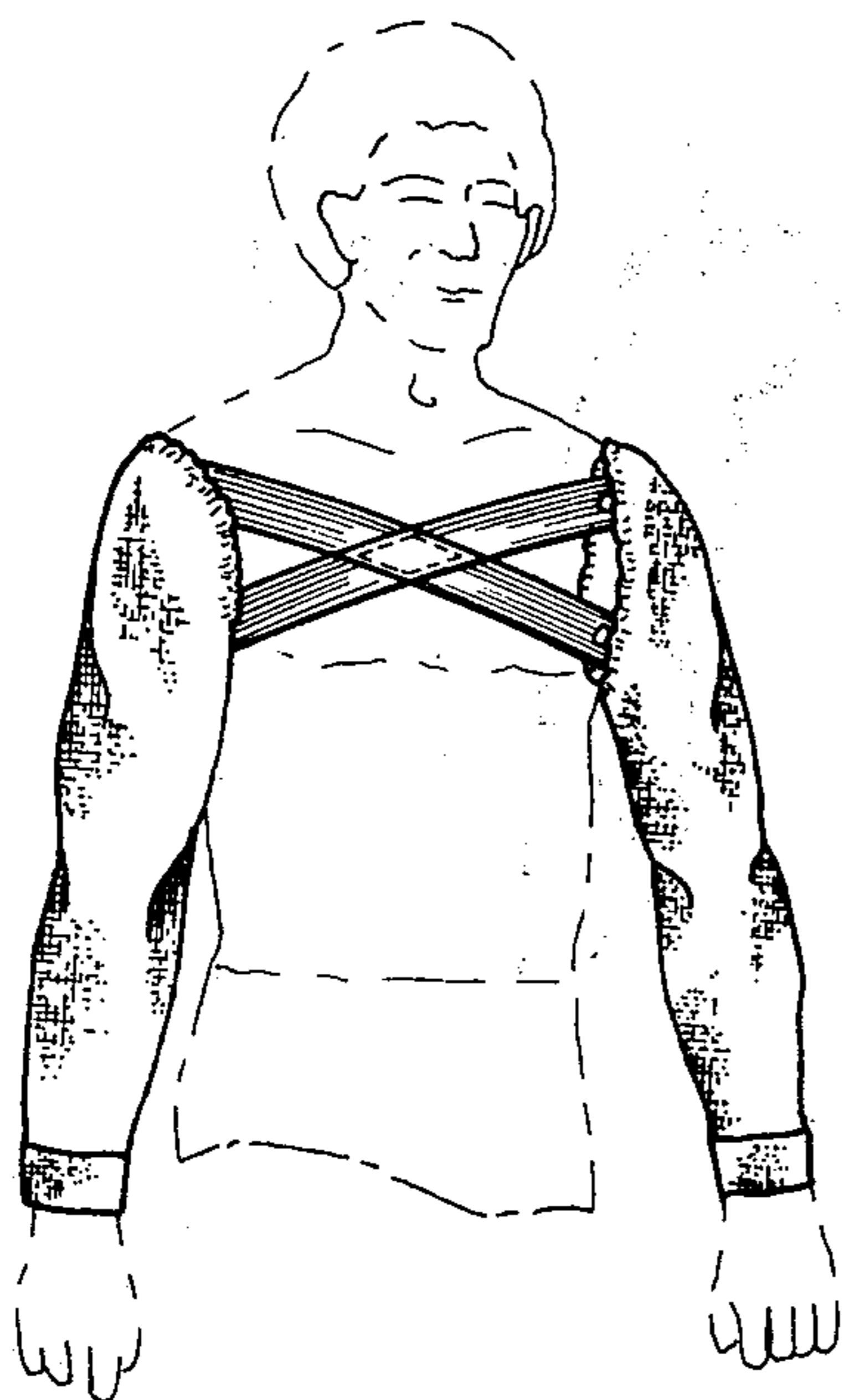
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for protective sleeves, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of protective sleeves showing our new design, with the broken line wearer included for illustrative purposes only; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 the rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image thereof; and FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

The characteristic features of our design are the elastic at the top of the sleeves, the rear straps and the diamond shaped reinforcement where the straps cross.



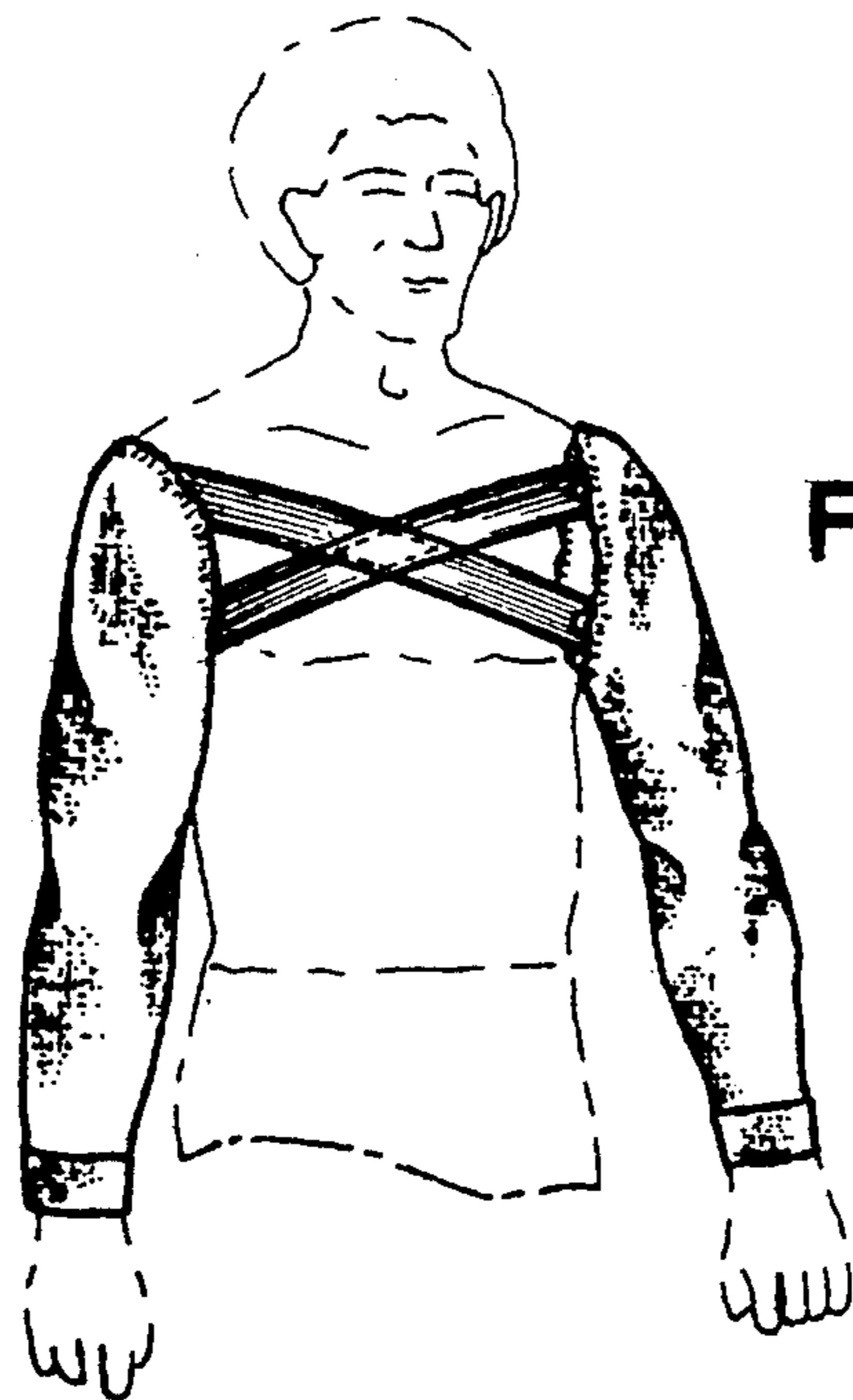

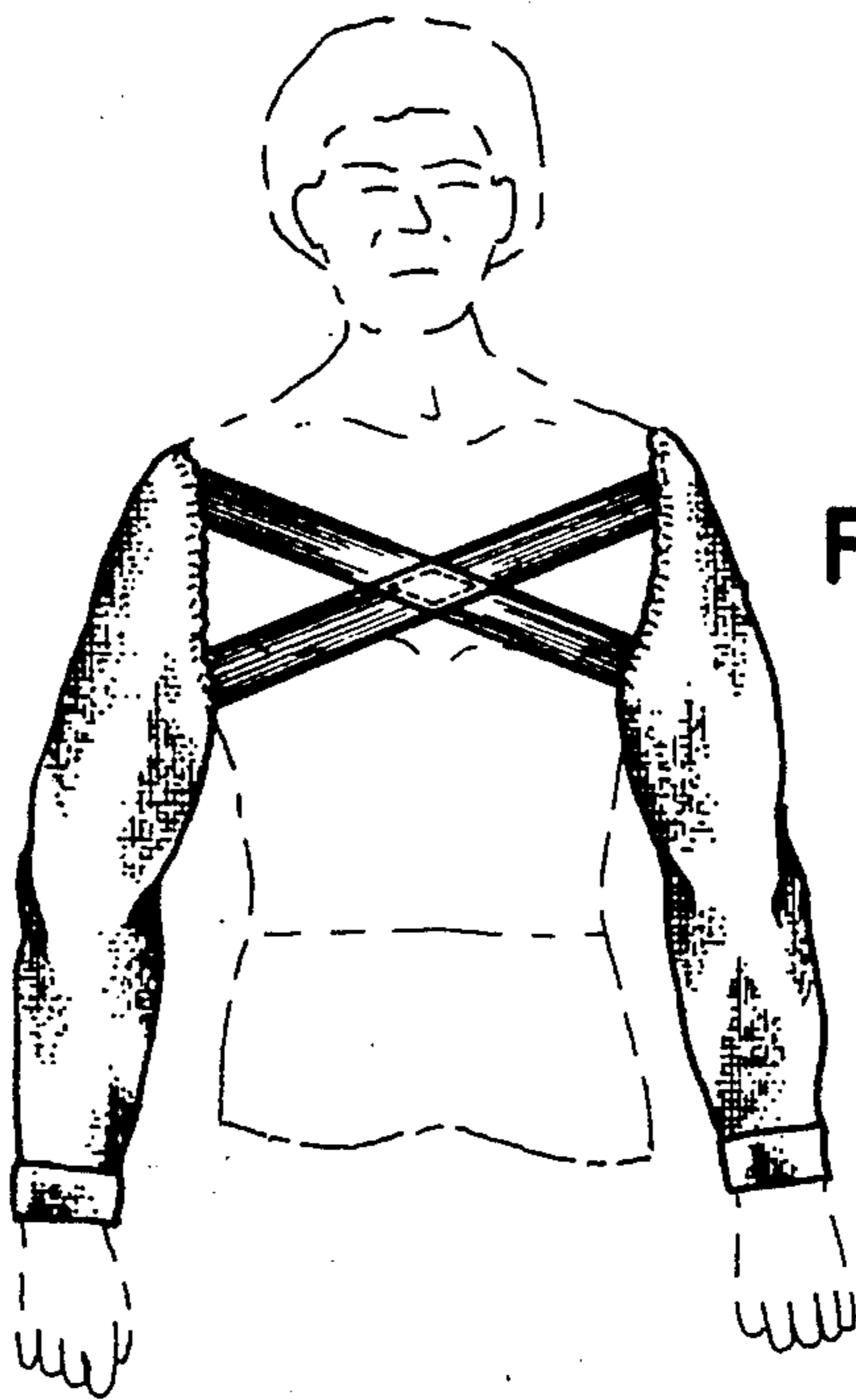

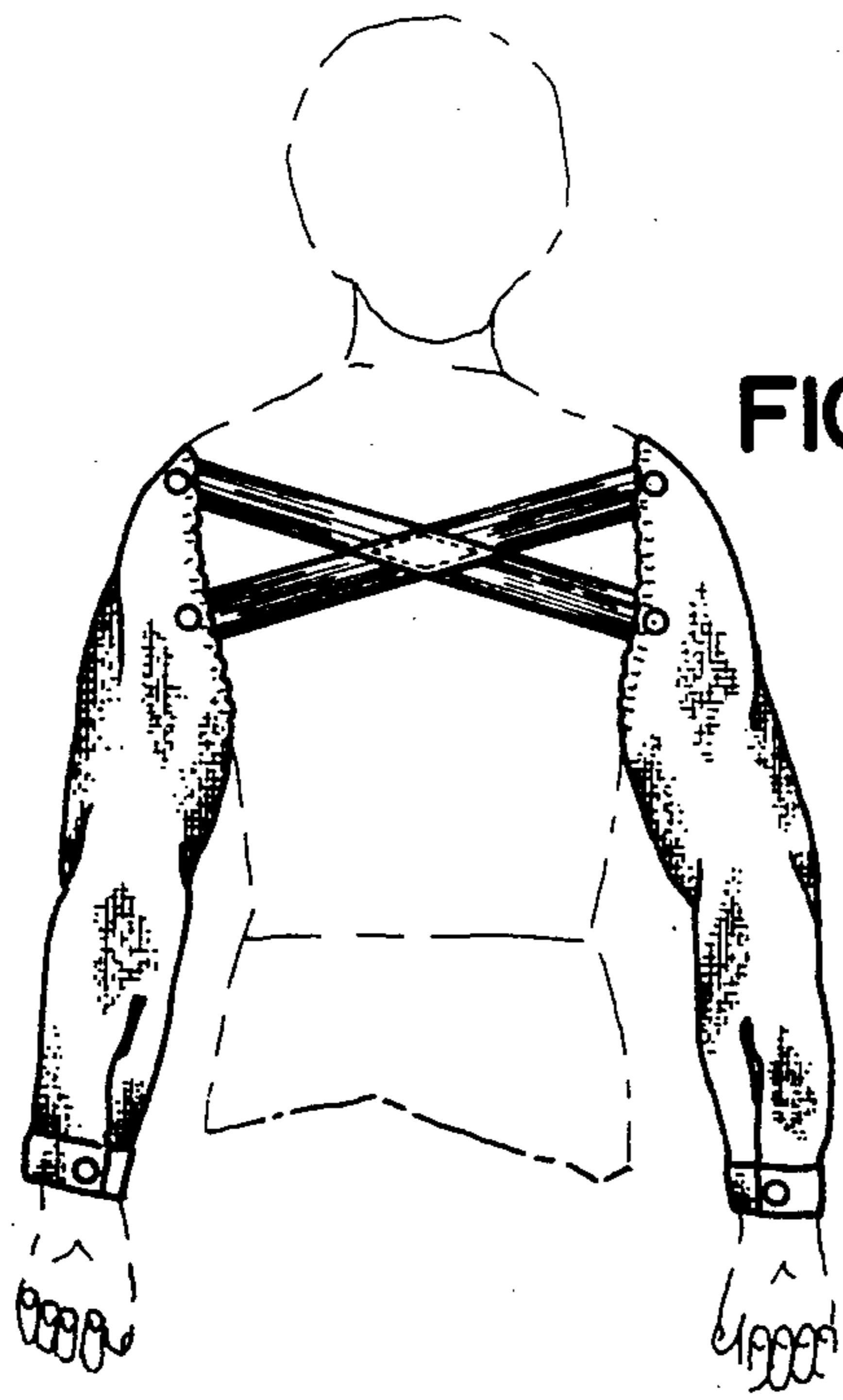

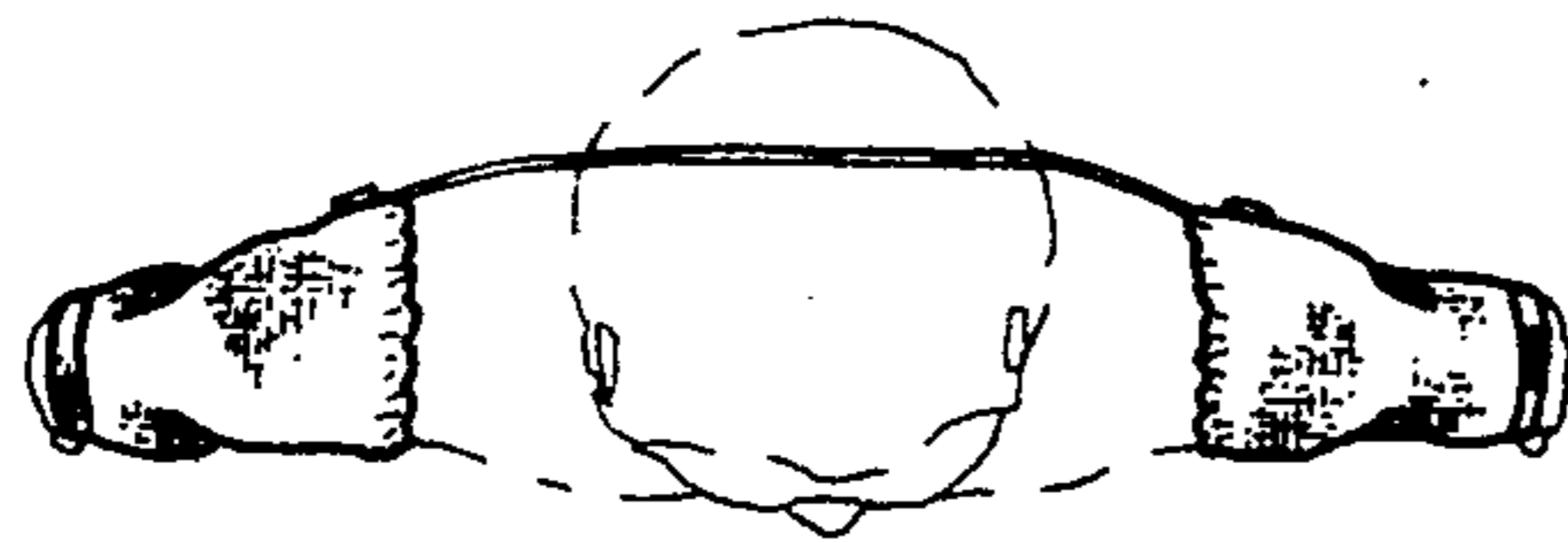
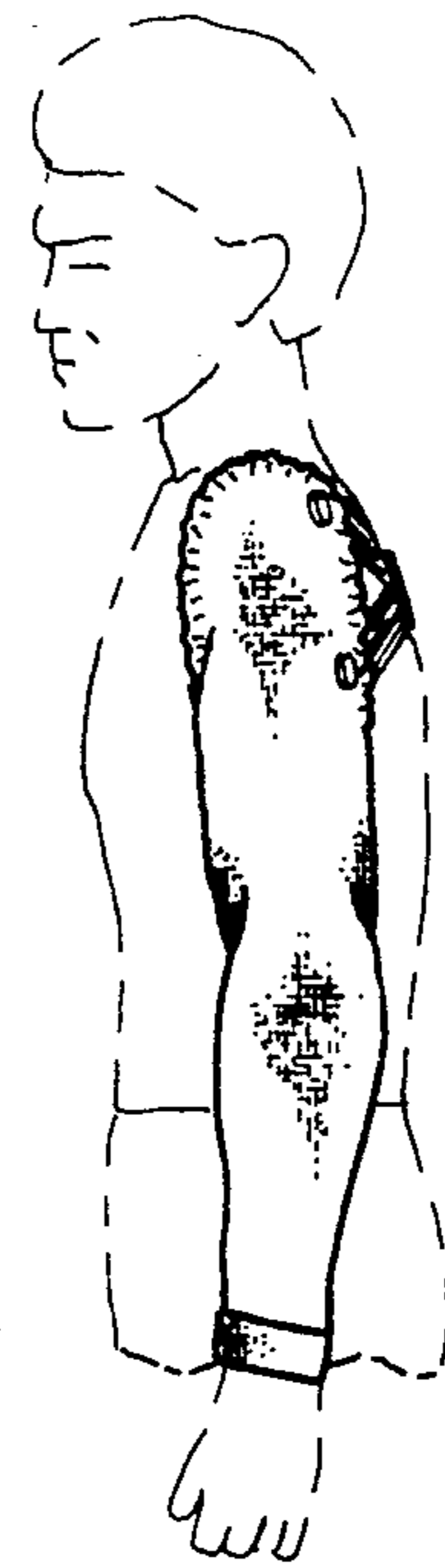
