[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a slide fastener chain, sub-
stantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a slide fastener chain show-
ing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary front elevational
view thereof.

FIG. 6 is an enlarged side elevational view of FIG. 5;
and

FIG. 7 is an enlarged top plan view thereof.

The characteristic feature of our design resides in the
clear fastener elements, each displaying the appearance
of tiny particles embedded within.

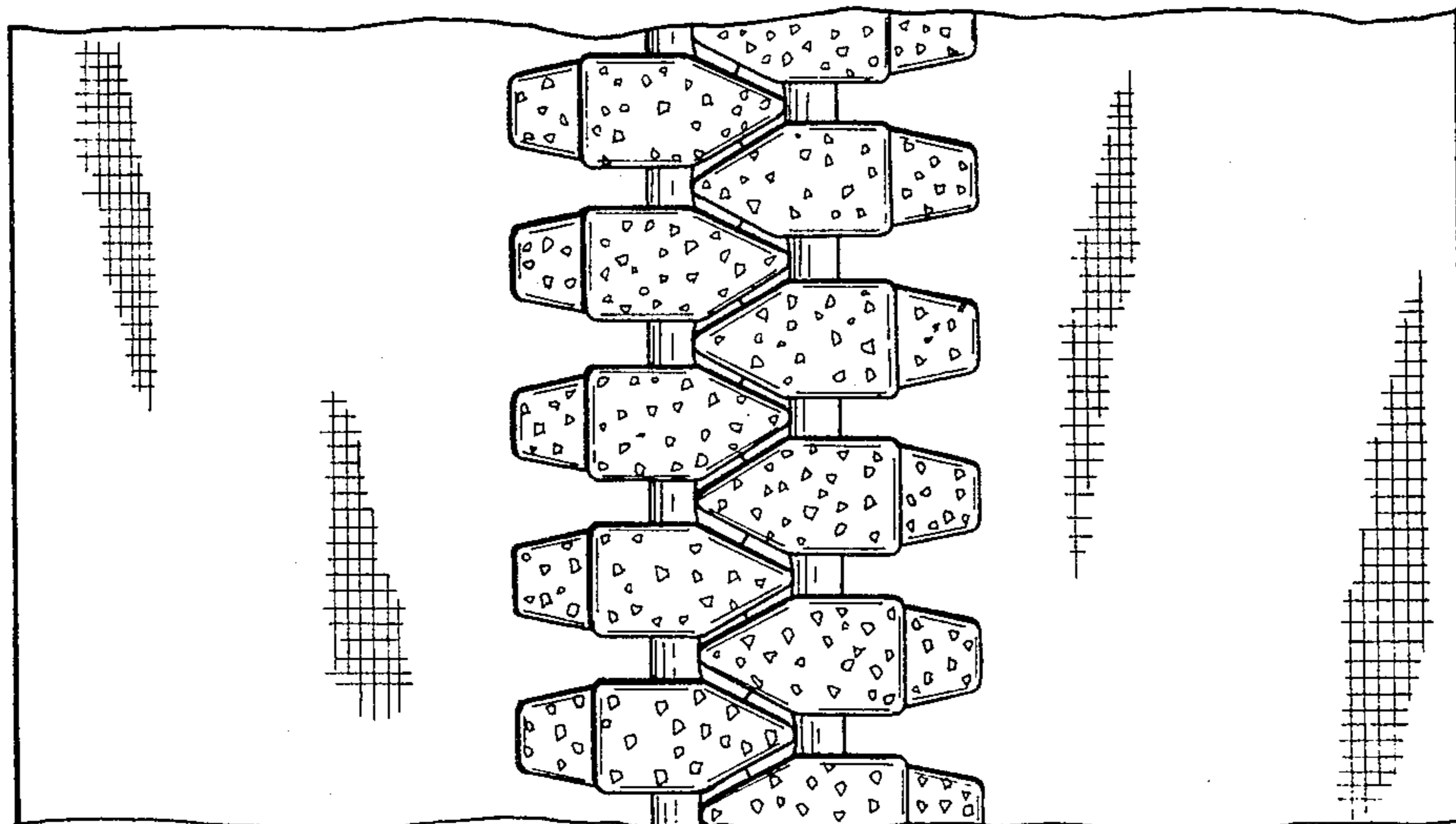

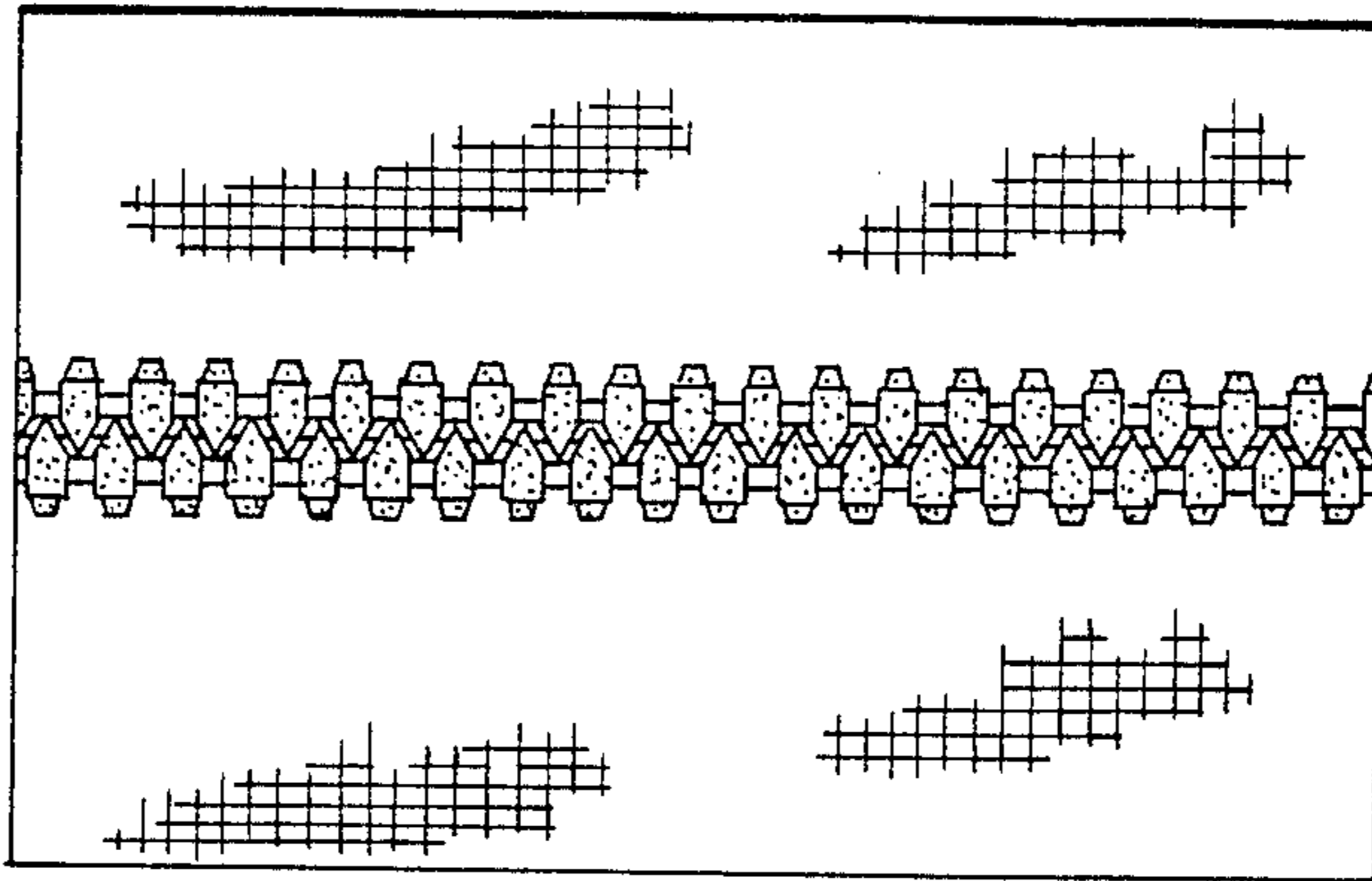

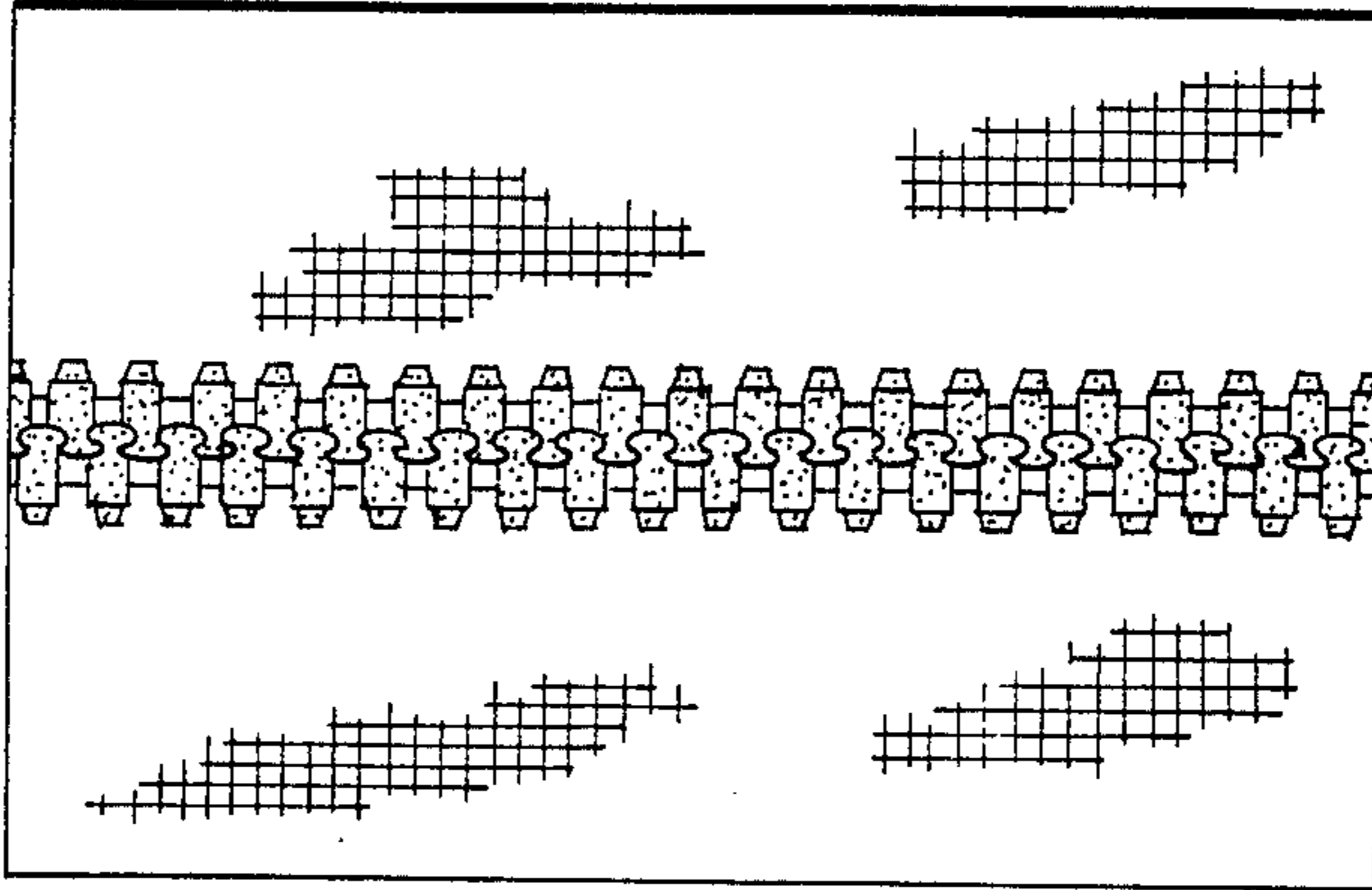

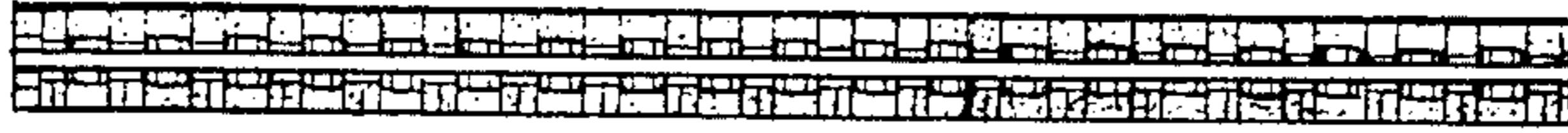

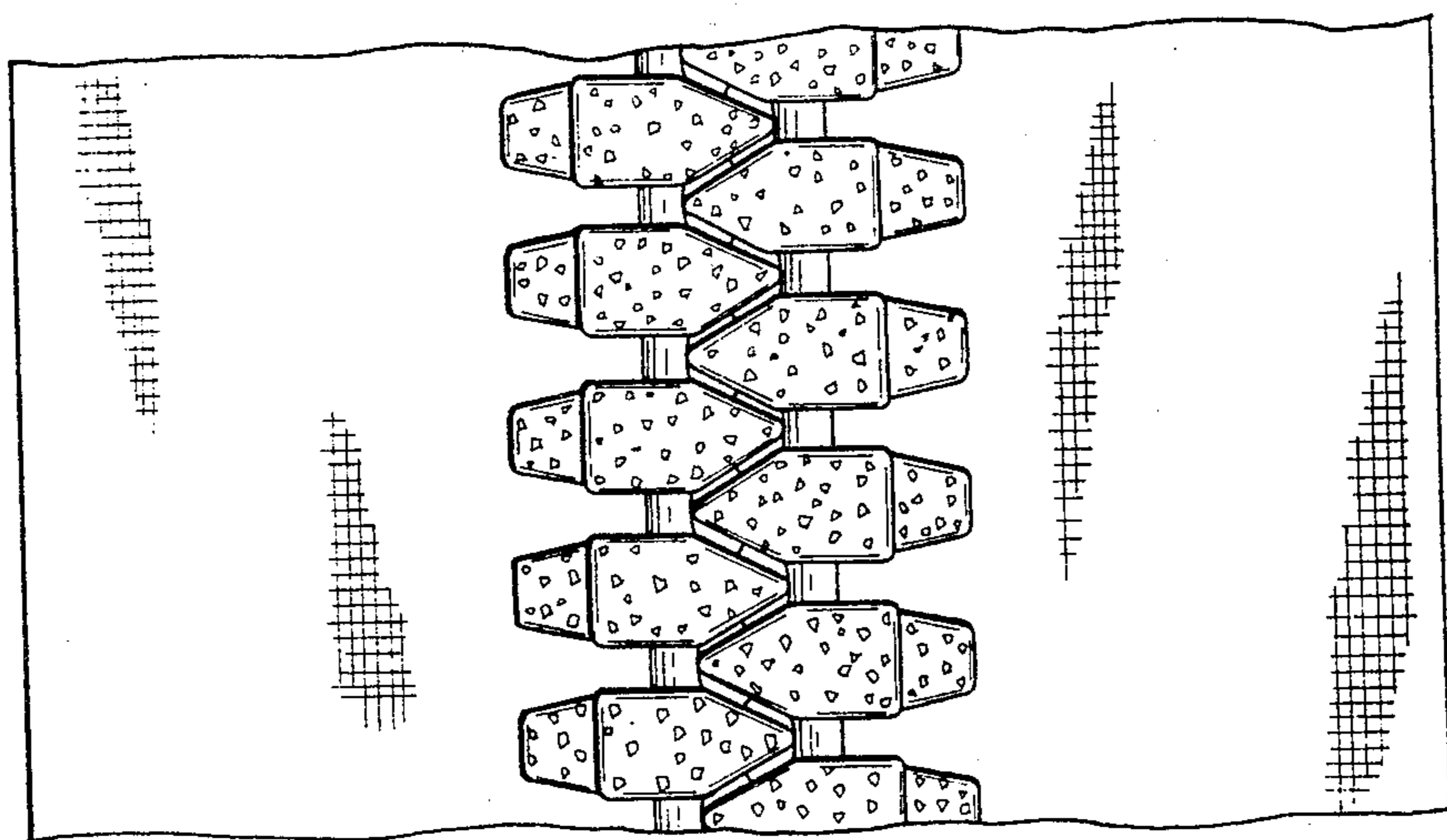

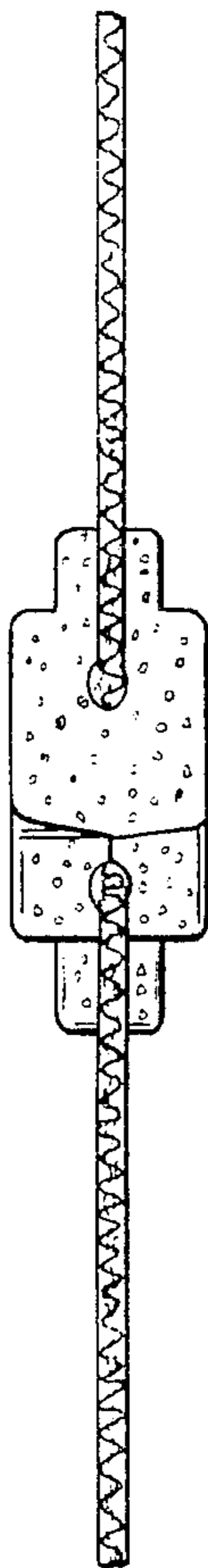

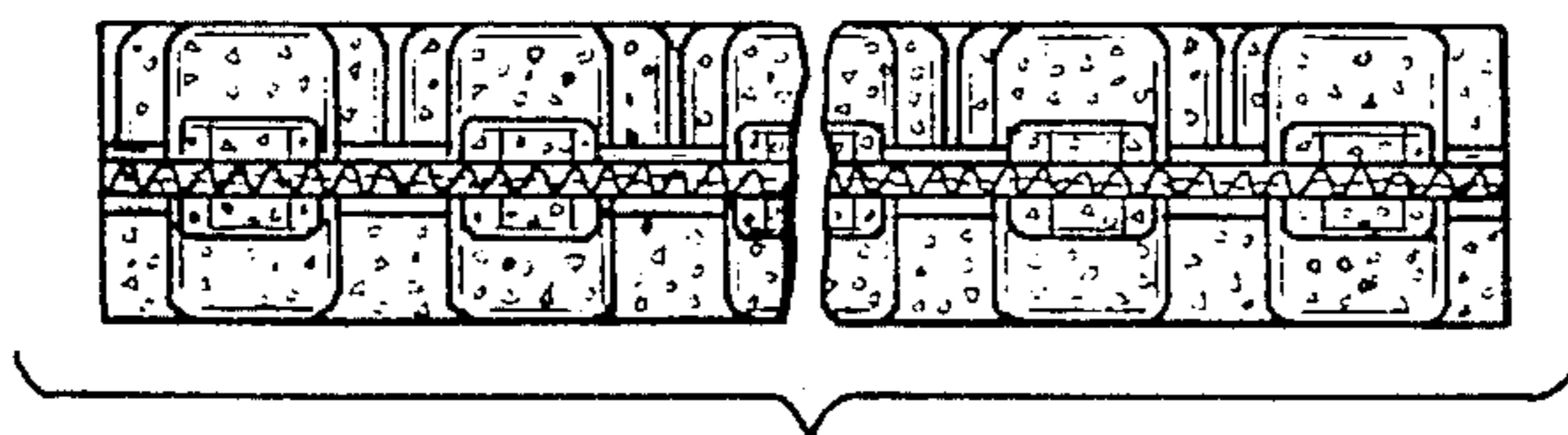
