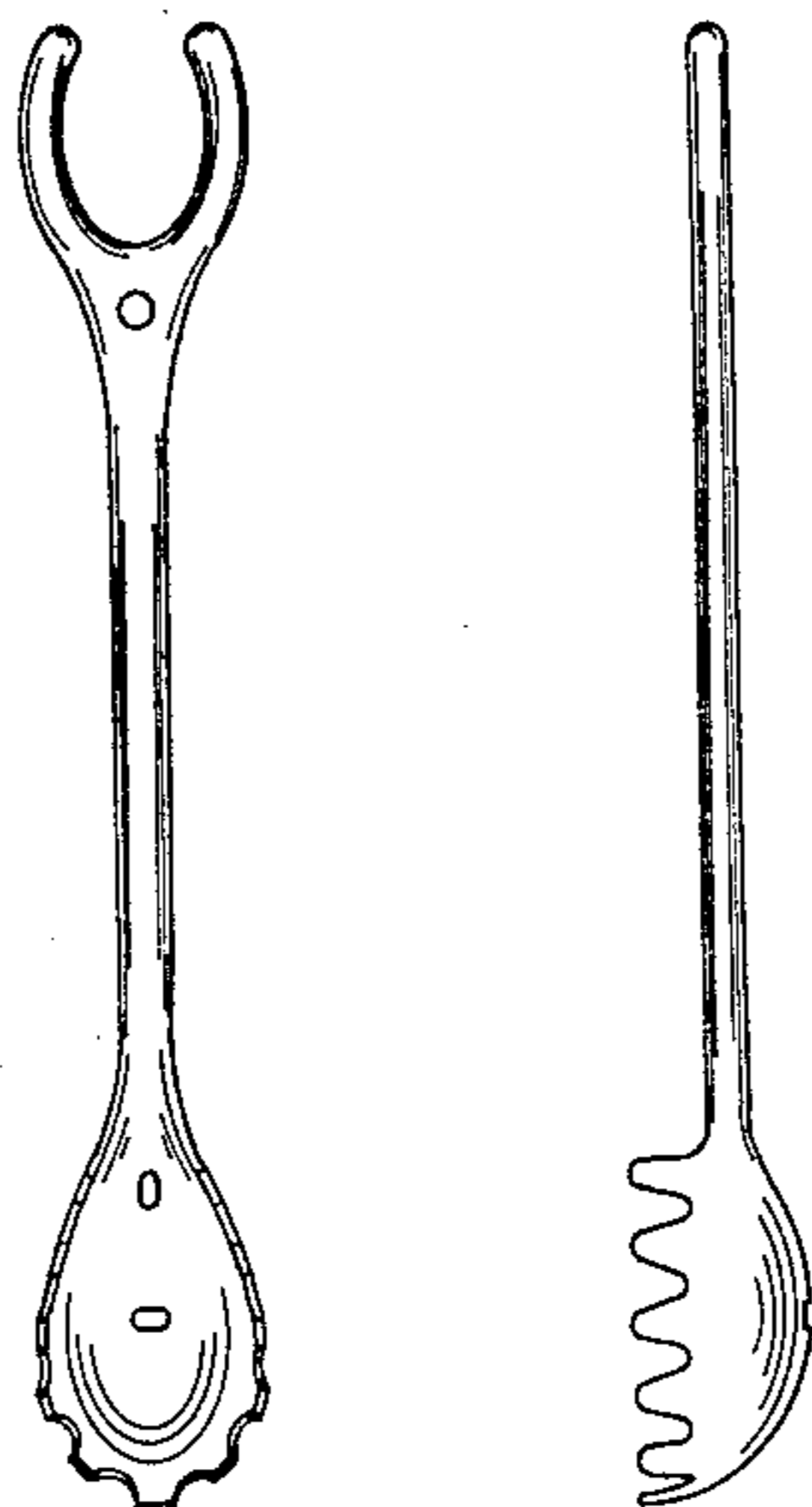

[57] **CLAIM**

The original design for a combined pasta measuring and serving utensil, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined pasta measuring and serving utensil, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



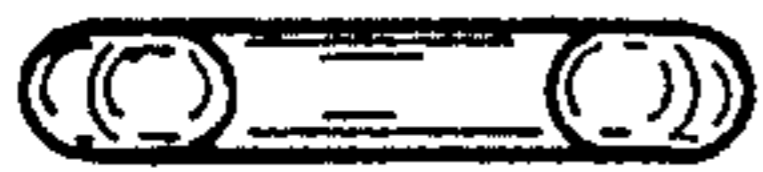

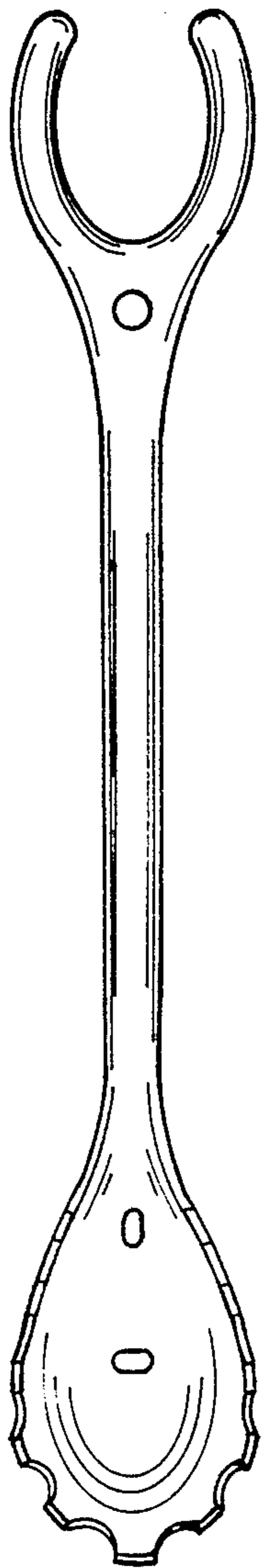

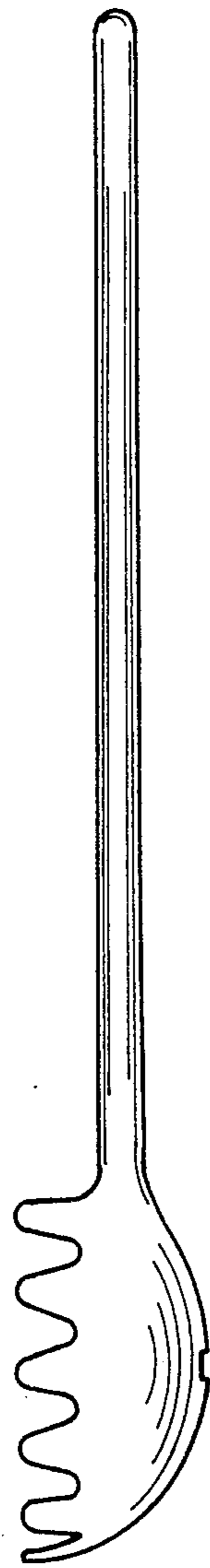

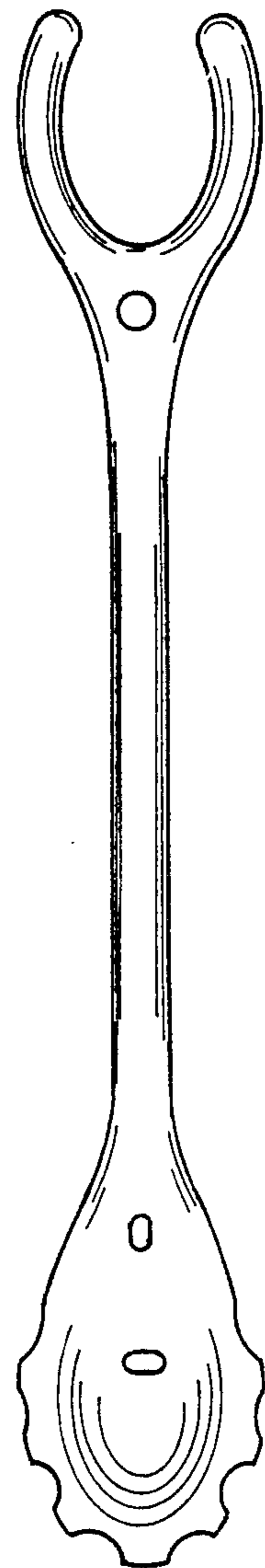

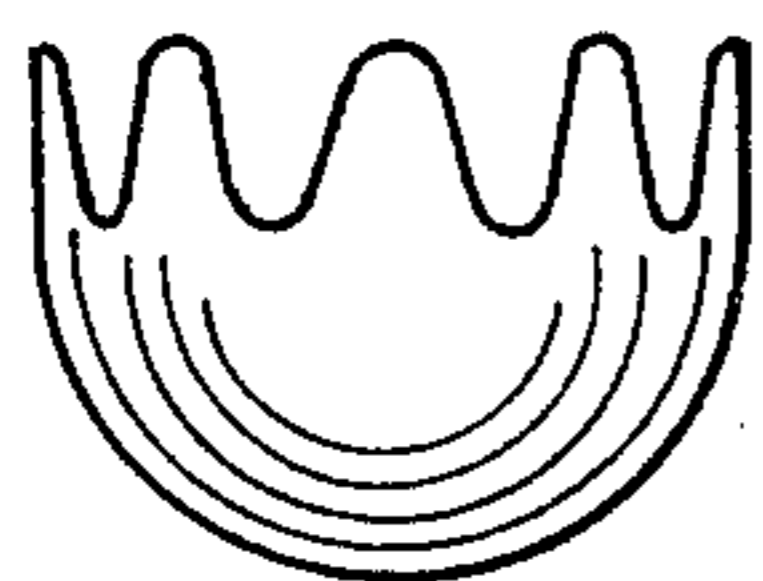
