DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a stove guard, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a back elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right end elevation view of the stove guard, the view of the opposite end being identical thereto, as shown in FIG. 1, except for the small hole shown in FIG. 6;

FIG. 7 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of a stove guard;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof;

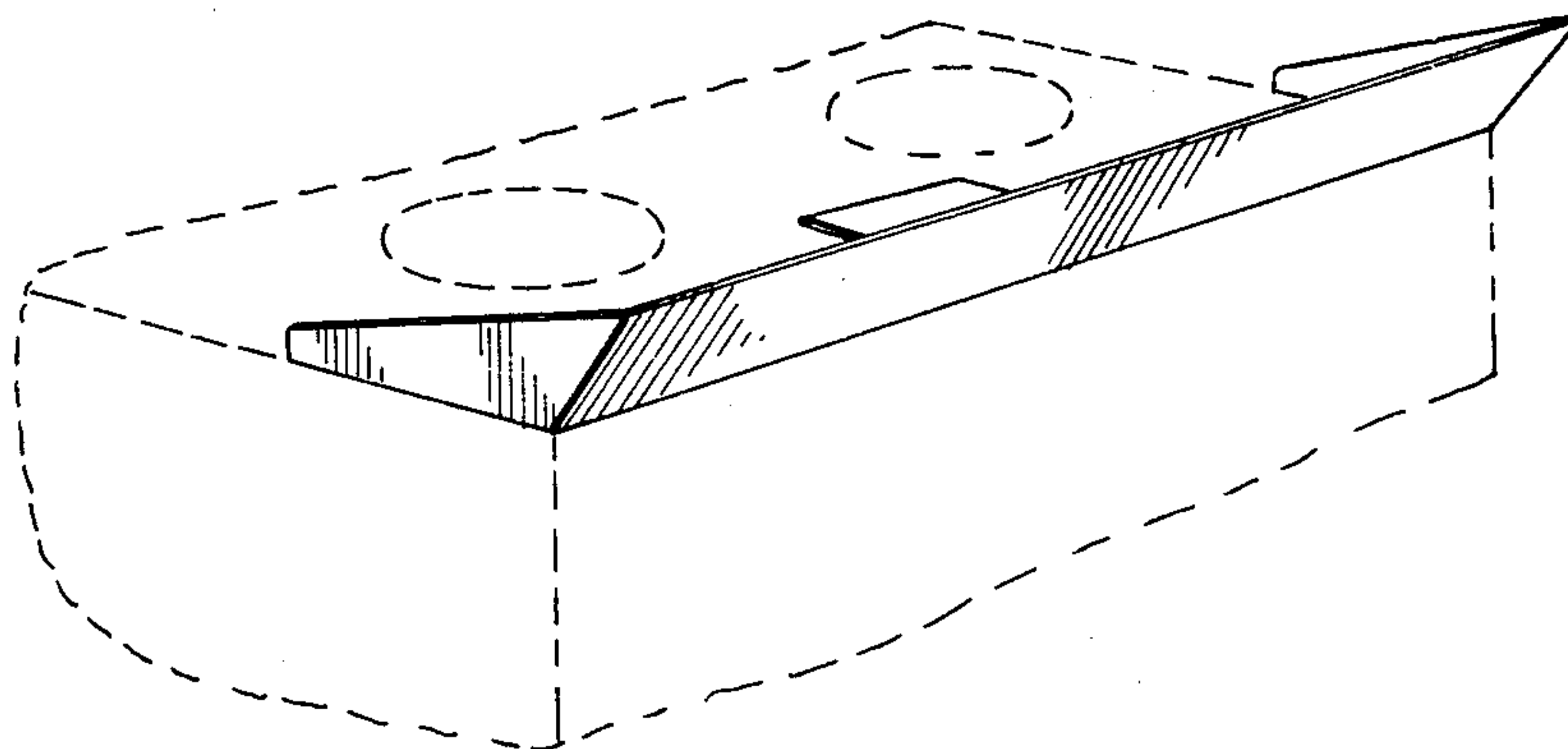
FIG. 9 is a front elevation view thereof;

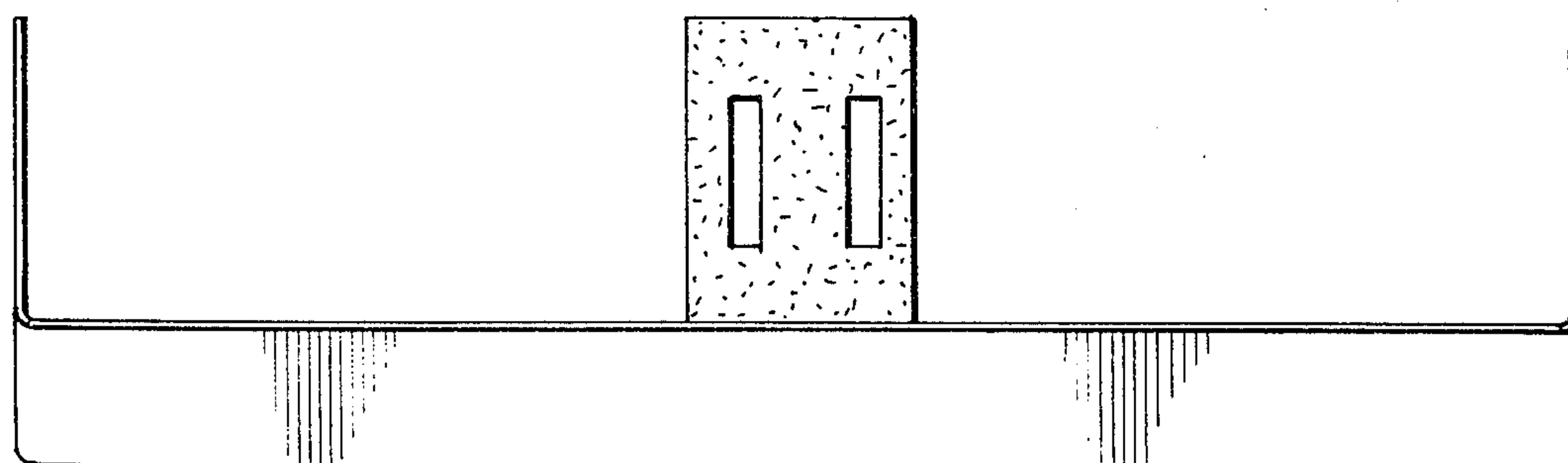
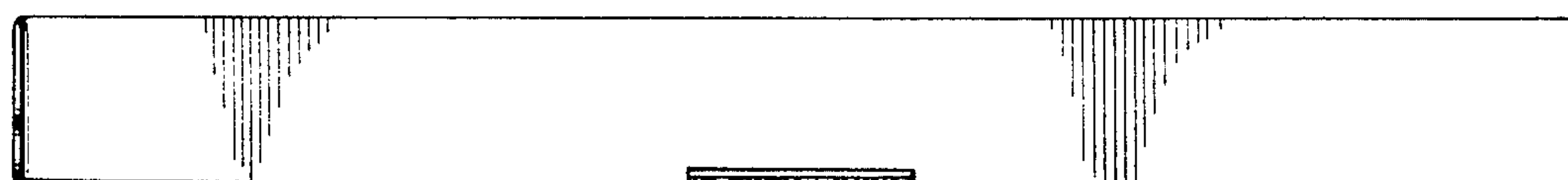
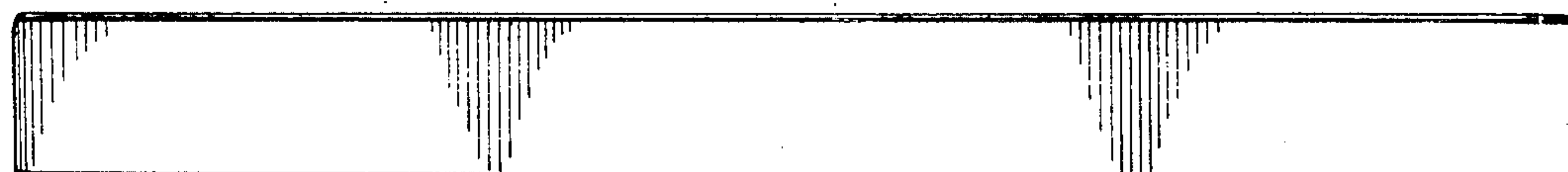
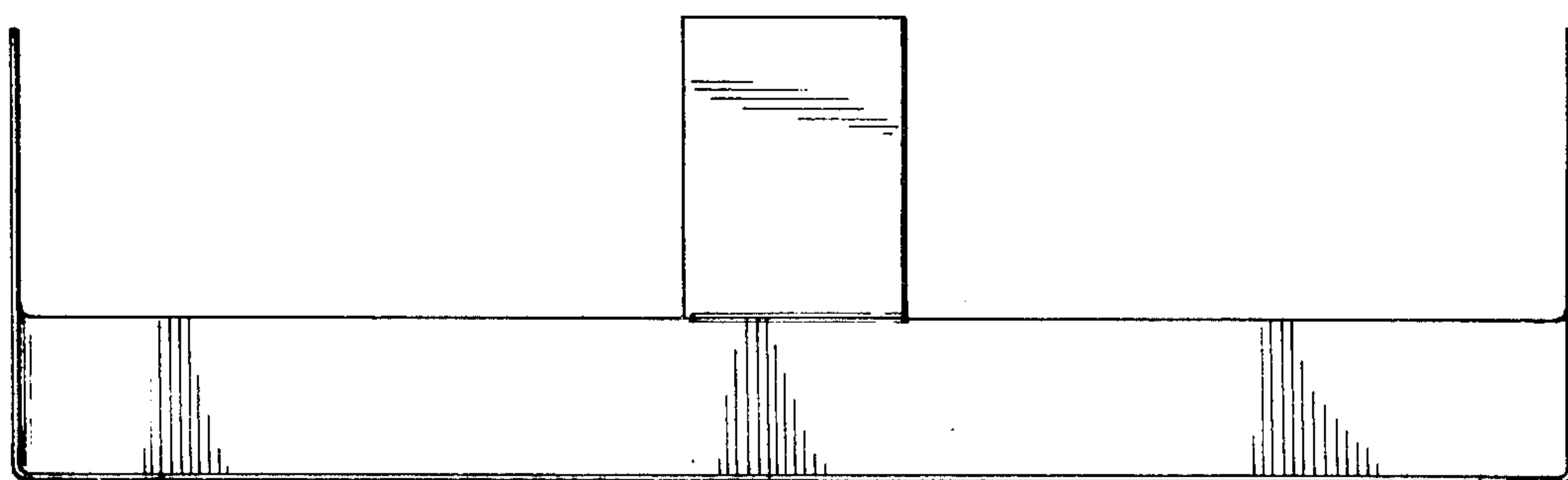
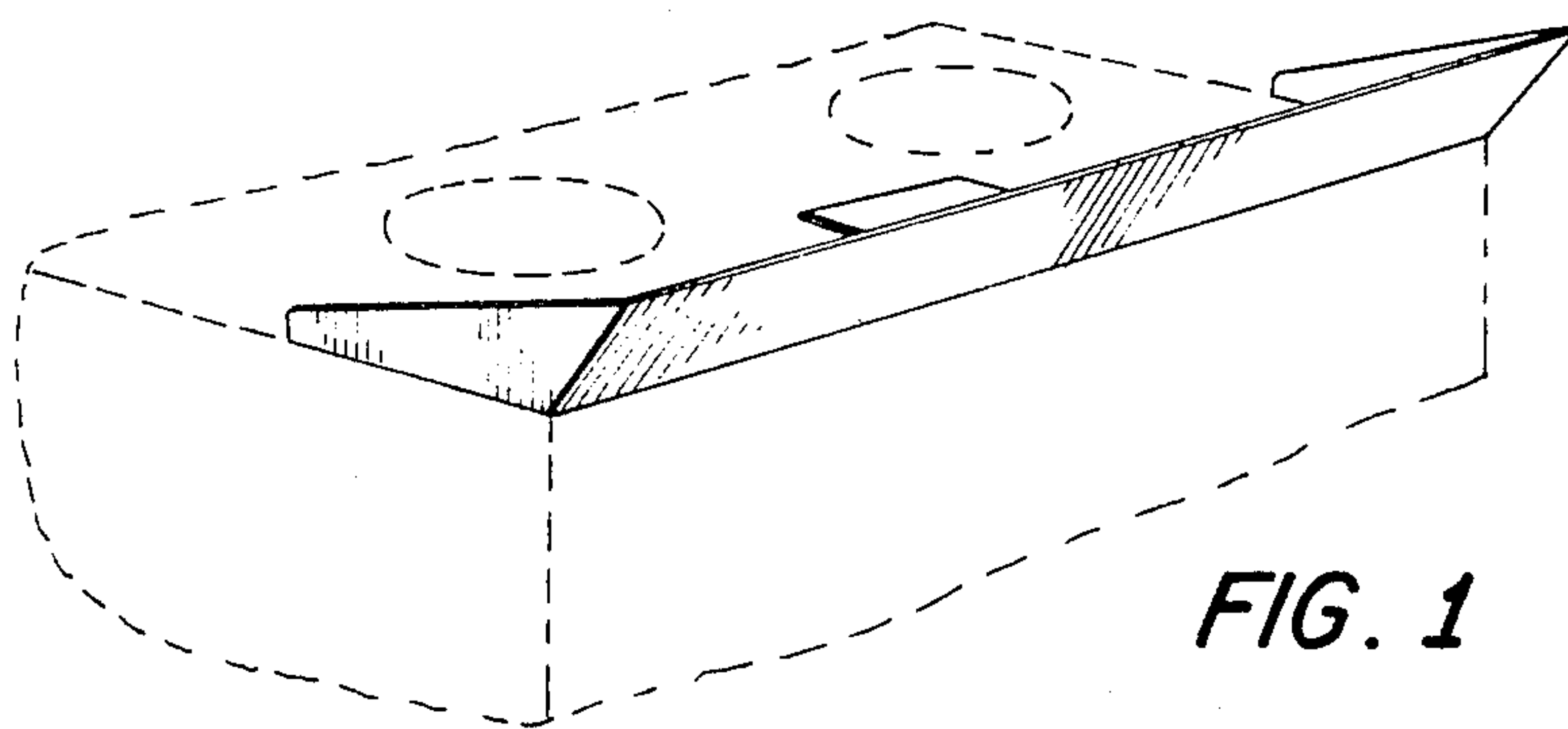
FIG. 10 is a back elevation view thereof;

The broken line disclosure shown in FIGS. 1 and 7 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.





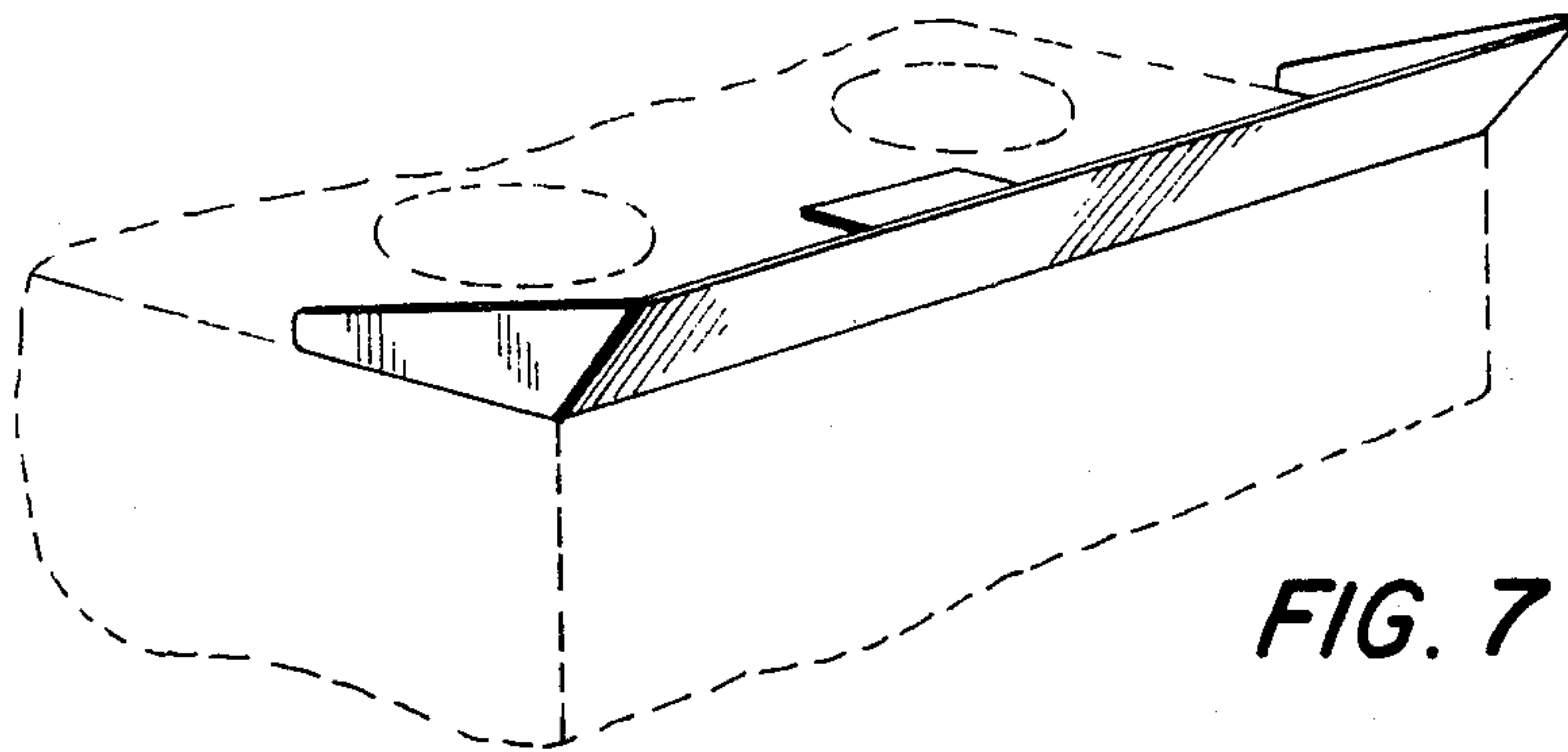

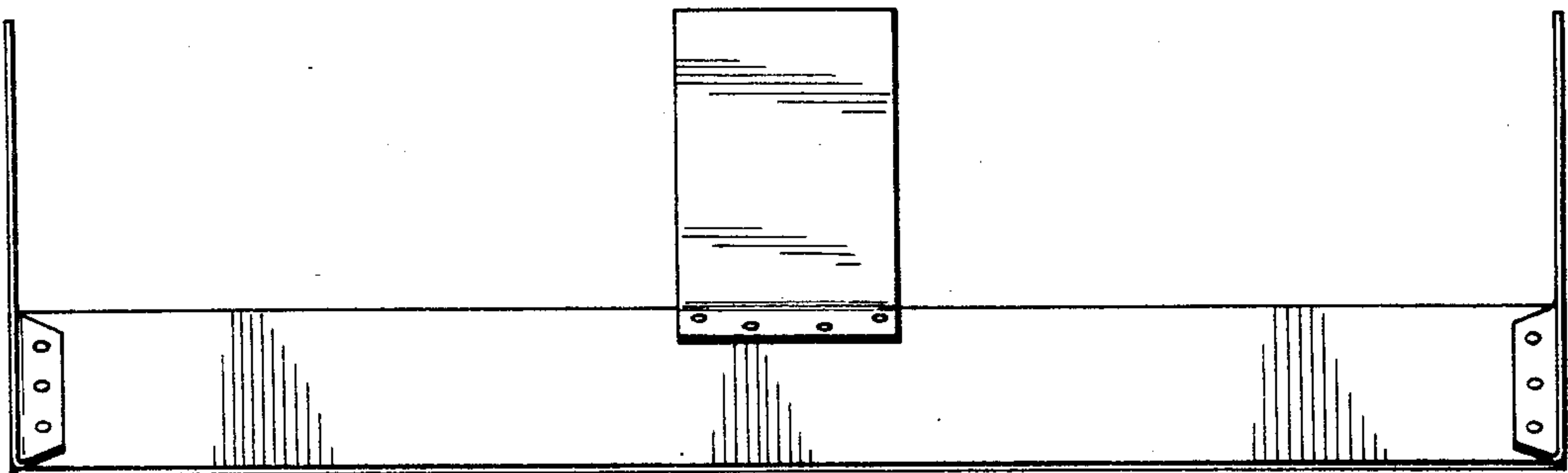

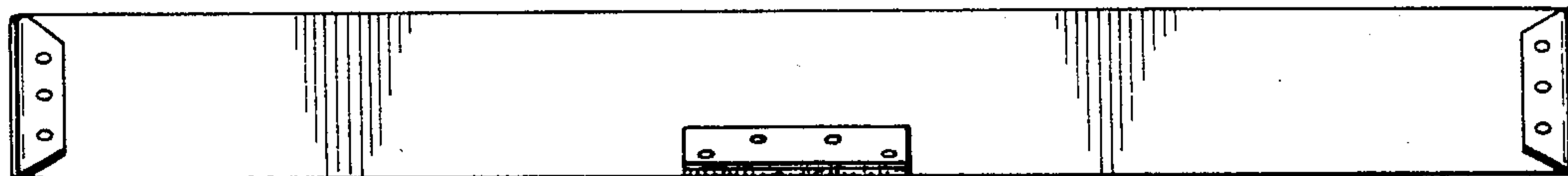

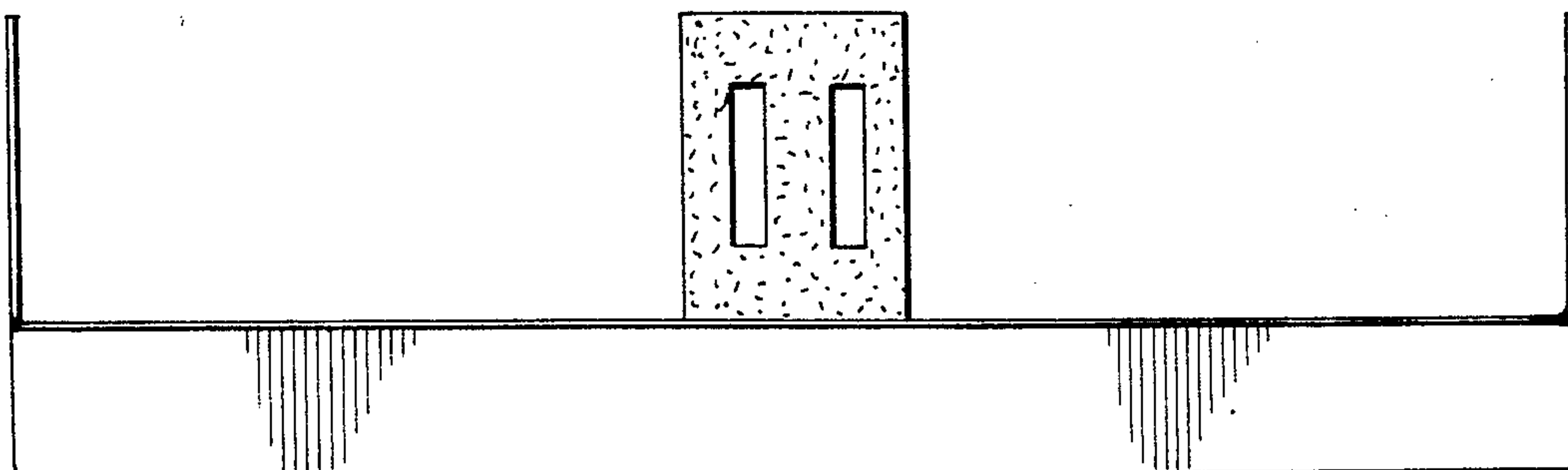

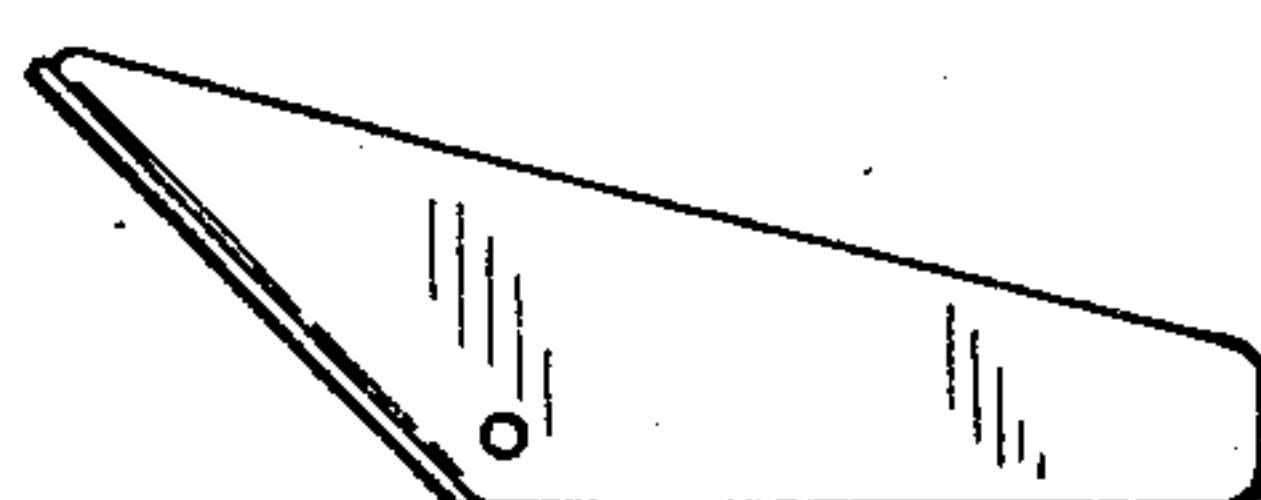
