The bottom is unornamented.

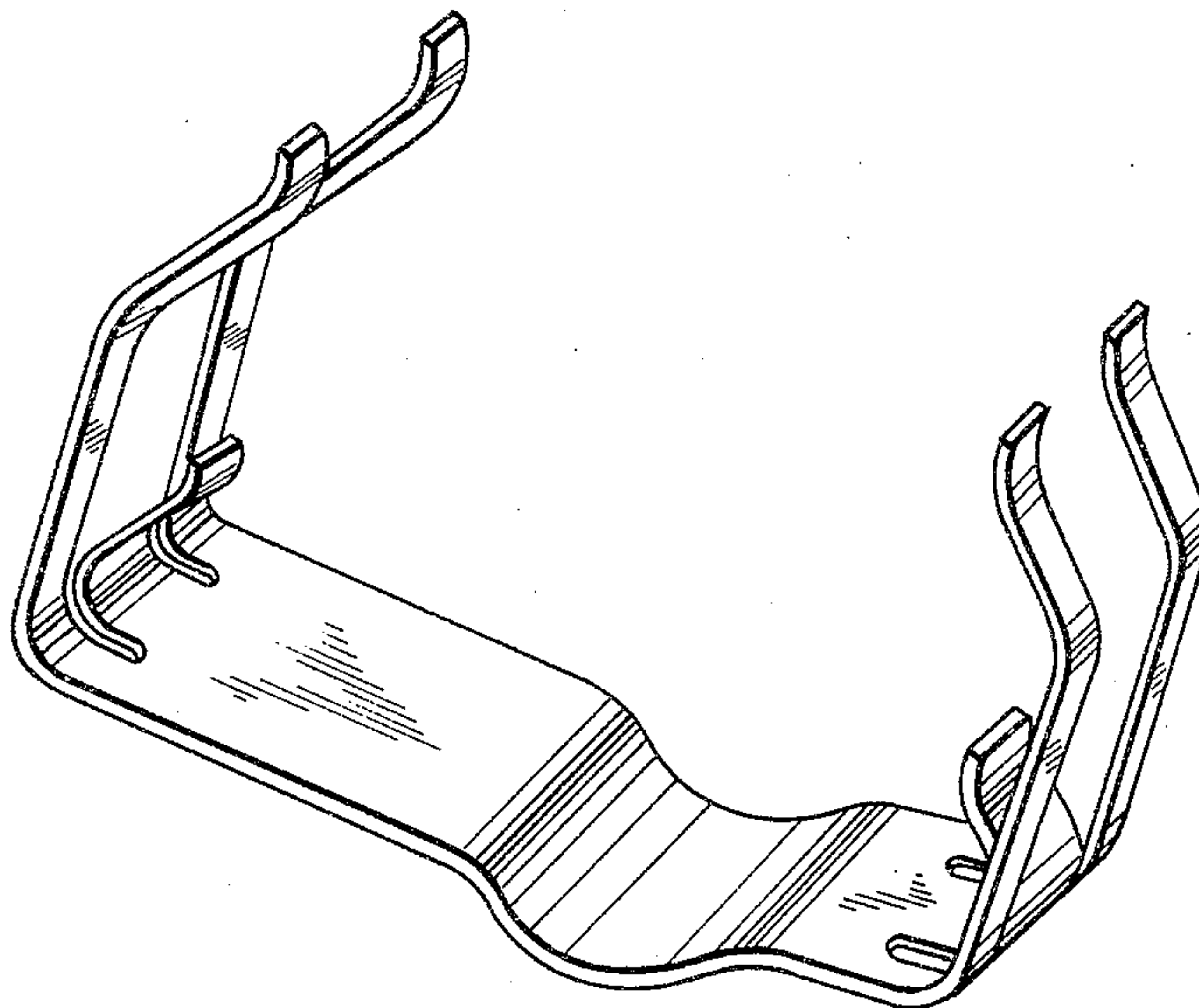

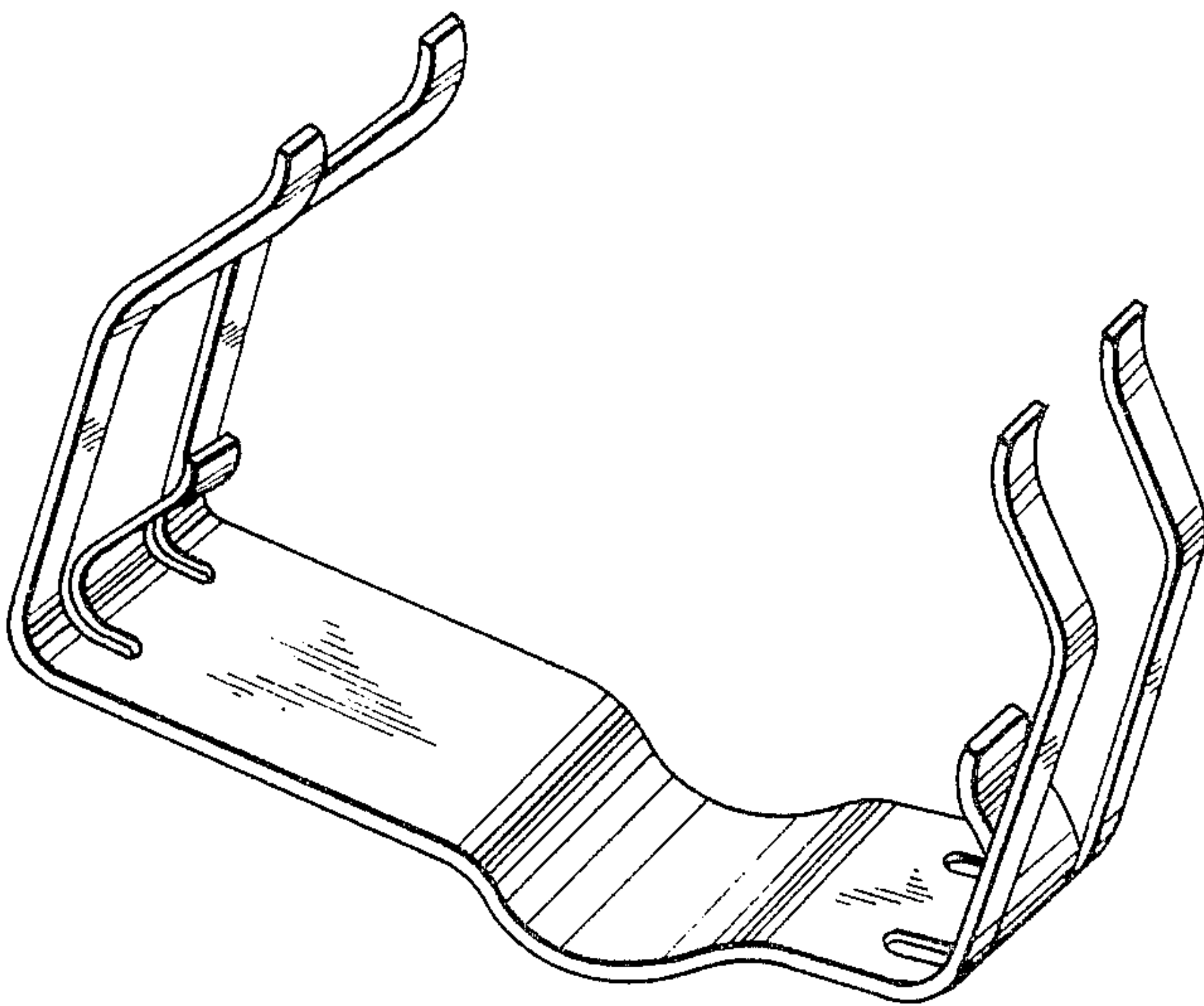

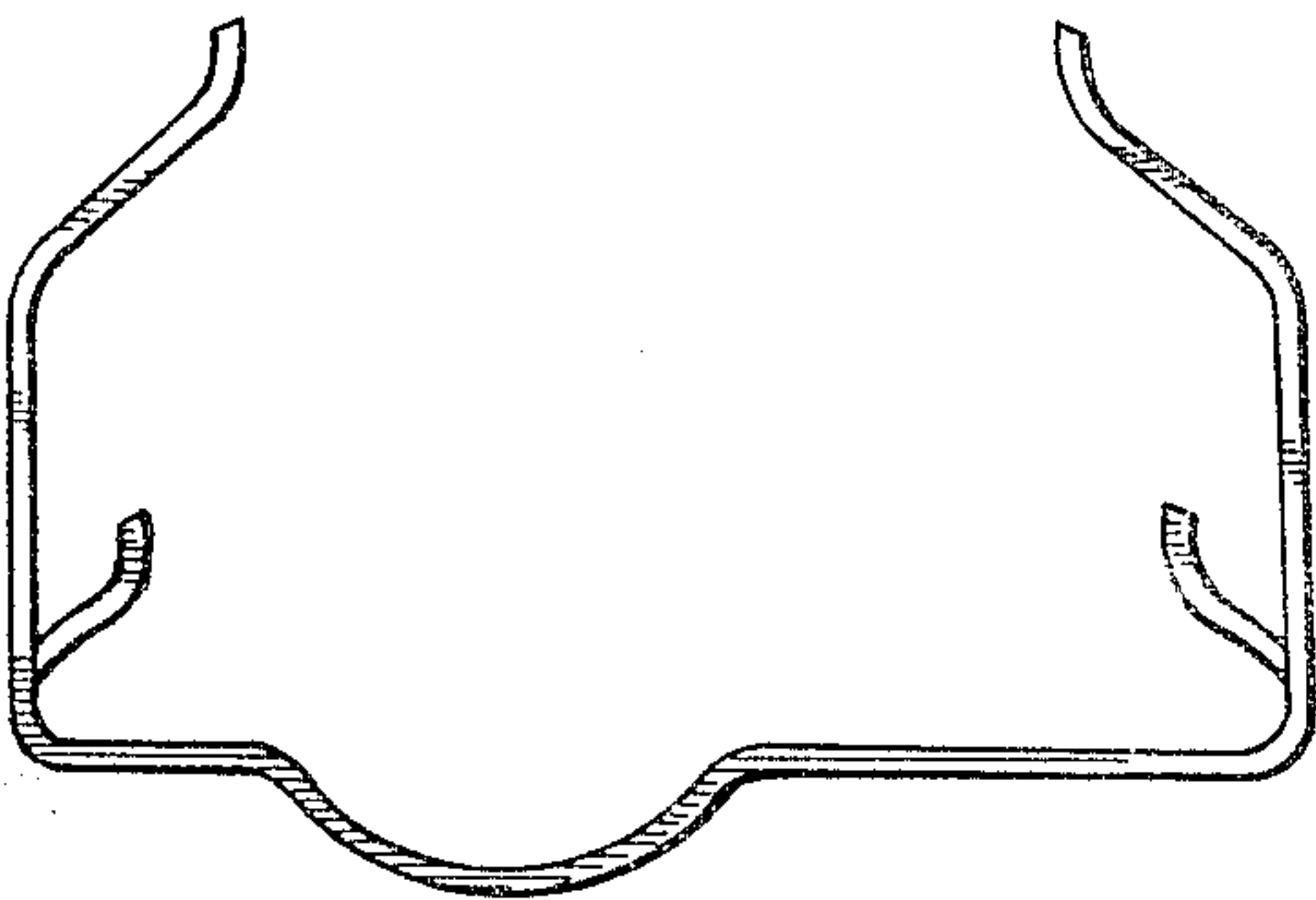
