FIG. 12 is a view like FIG. 1 showing a digital display.

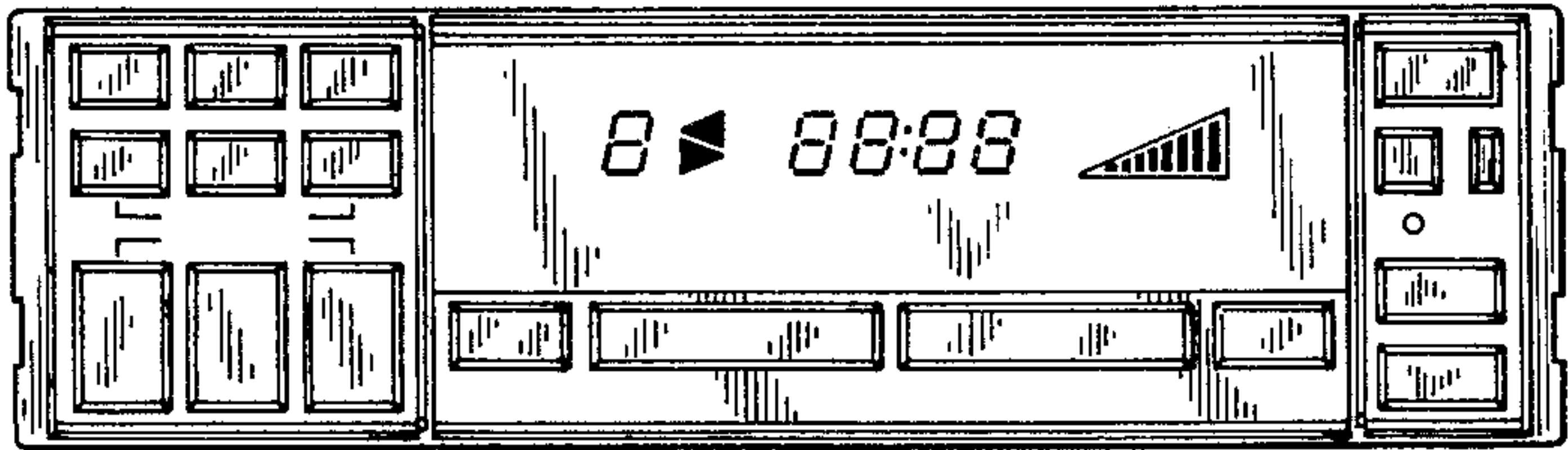
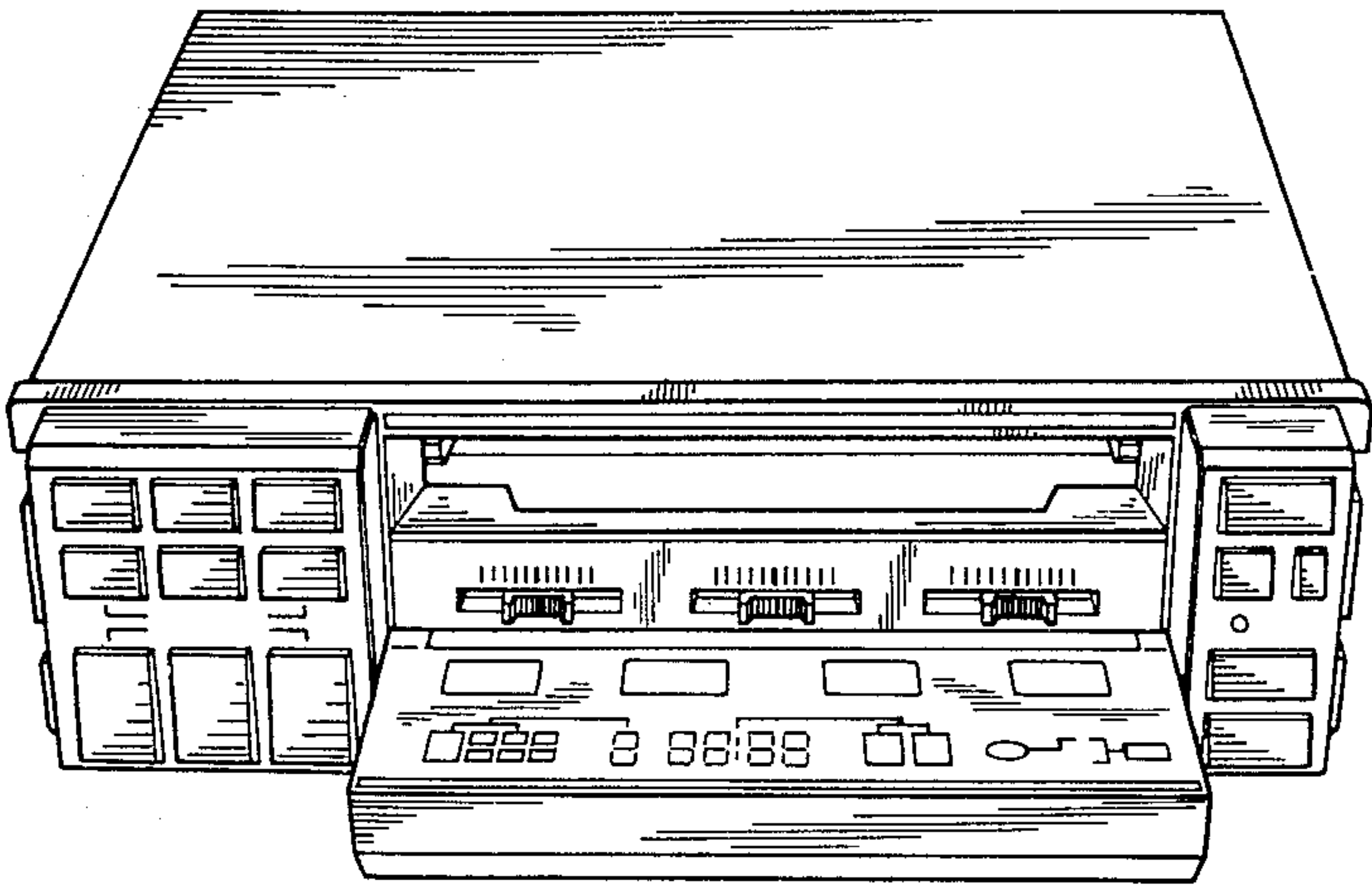

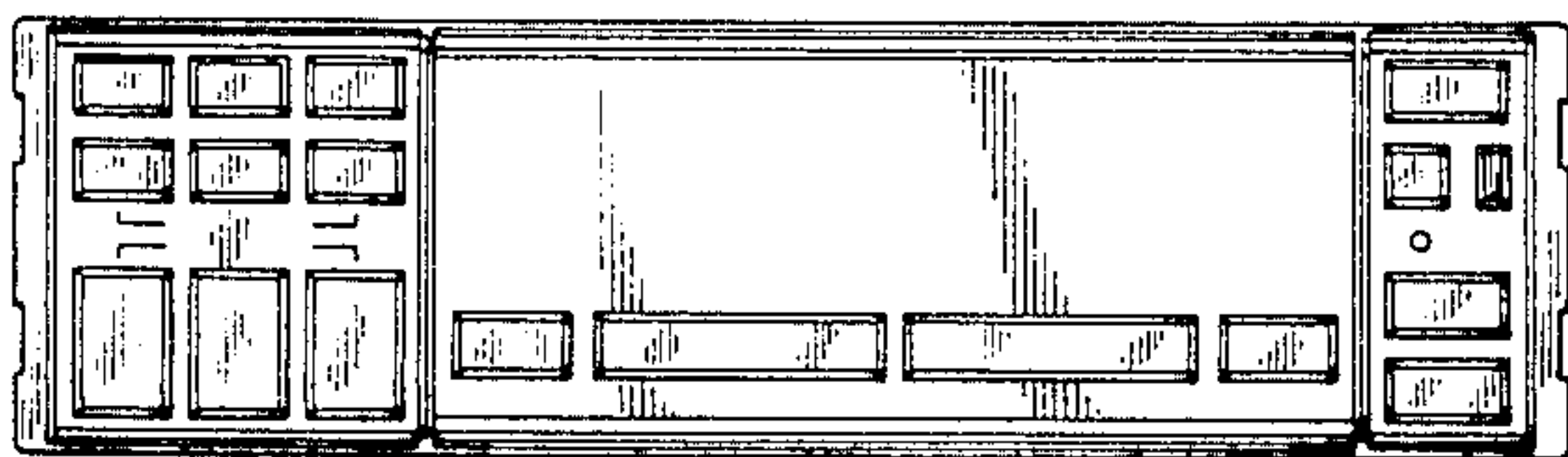

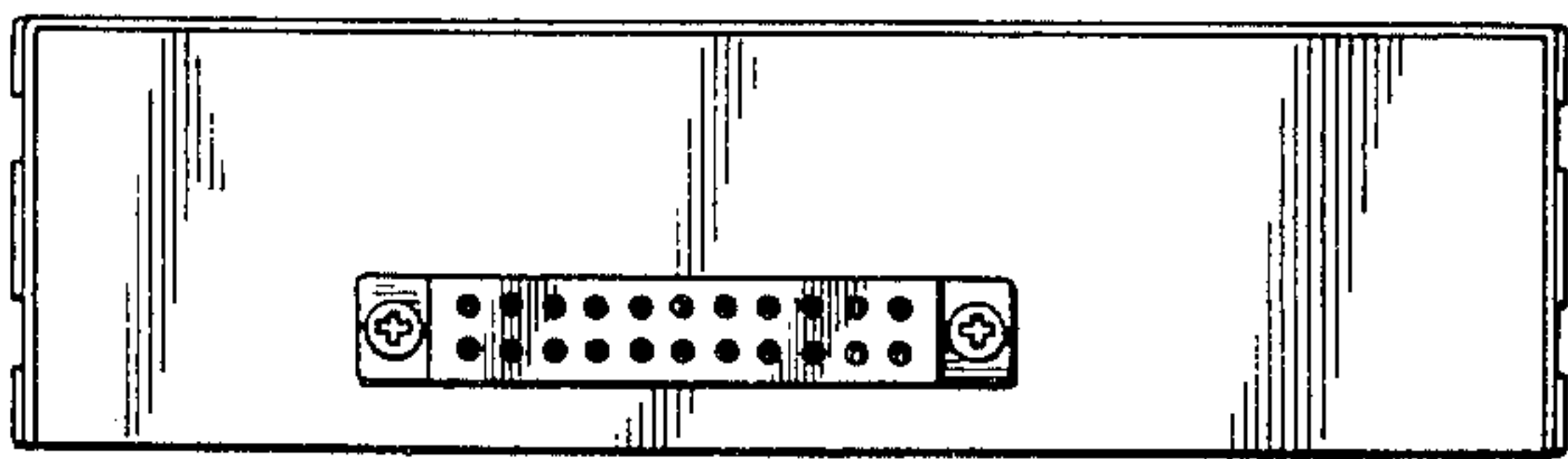

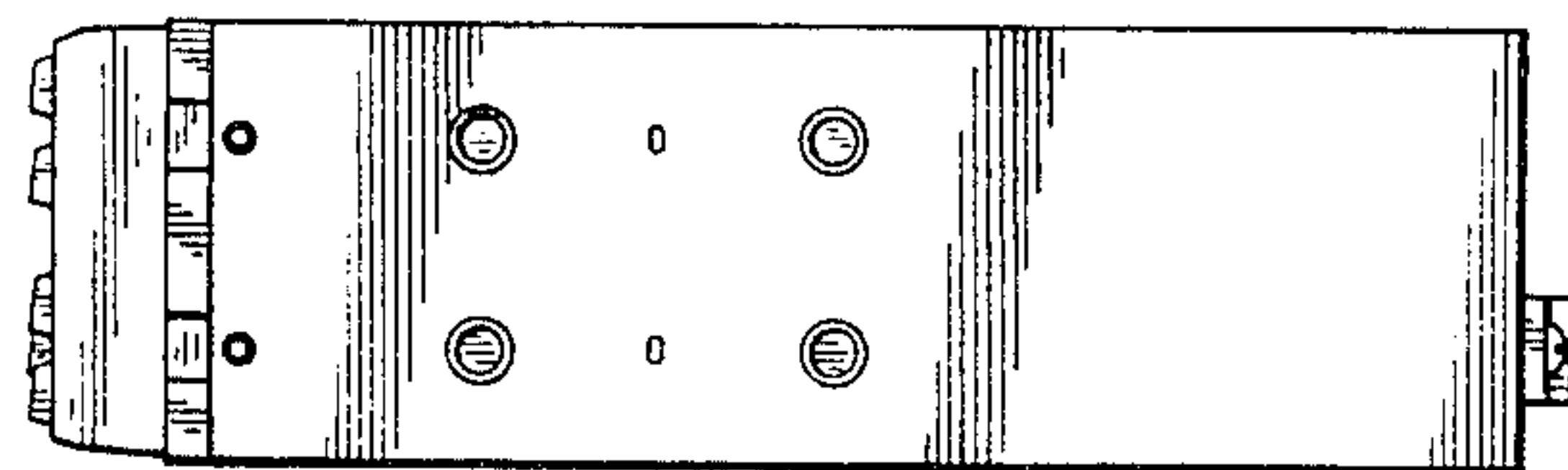

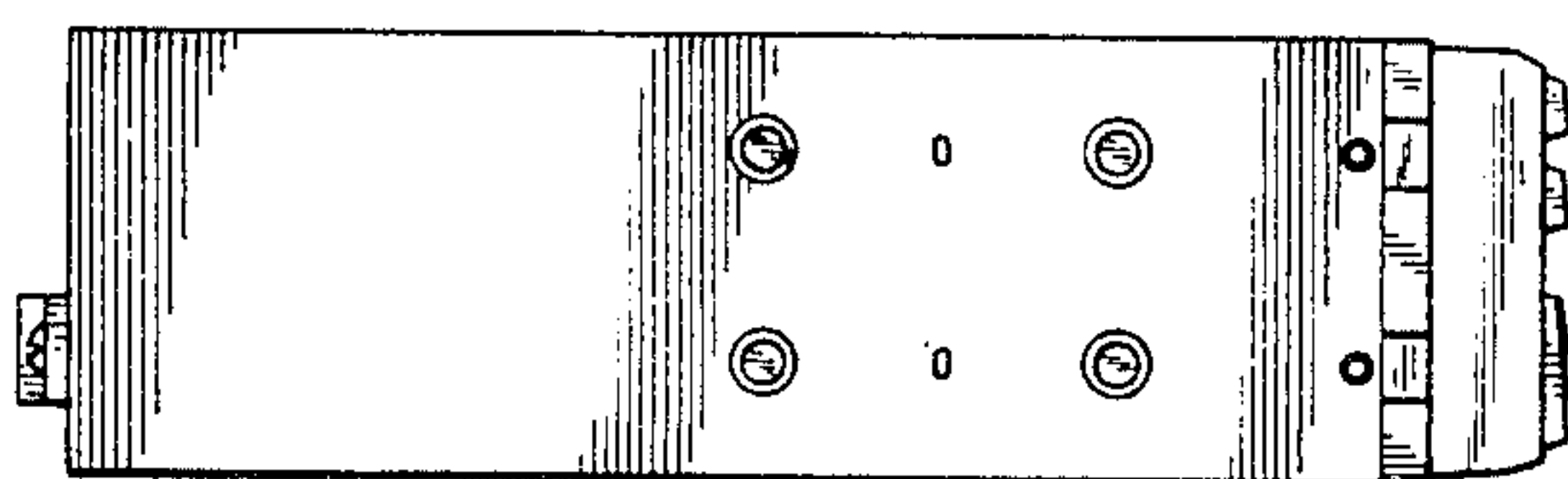

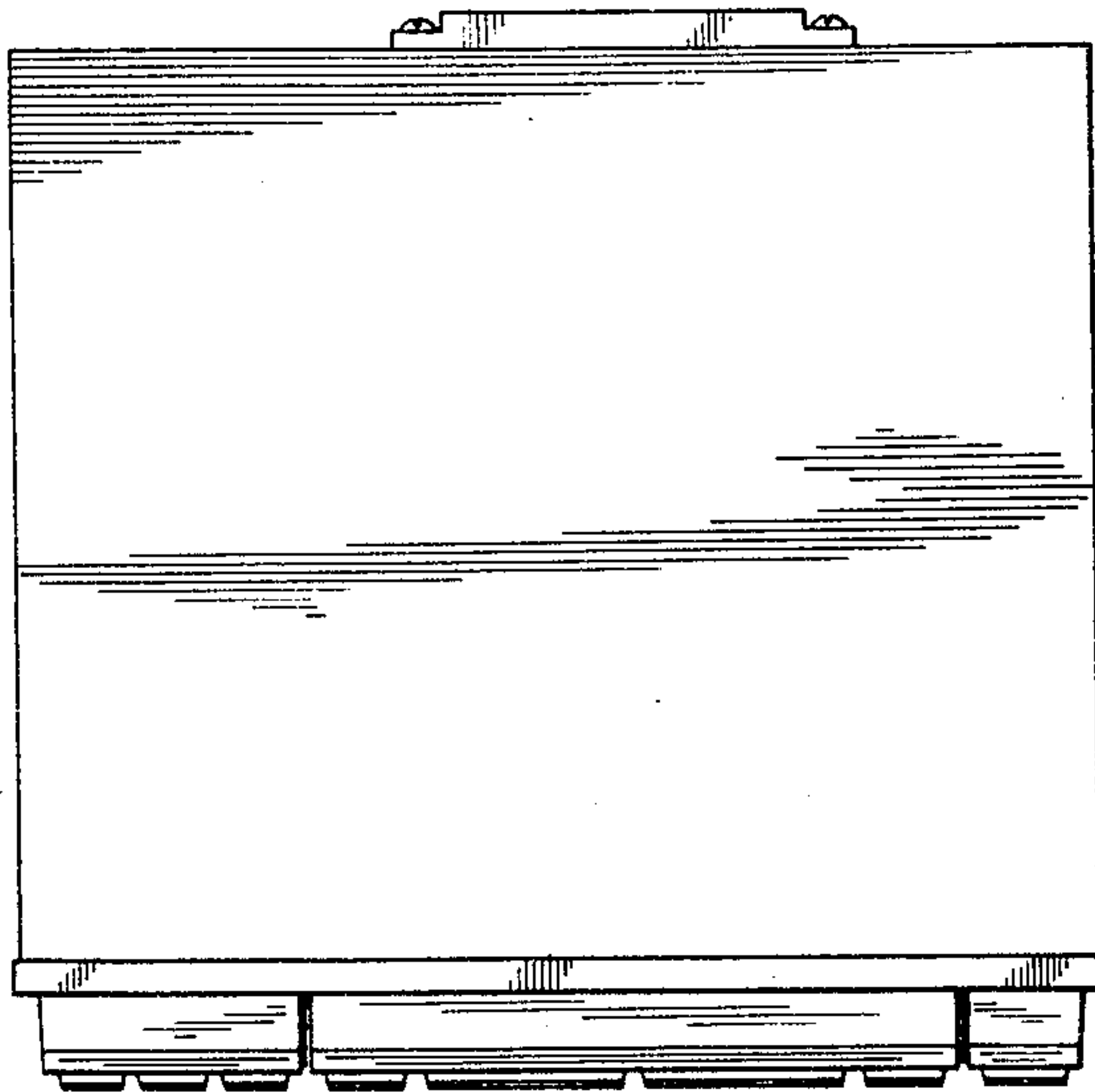

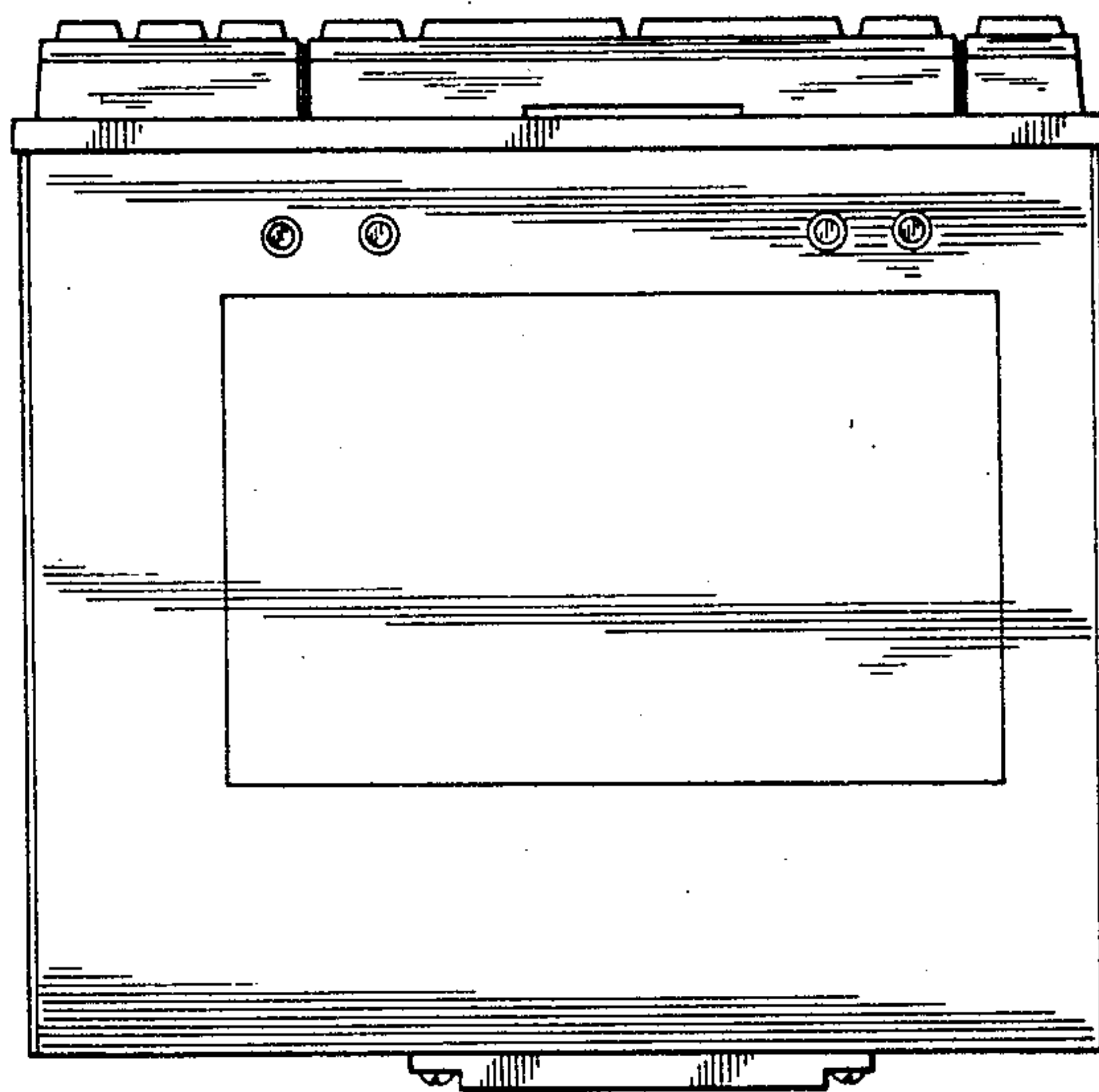

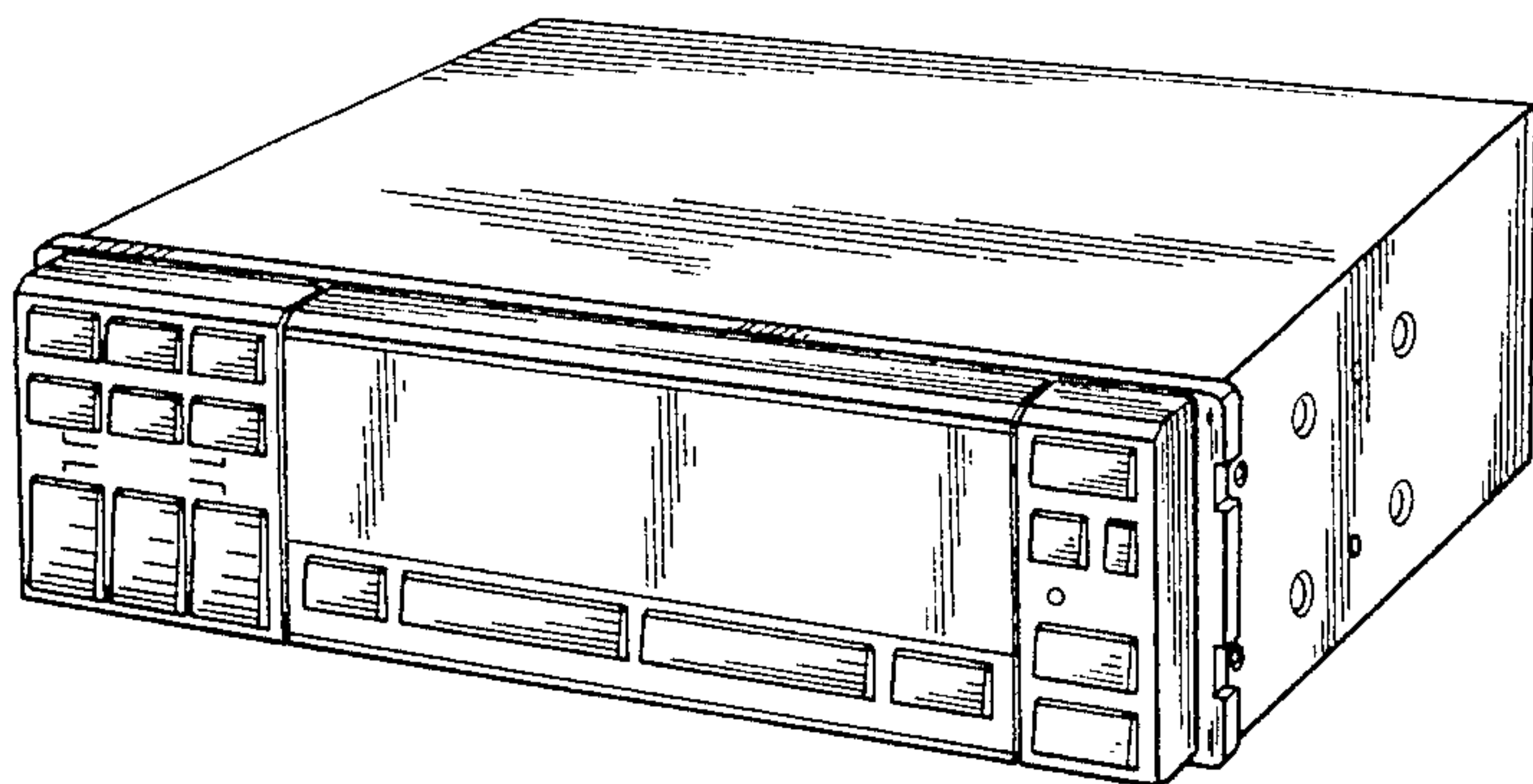
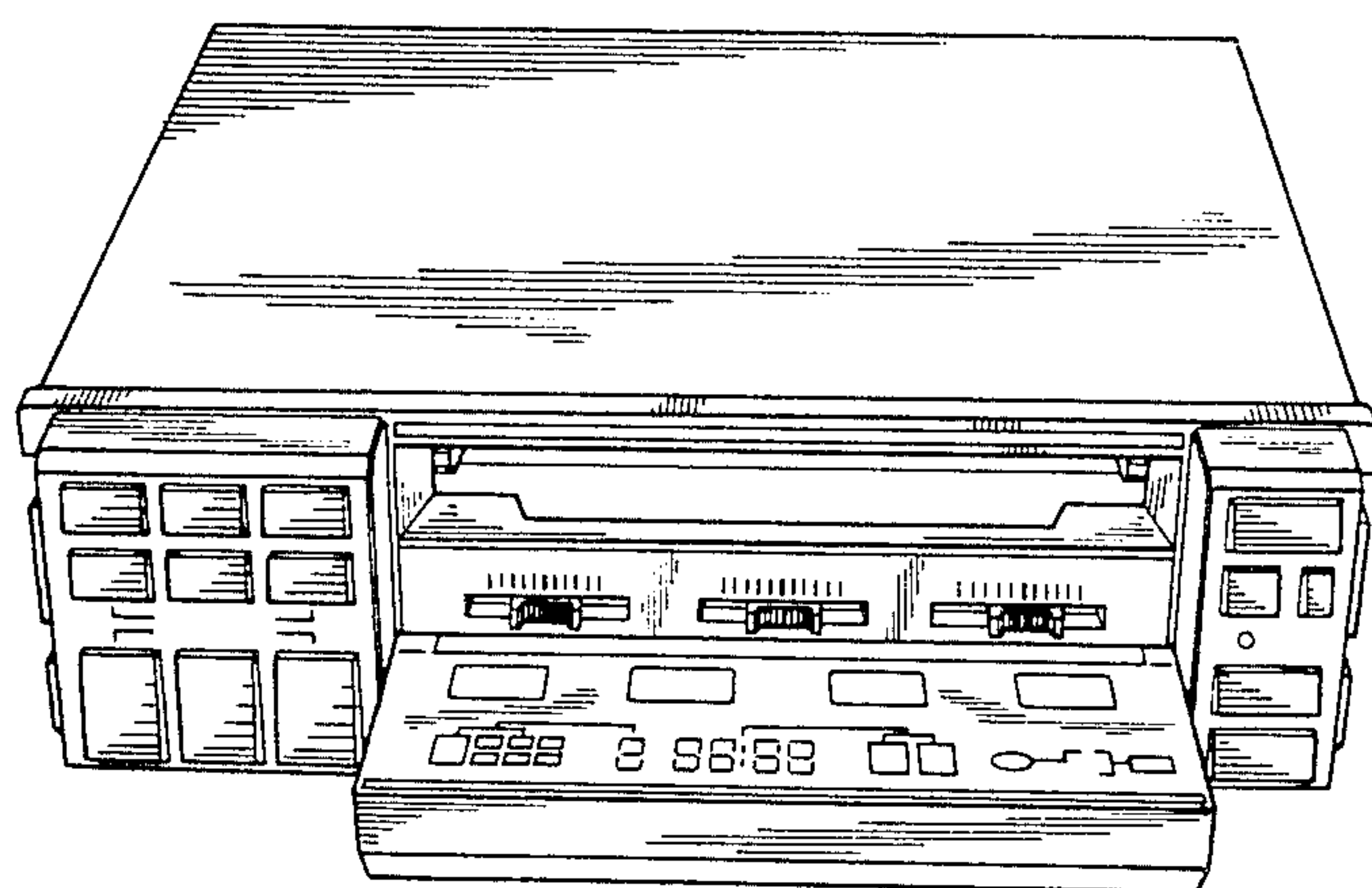
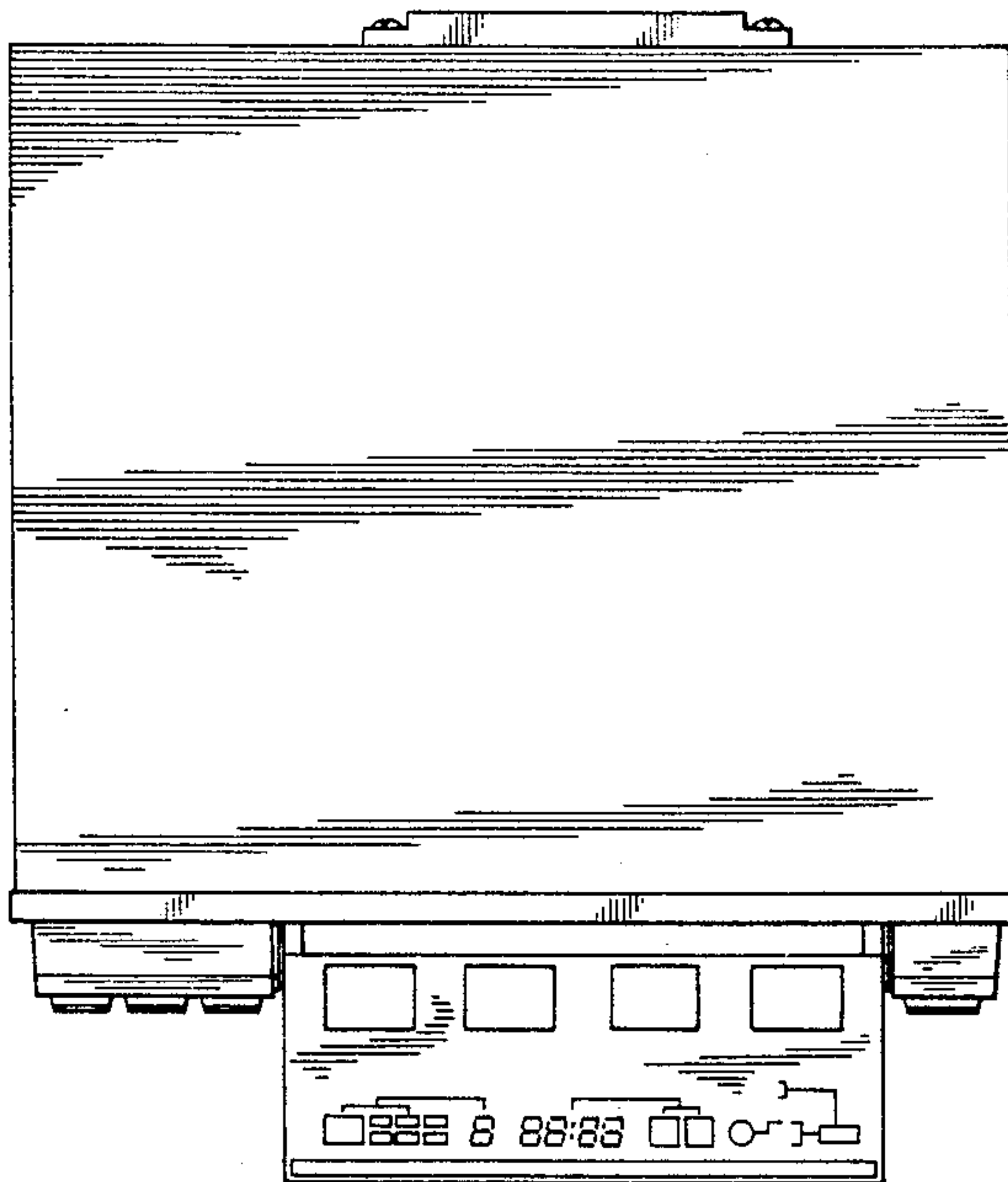


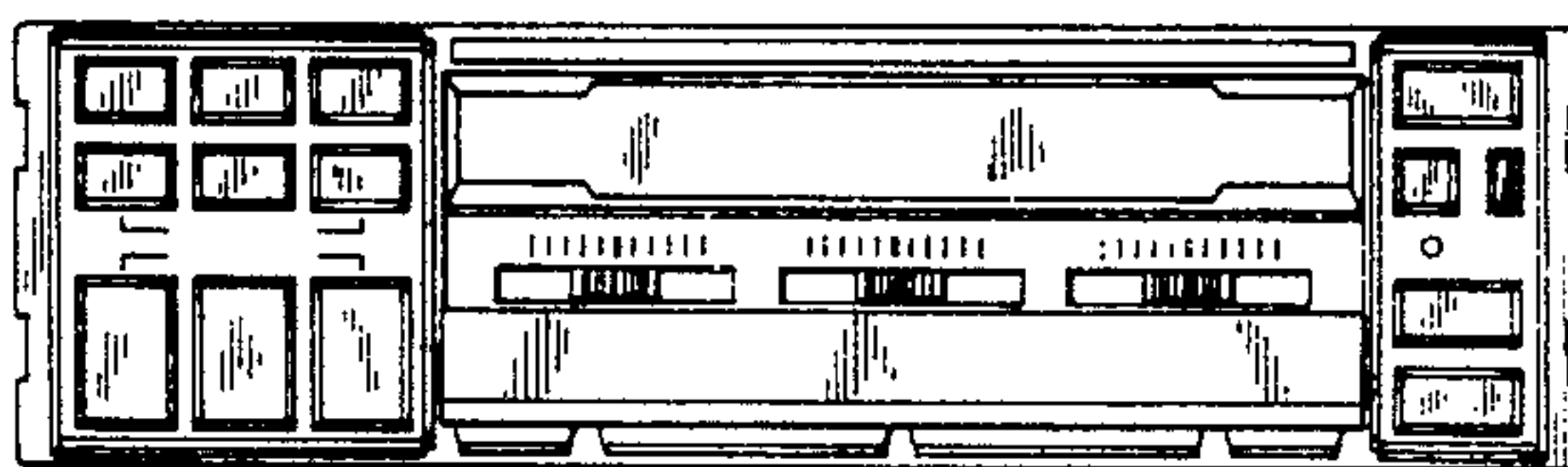

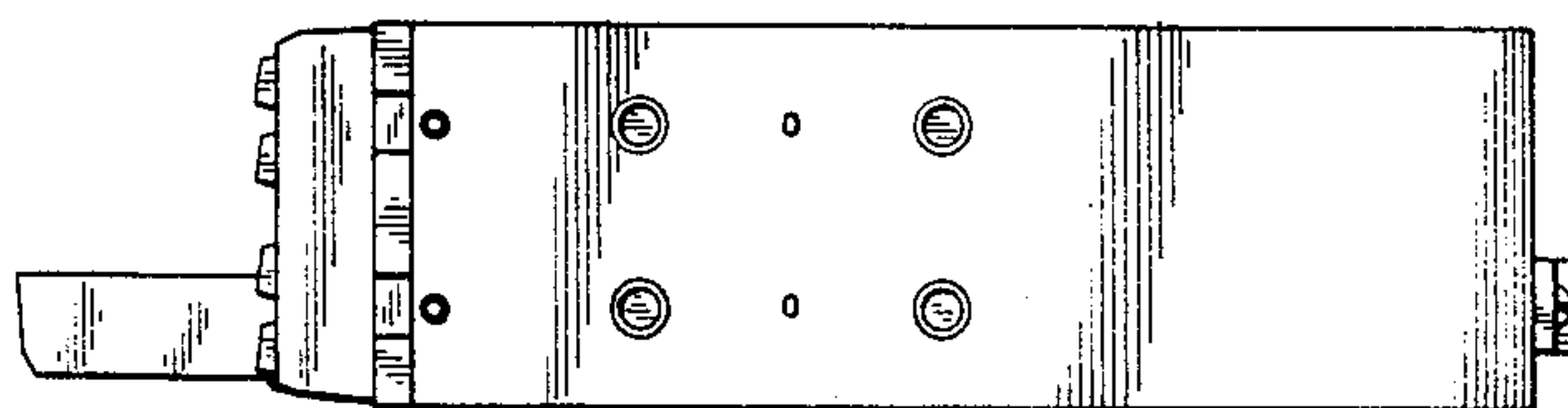
