FIG. 7 is a front, top and right side perspective view thereof;


FIG. 8 is a front and top perspective view thereof with the front cover pivoted open;


FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof as shown in FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a front elevational view thereof as shown in FIG. 8;


FIG. 11 is a right side elevational view thereof as shown in FIG. 8; and

FIG. 12 is a view like FIG. 1 showing a digital display.























