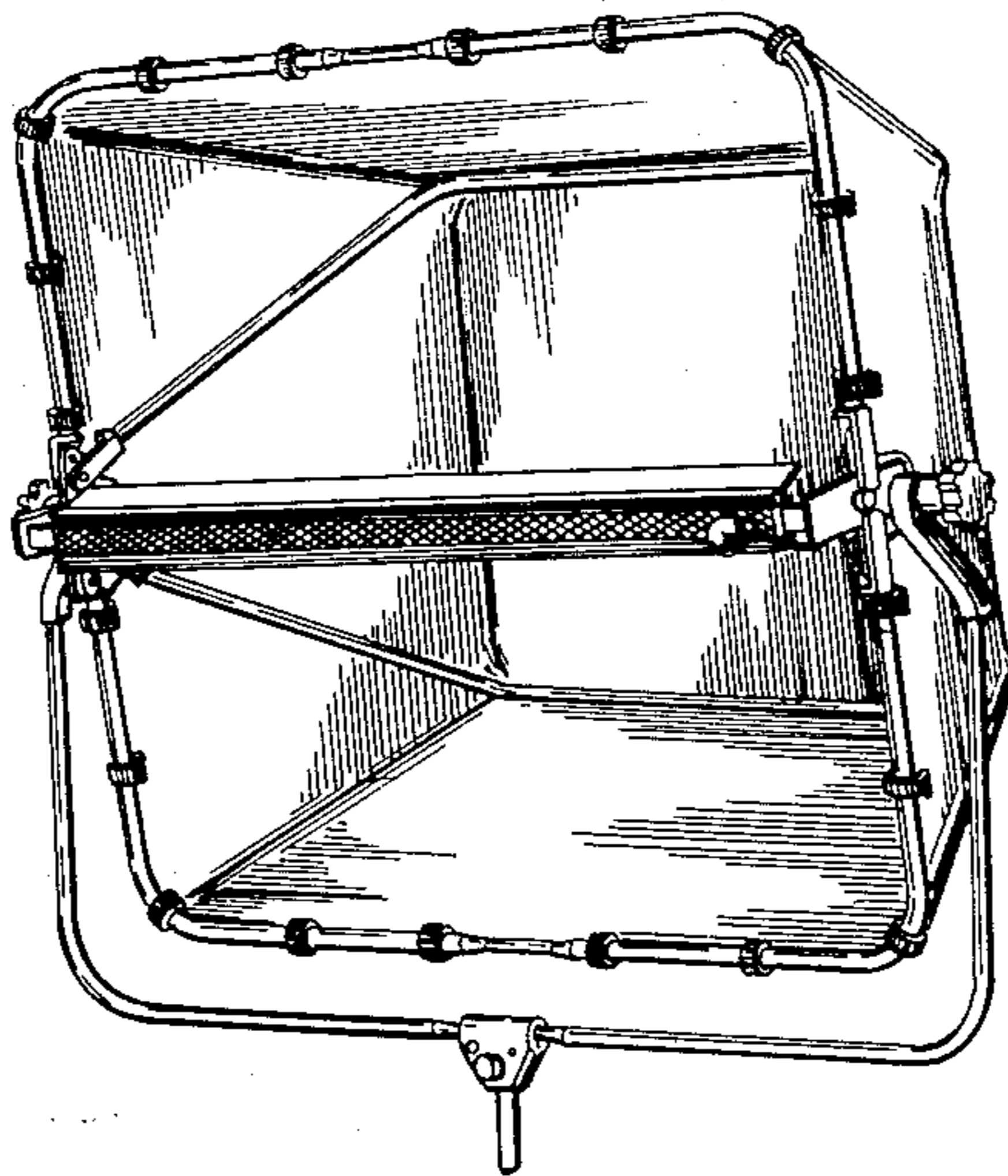

The ornamental design for the modular folding photographic light, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the modular folding photographic light showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of our design;
FIG. 8 is a rear, right side perspective view thereof, the left side being a mirror image of the right.



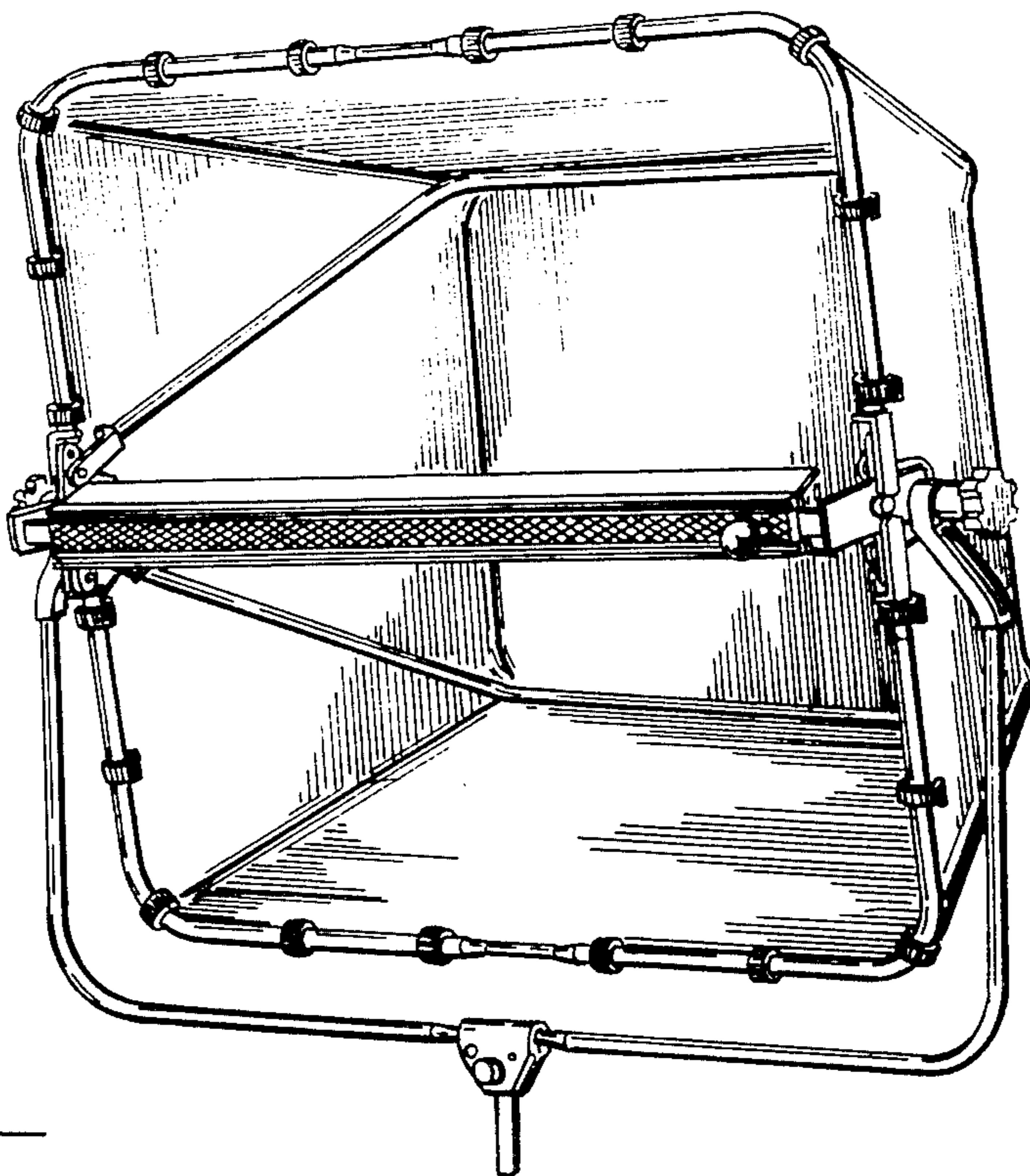

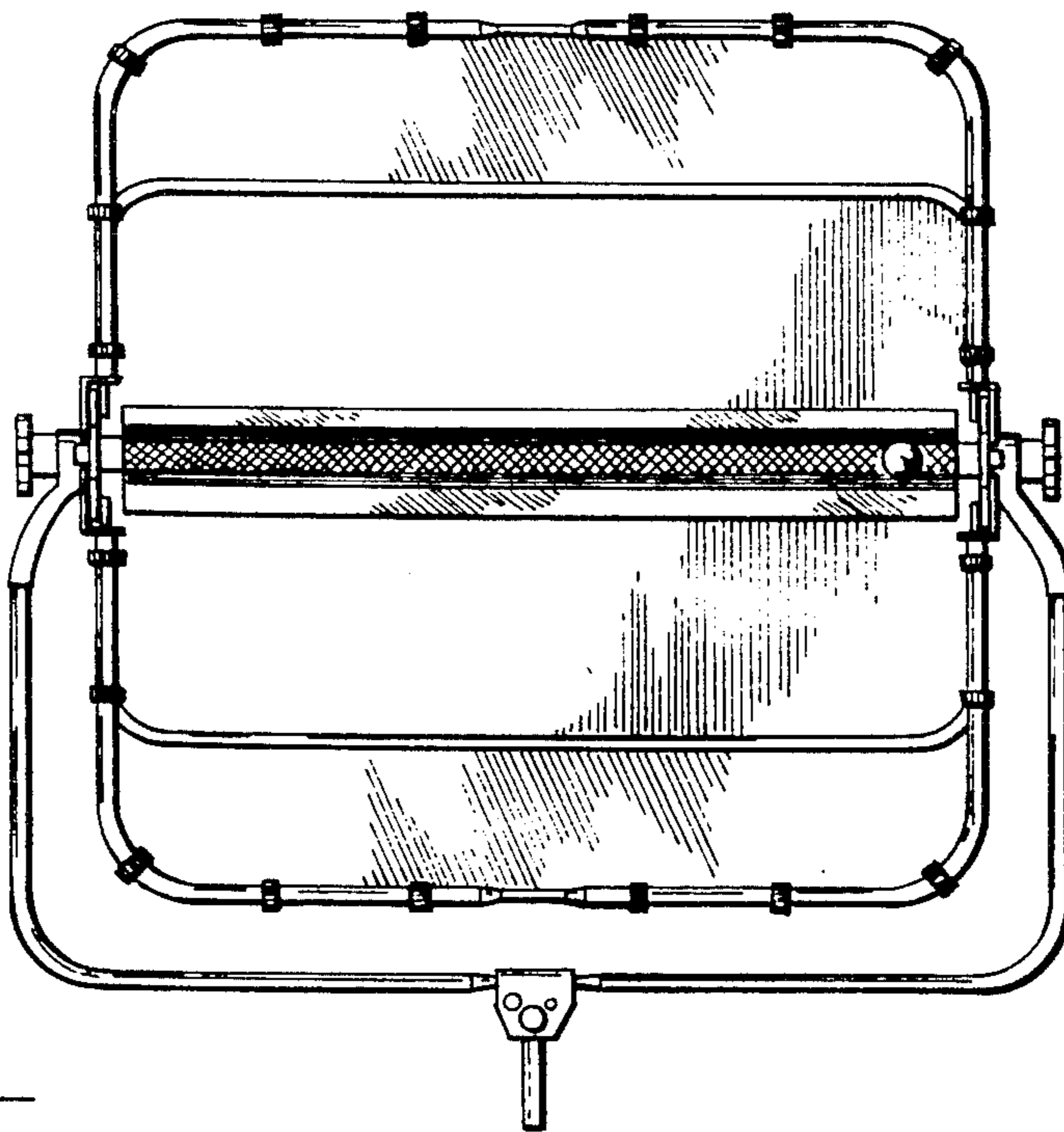

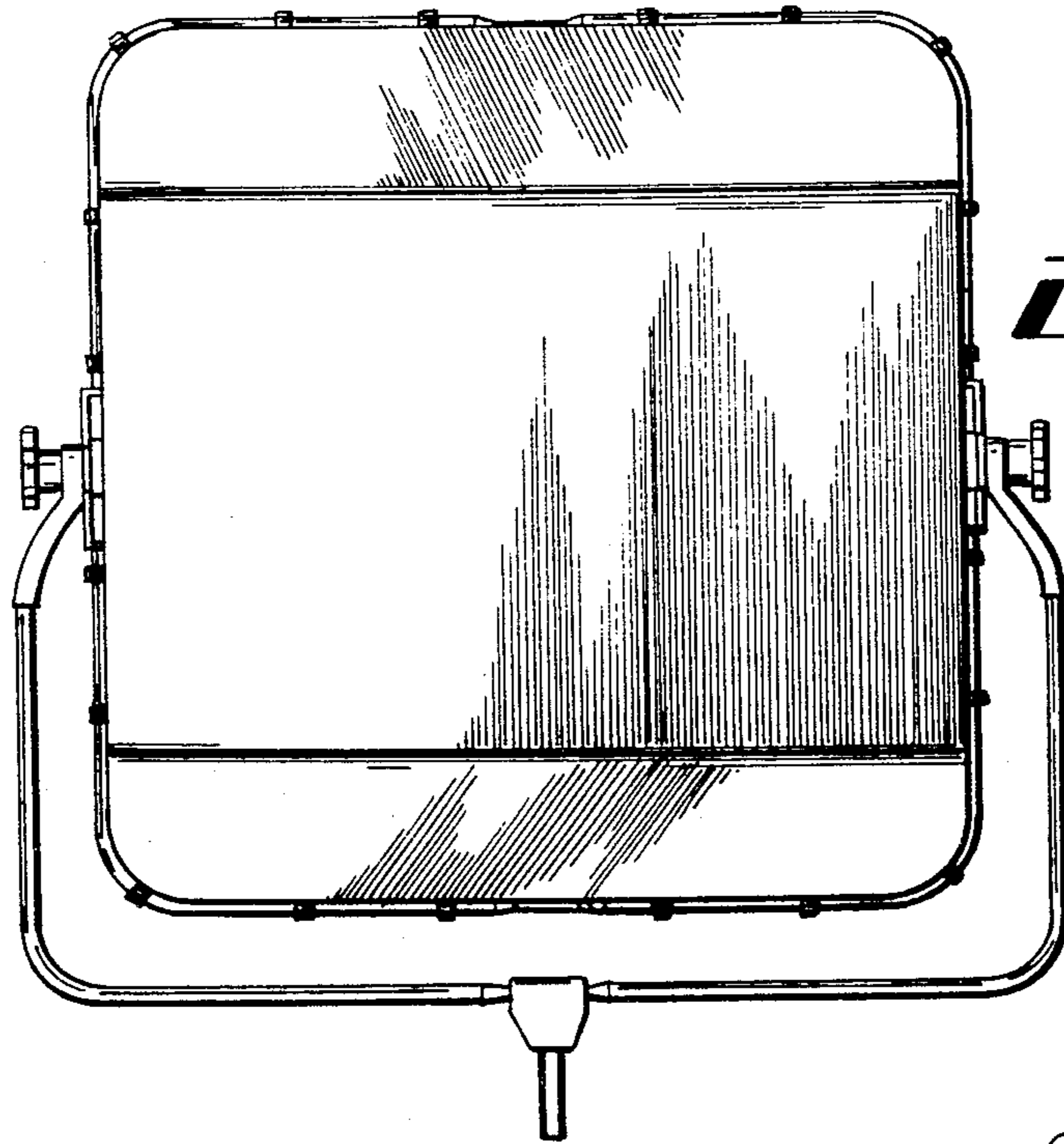

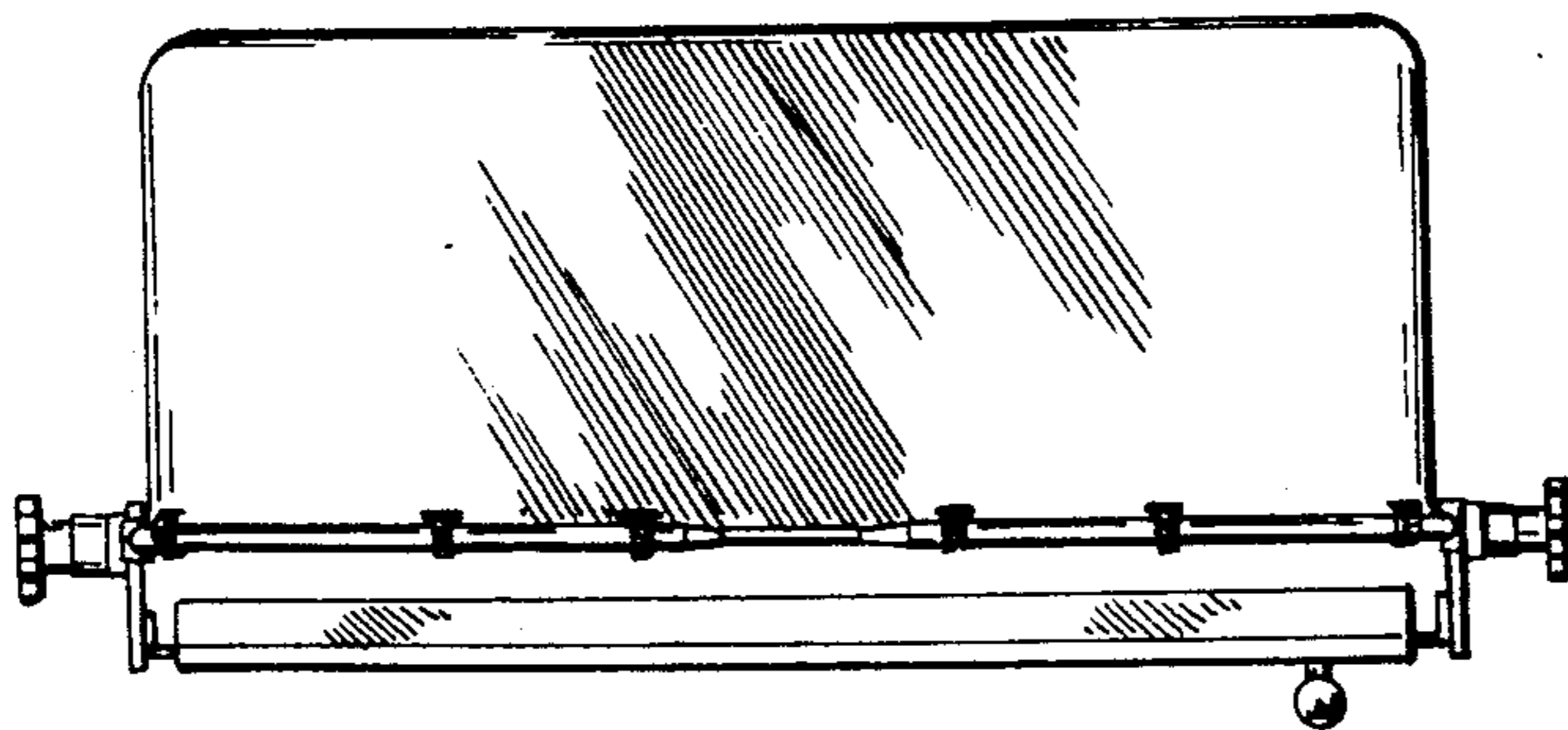

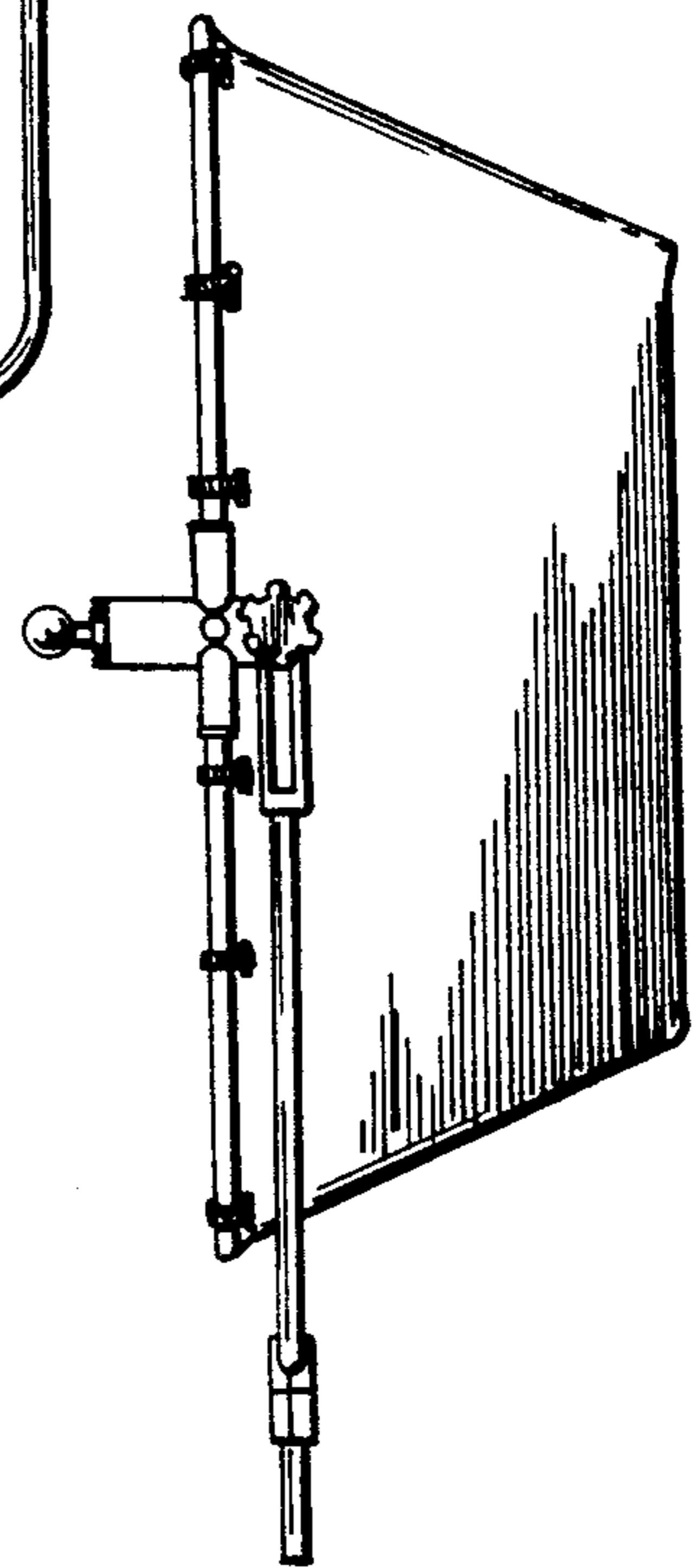

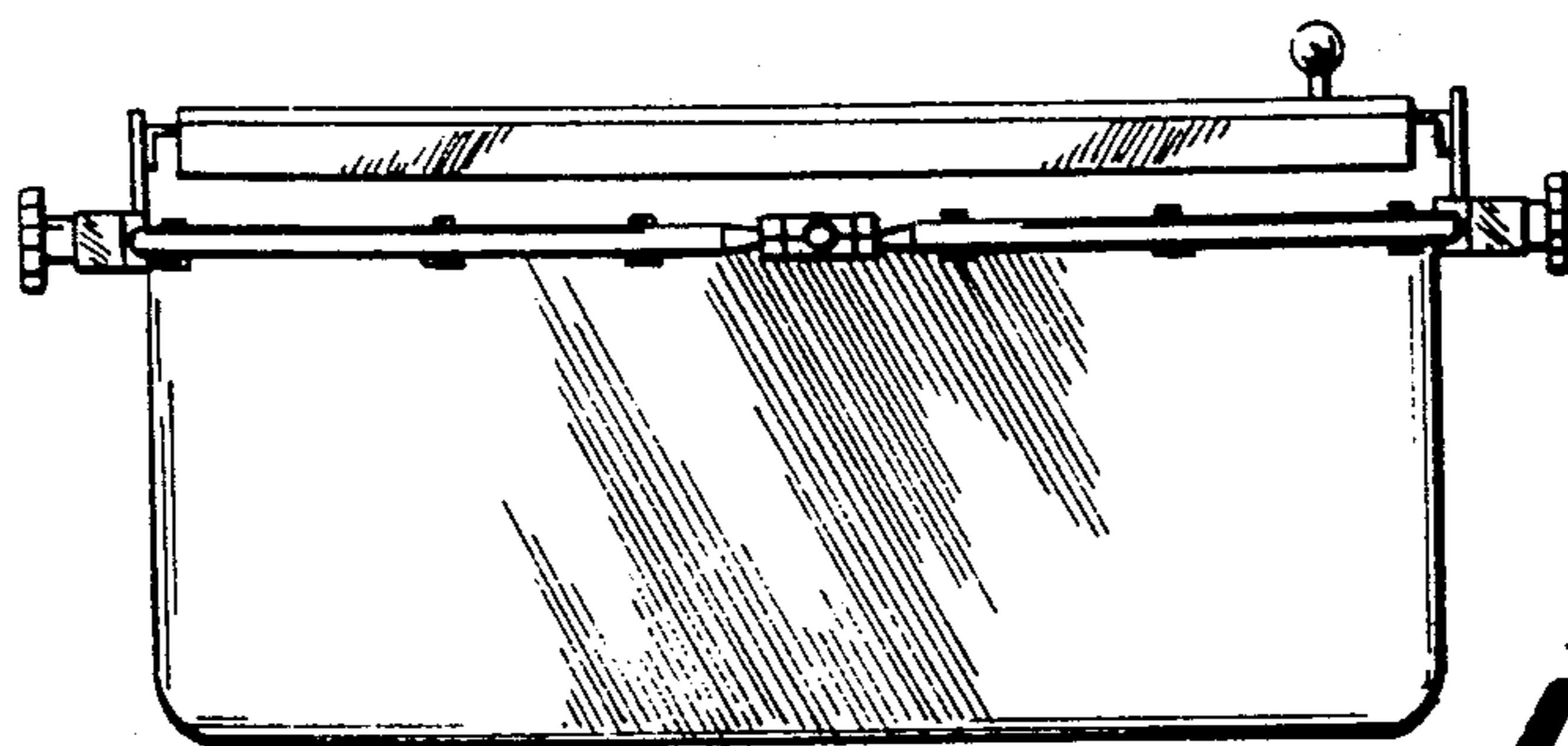

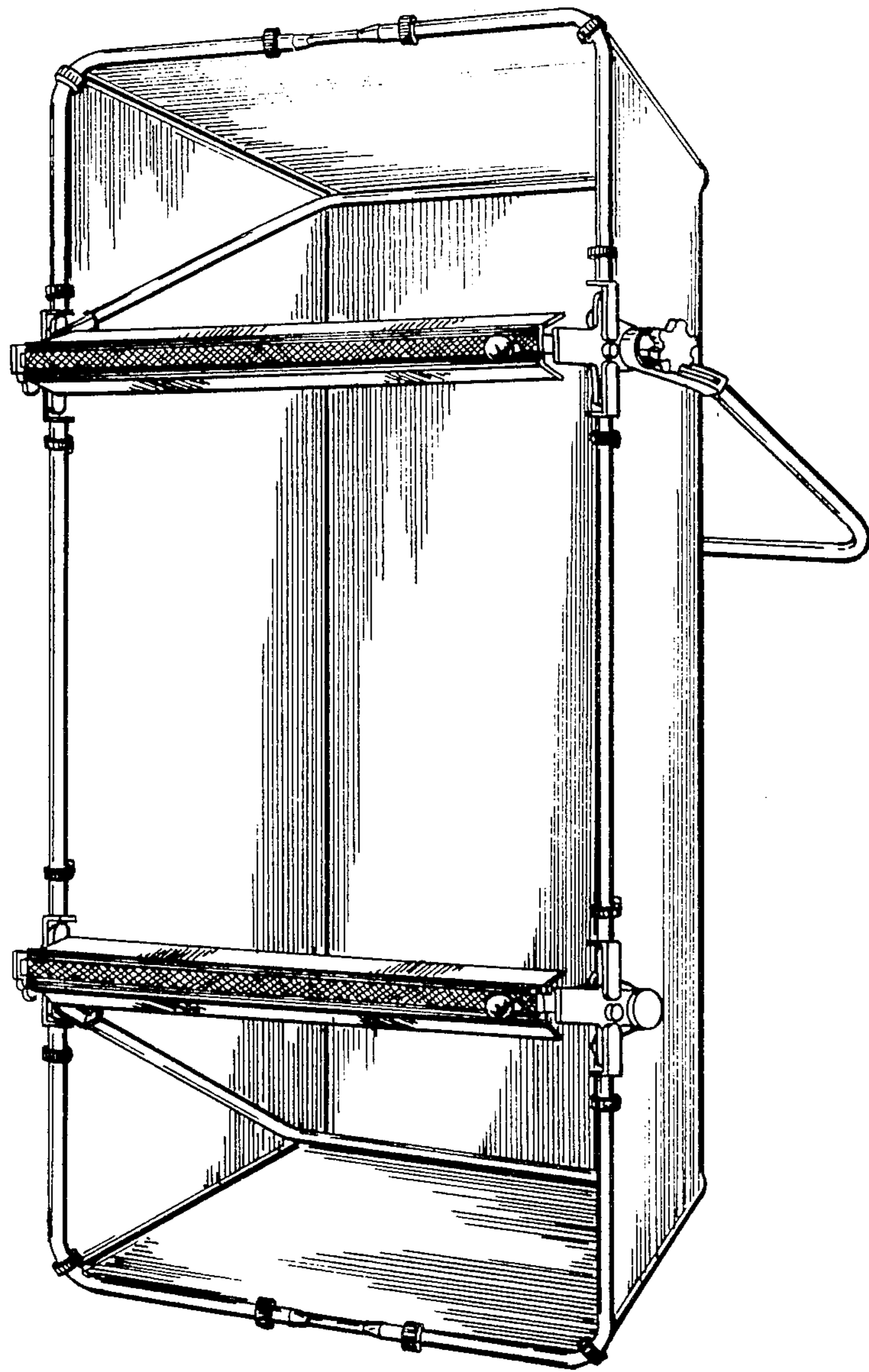

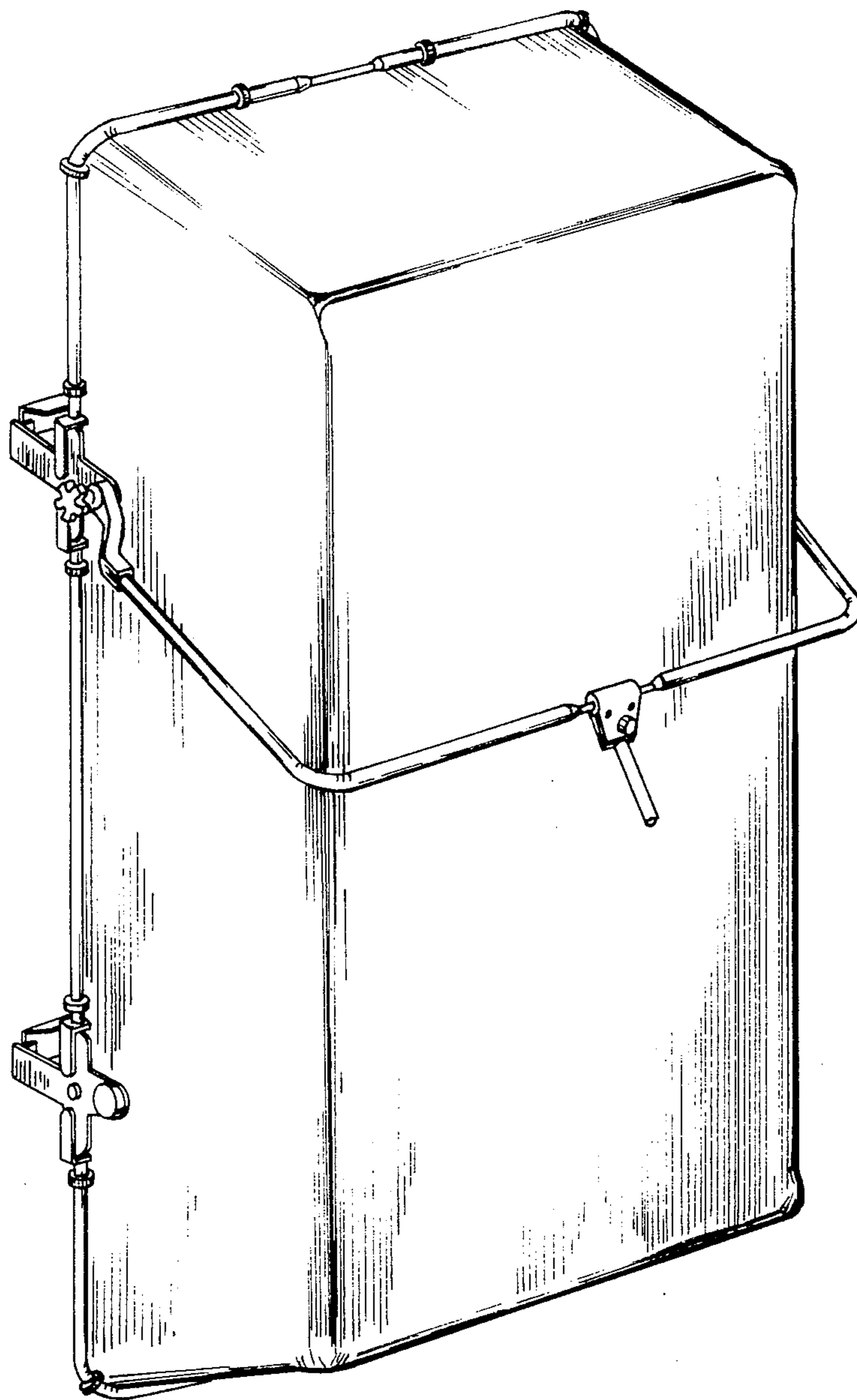
