[57] CLAIM

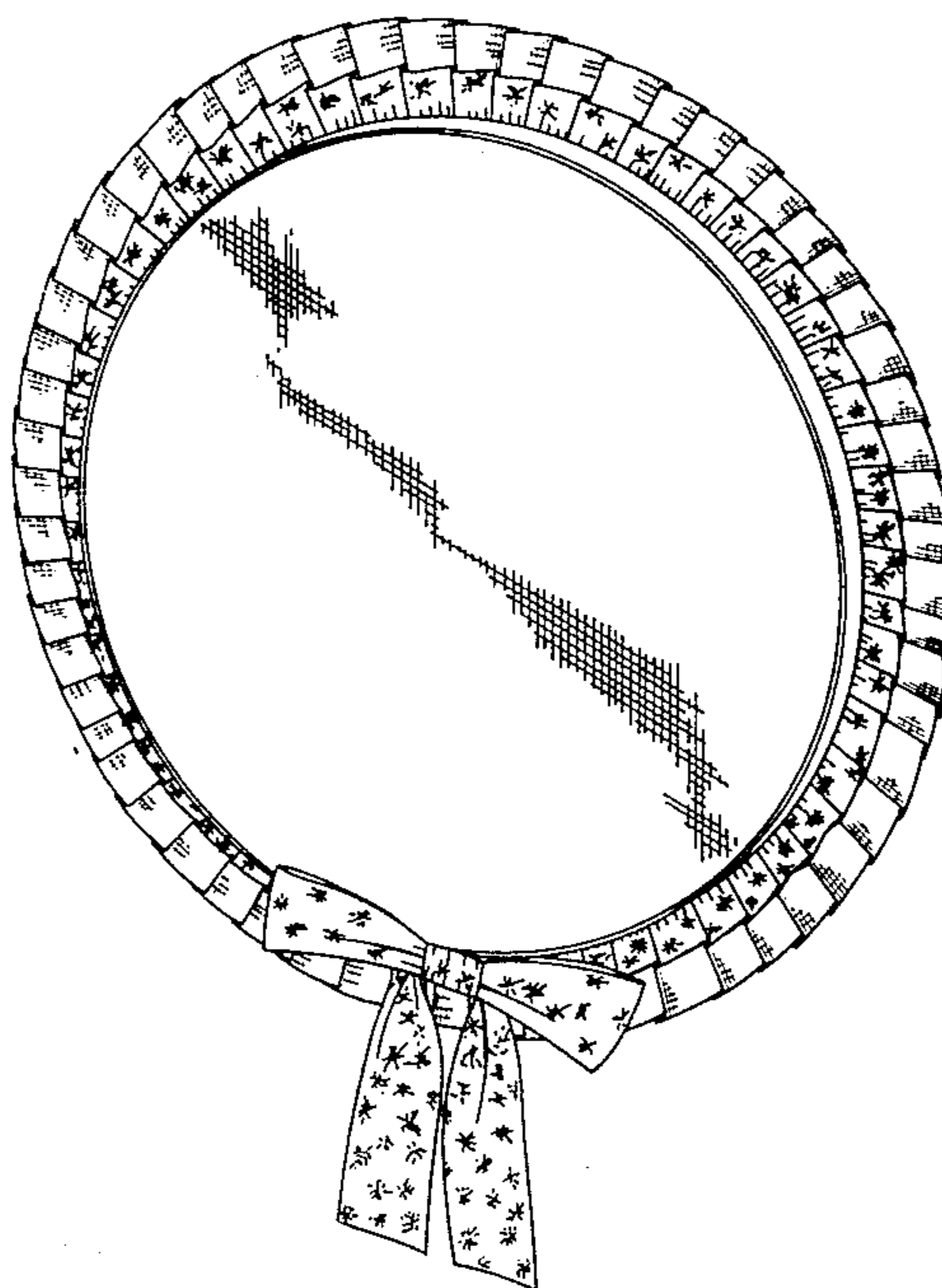

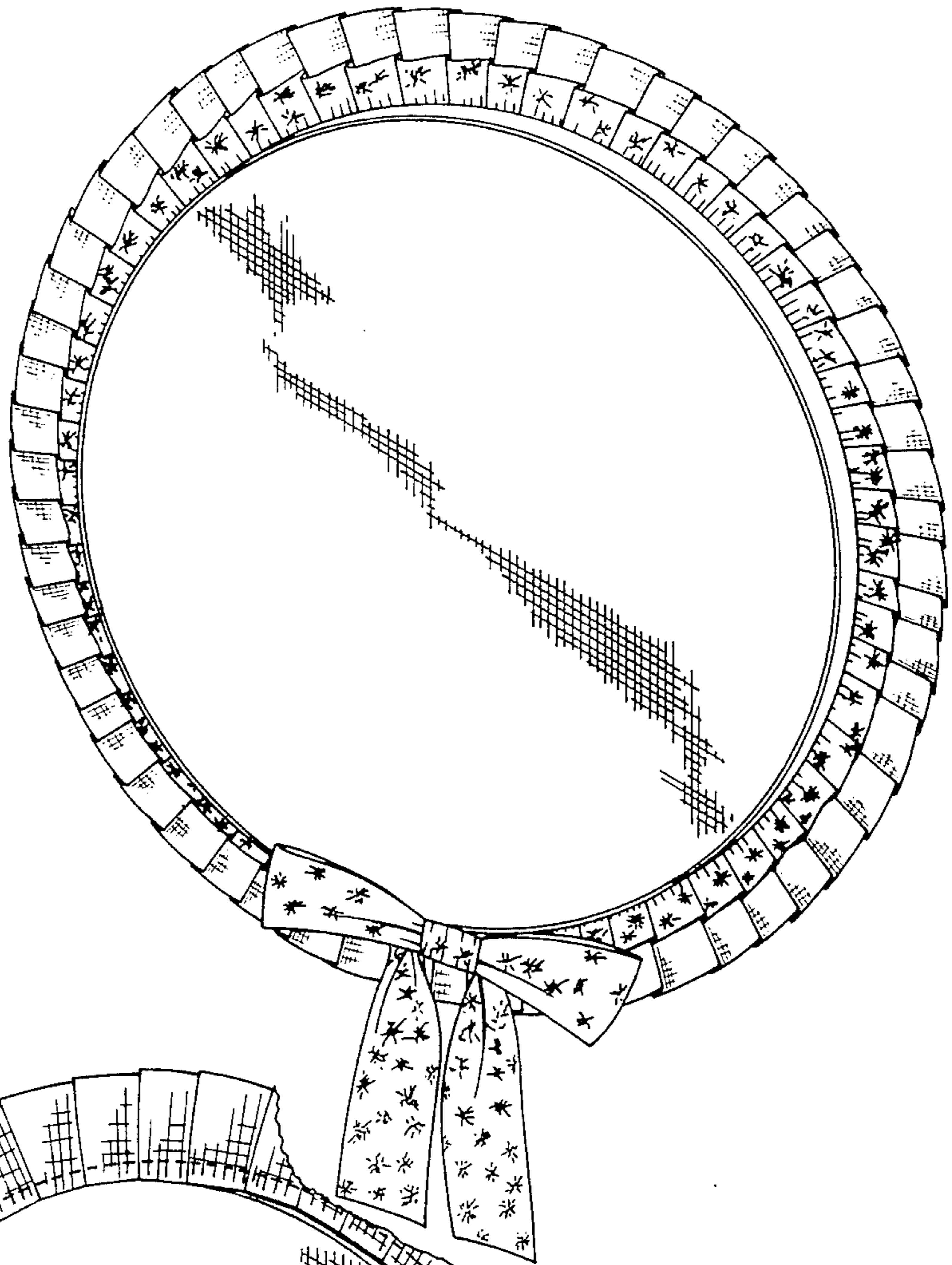
