DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the vanity case showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view, and;
 FIG. 6 is a perspective view with the drawers and top fully opened.

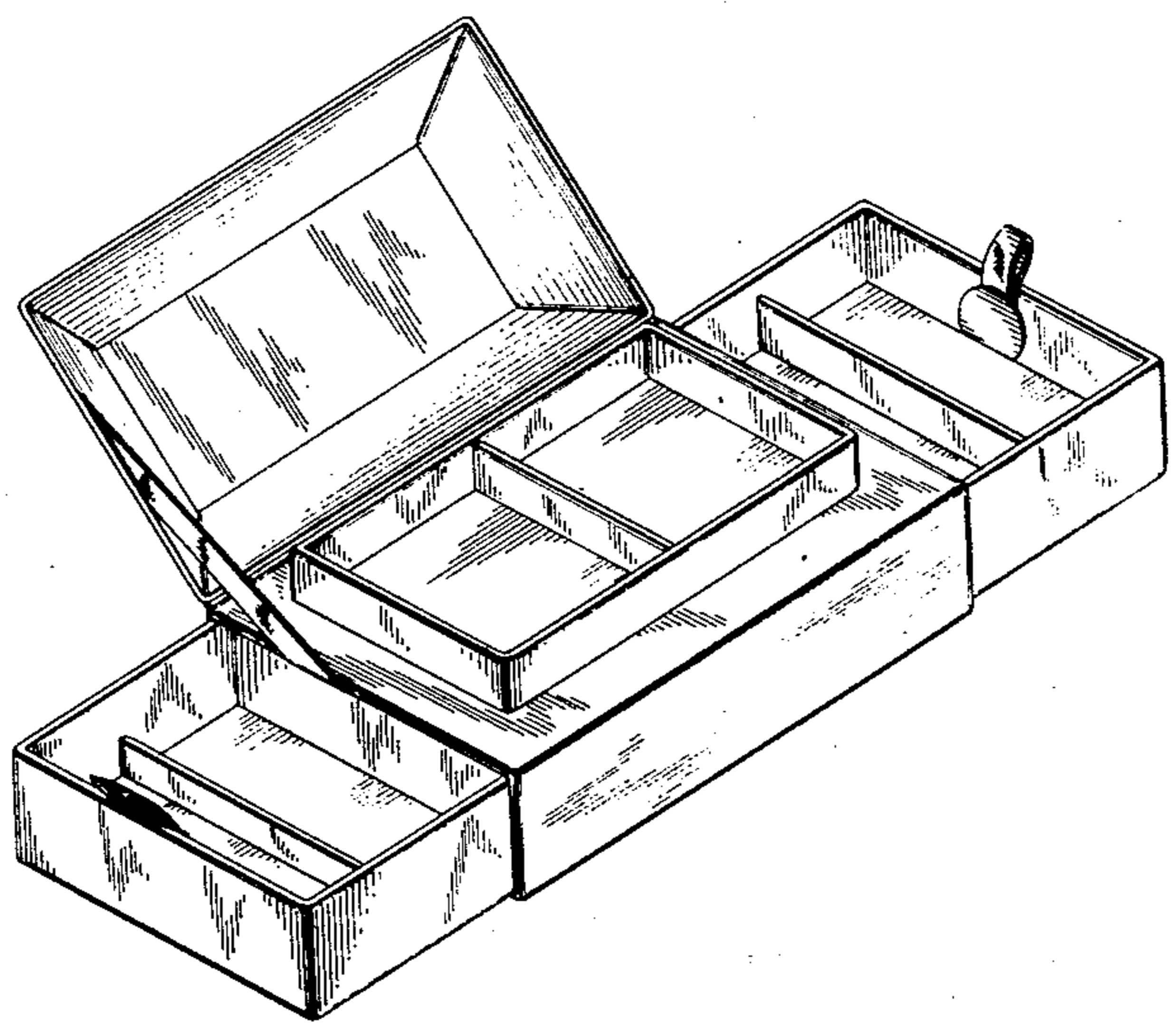
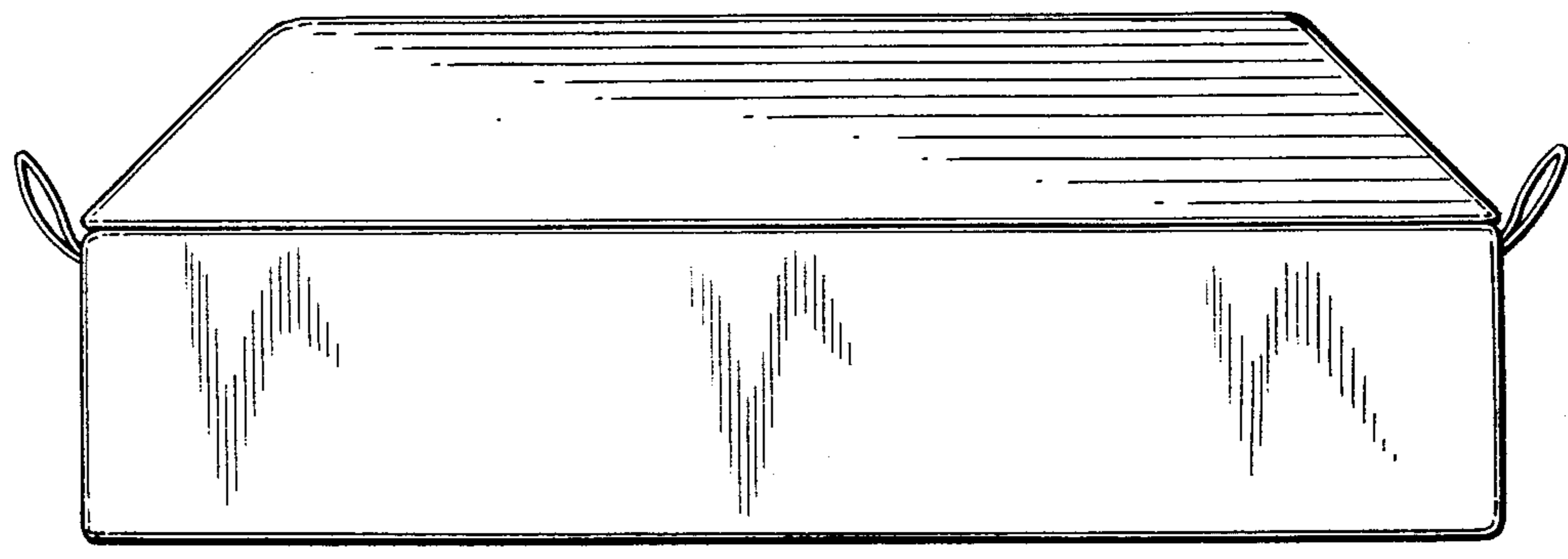

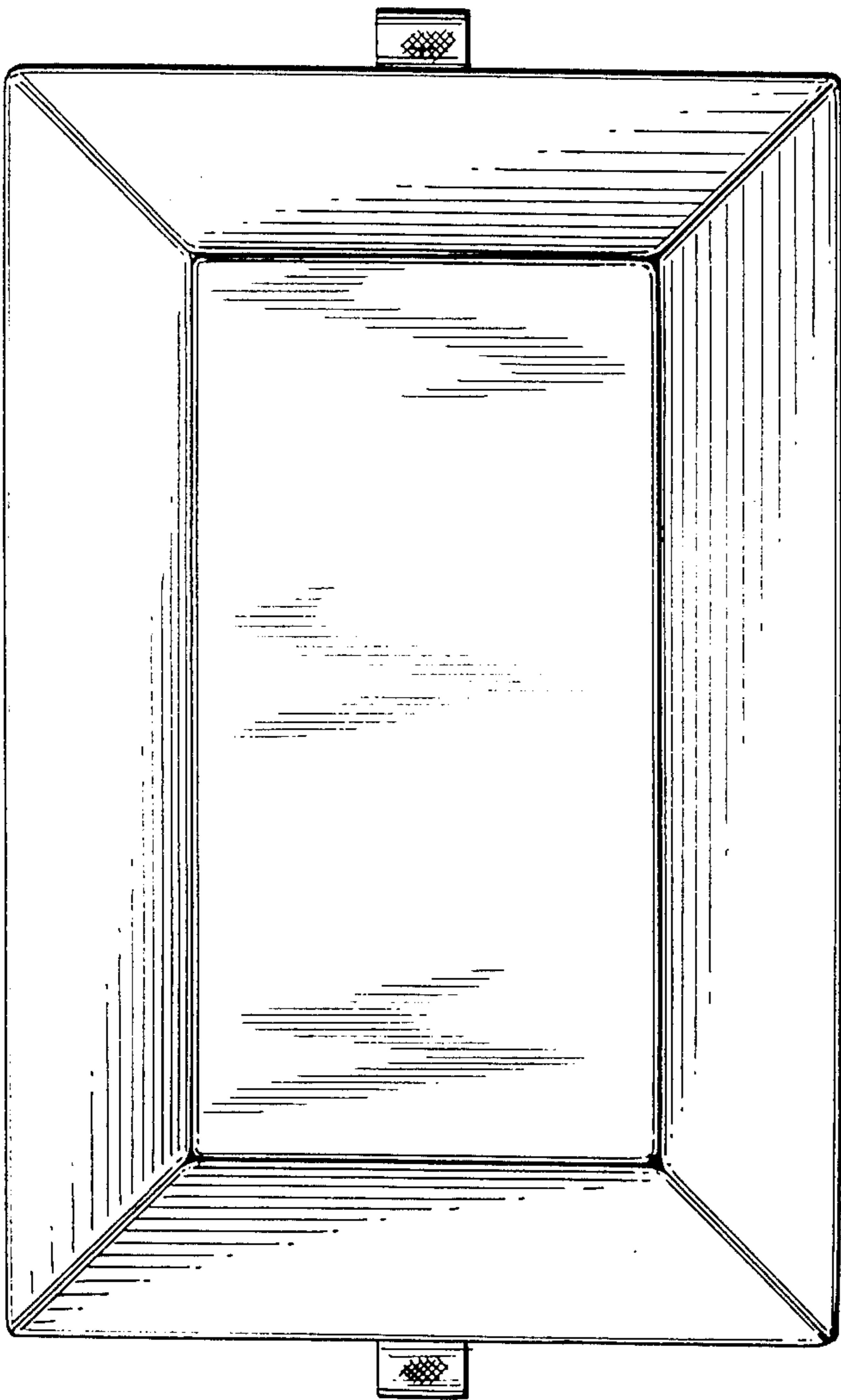

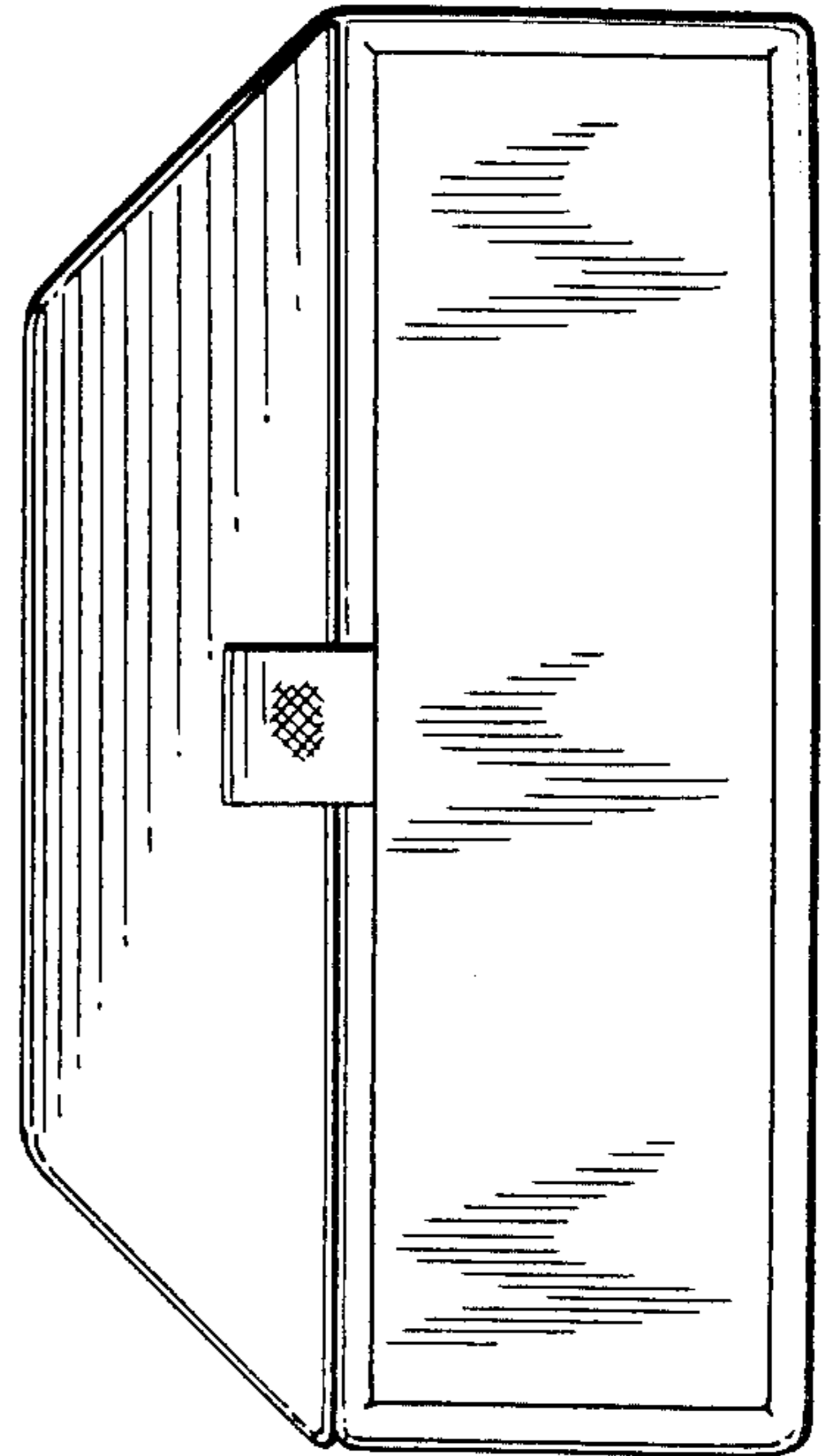

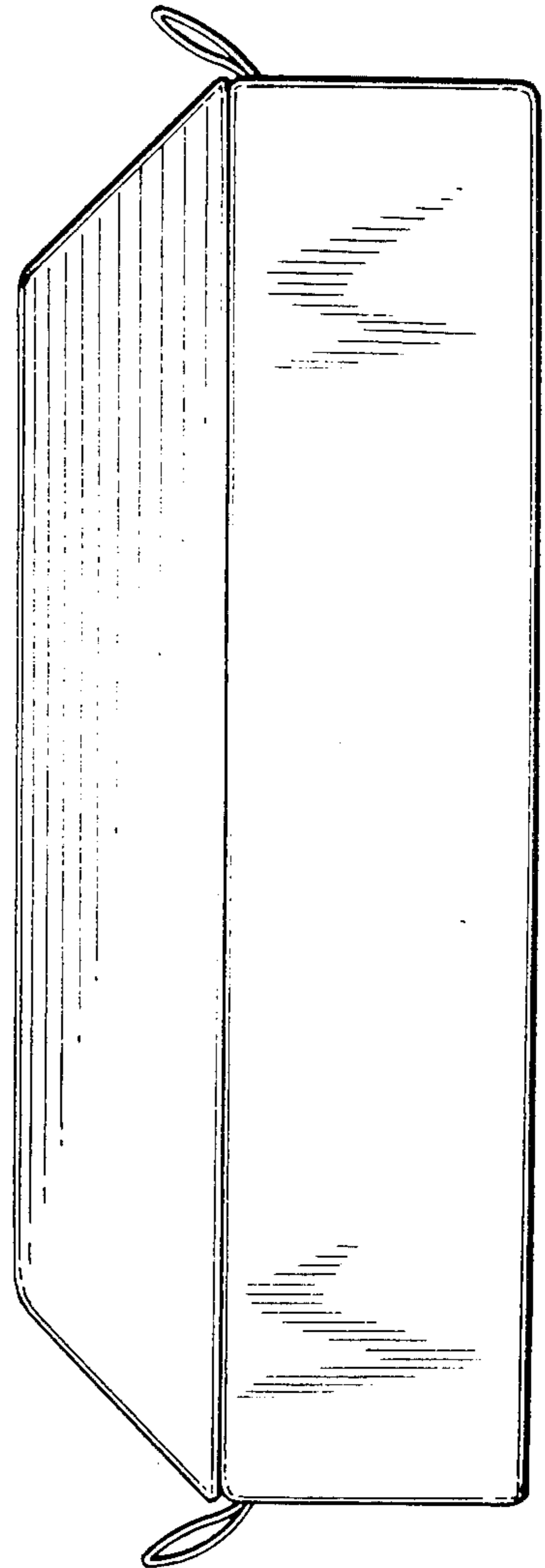

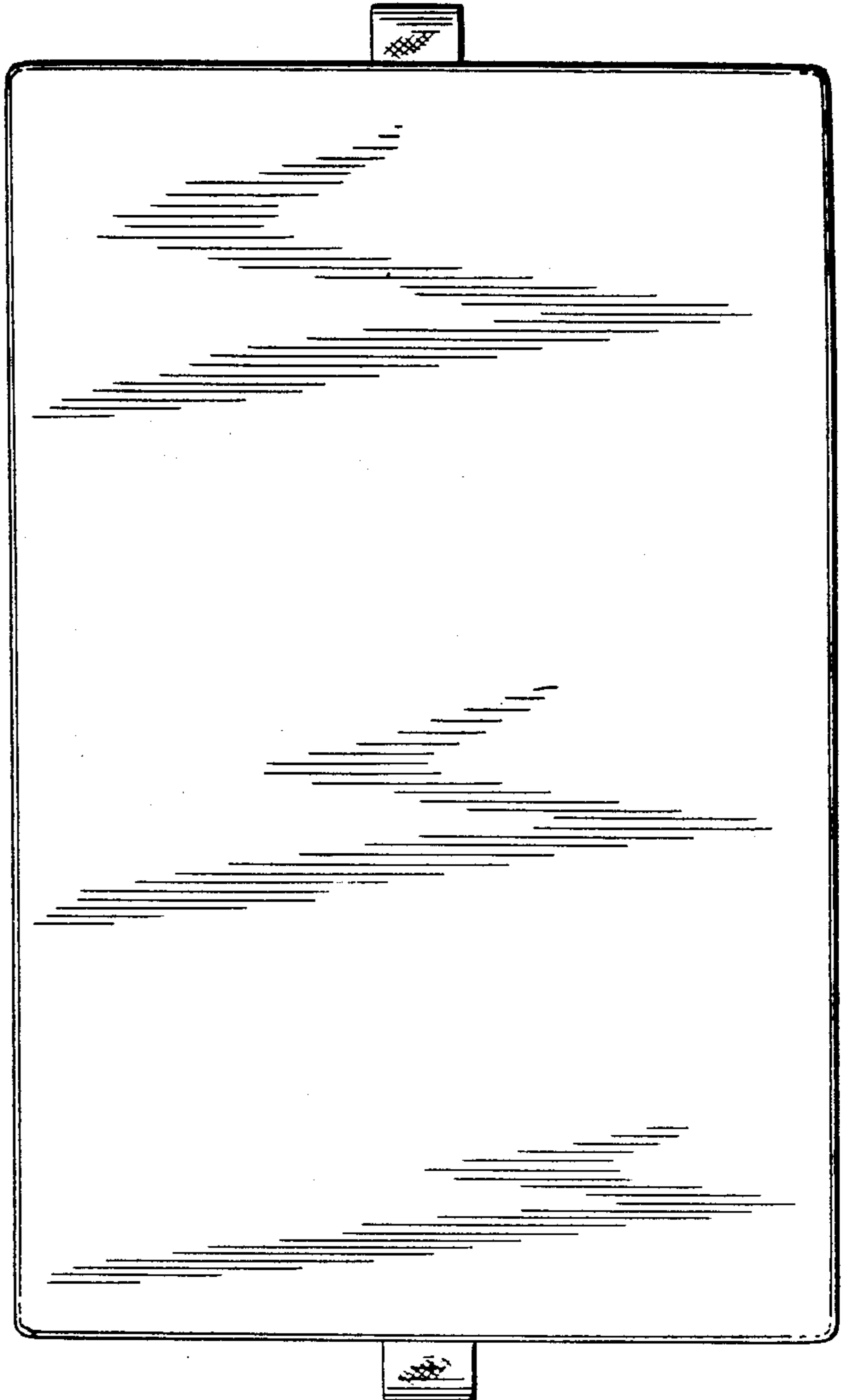
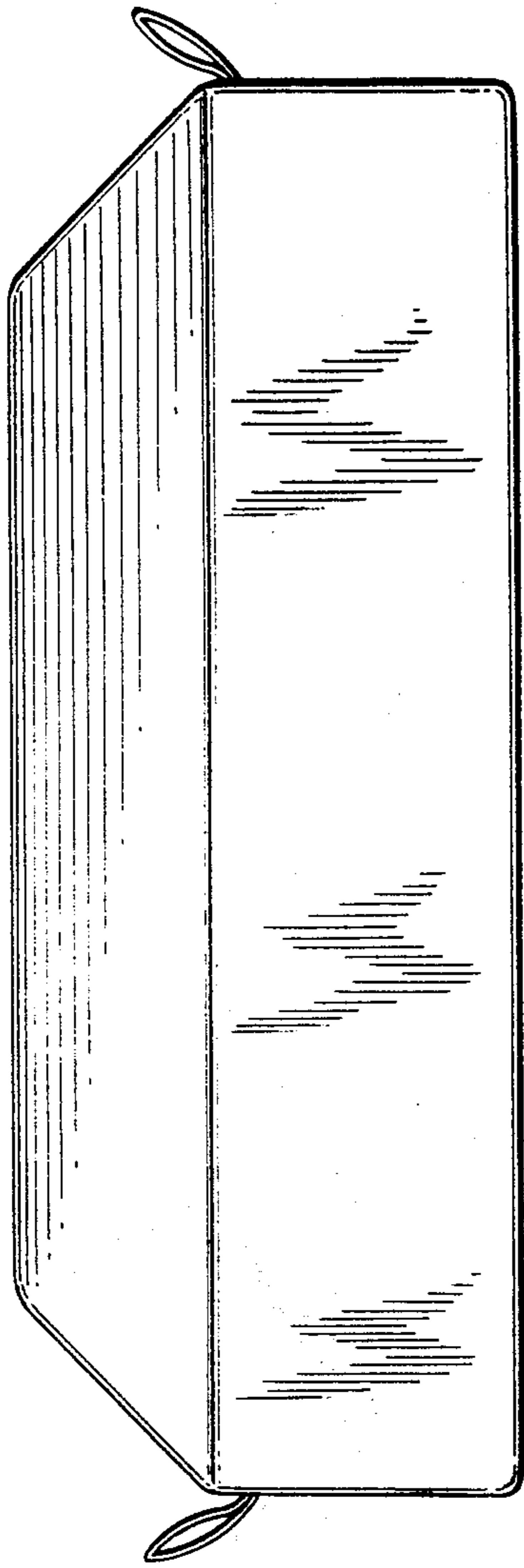

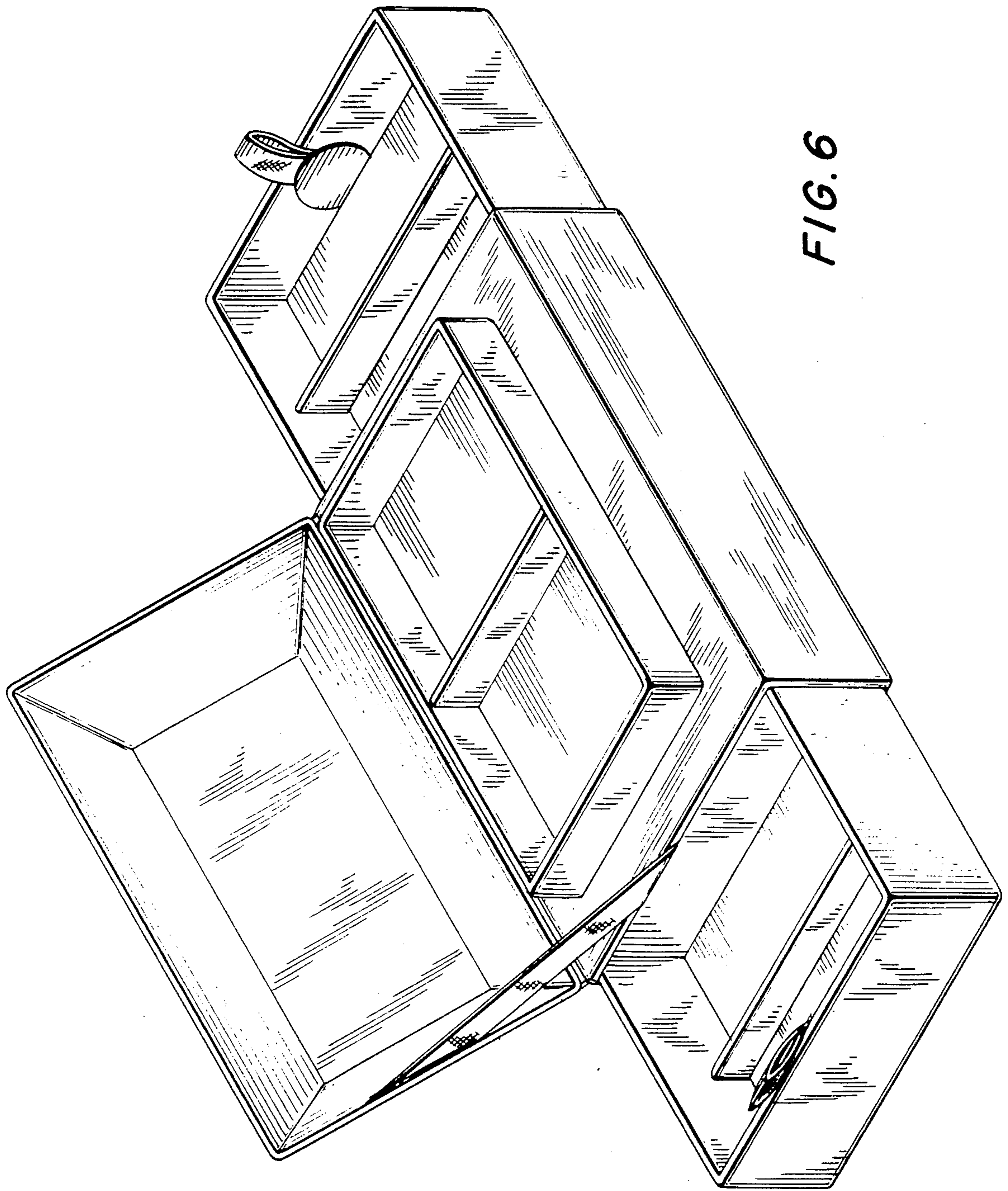
