The ornamental design for a hot dog slitter, as shown and described.

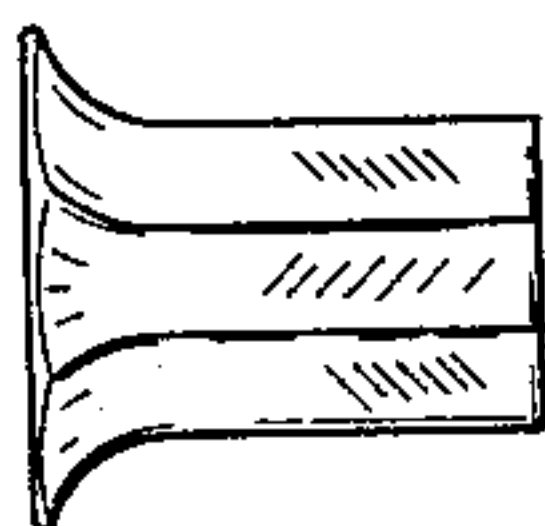
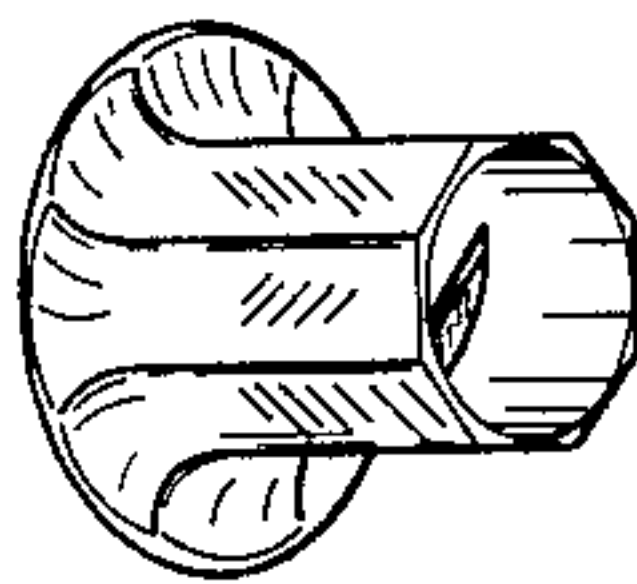
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is an opposite end elevational view thereof;



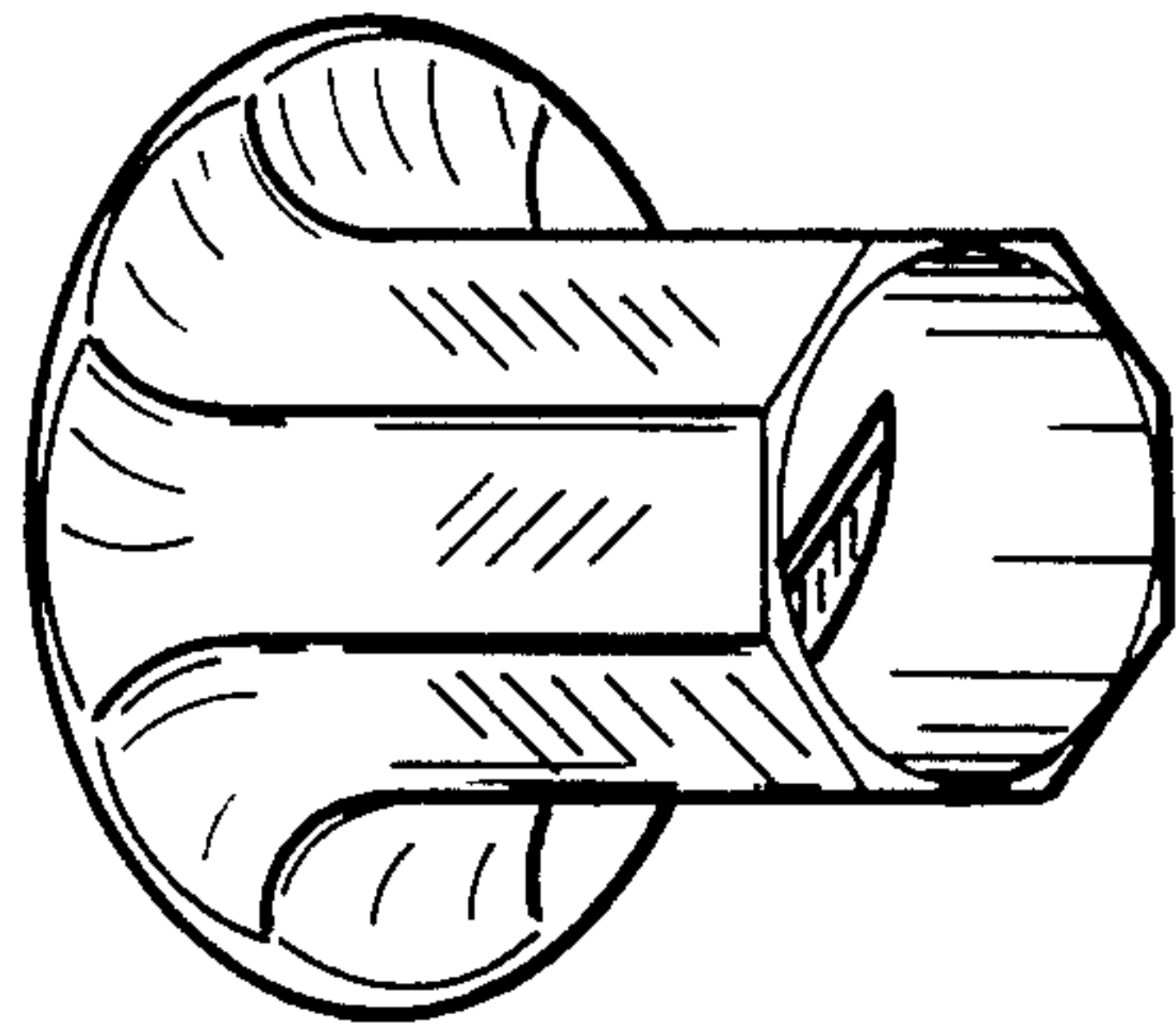

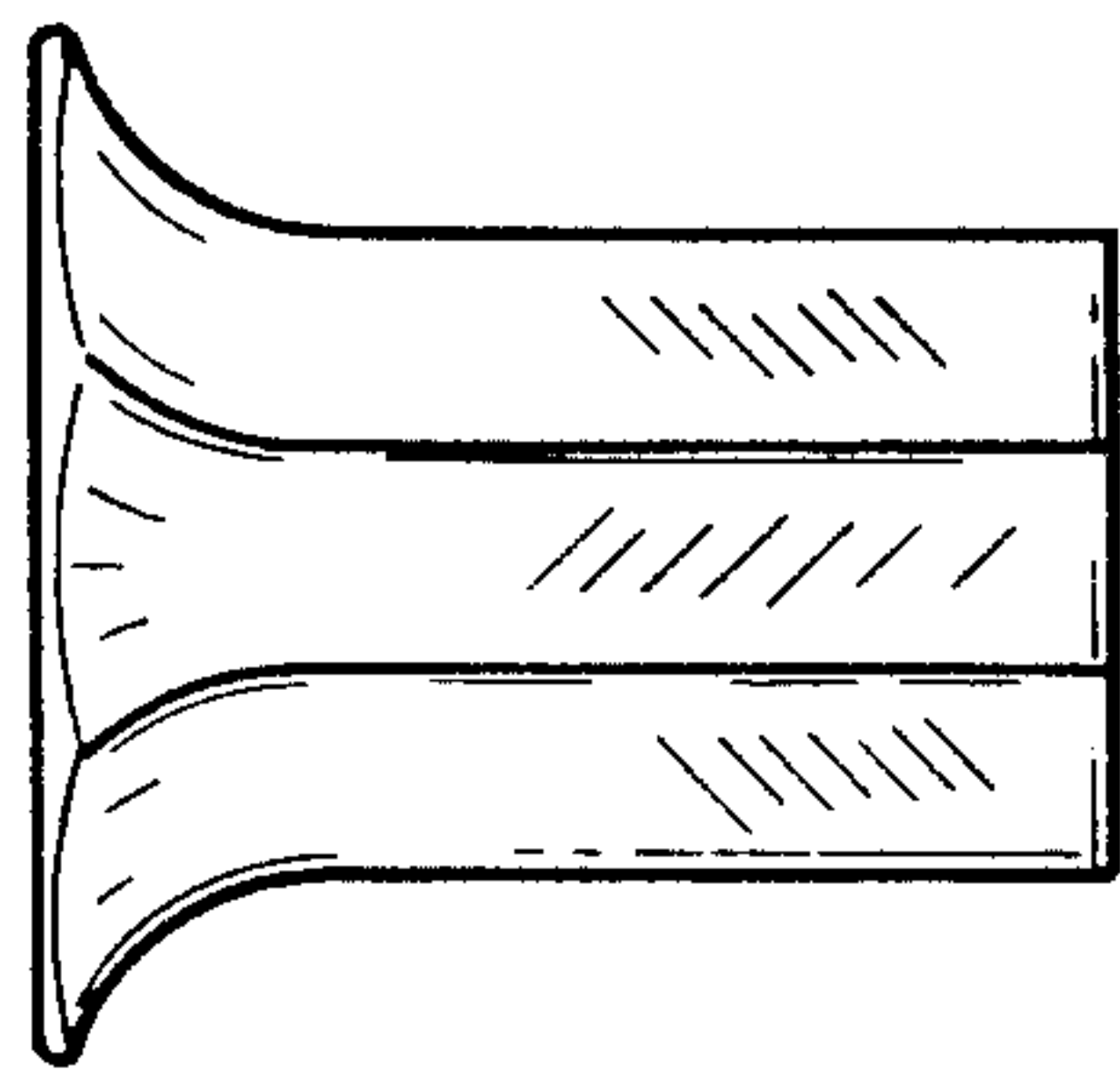
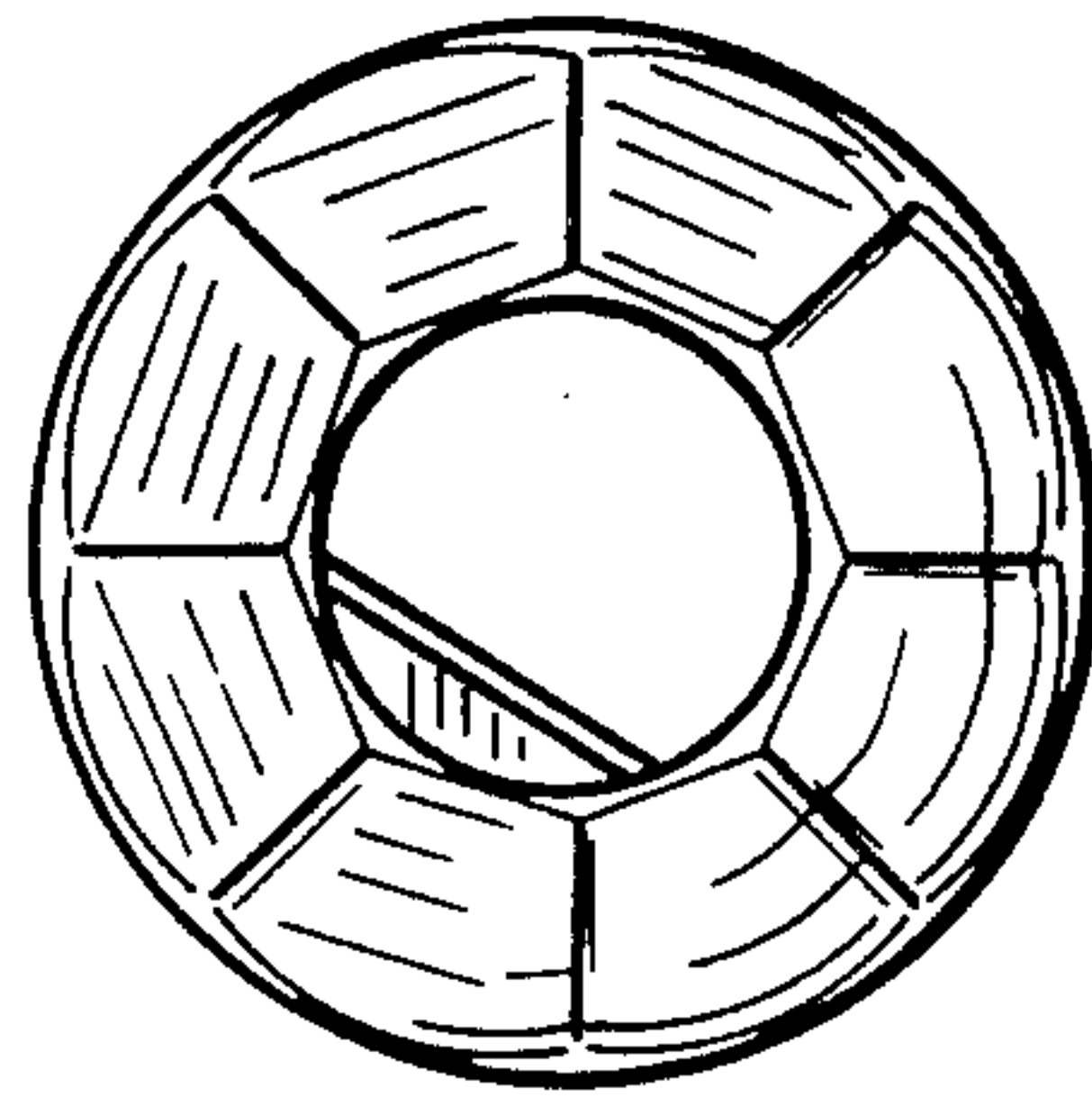
