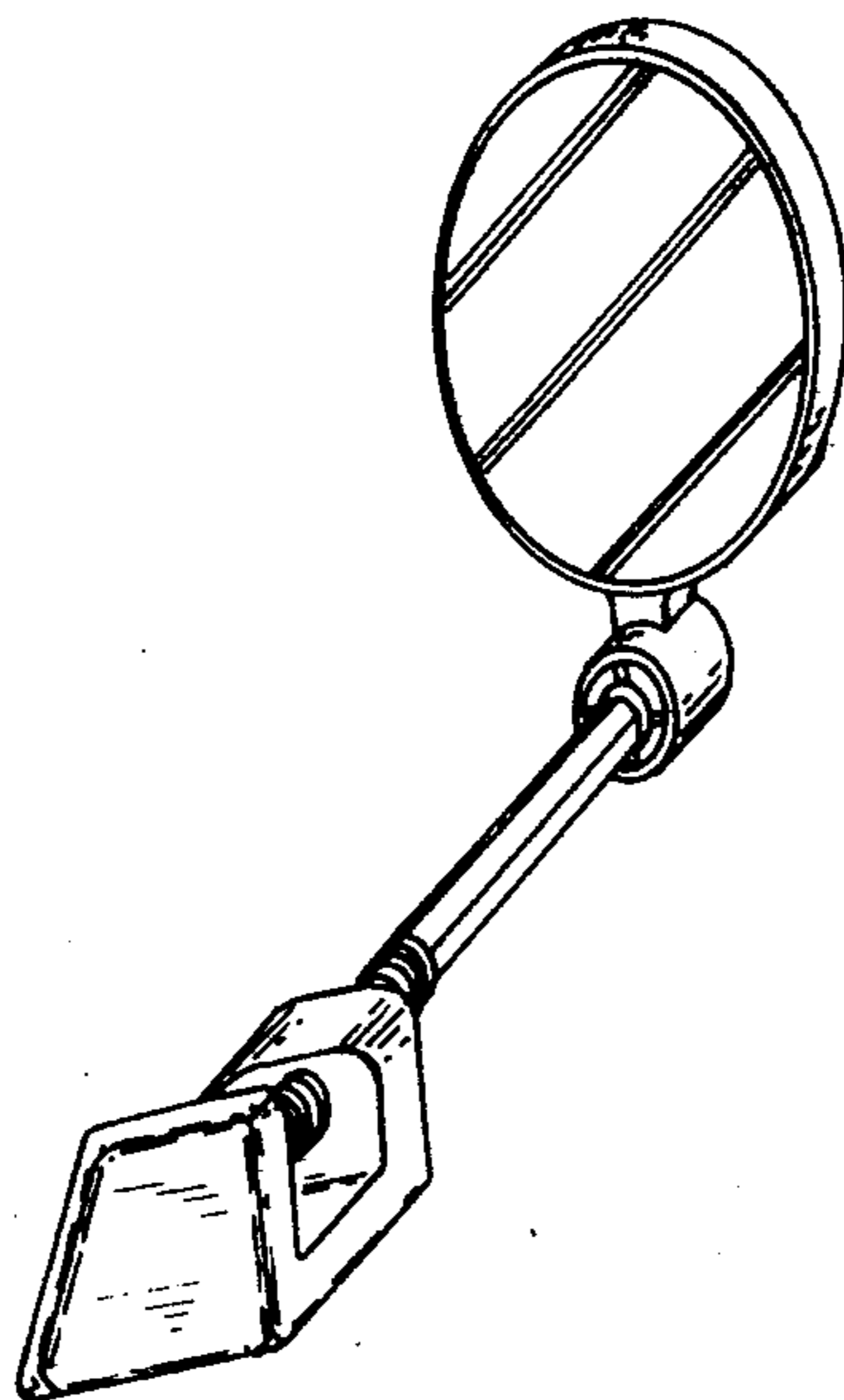

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a rear view mirror for attachment to a crash helmet, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a rear view mirror for attachment to a crash helmet showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevation view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof opposite to that shown in FIG. 2; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is an end elevation view thereof; and FIG. 7 is an end elevation view thereof opposite to that shown in FIG. 6.



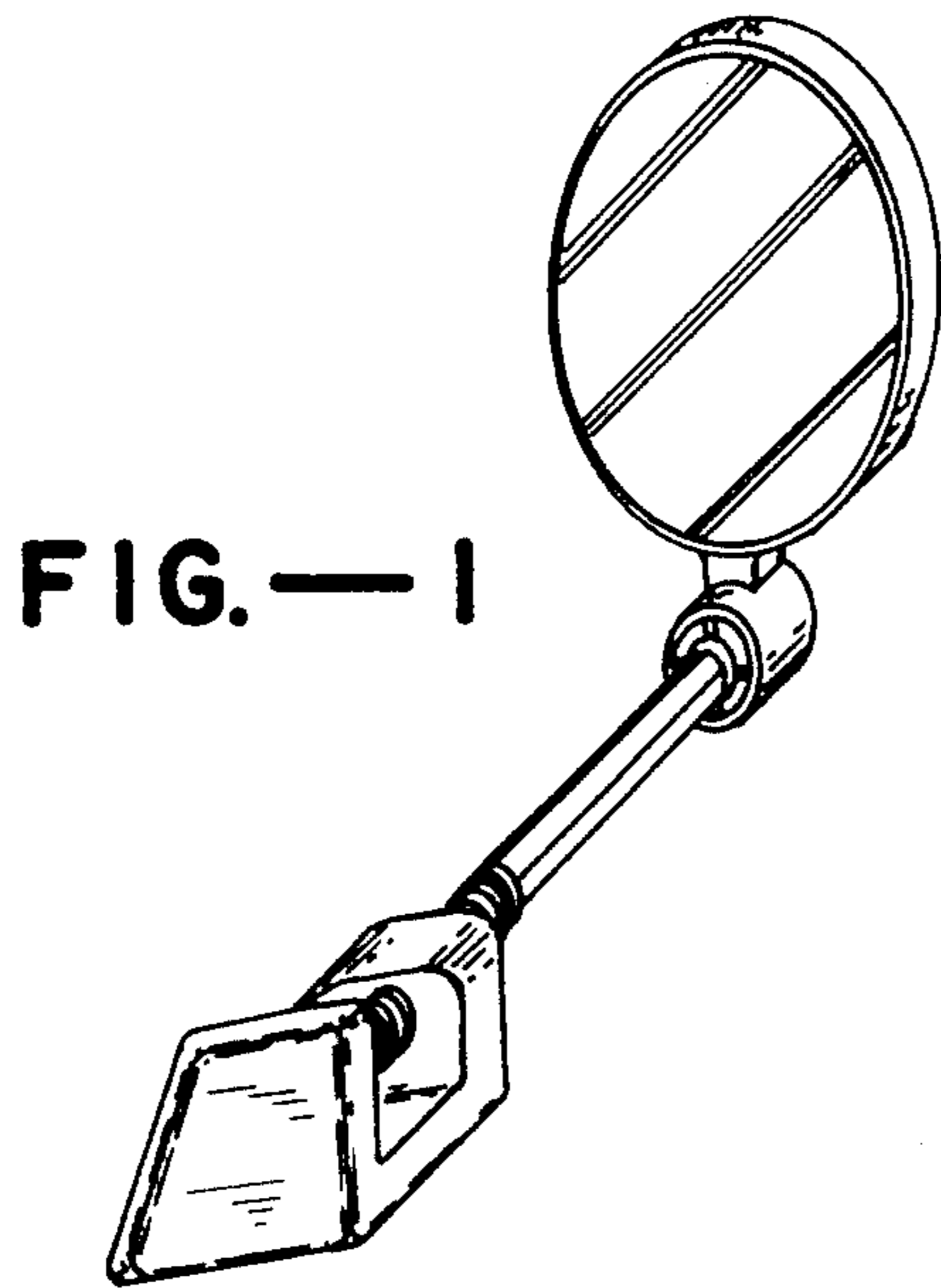

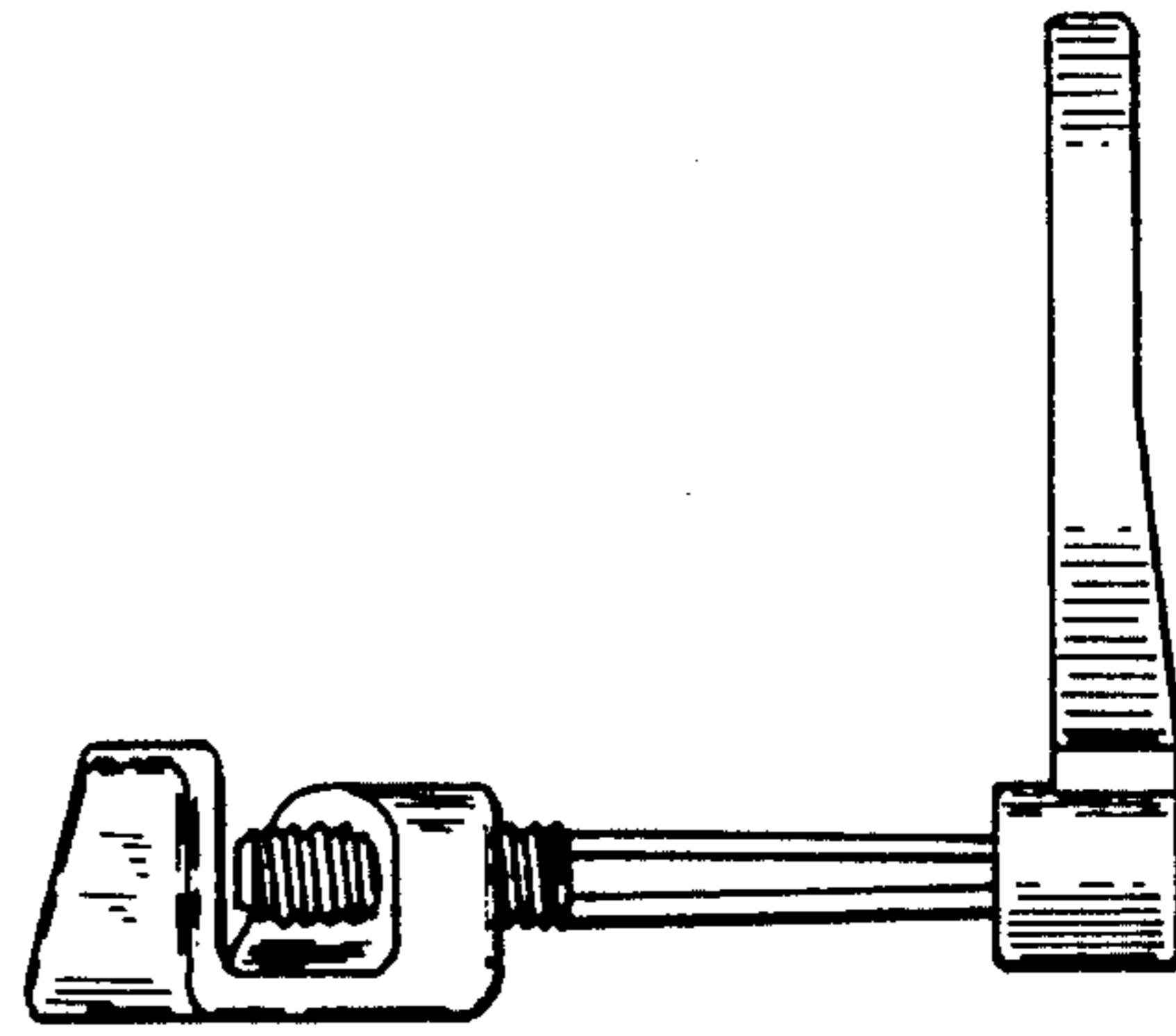

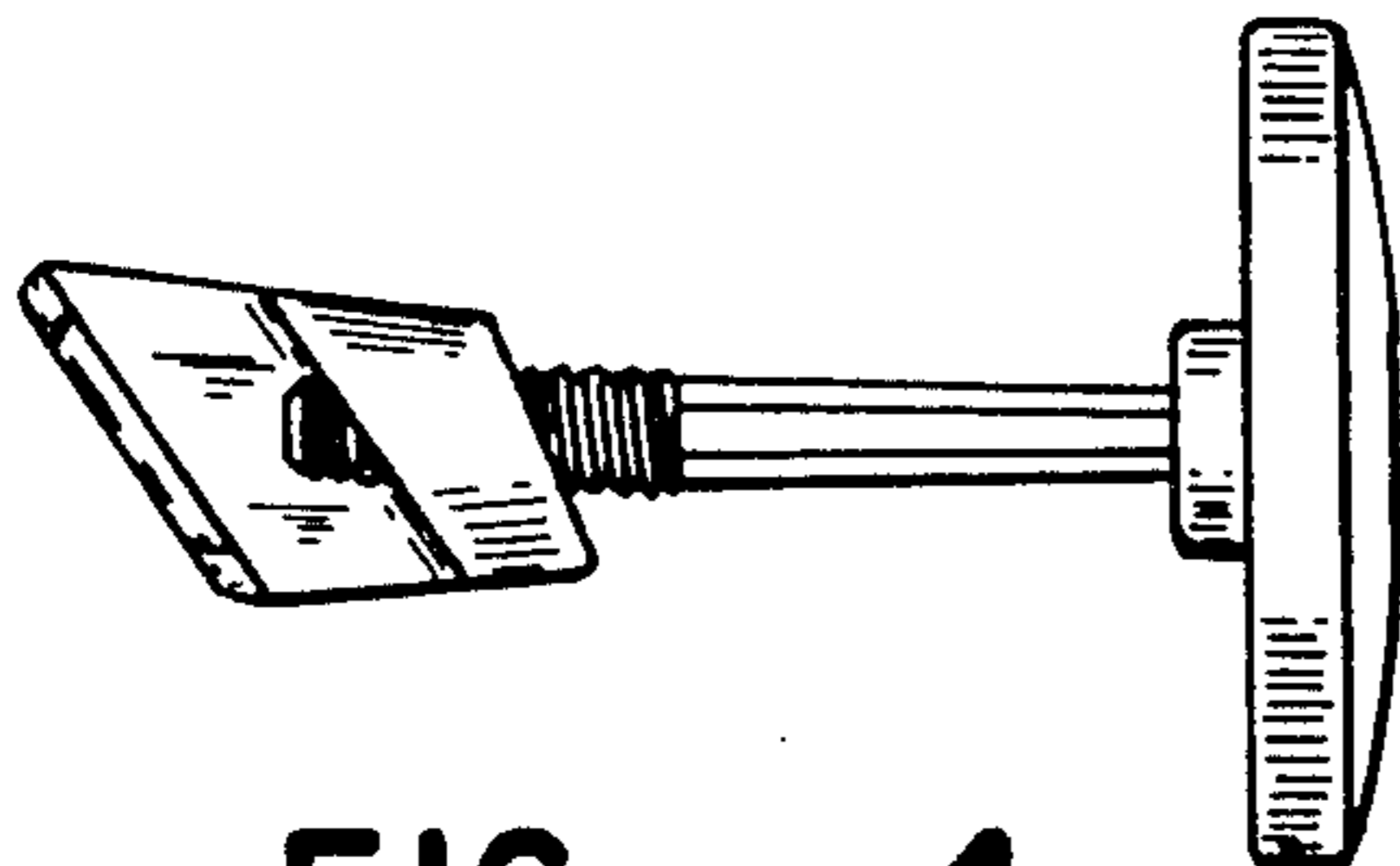

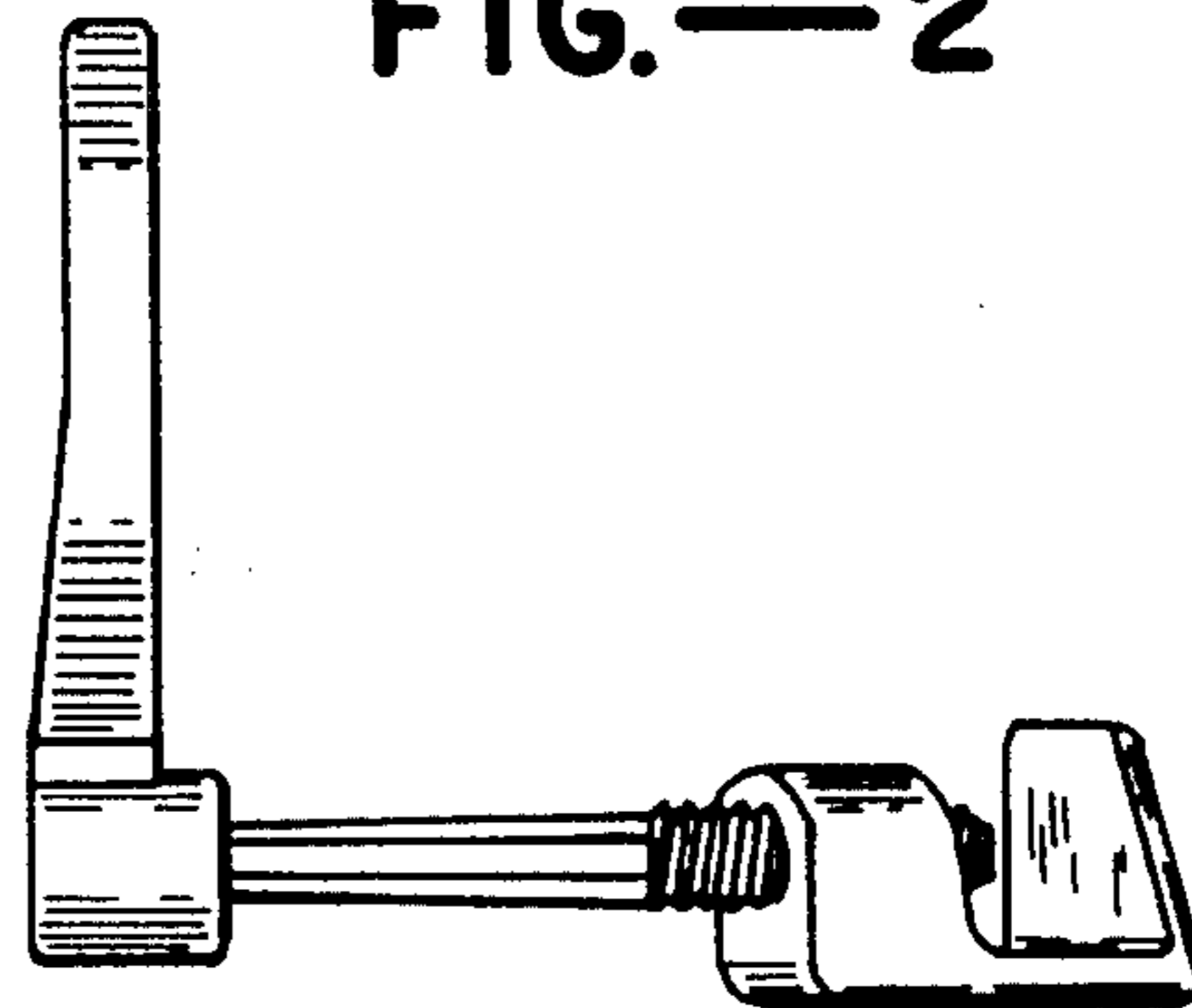

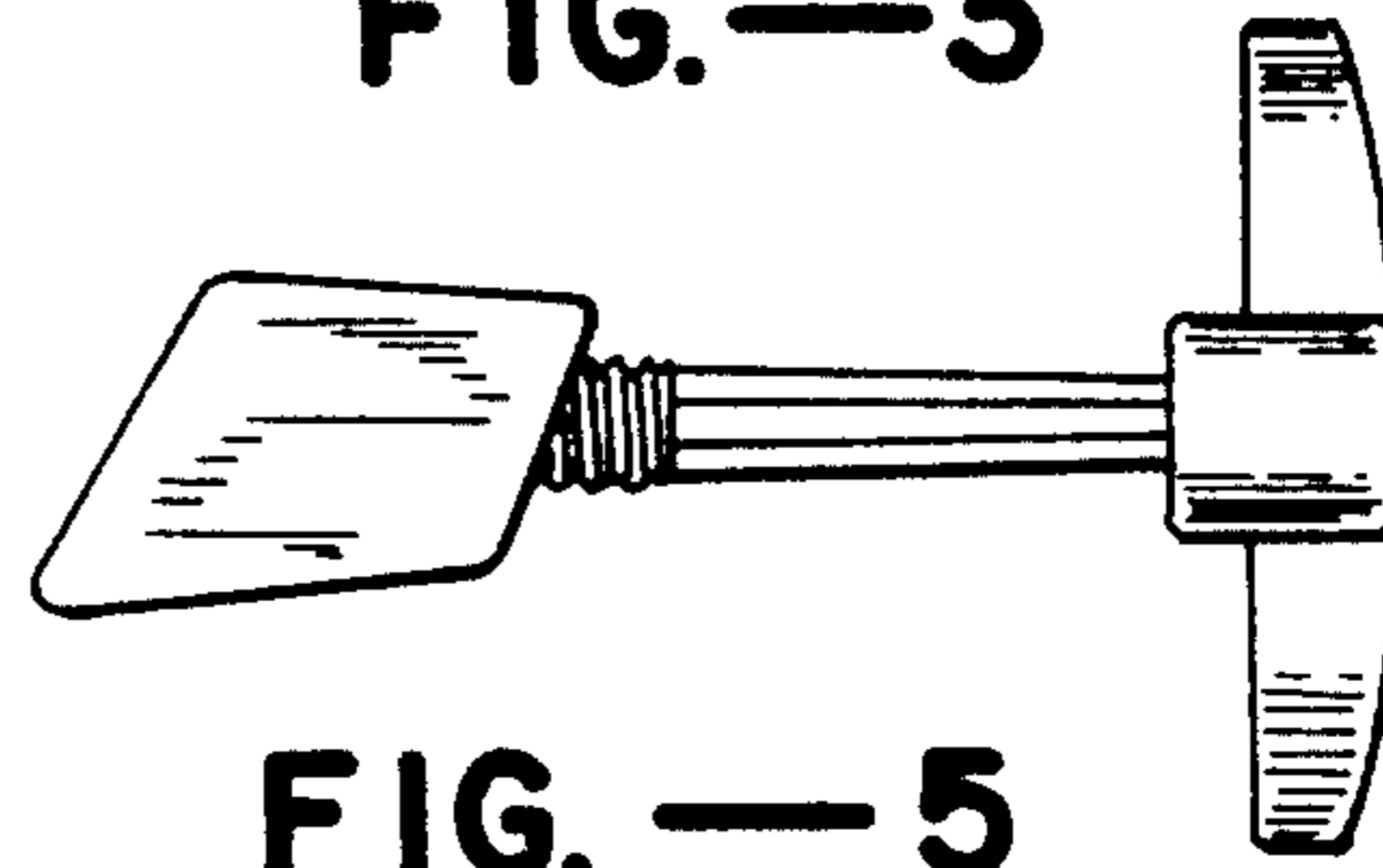

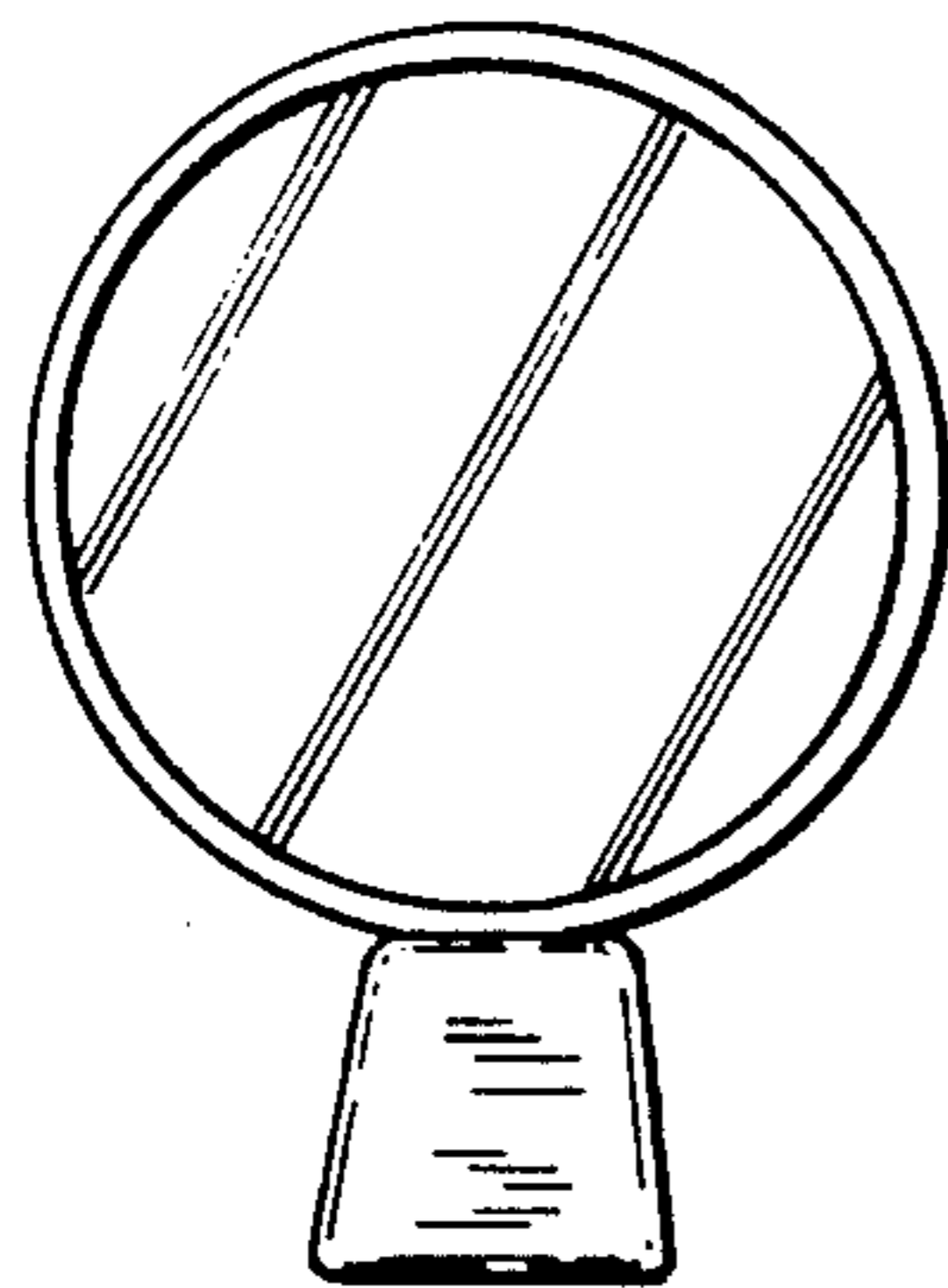

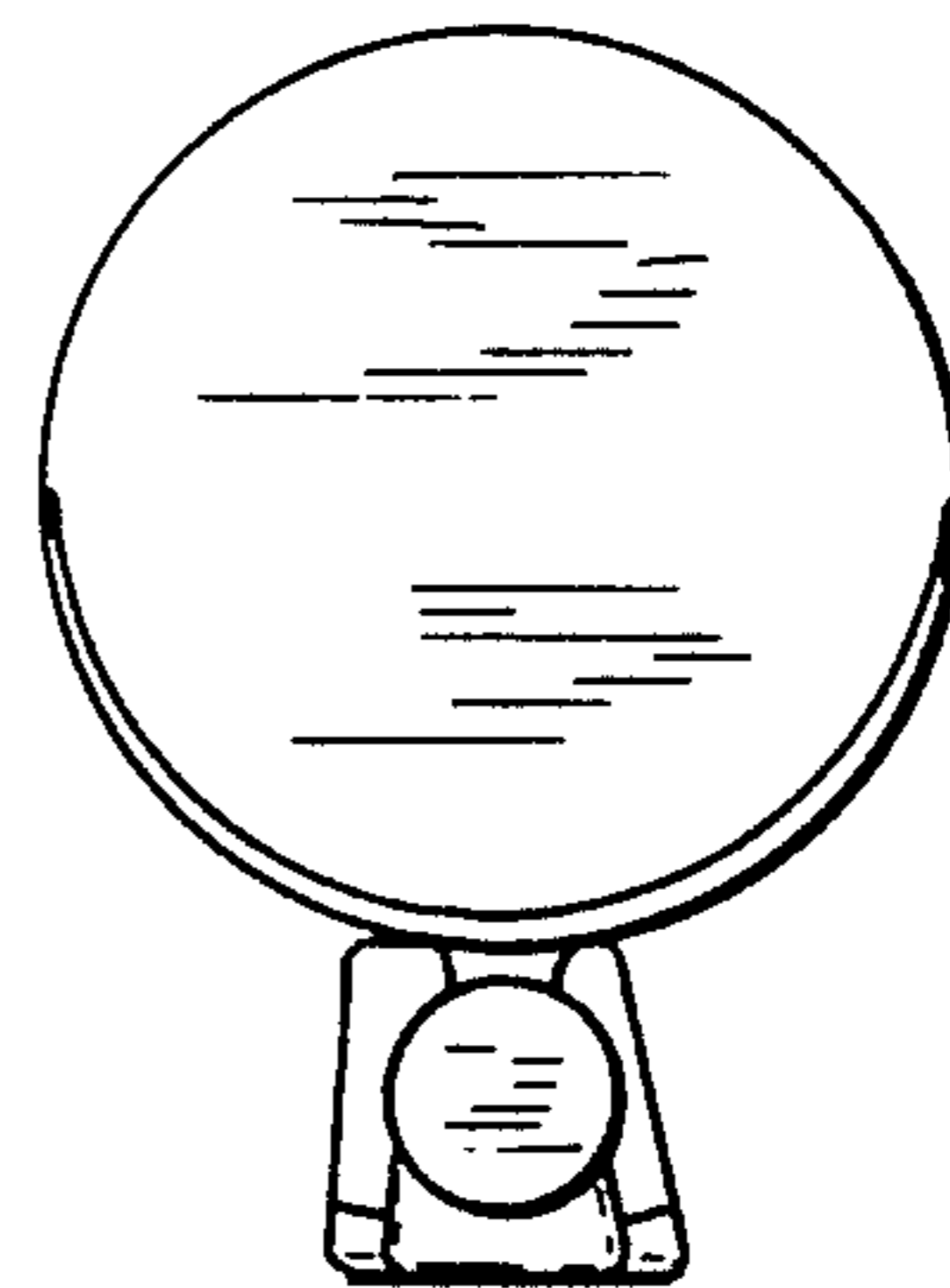
