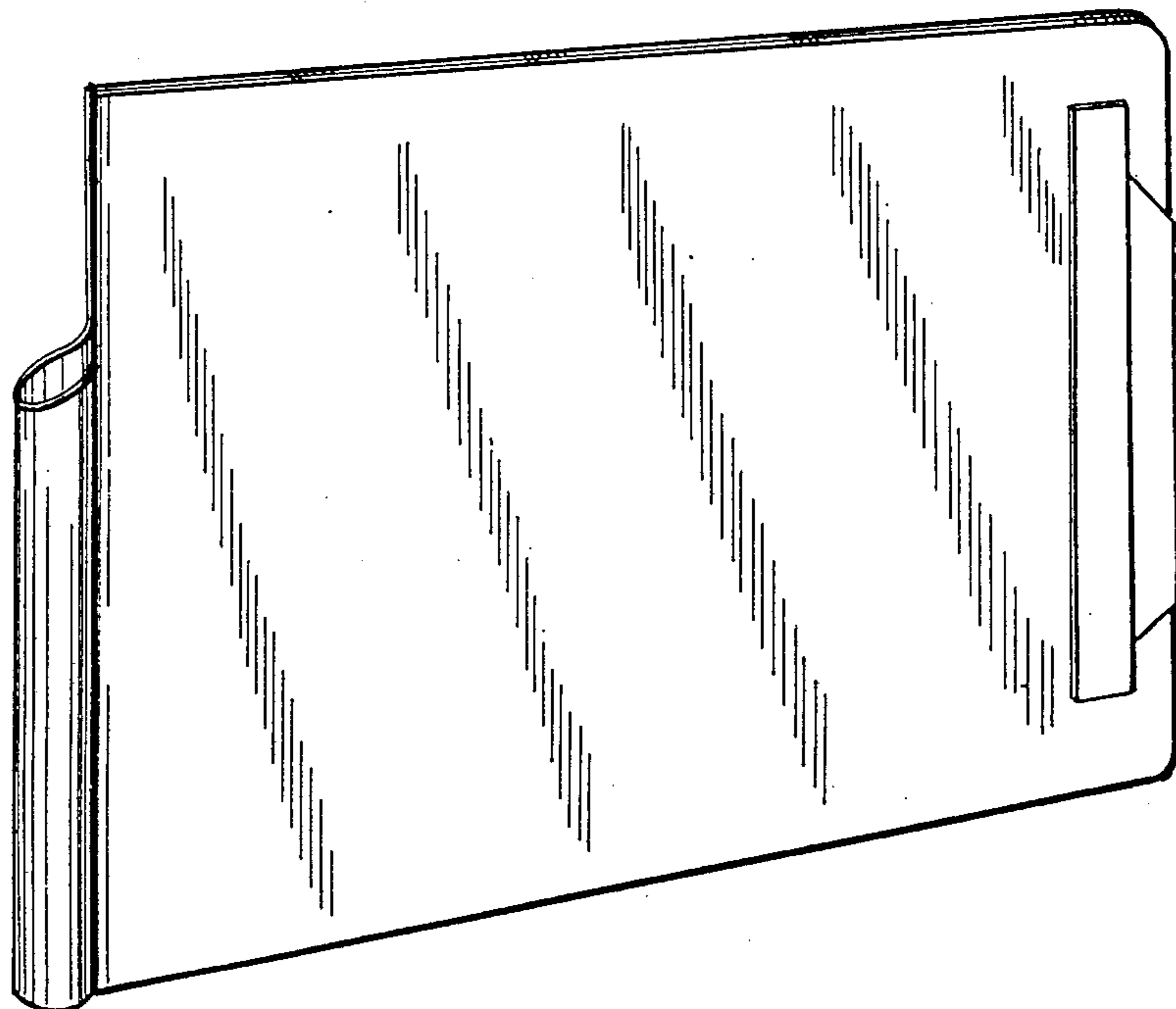

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a holder for a rule book and score card showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a reduced scale plan view of the interior in an open position; and
 FIG. 4 is a reduced scale plan view of the exterior in an open position.



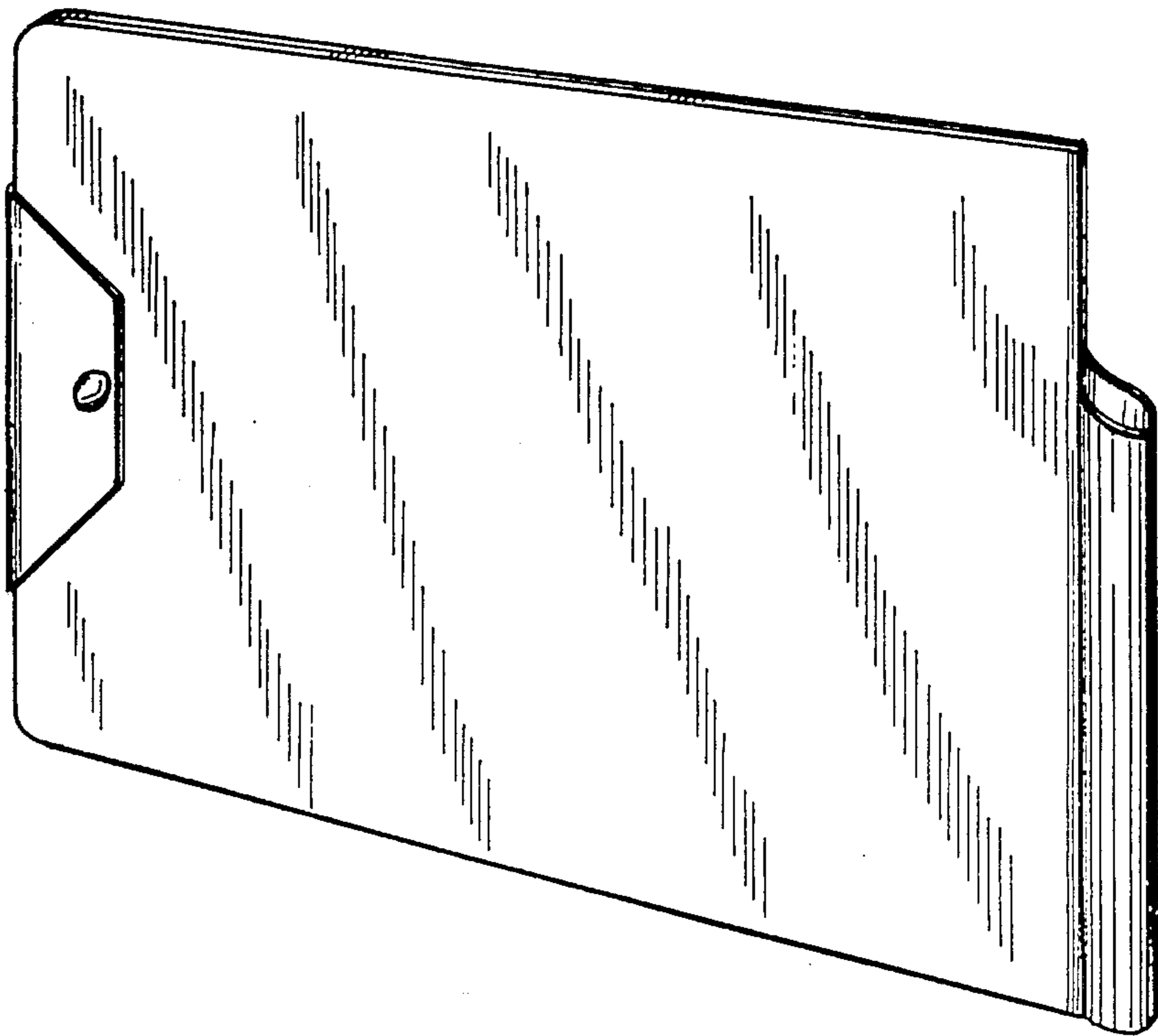

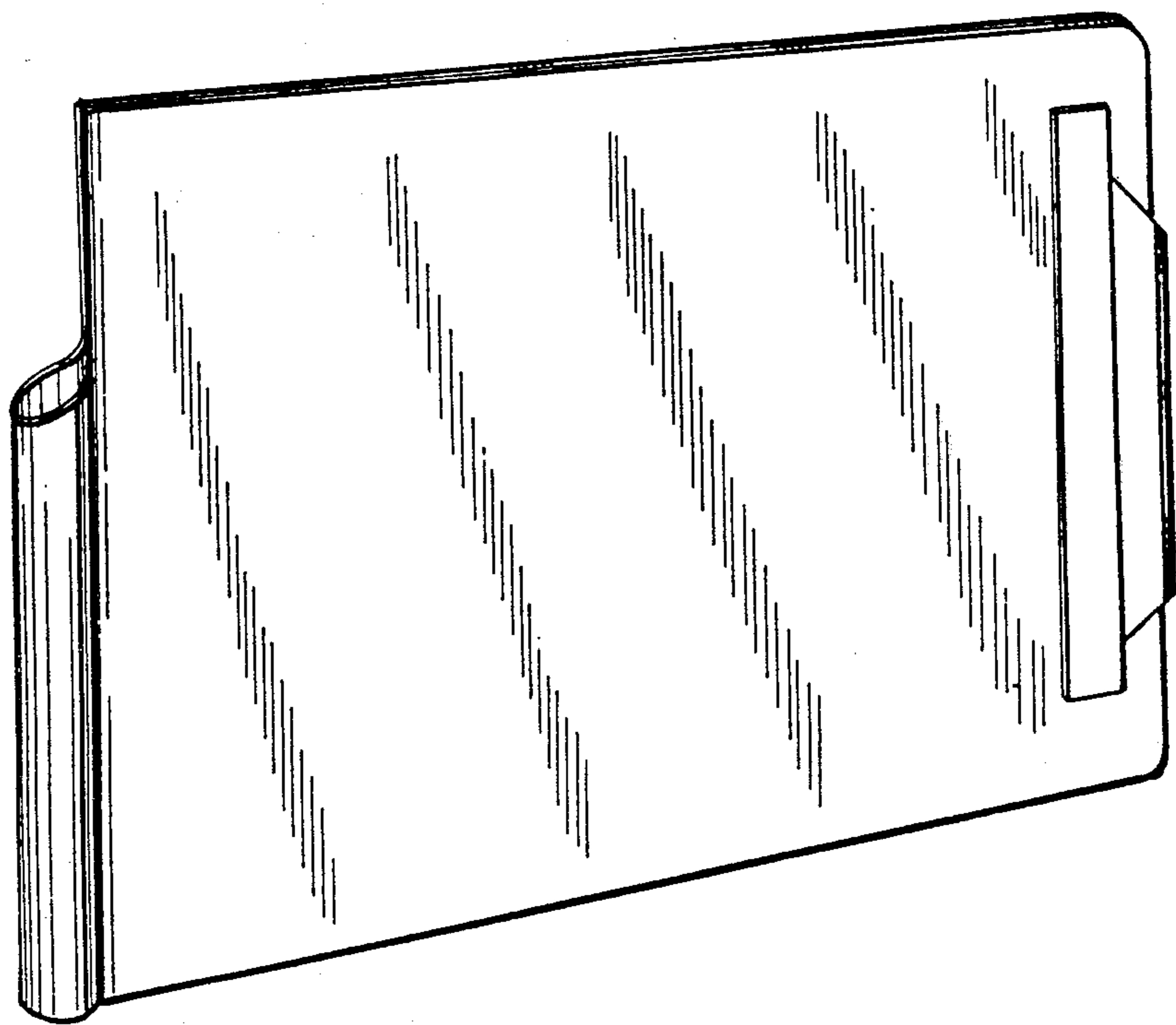

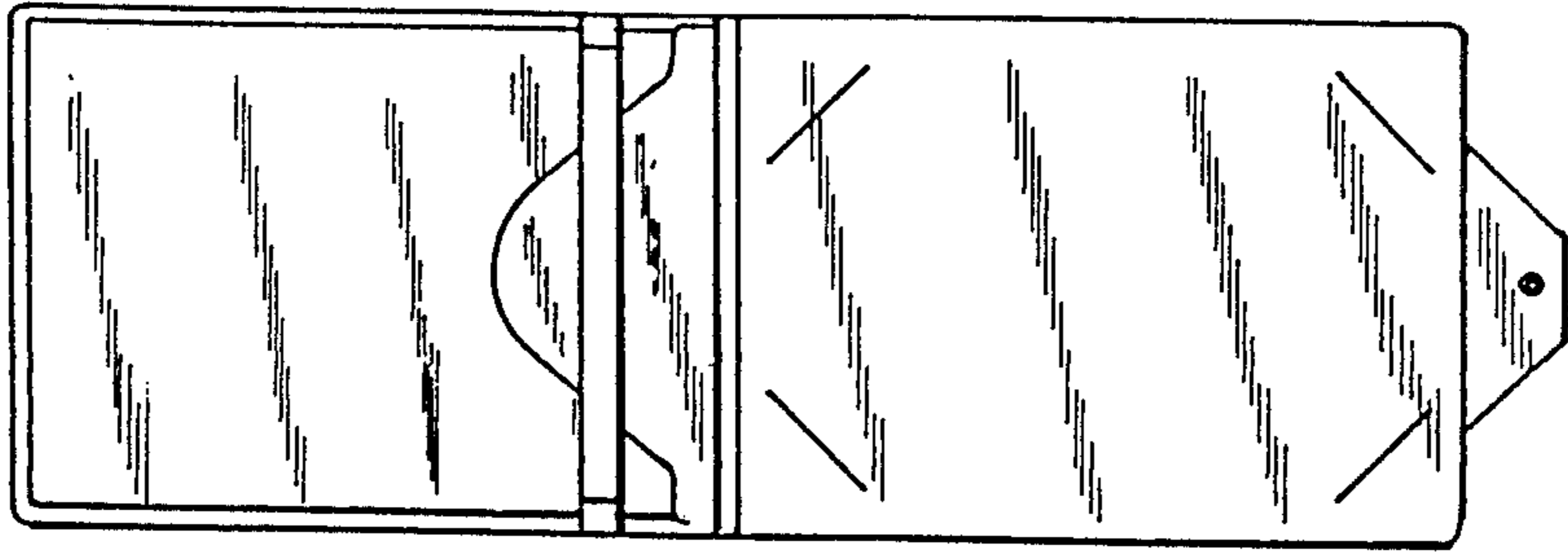

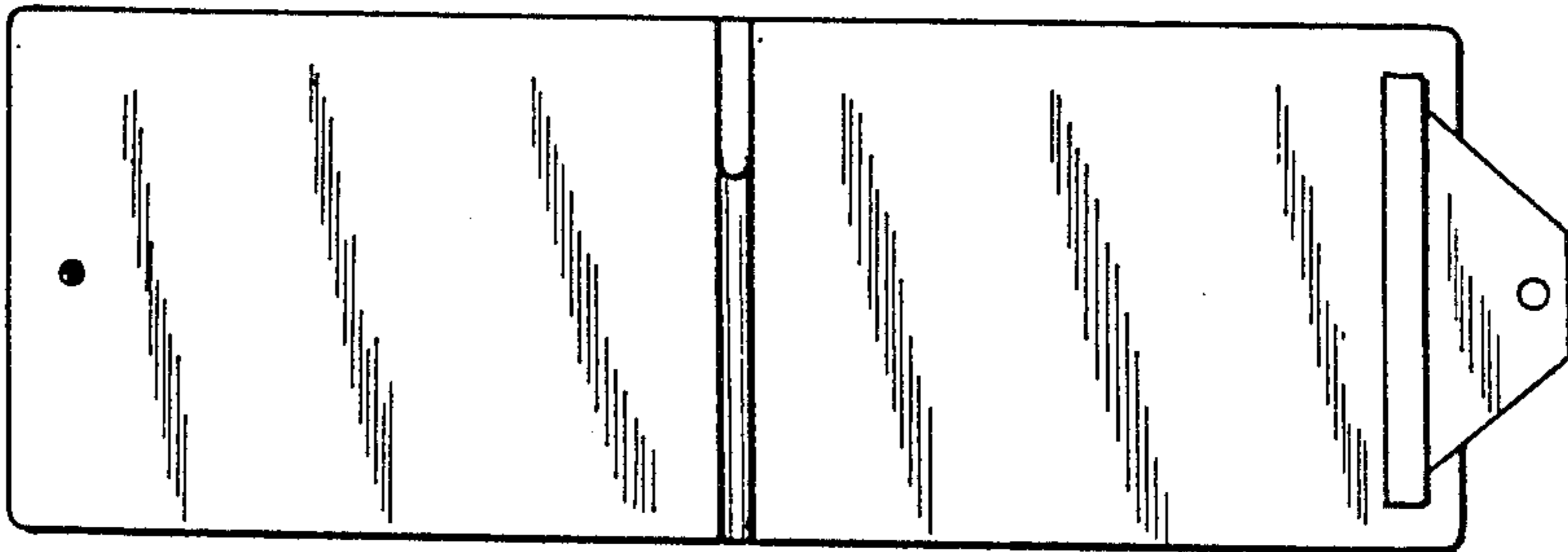
