The ornamental design for a housing part for a coin dispenser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a housing part for a coin dispenser, showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom rear perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a cross sectional view thereof taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 2.

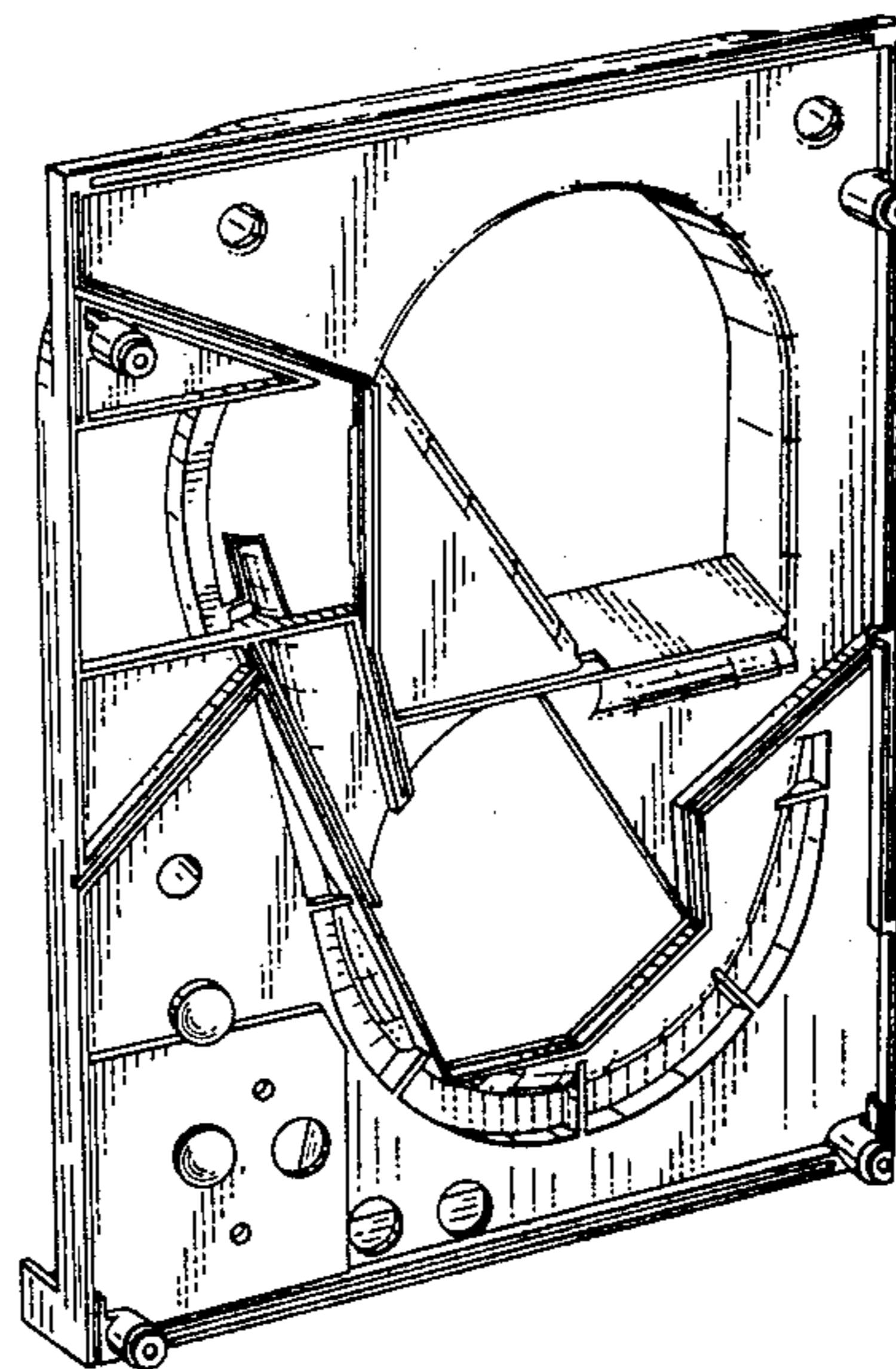
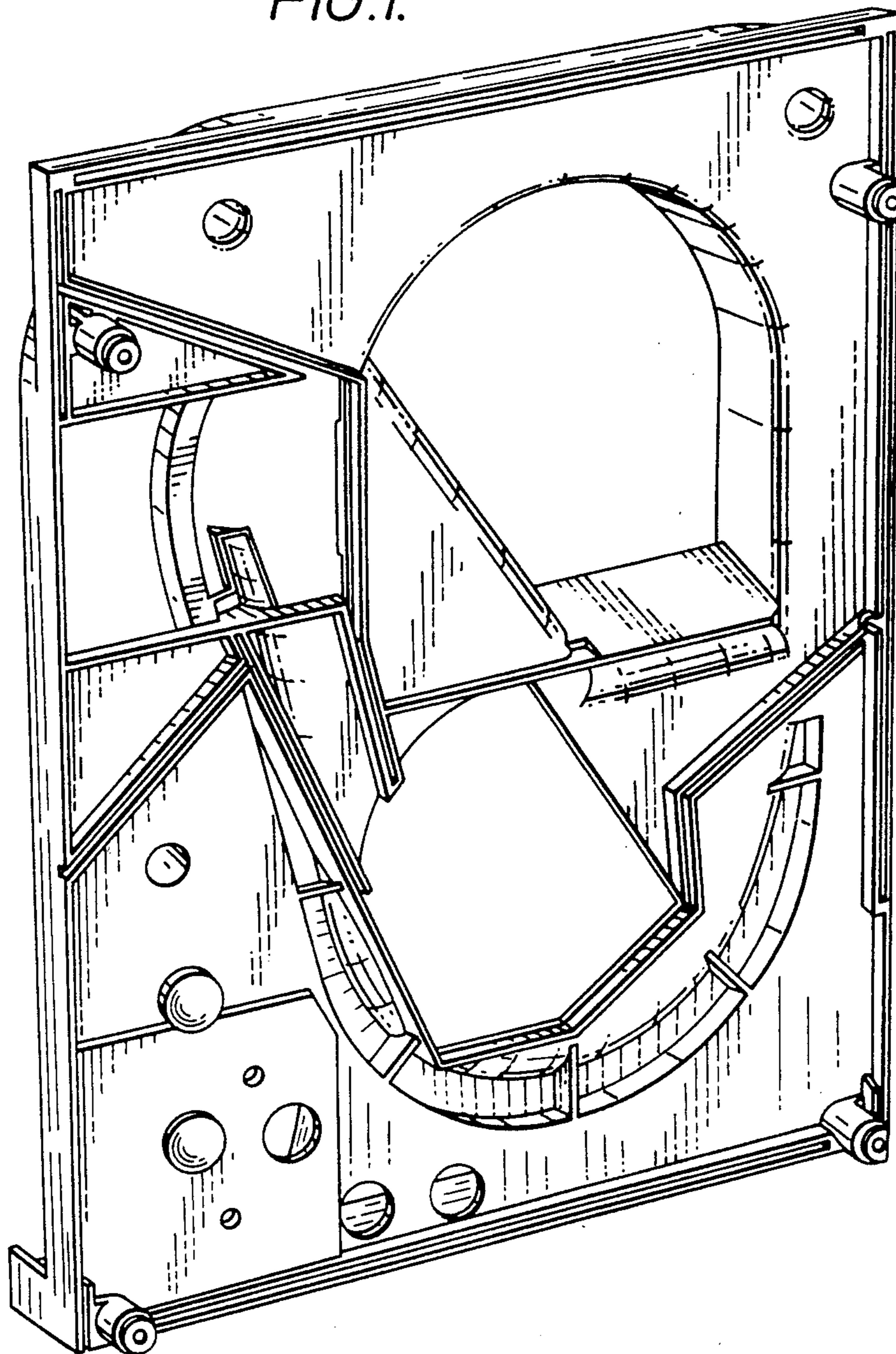

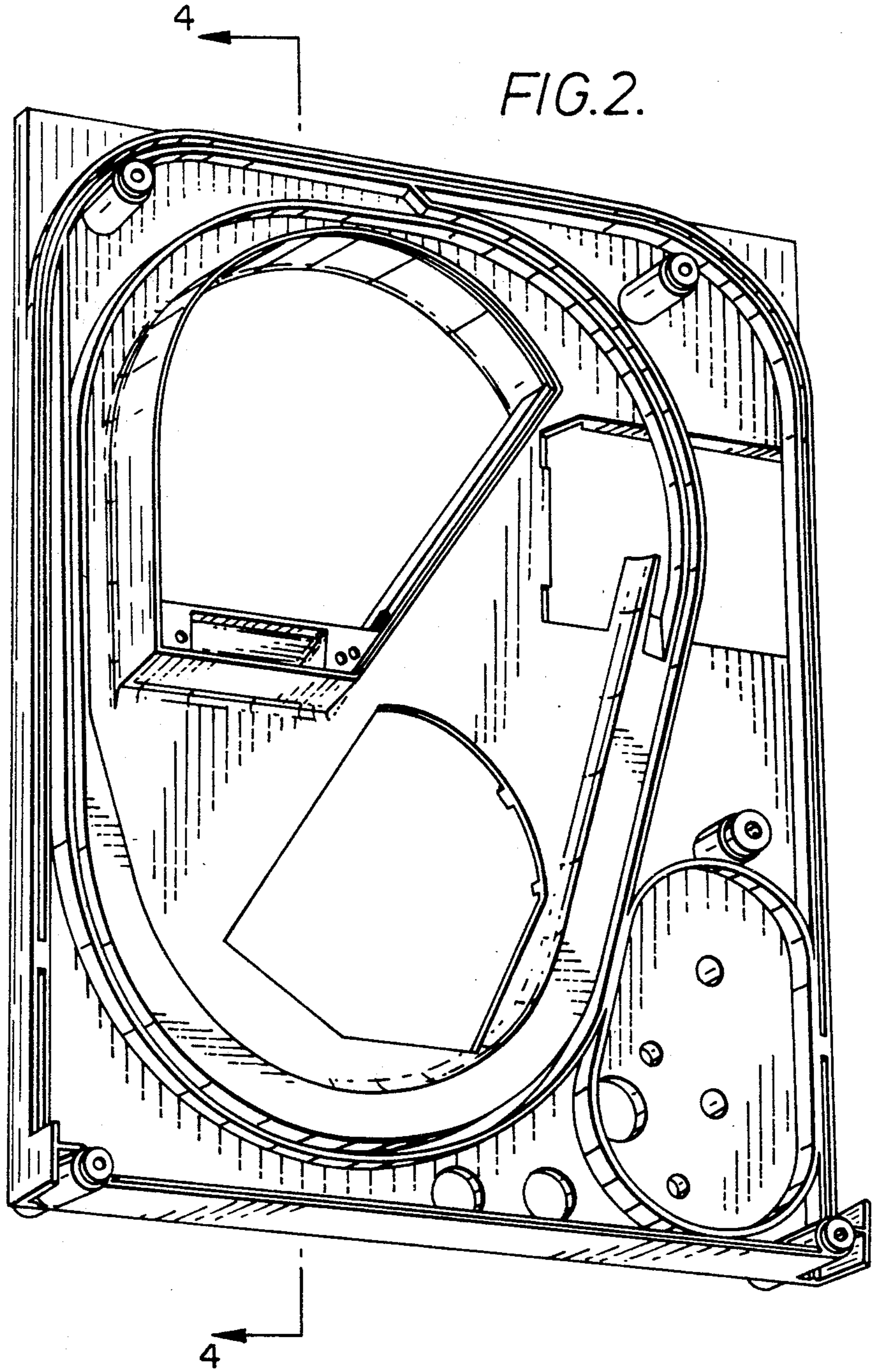

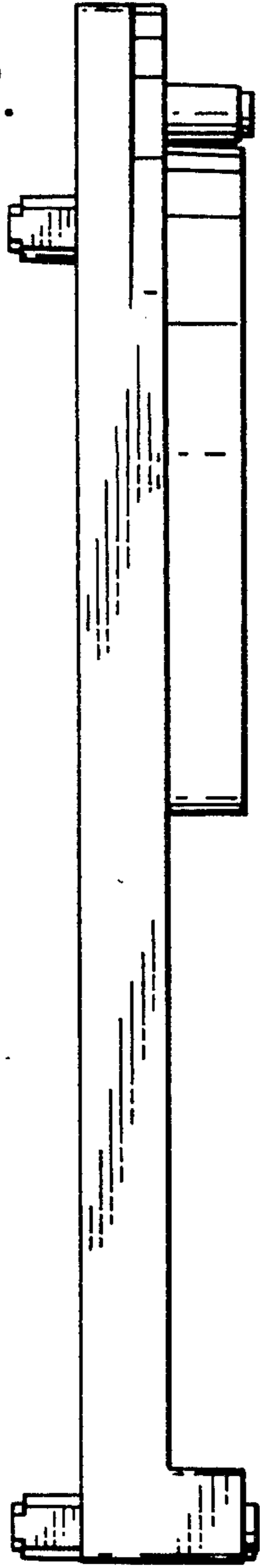
