The ornamental design for pot holder for arthritic persons, substantially as shown and described.

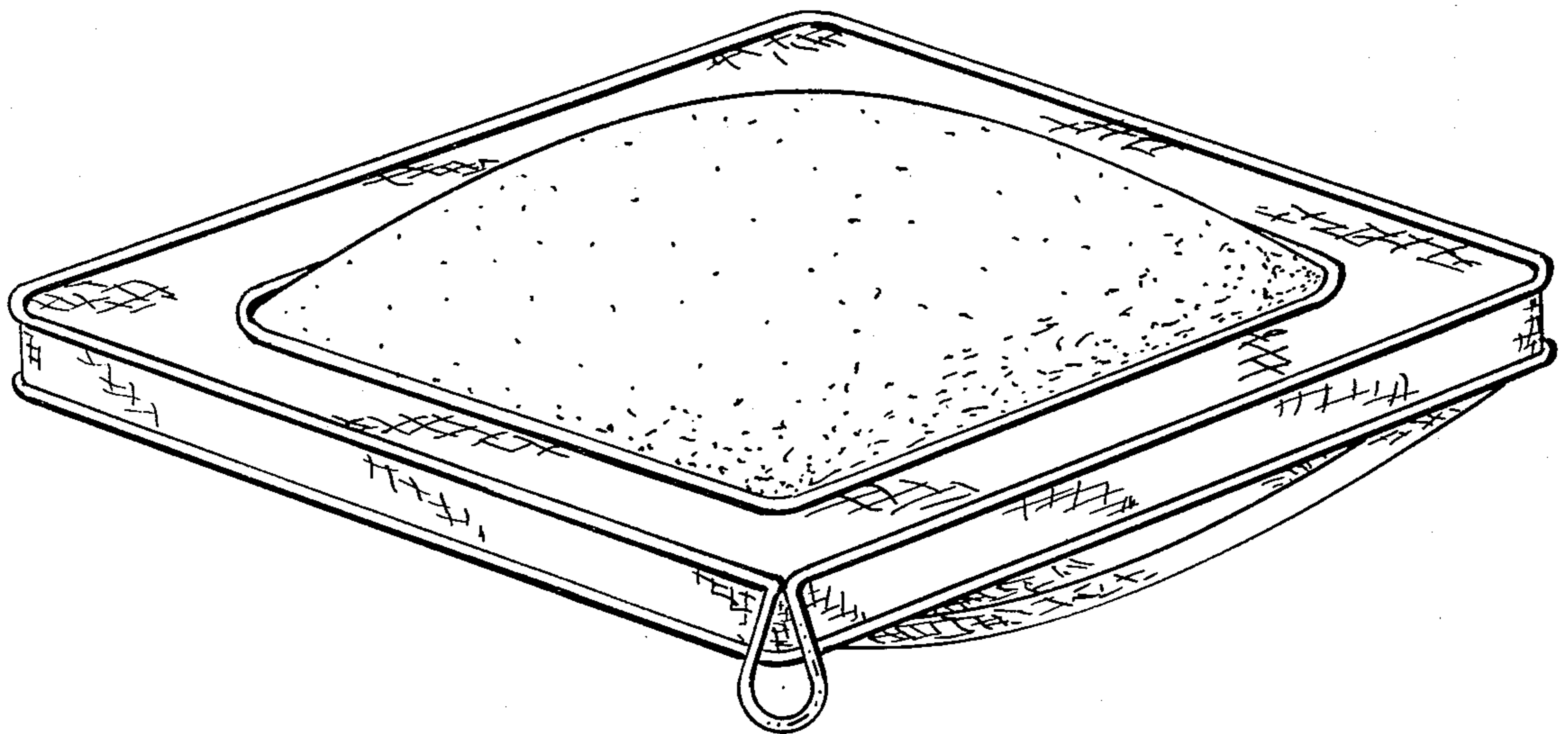
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and side perspective view of a pot holder for arthritic persons showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and

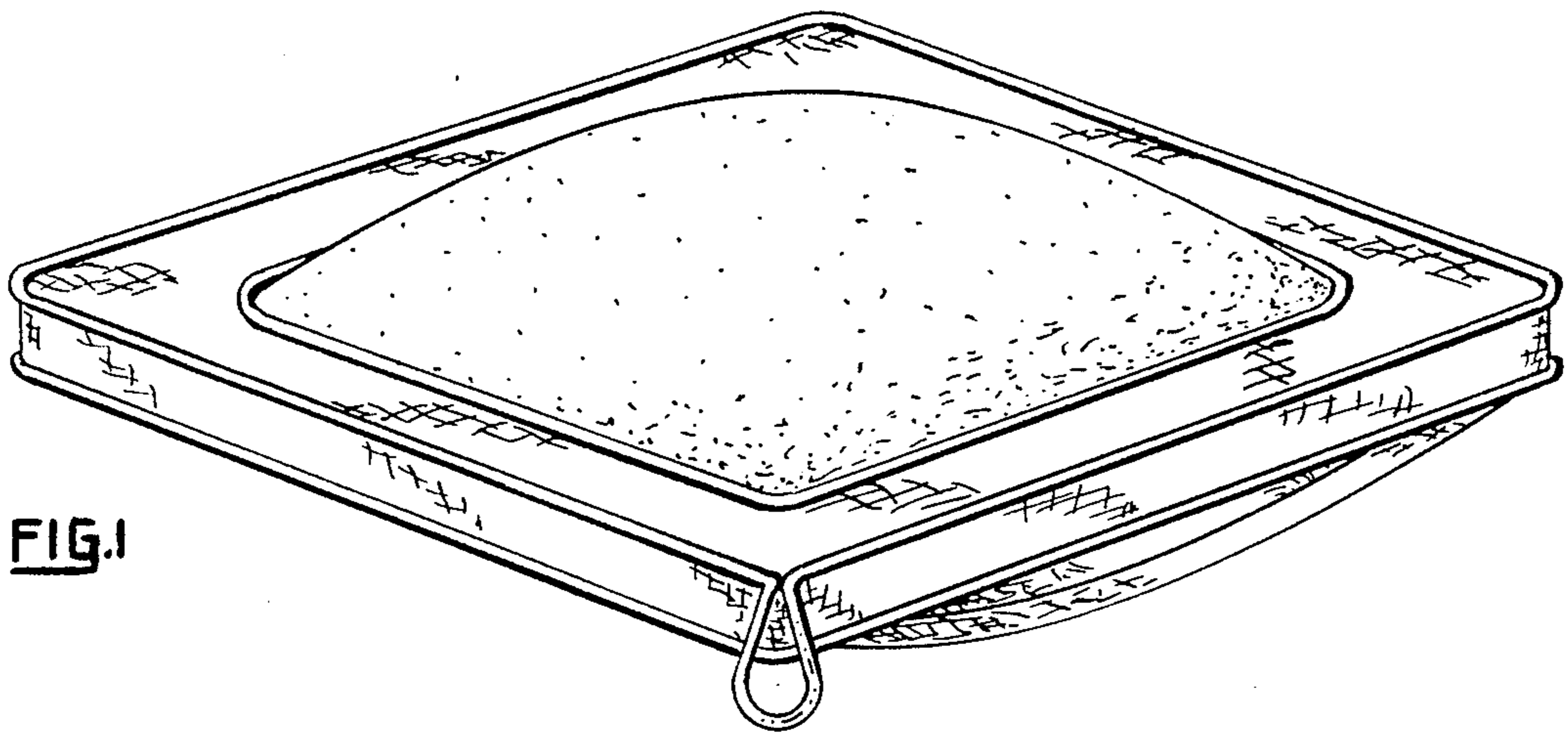

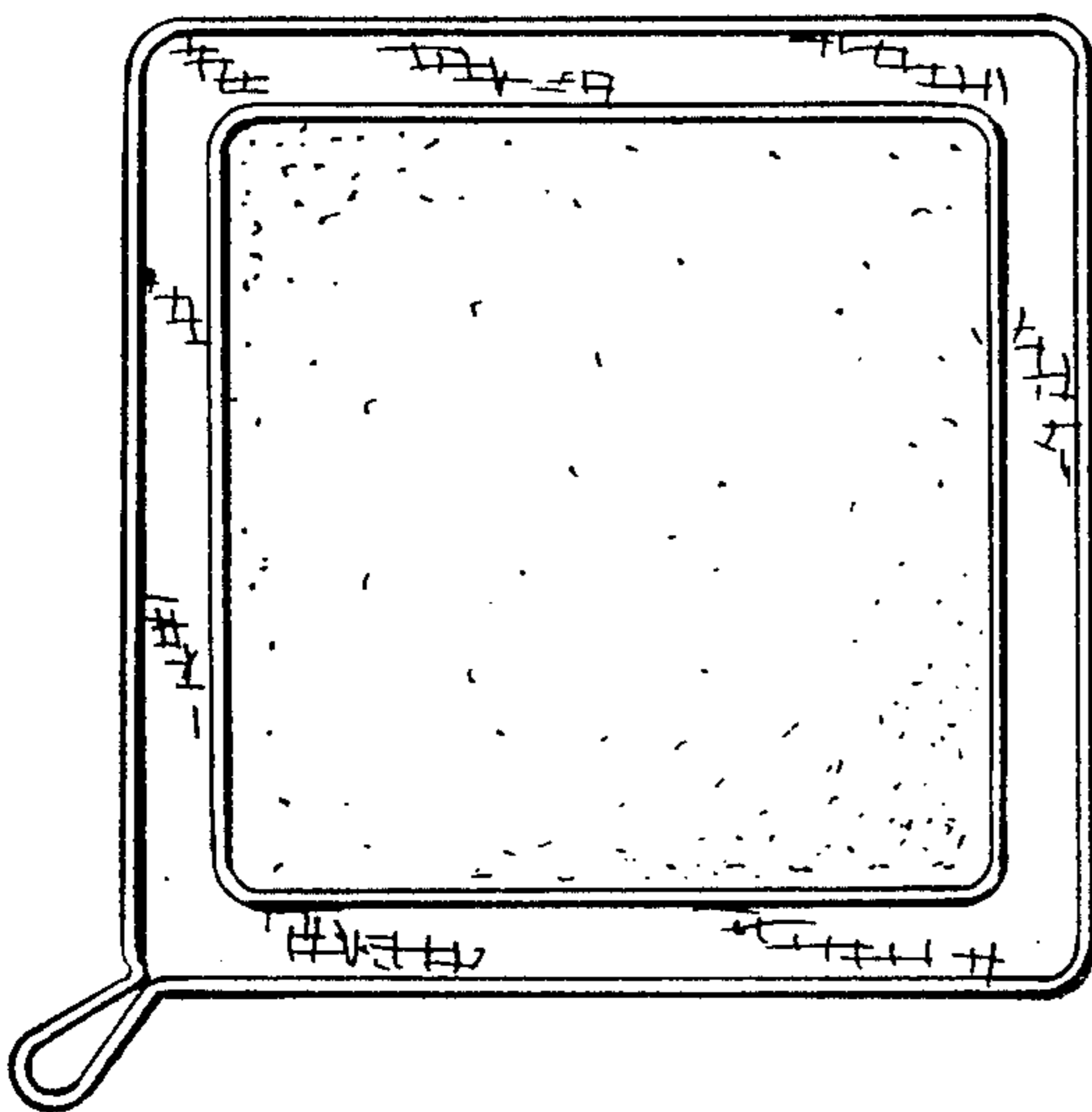

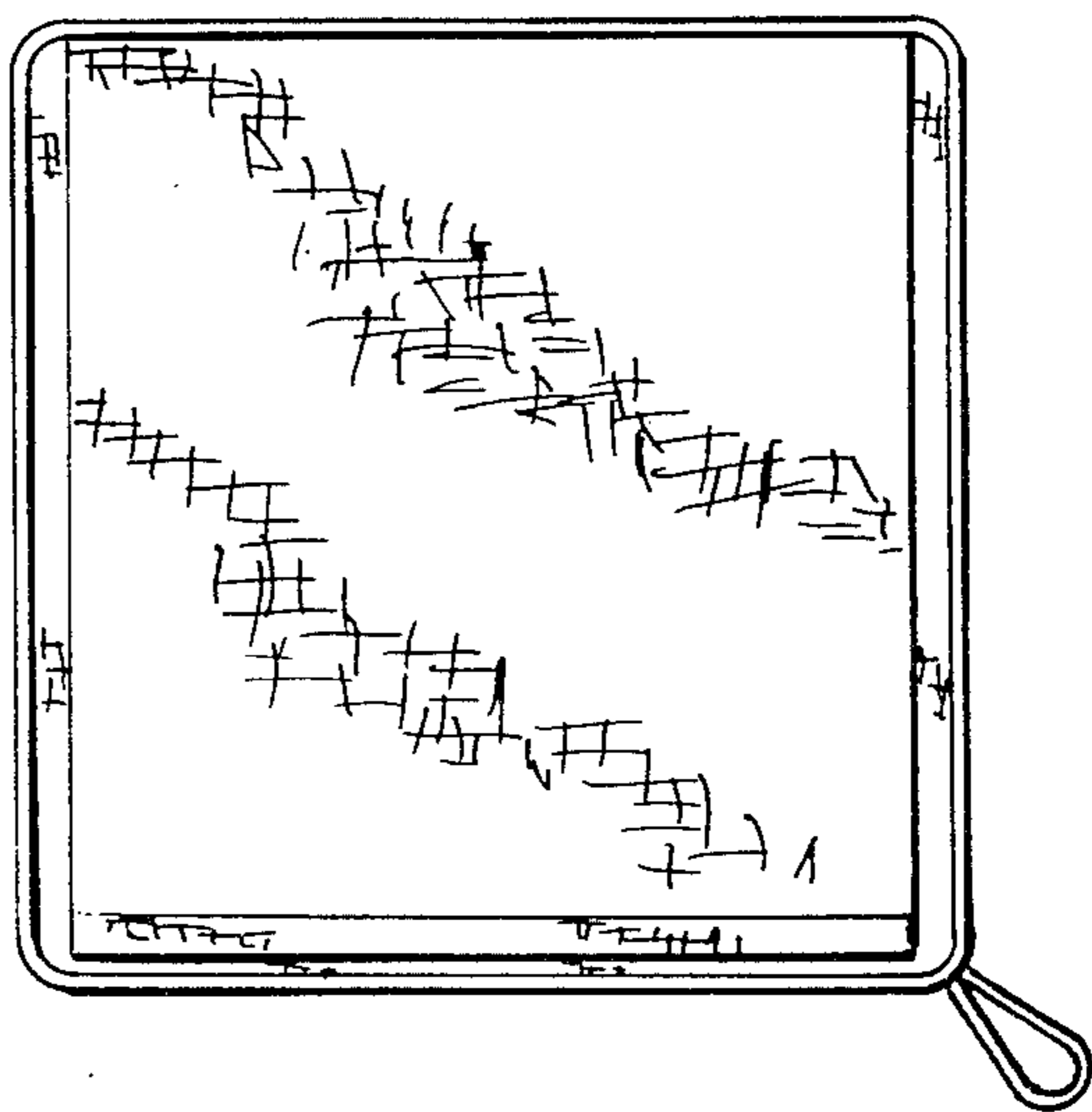

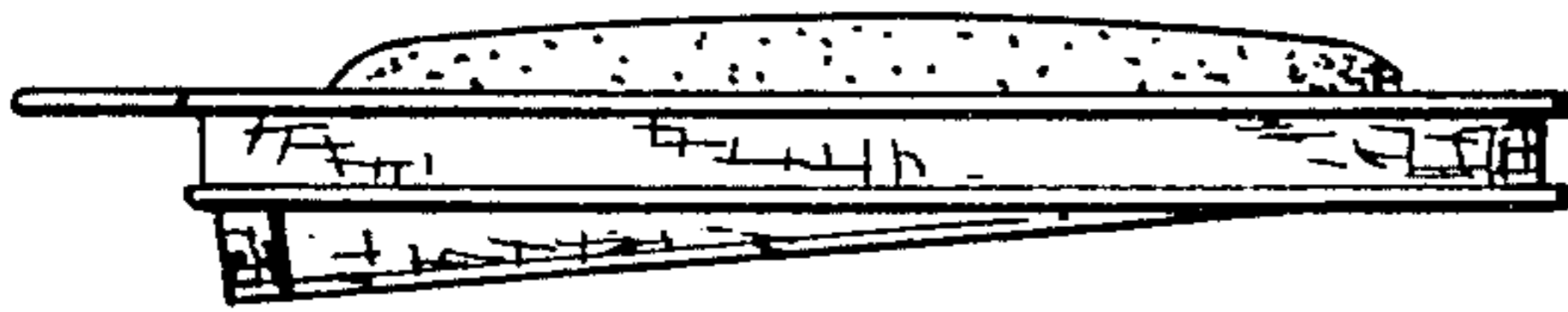

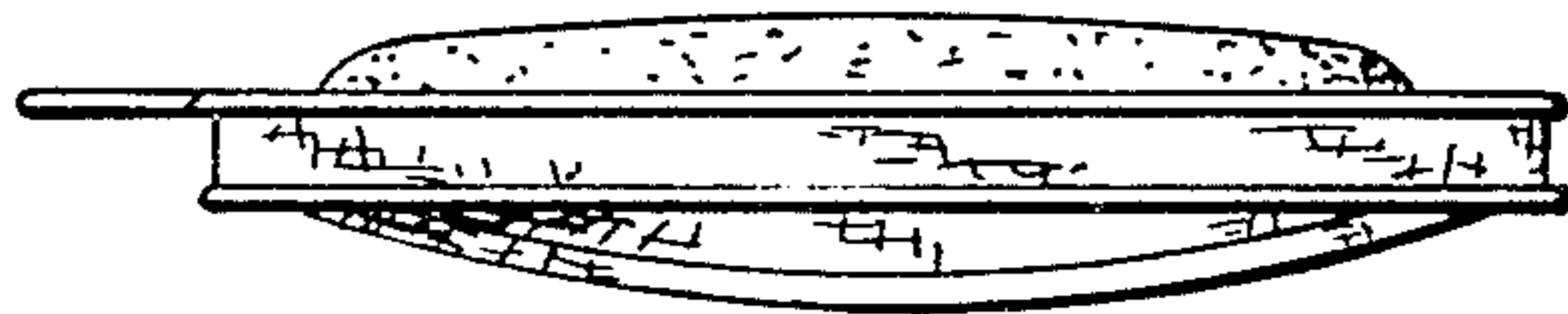
