[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined dressing table and storage unit for an infant, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the top, front and right side of a combined dressing table and storage unit for an infant showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a left-side elevational view thereof, the right side being substantially a mirror image thereof; and FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof.



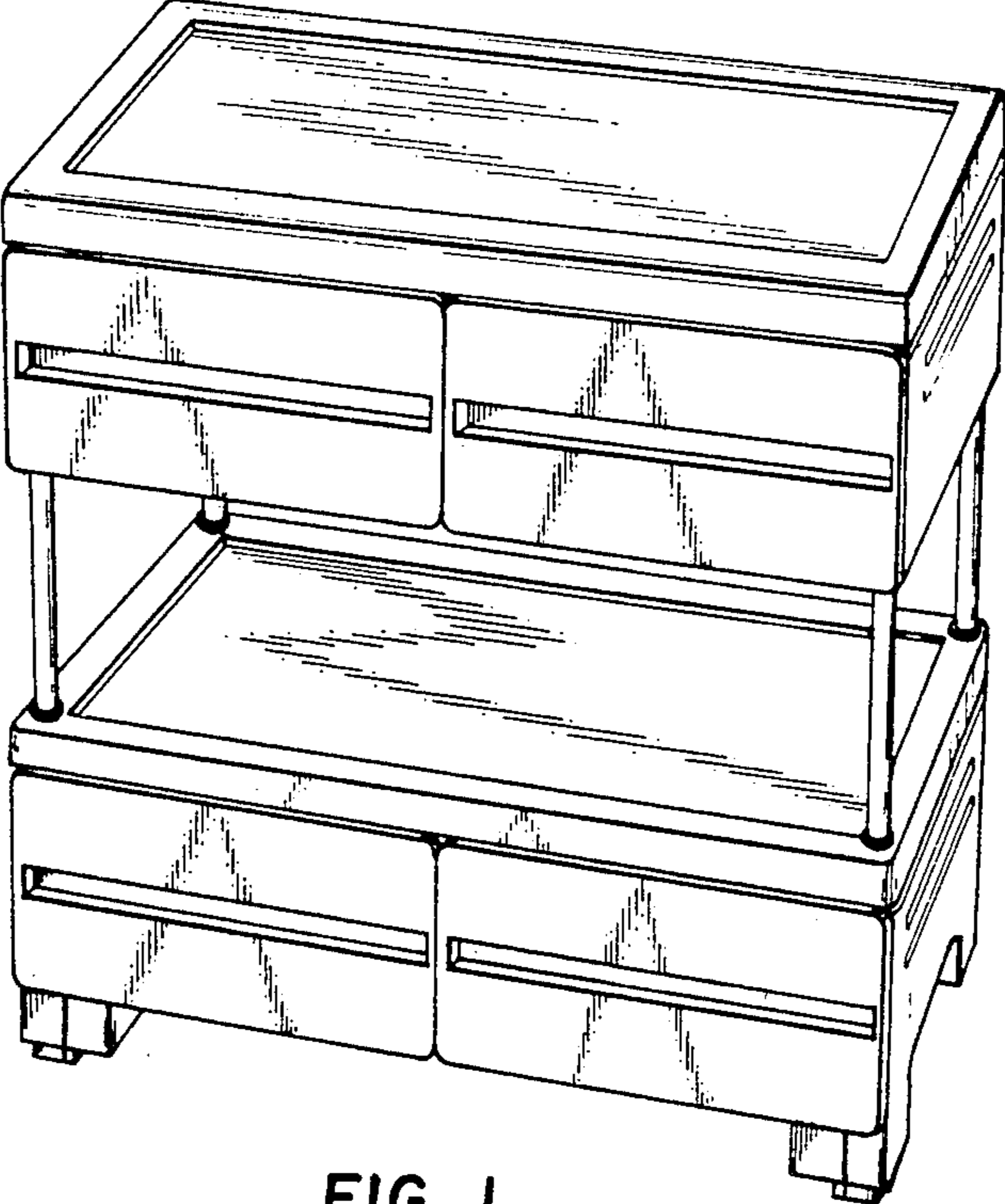

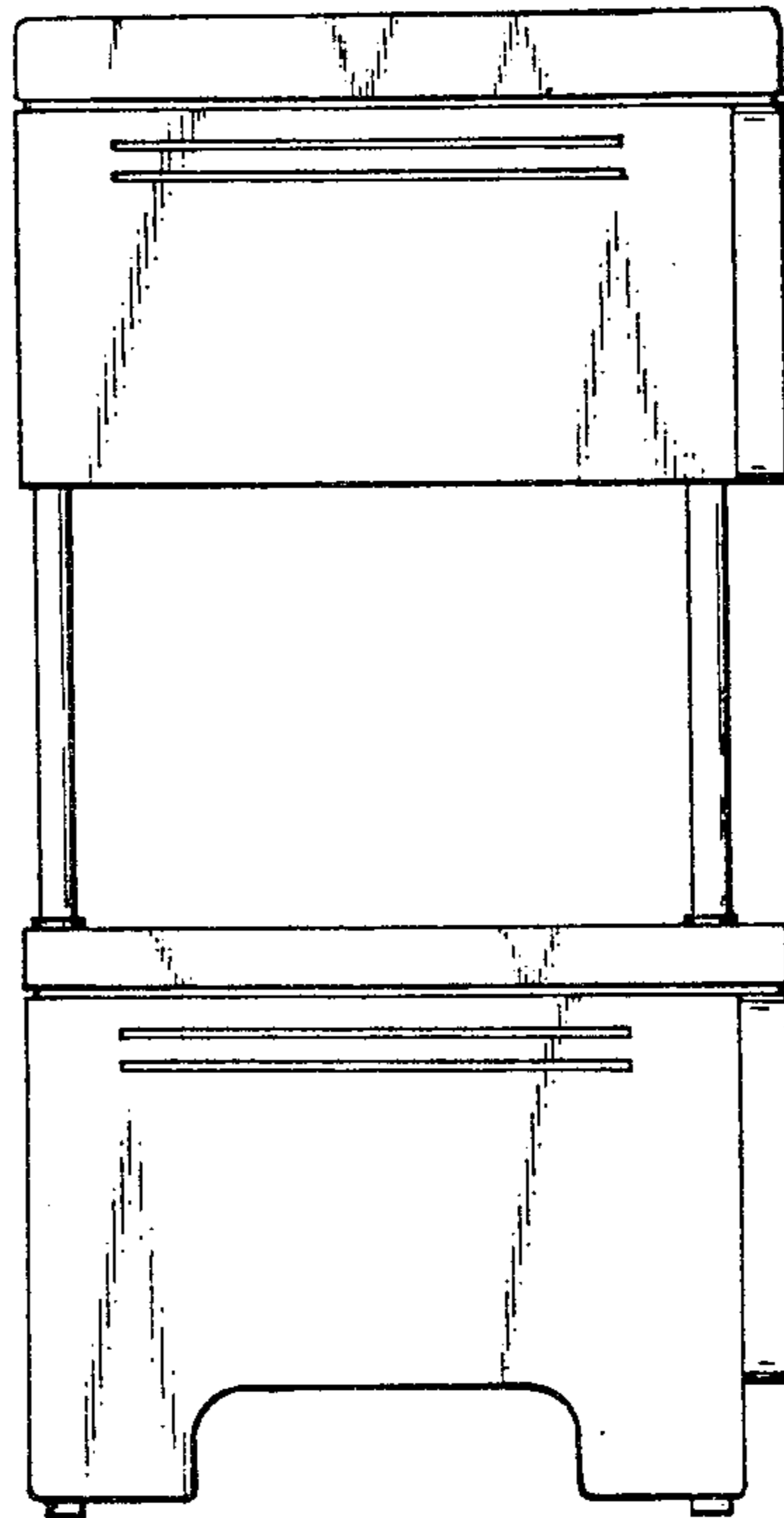

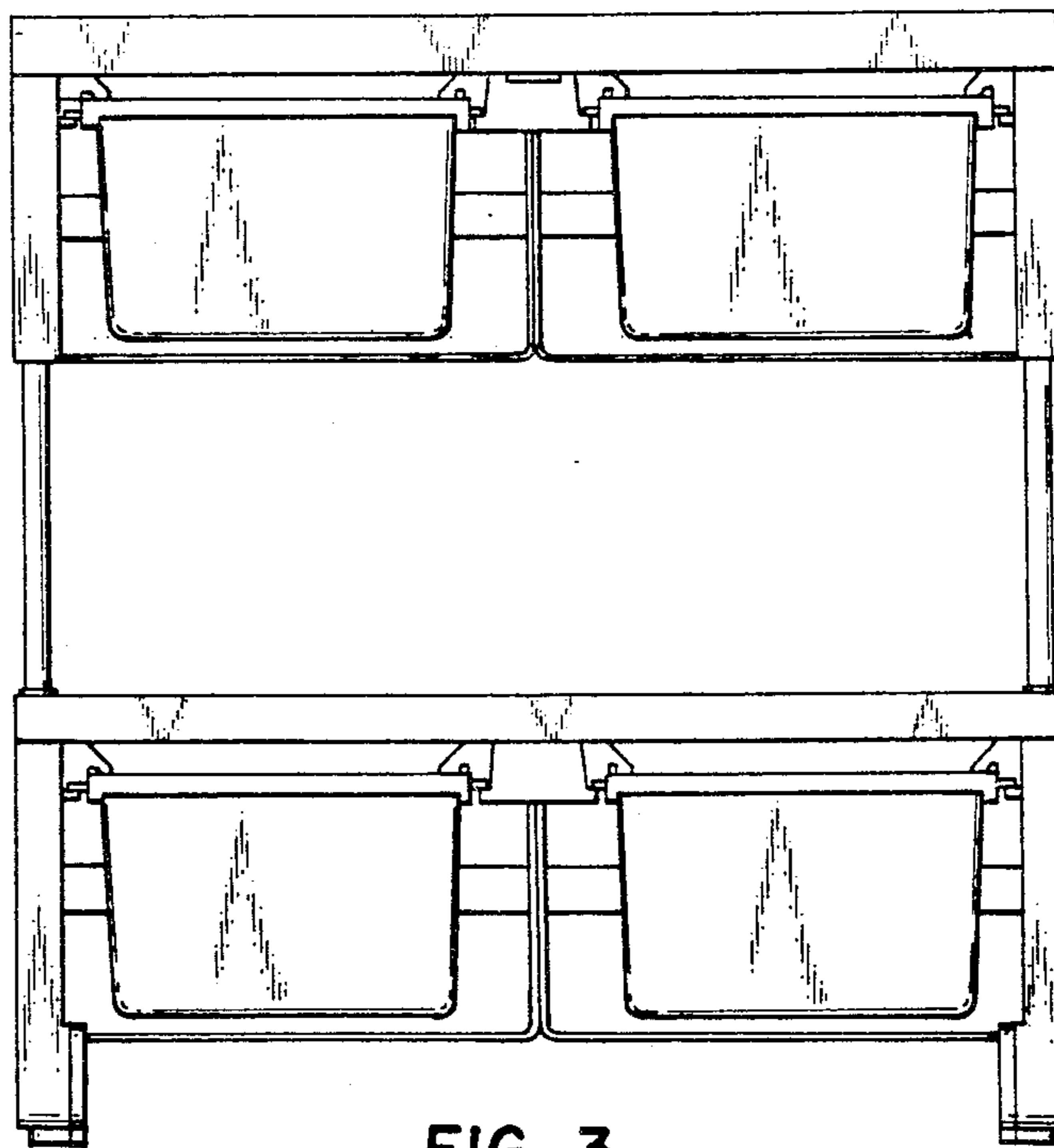
