[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a frying pan grease drain insert, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a frying pan grease drain insert showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side view thereof, the opposite side view being identical;

FIG. 4 is another side view thereof, the opposite side view being identical with a frying pan shown in phantom for illustration purposes only.

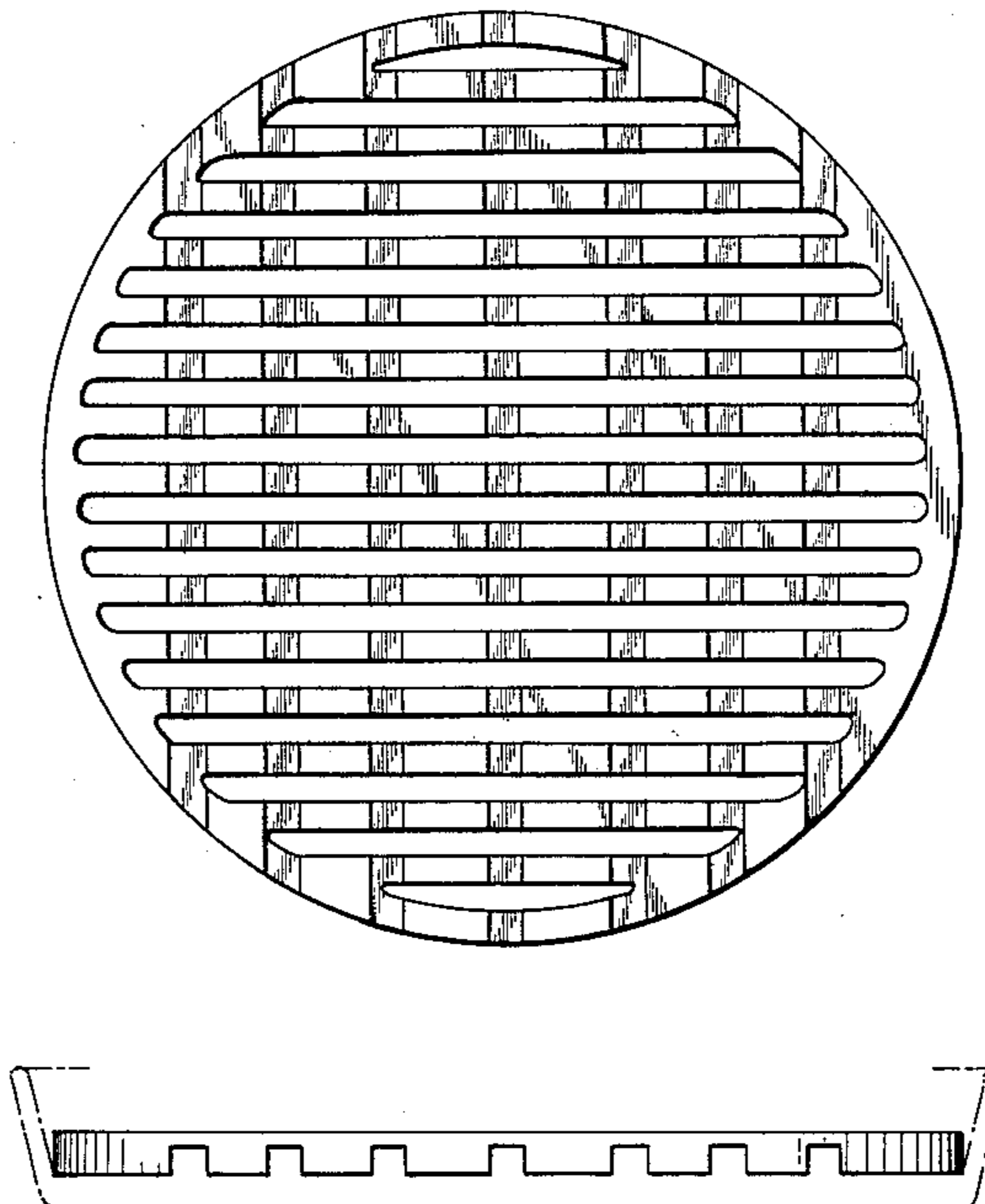

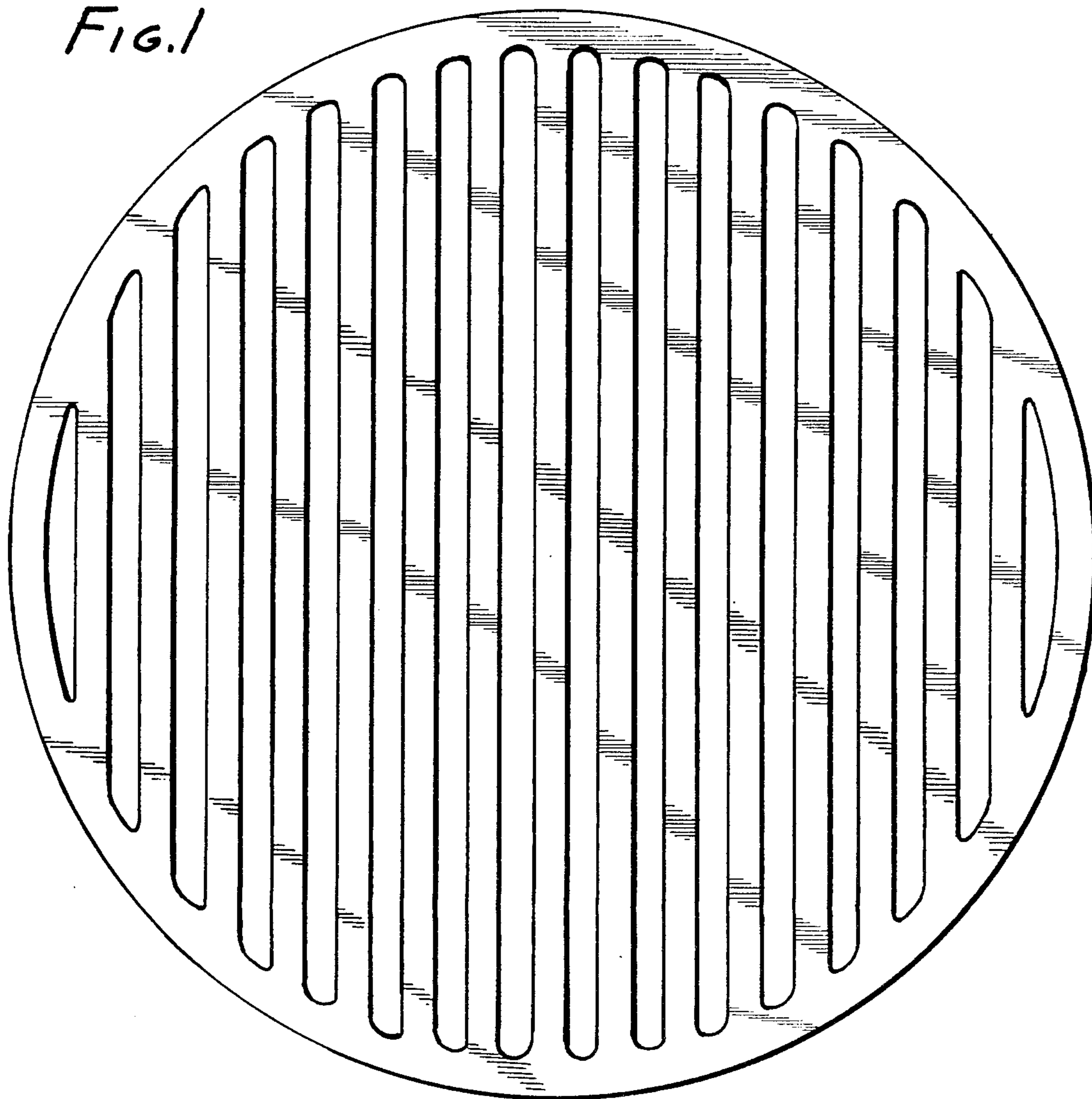

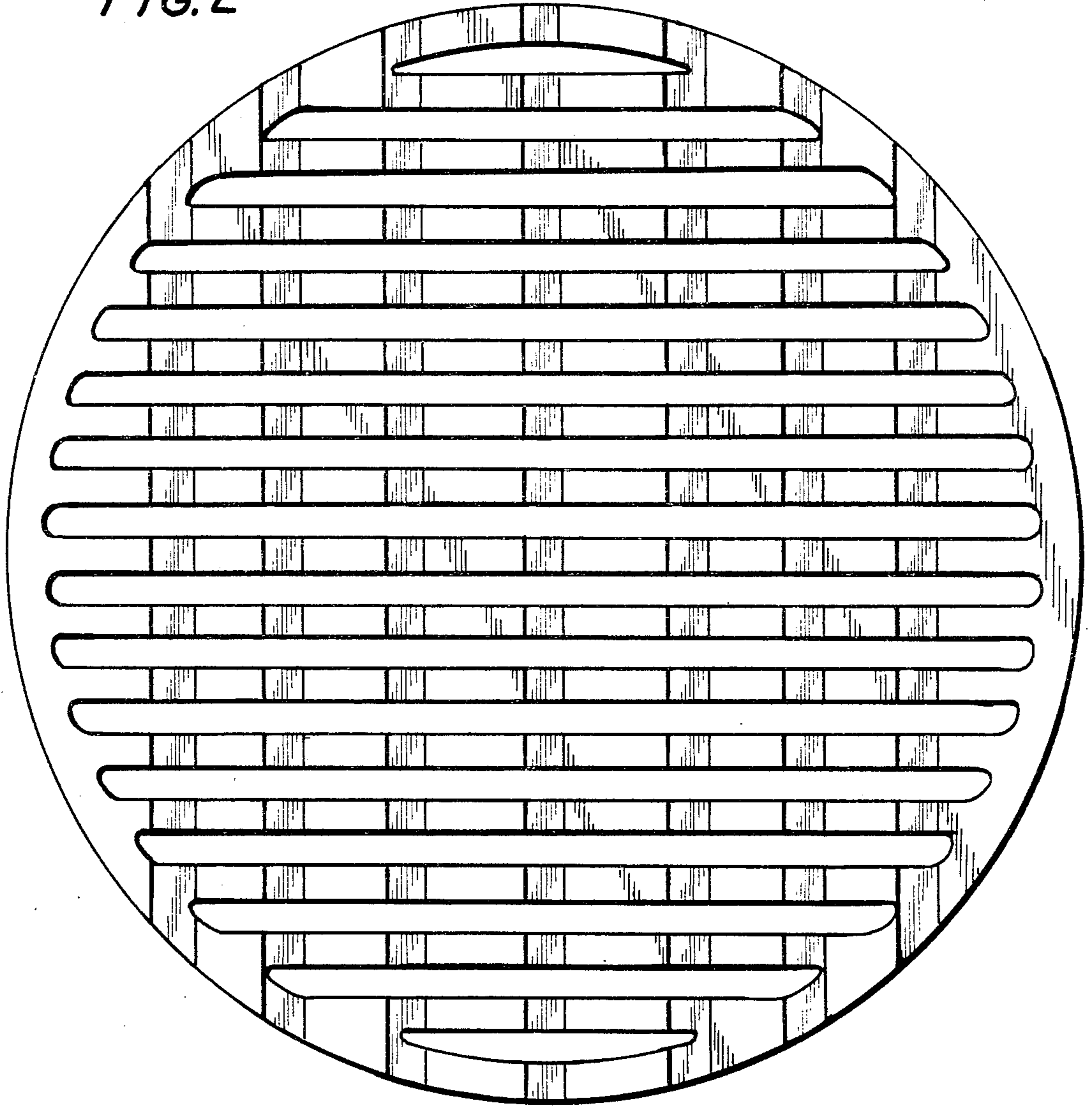
