The ornamental design for a combined motorcycle fairing bug deflector and mounting bracket, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a combined motorcycle fairing bug deflector and mounting bracket embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; the left side elevational view being a mirror image of FIG. 2;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.
