The ornamental design for a body washing implement with brush and sponge heads, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left-side elevational view of a body washing implement with brush and sponge heads showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a right-side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a left-side elevational view of a modification of the body washing implement with brush and sponge heads shown in FIG. 1; and
 FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of FIG. 7.

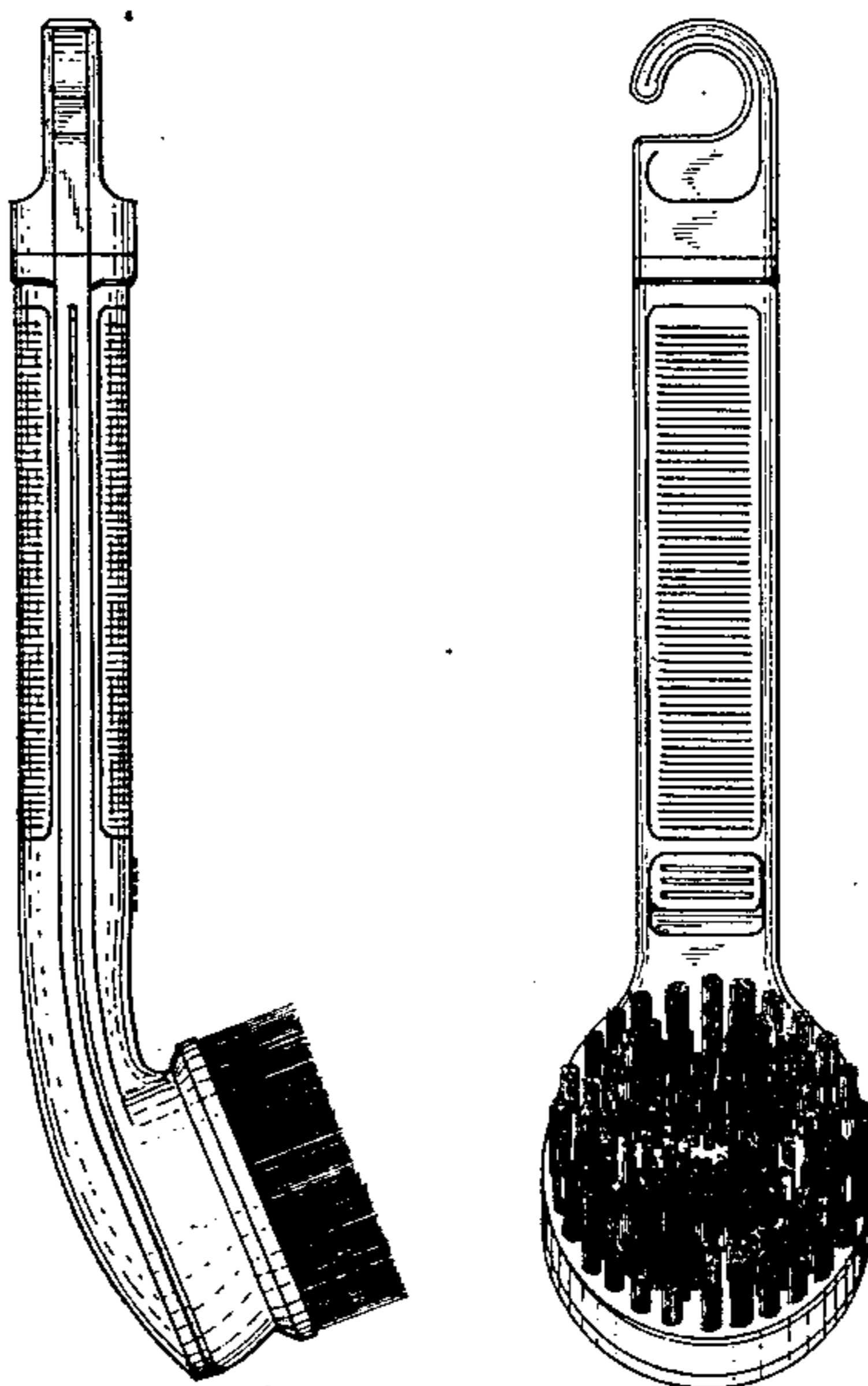

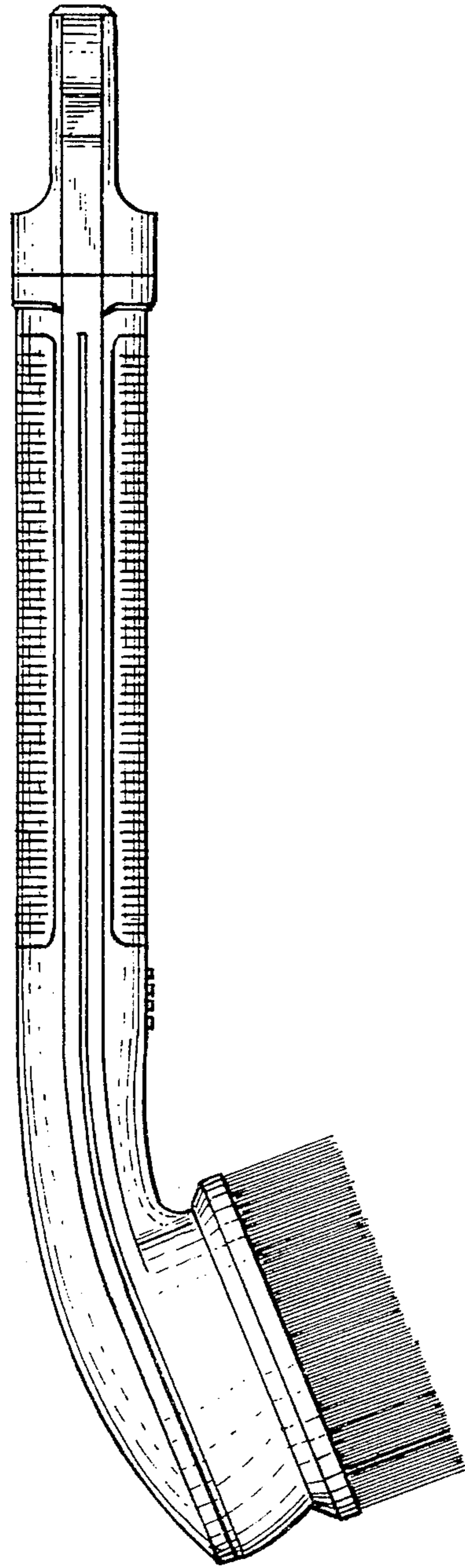

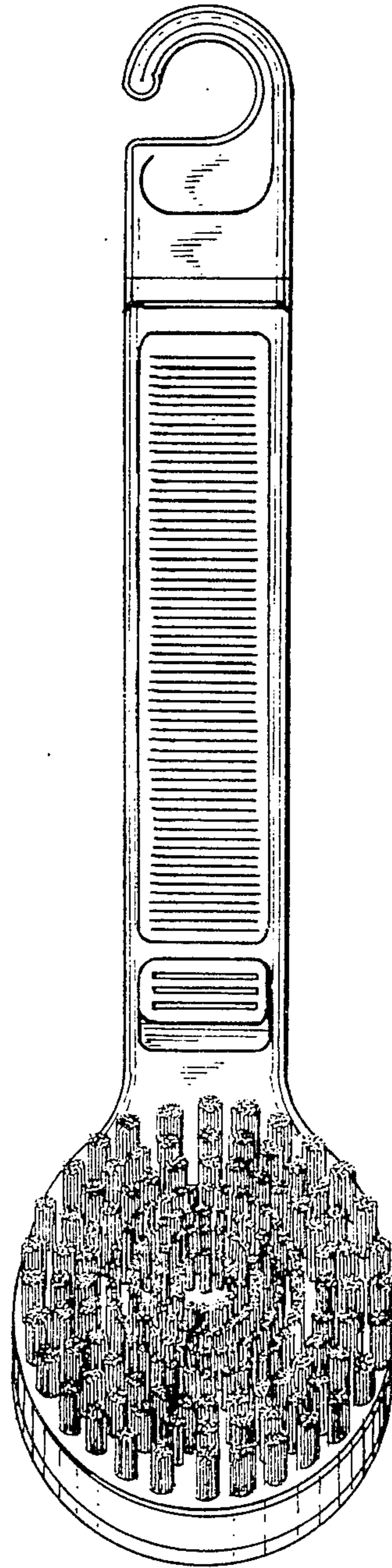

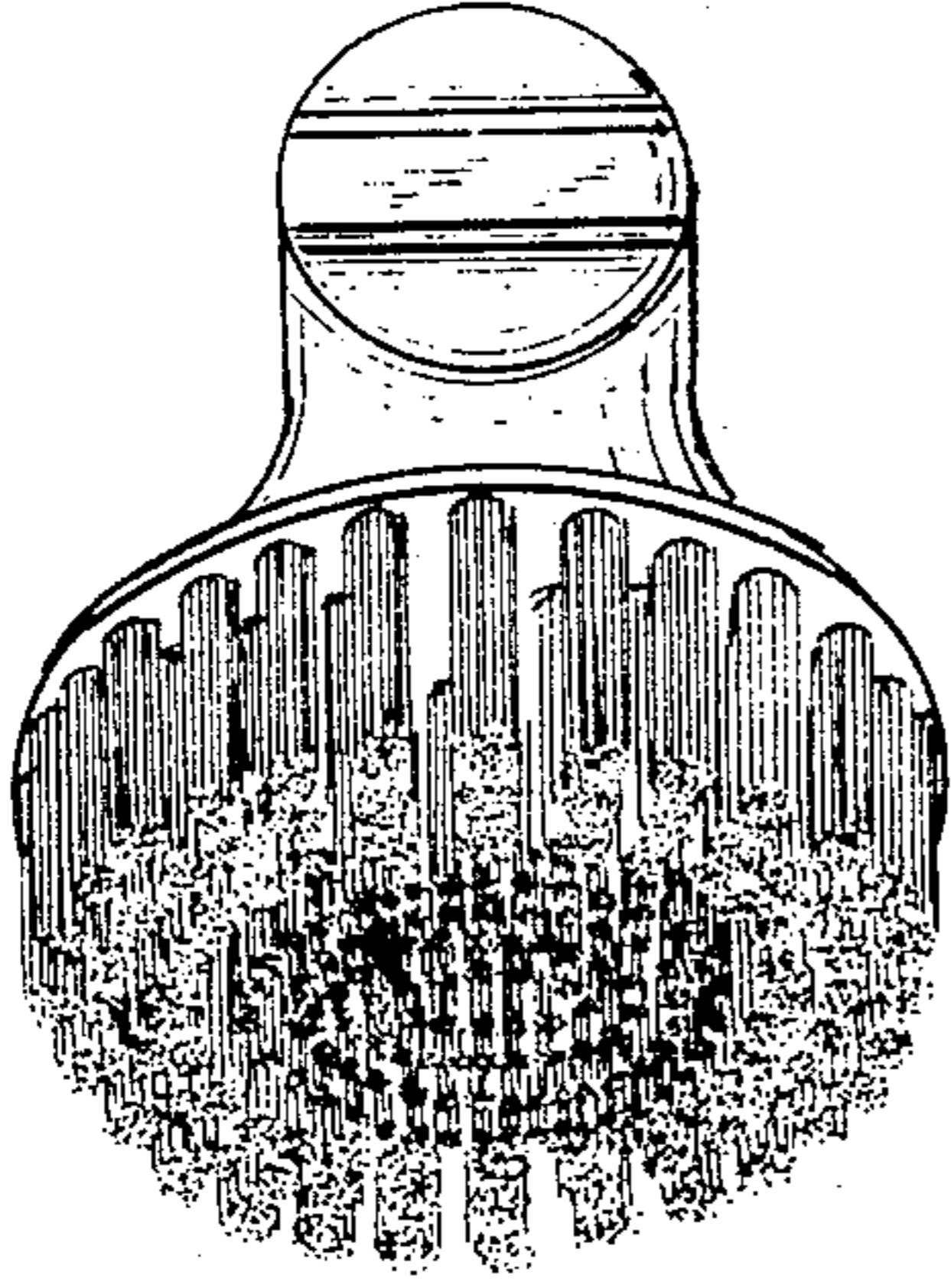

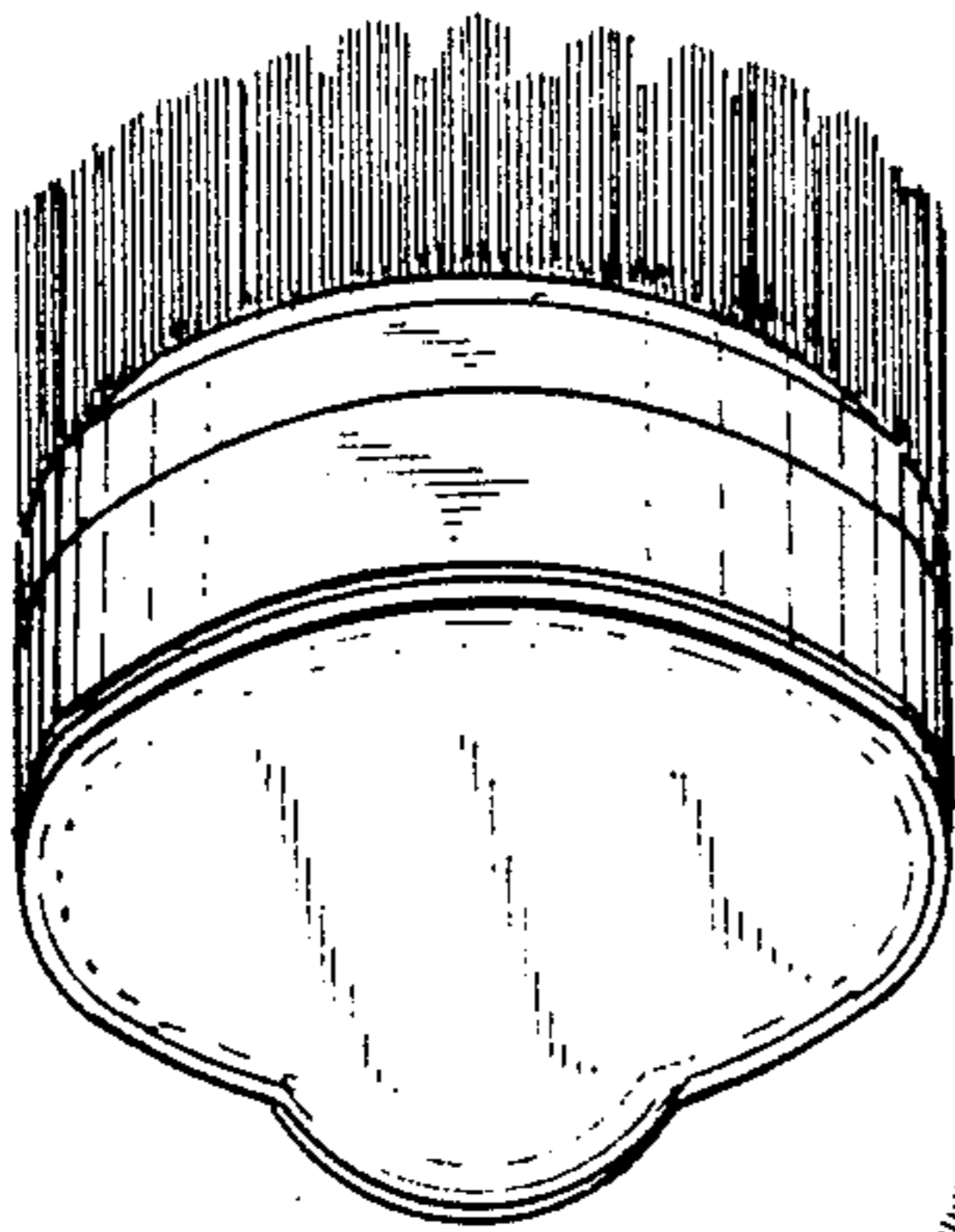

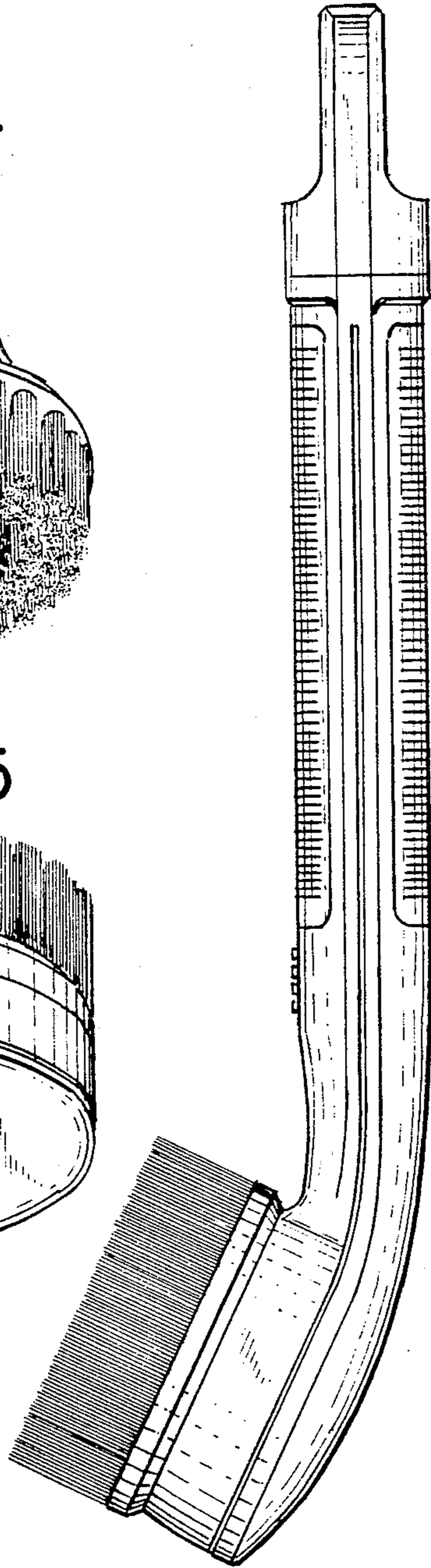

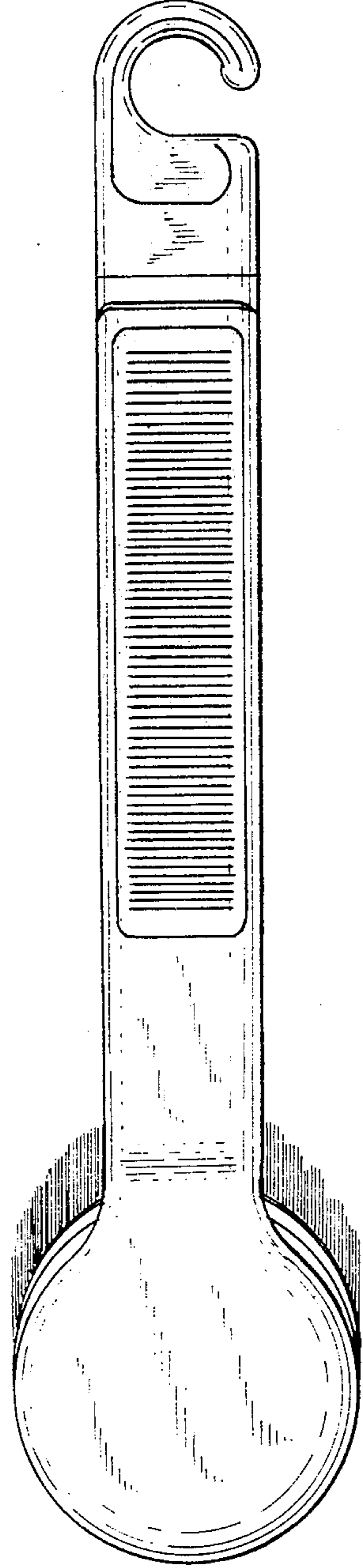

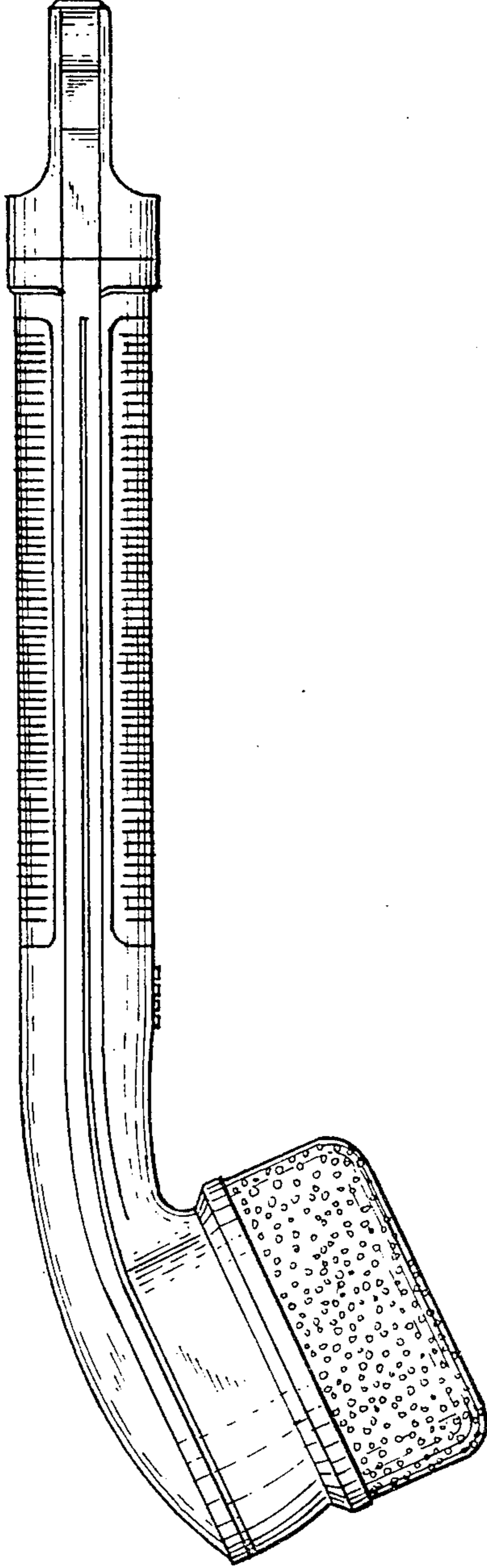
