[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an umbrella boot holder, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of the umbrella boot holder showing my new design in a closed position; FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof shown in an open position; FIG. 3 is a perspective view thereof with shoes in the pockets shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only; FIG. 4 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the design shown in FIG. 1; and FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the design of FIG. 1.

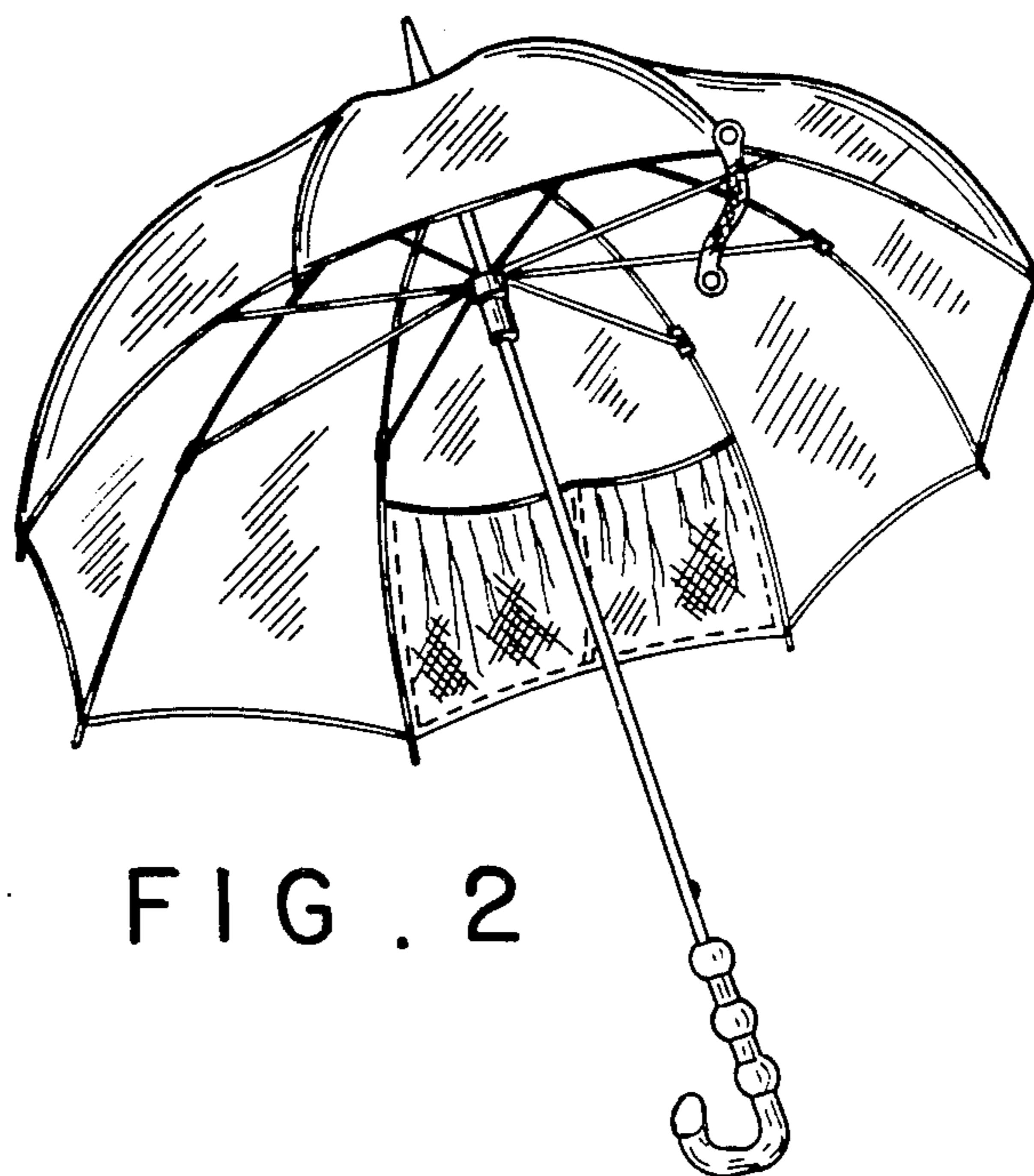
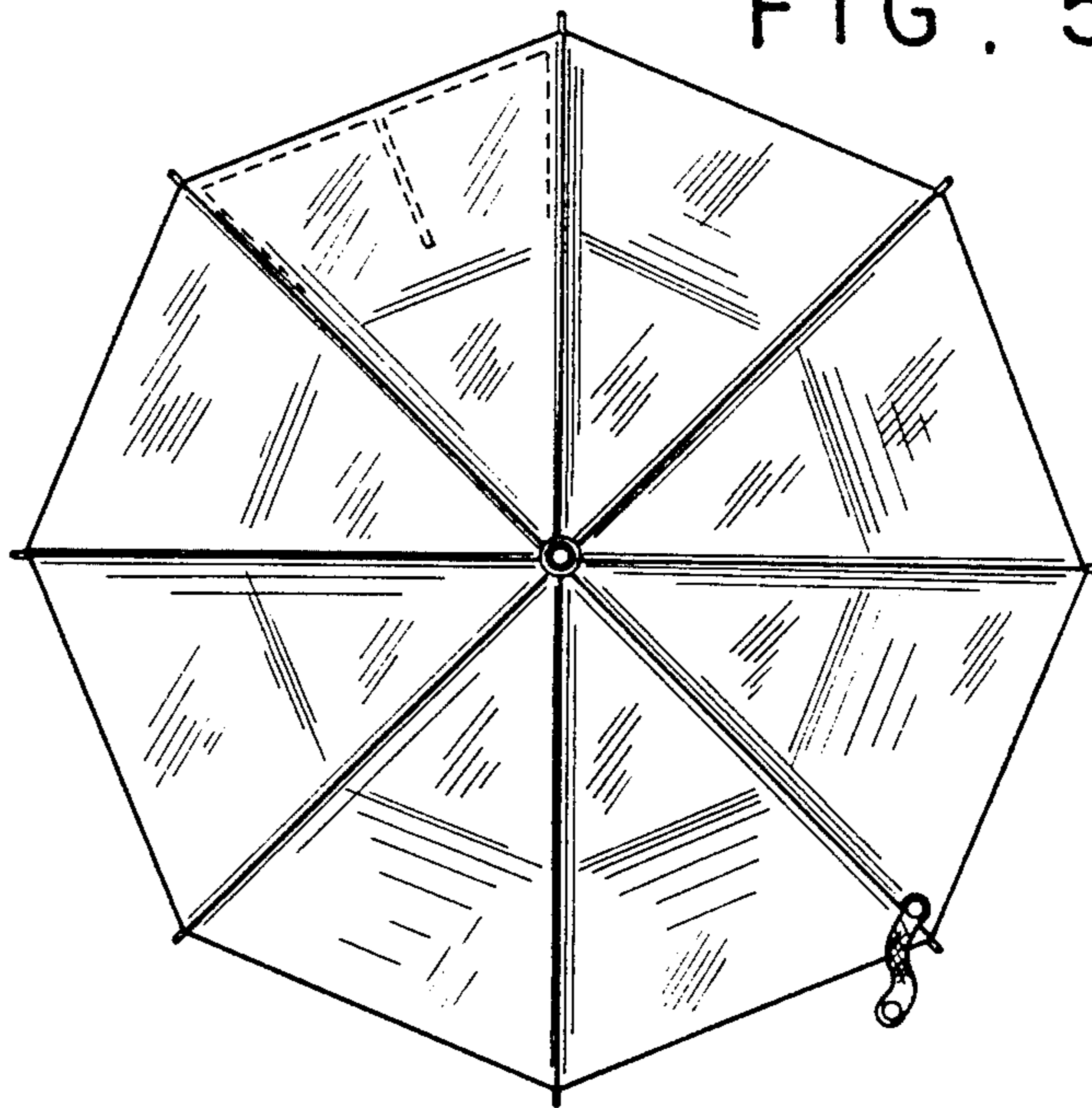
