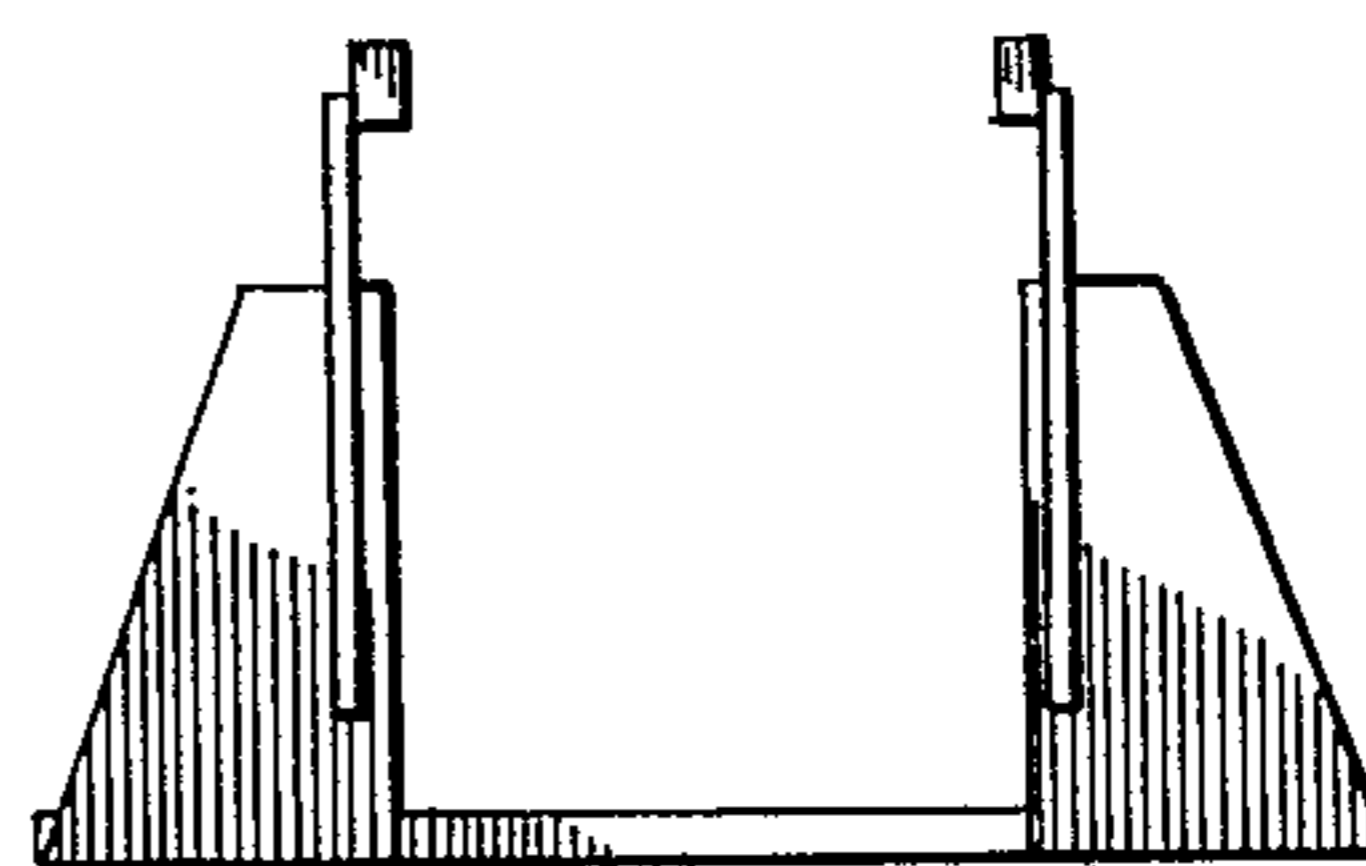
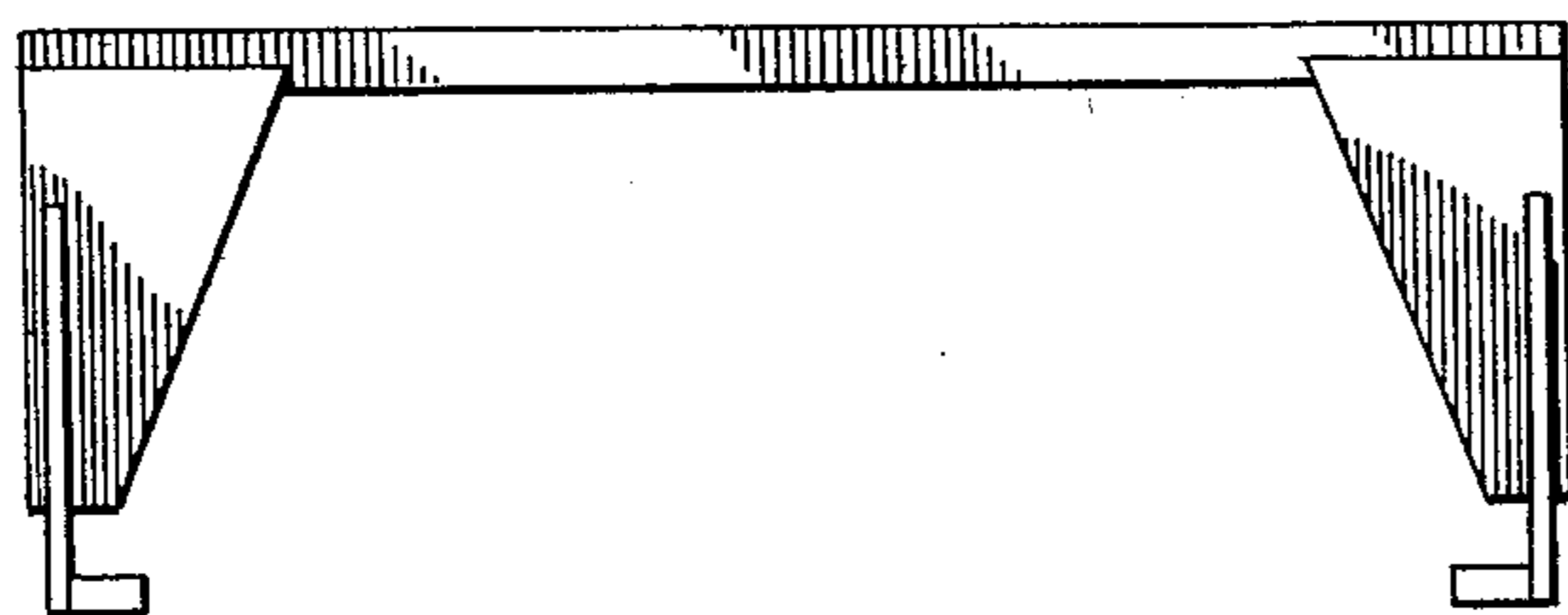

The ornamental design for a training walker for an infant, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a training walker for an infant showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a front perspective view thereof showing elements of the device separated from one another.



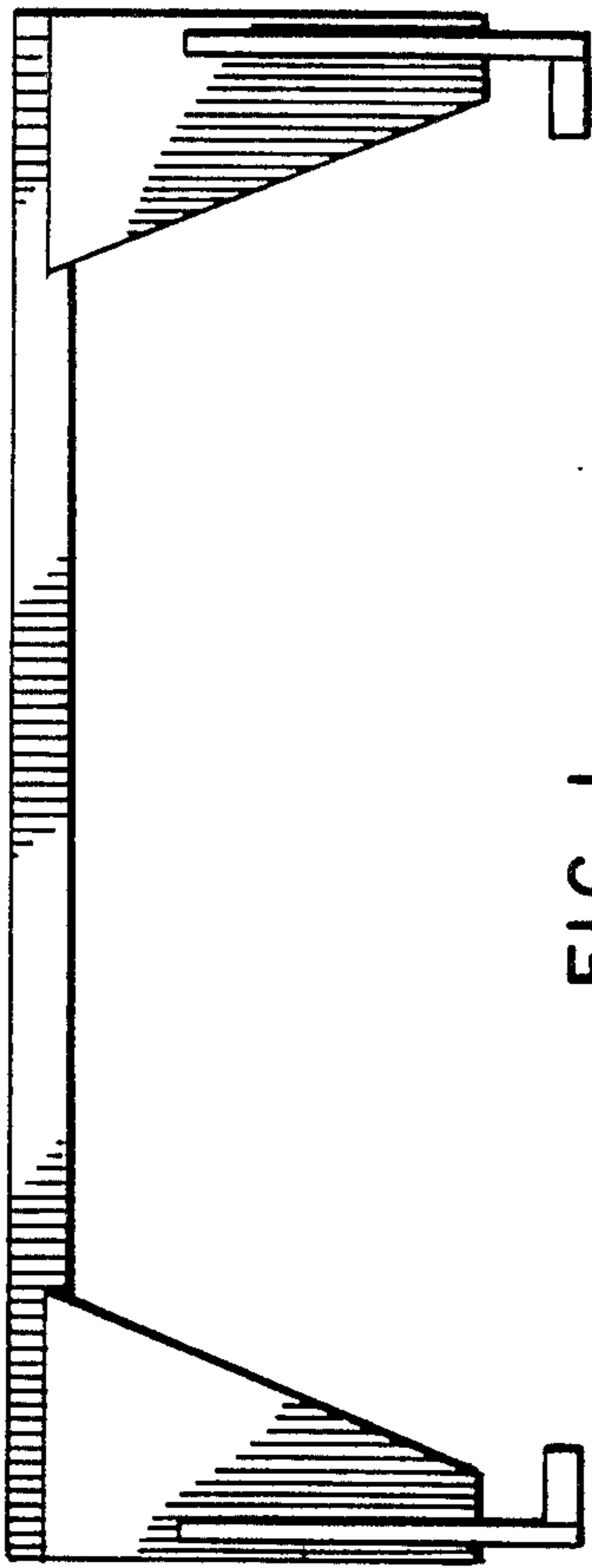

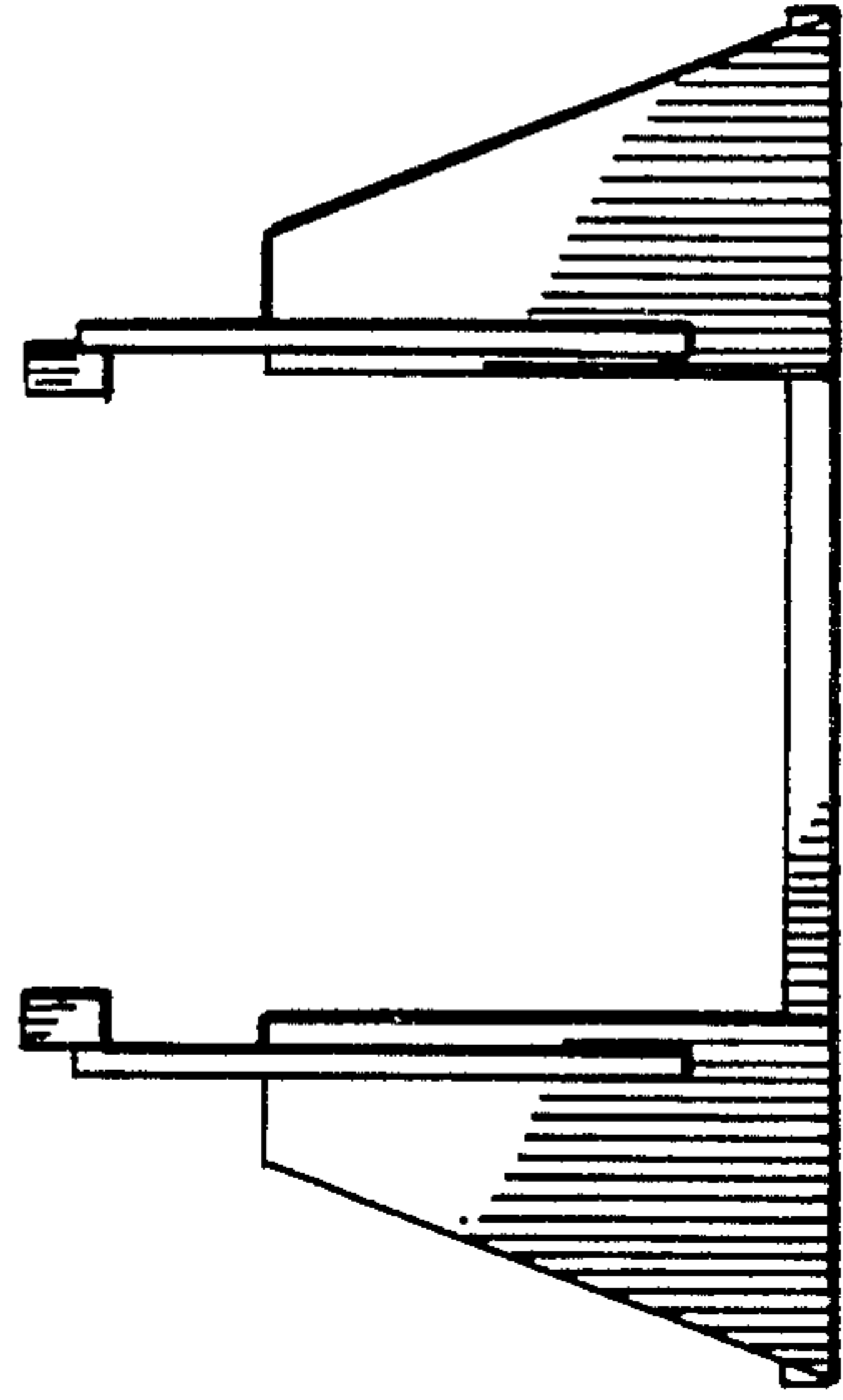

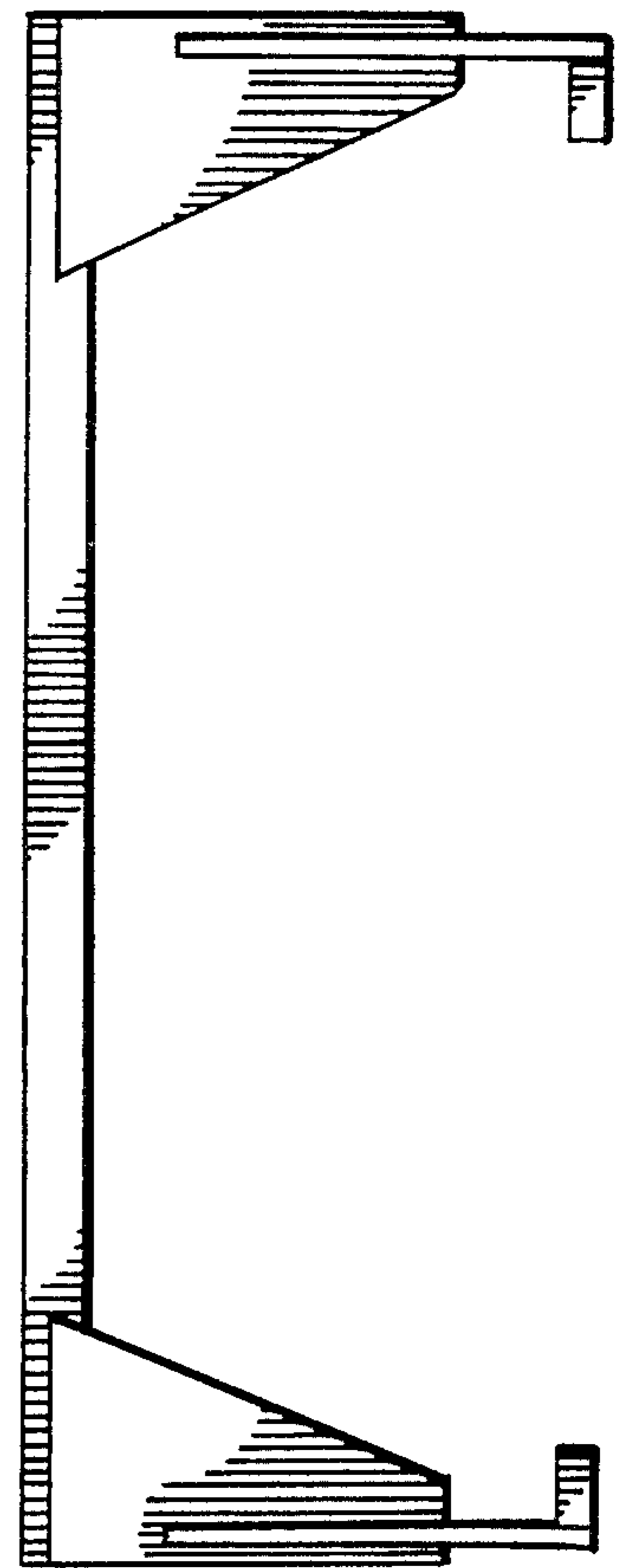

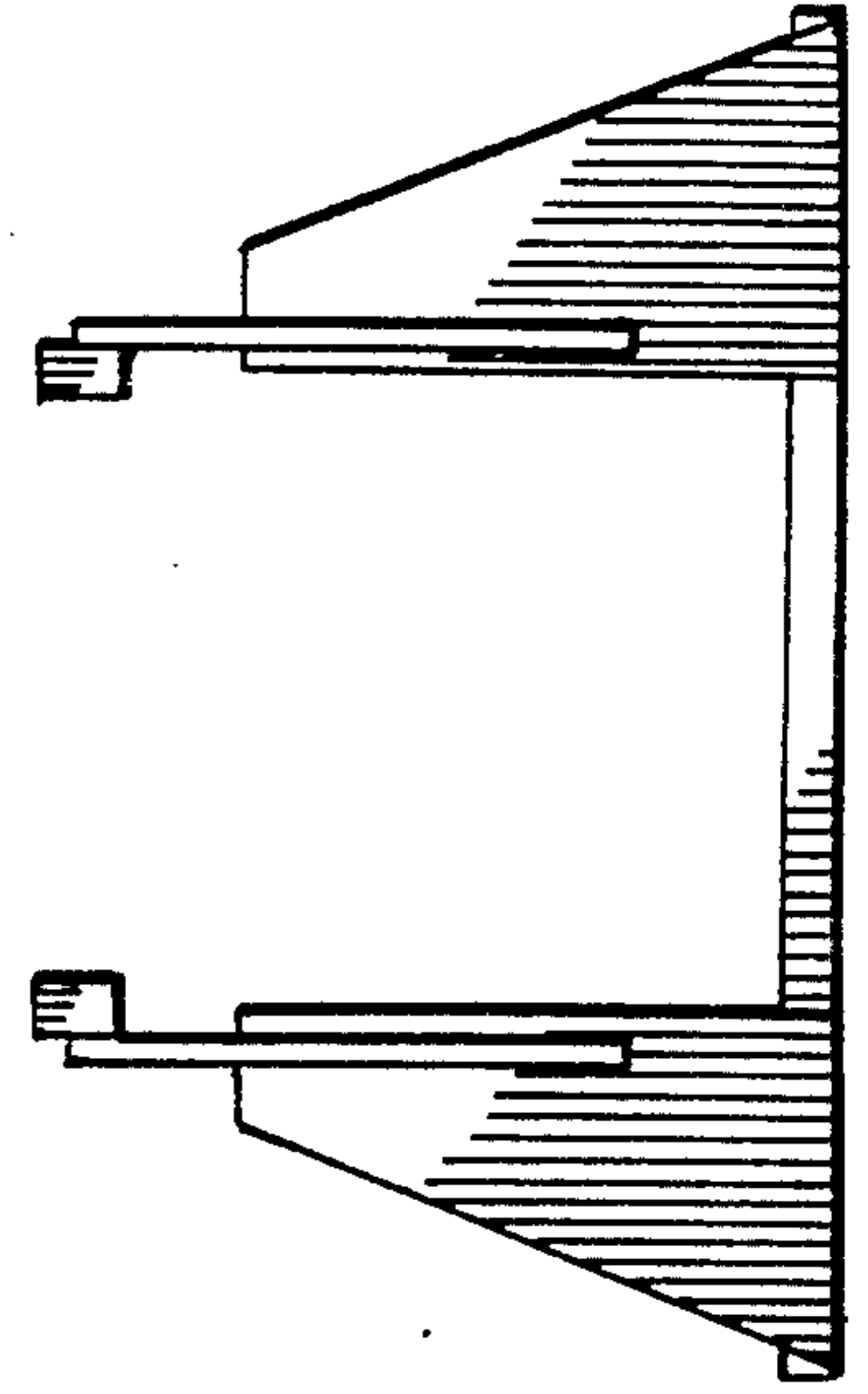

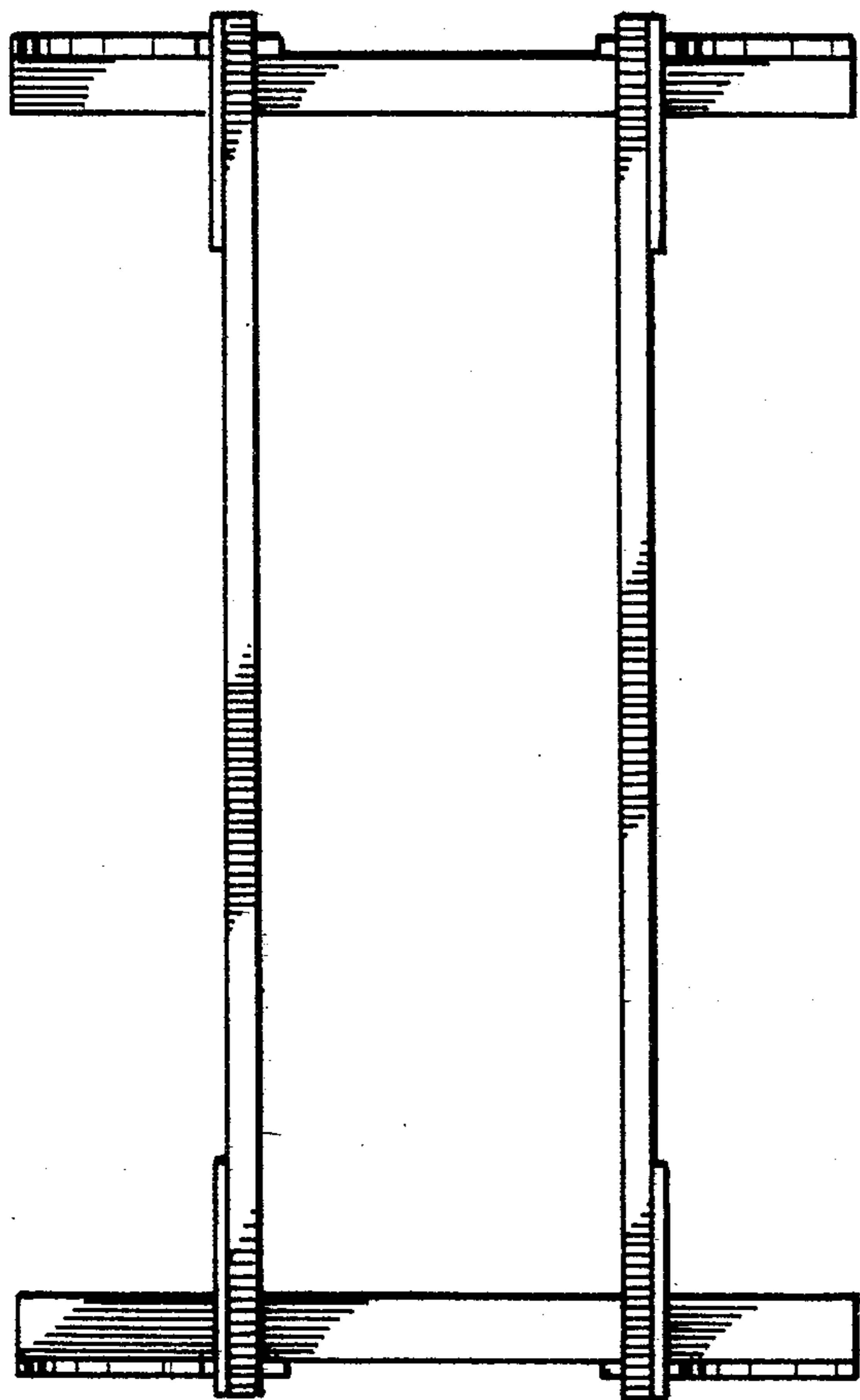
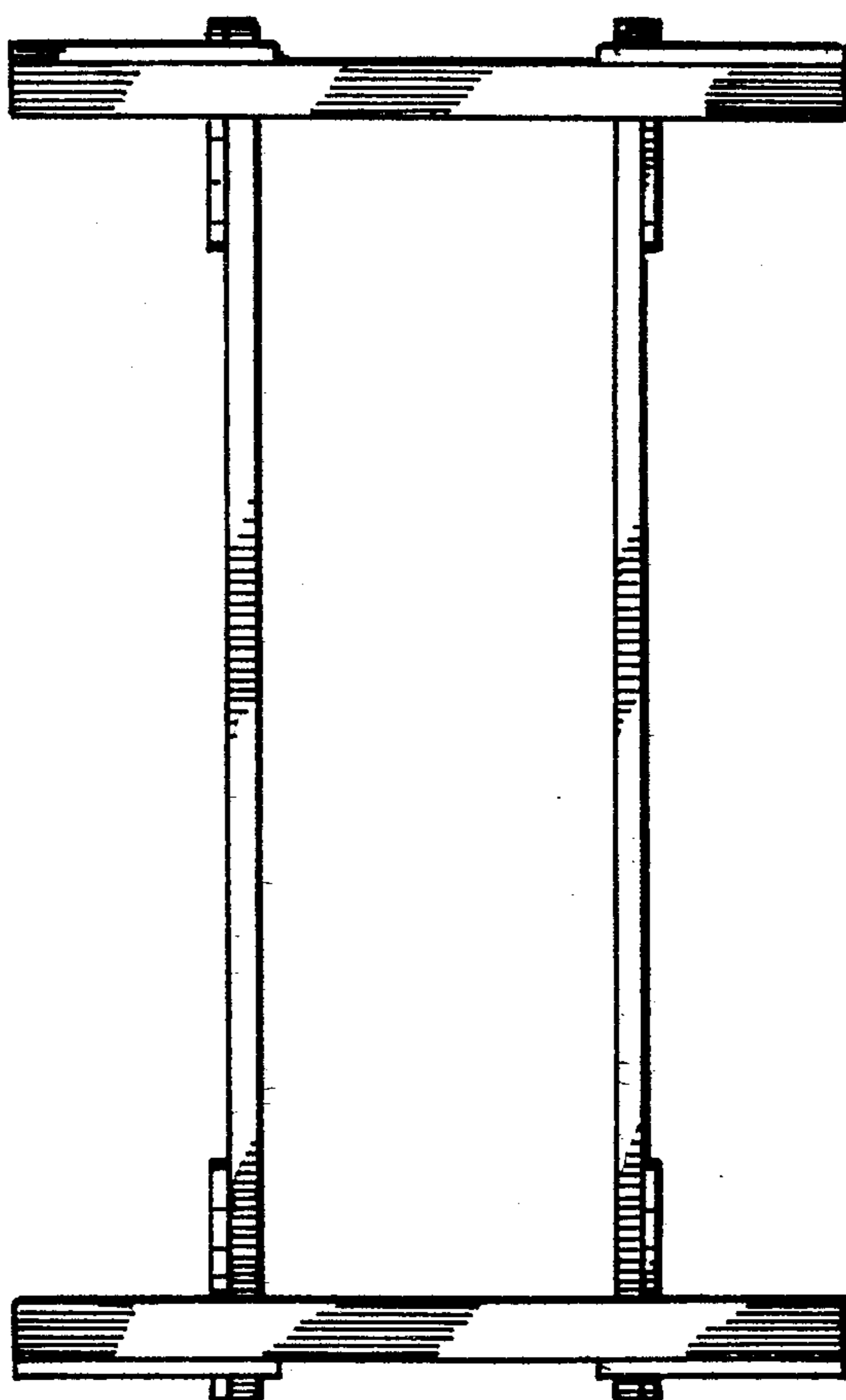

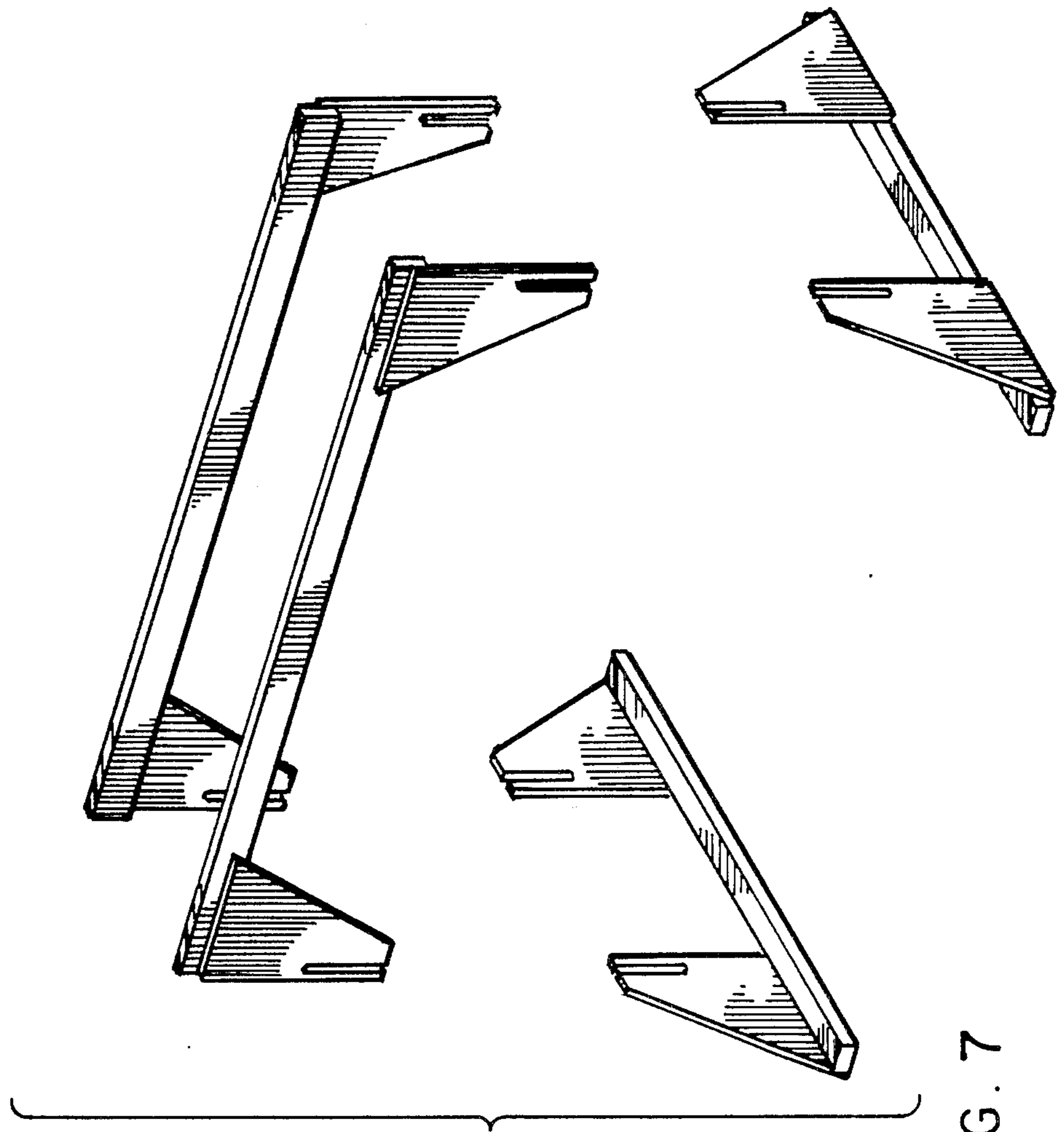
