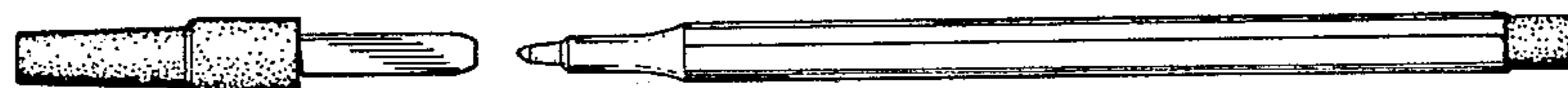
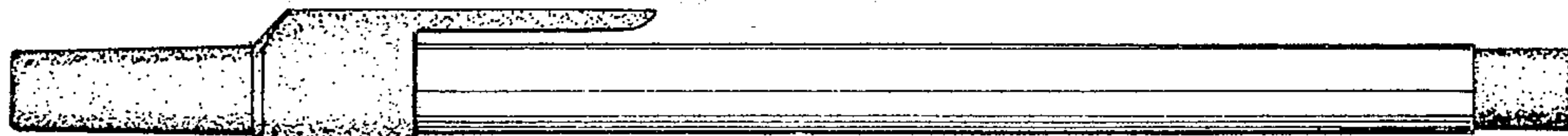

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined writing instrument and cap, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined writing instrument and cap showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a left-side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
 FIG. 7 is an exploded rear elevational view with the cap removed from the writing instrument.



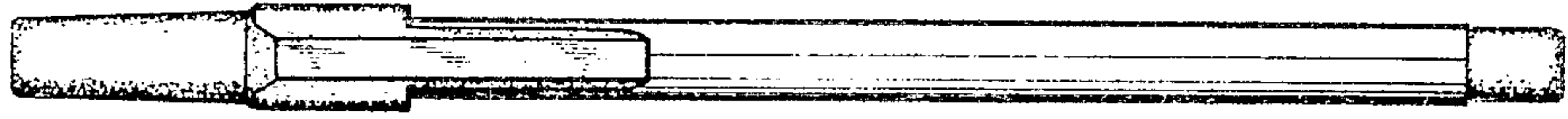

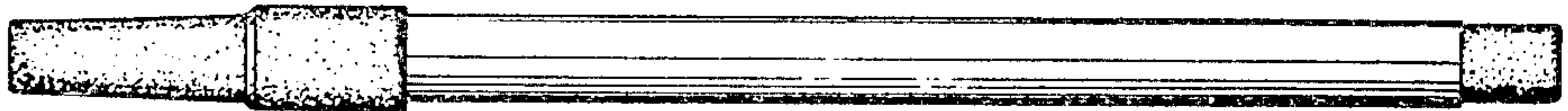

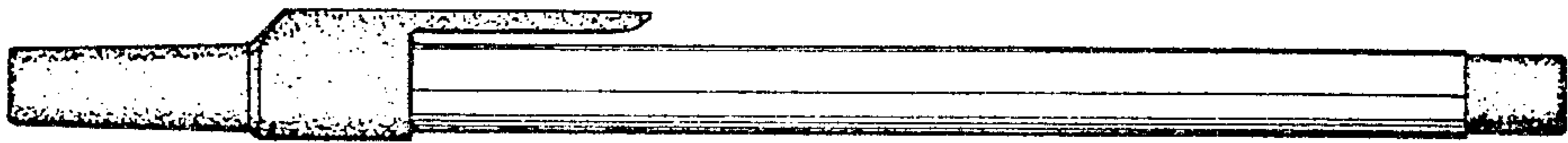

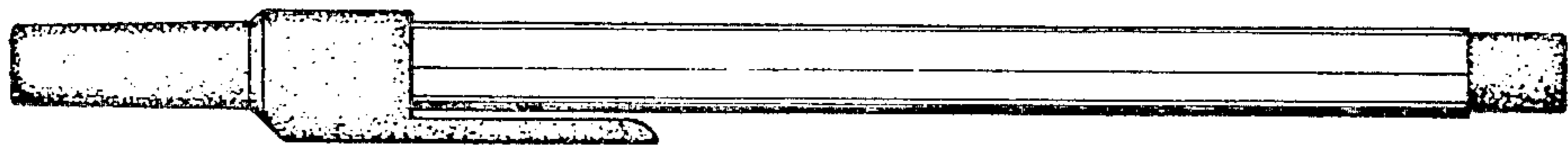
