FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

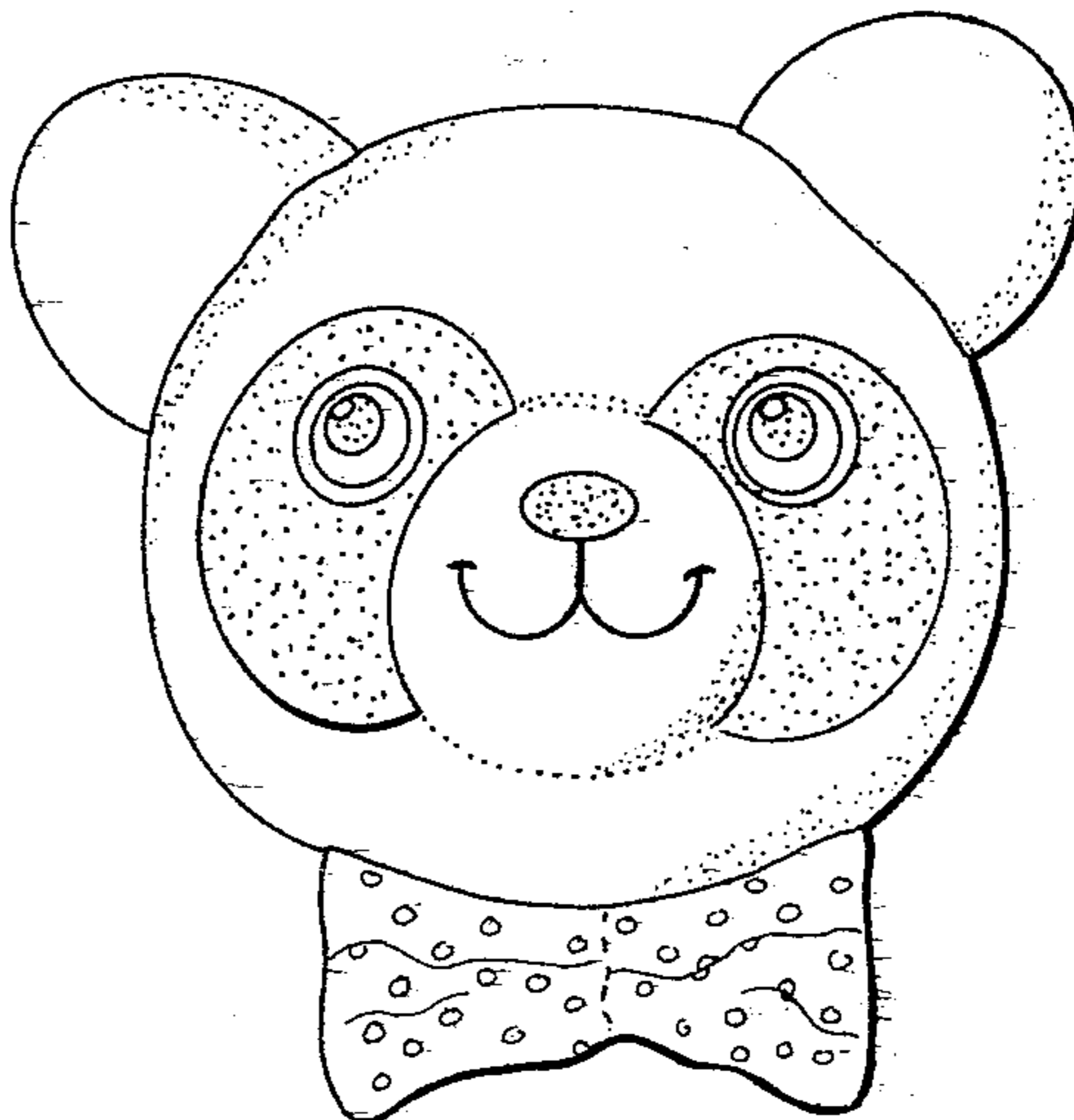
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

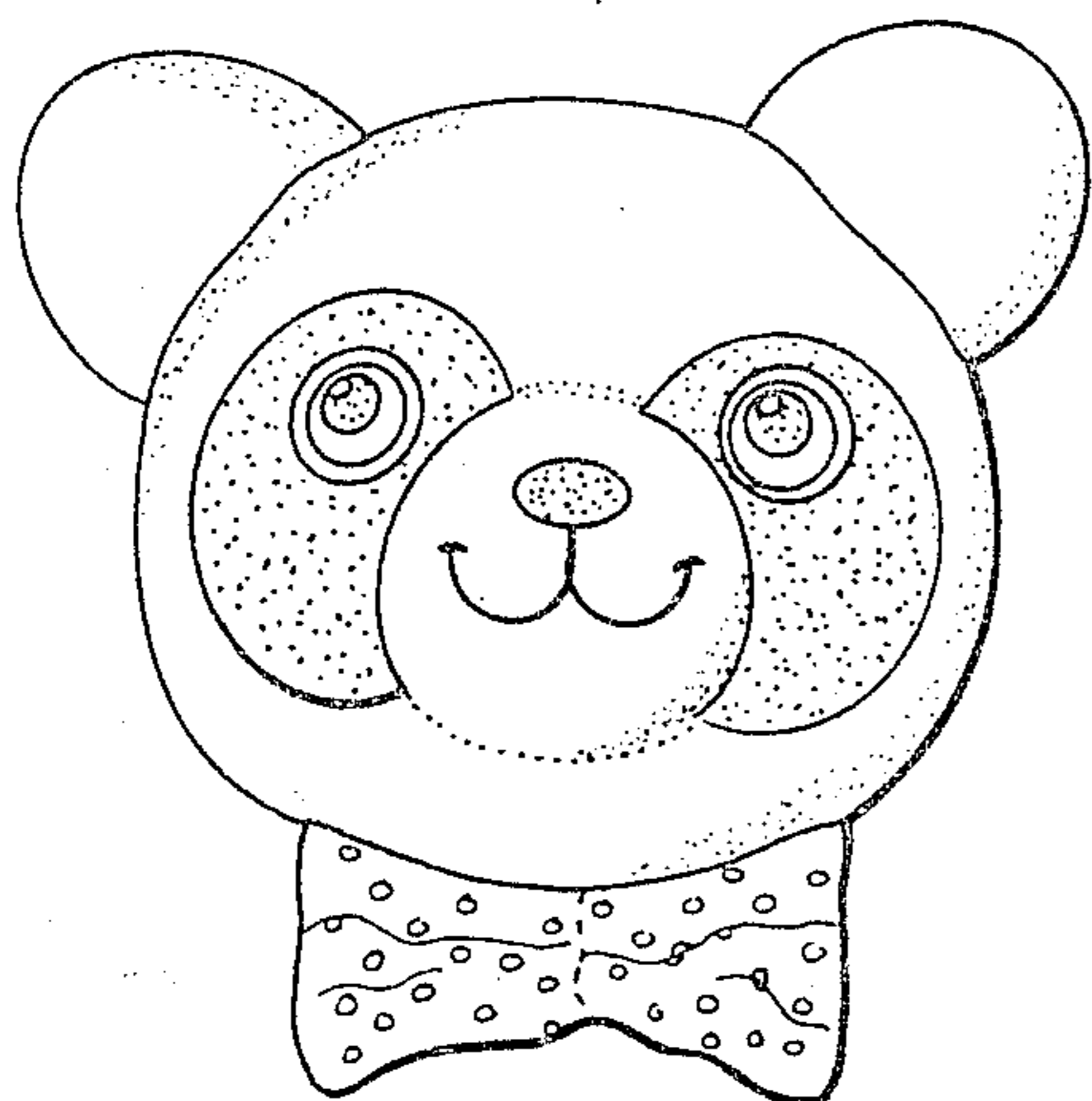

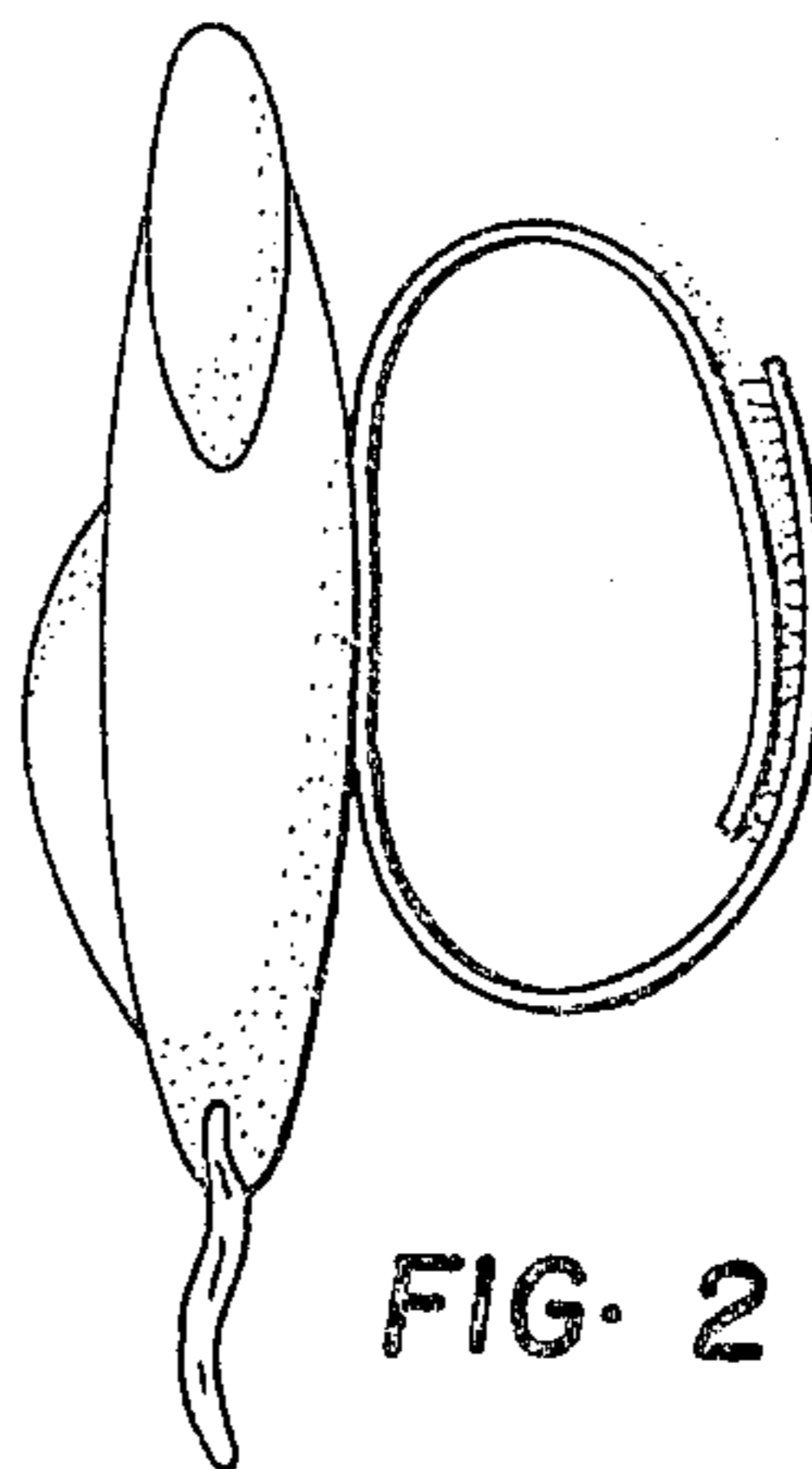

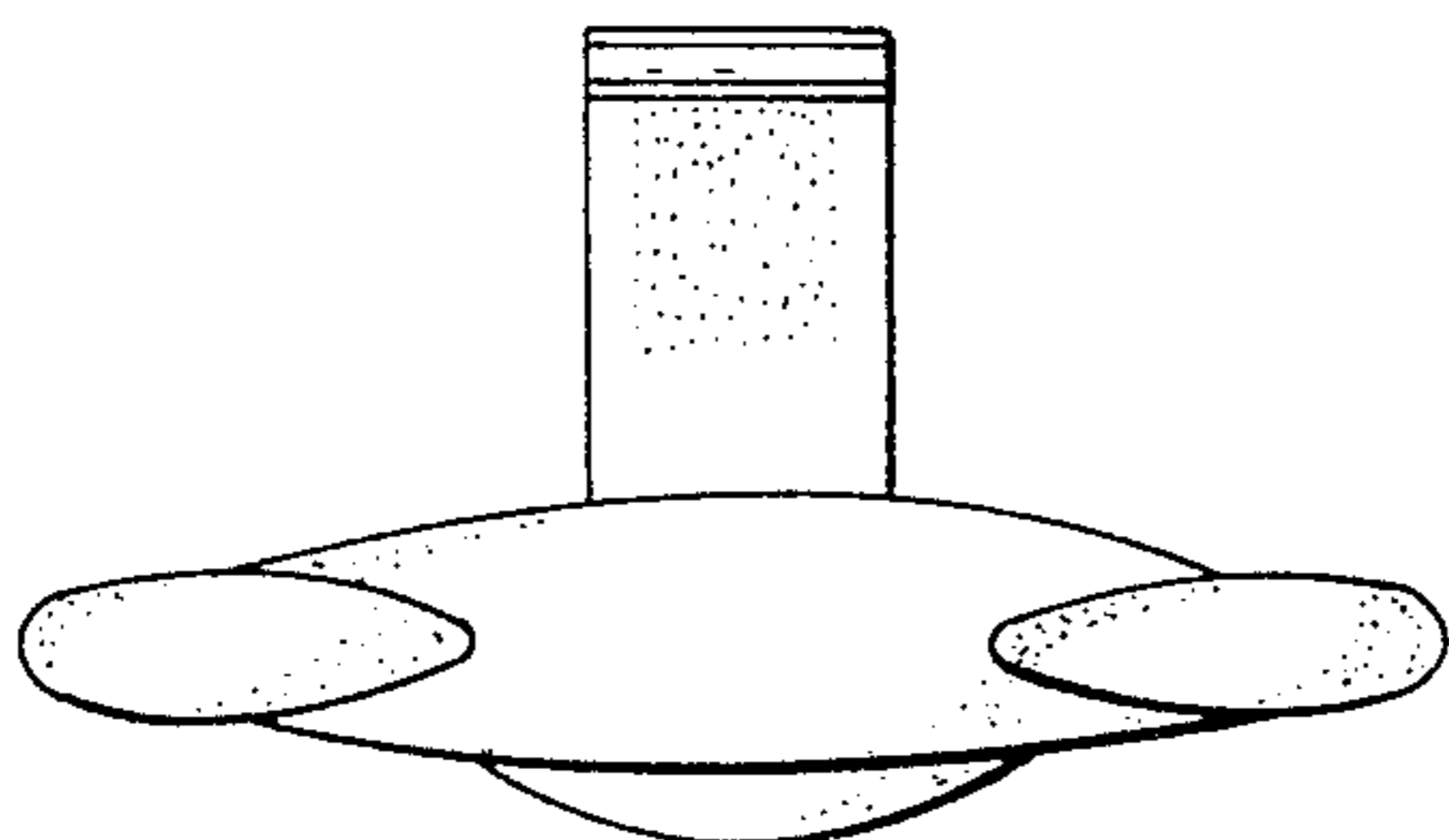

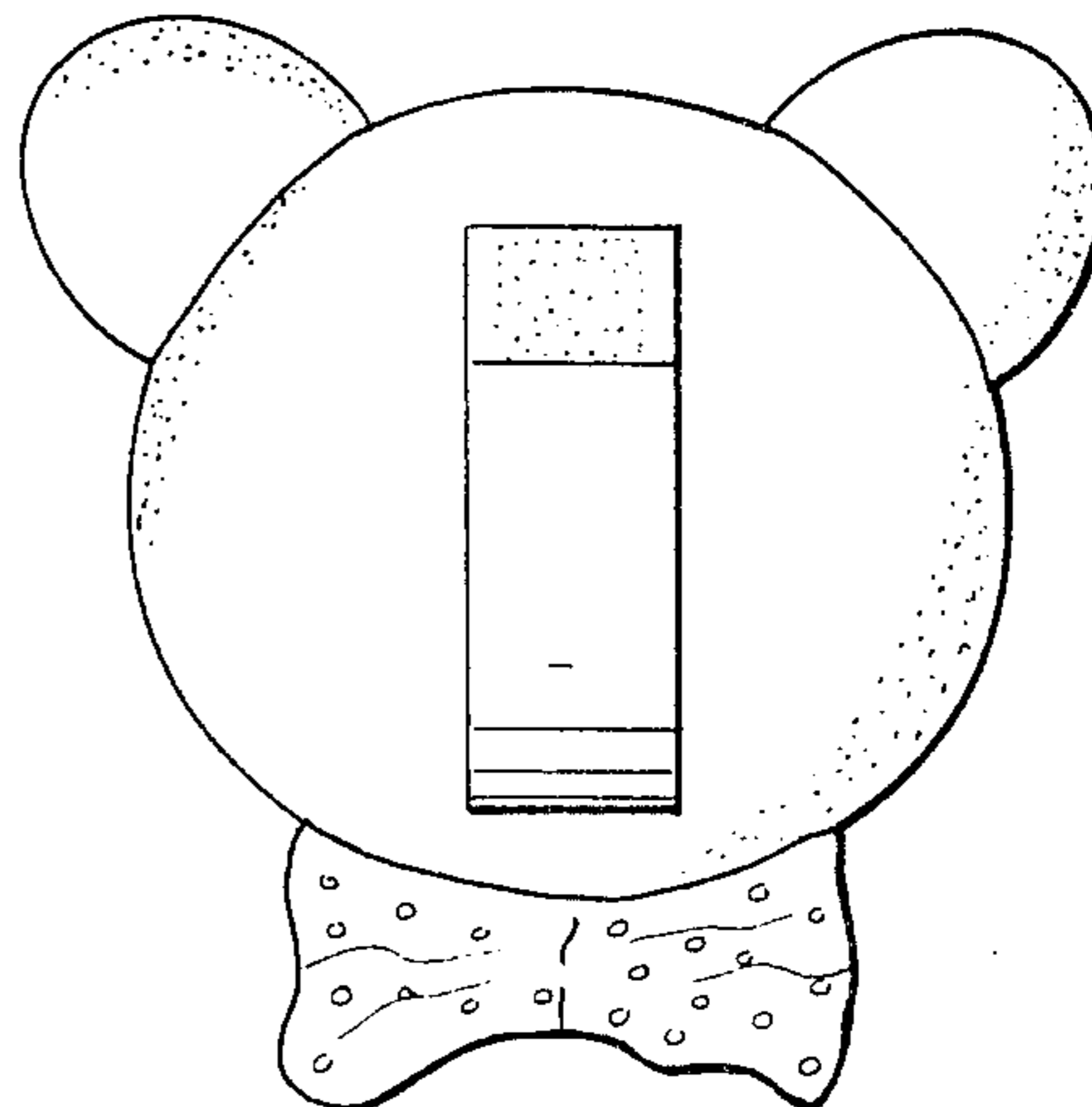

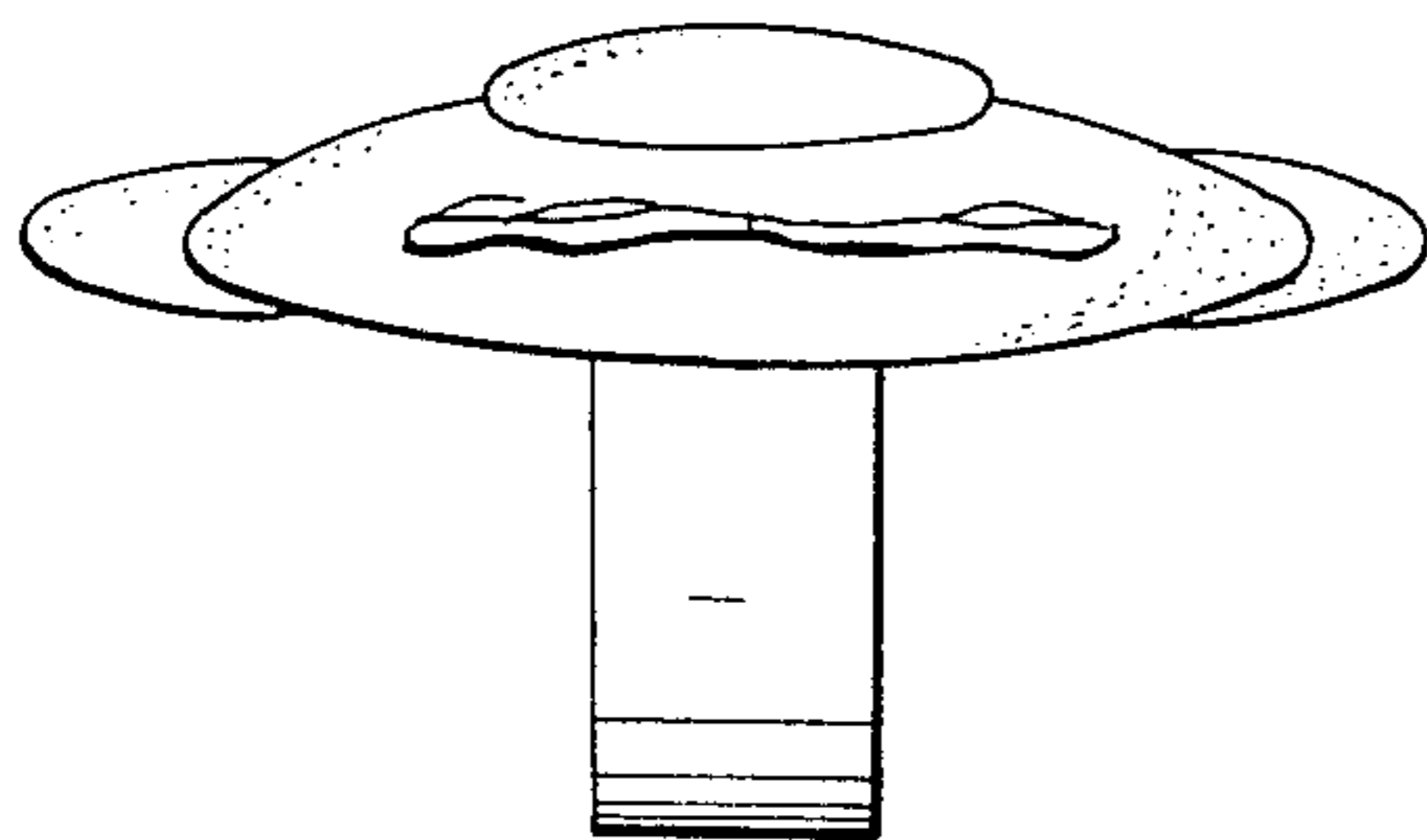
