[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined inhalator and facial treatment vapor applicator mask and reservoir, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an exploded perspective view of a combined inhalator and facial treatment vapor applicator mask and reservoir showing my new design; FIG. 2 is an assembled perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof. A left side elevational view would appear as a mirror image of FIG. 7.

The broken line showing of lettering on the mask is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

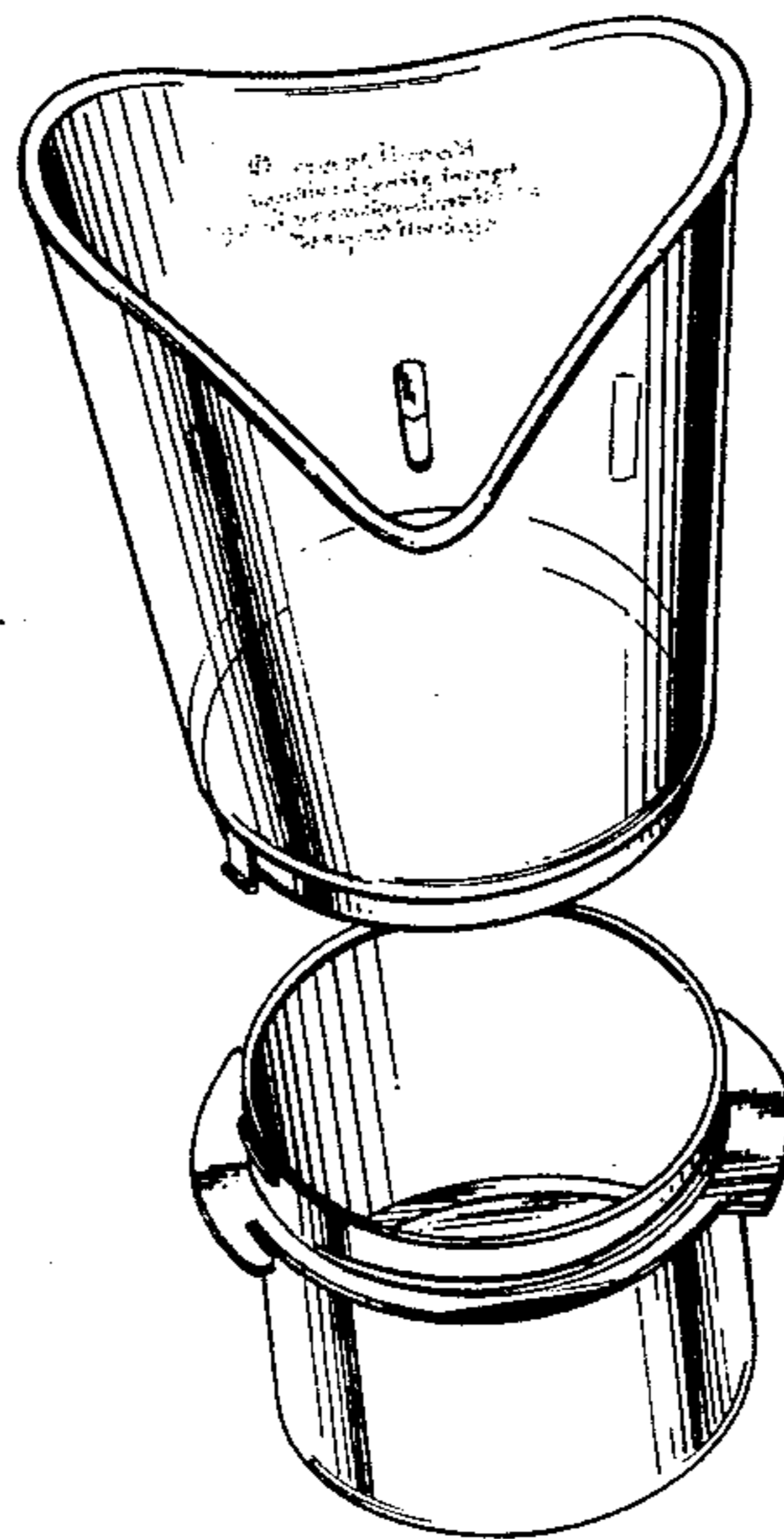

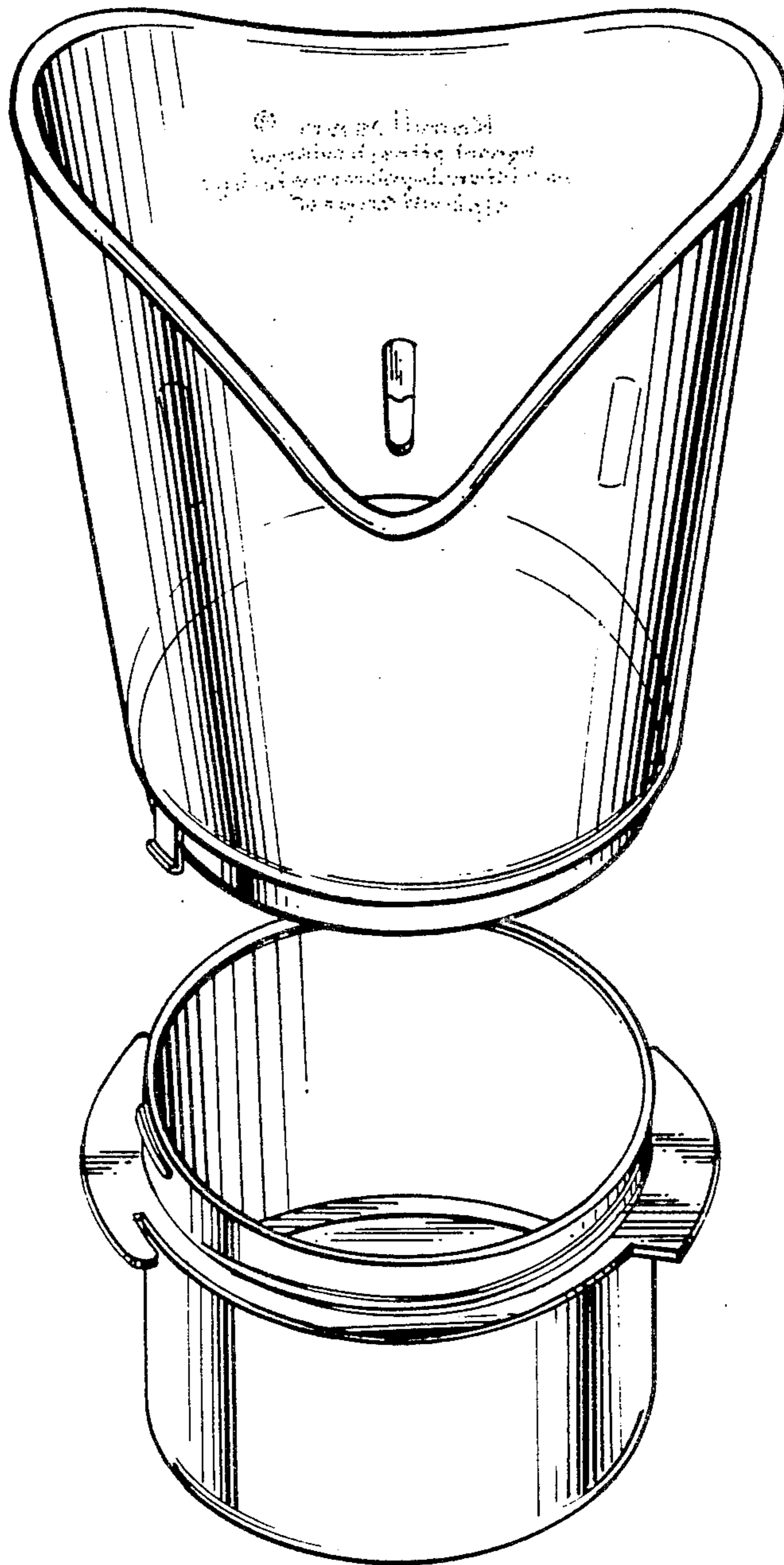

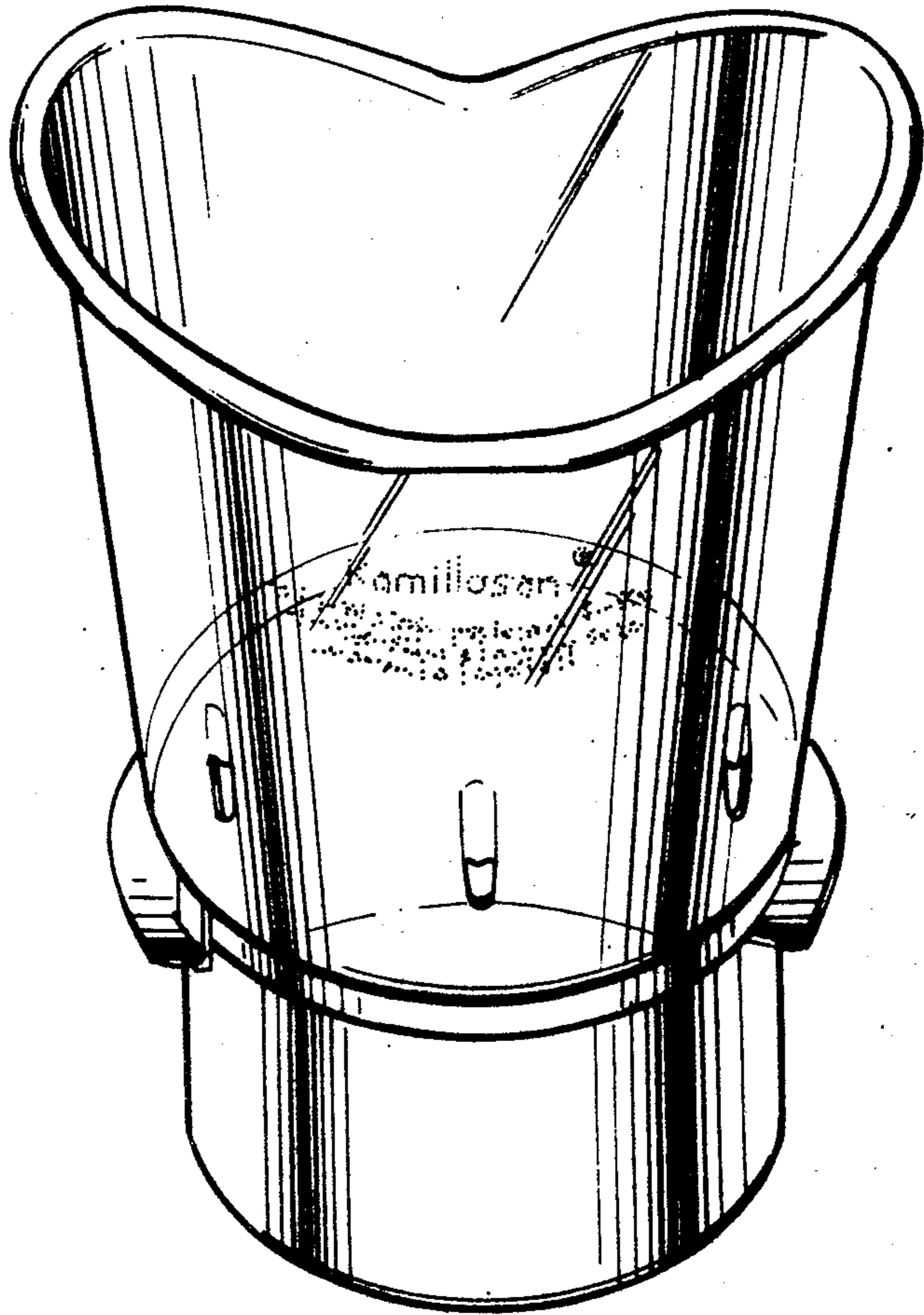

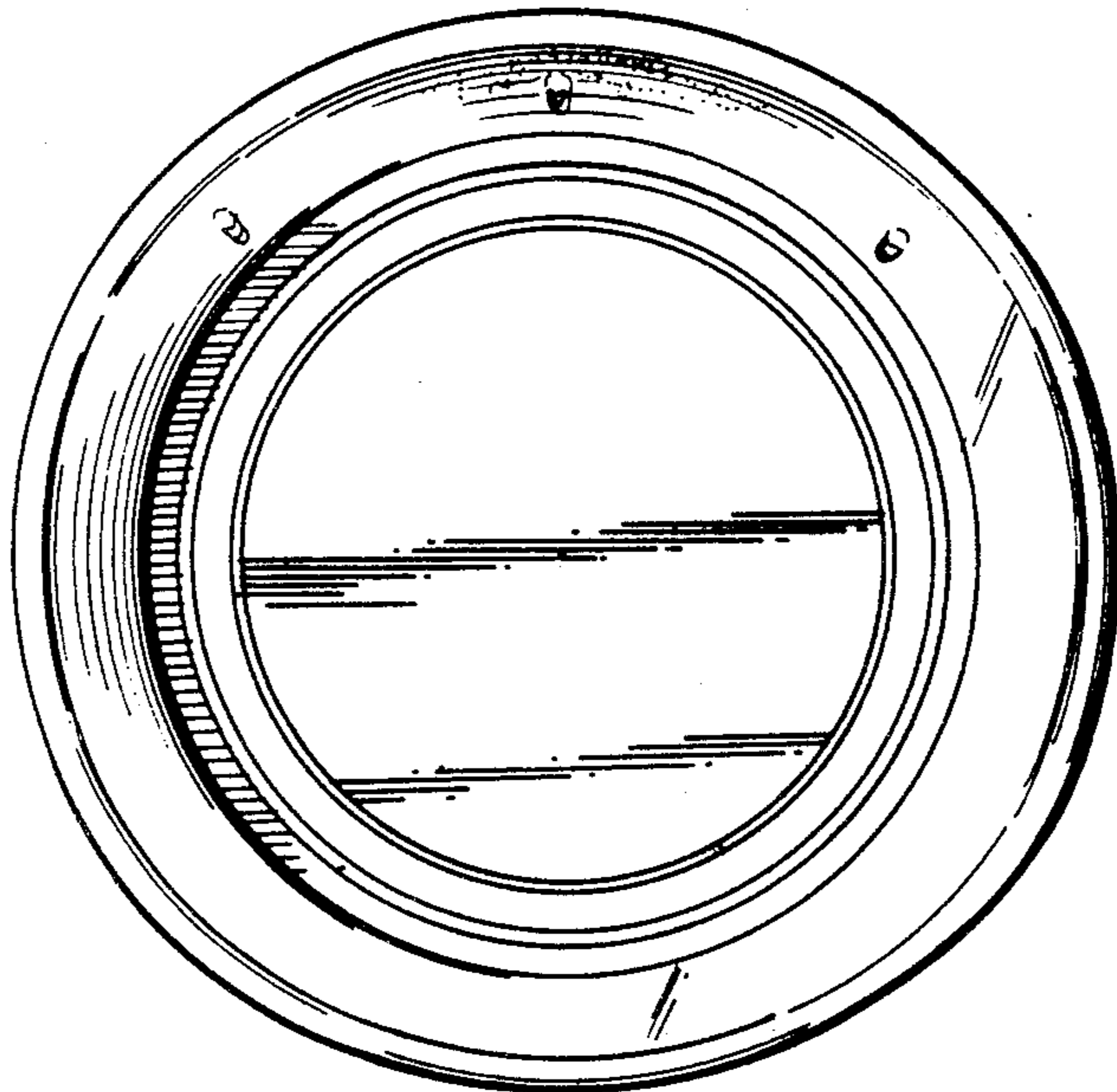

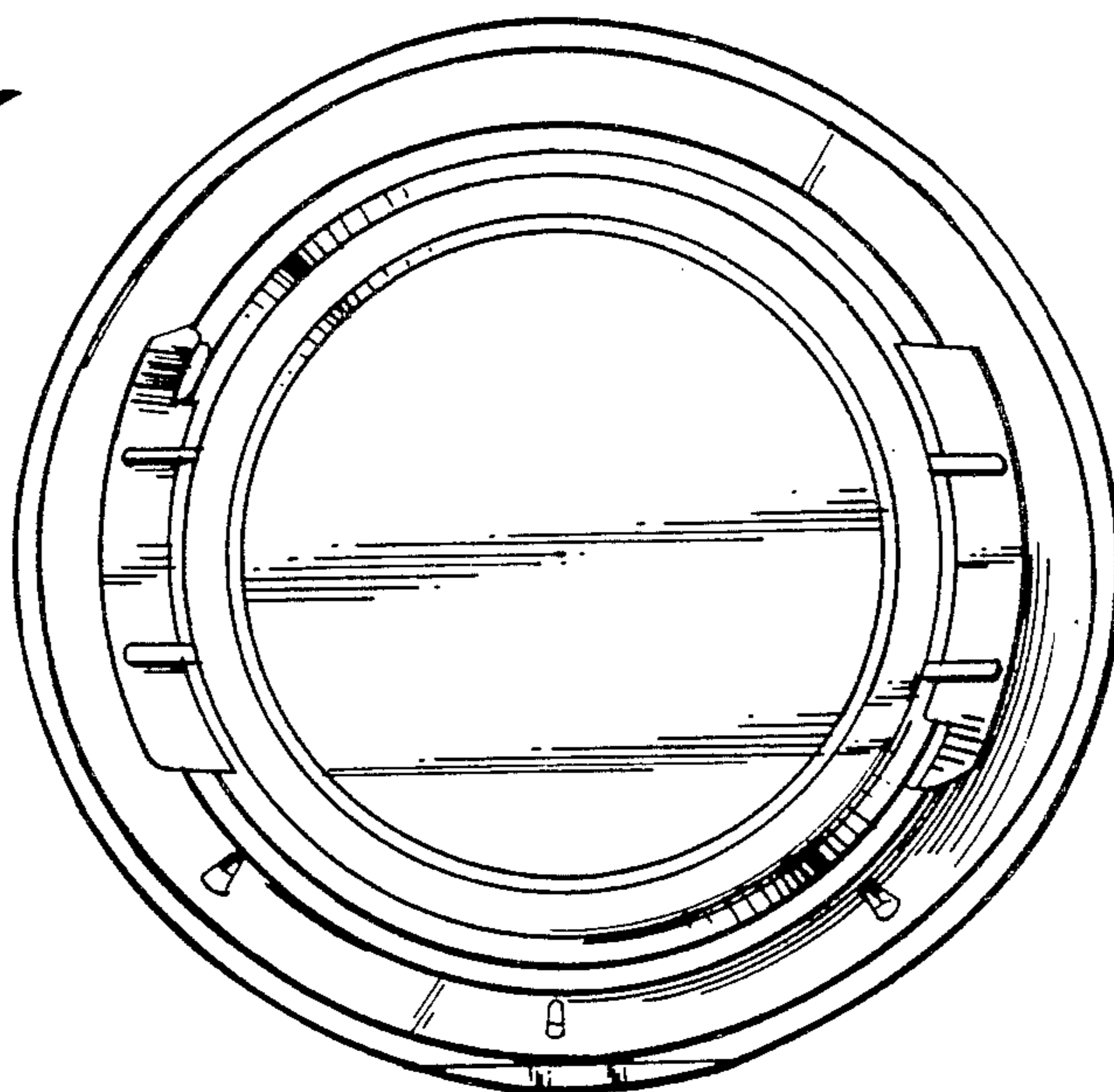

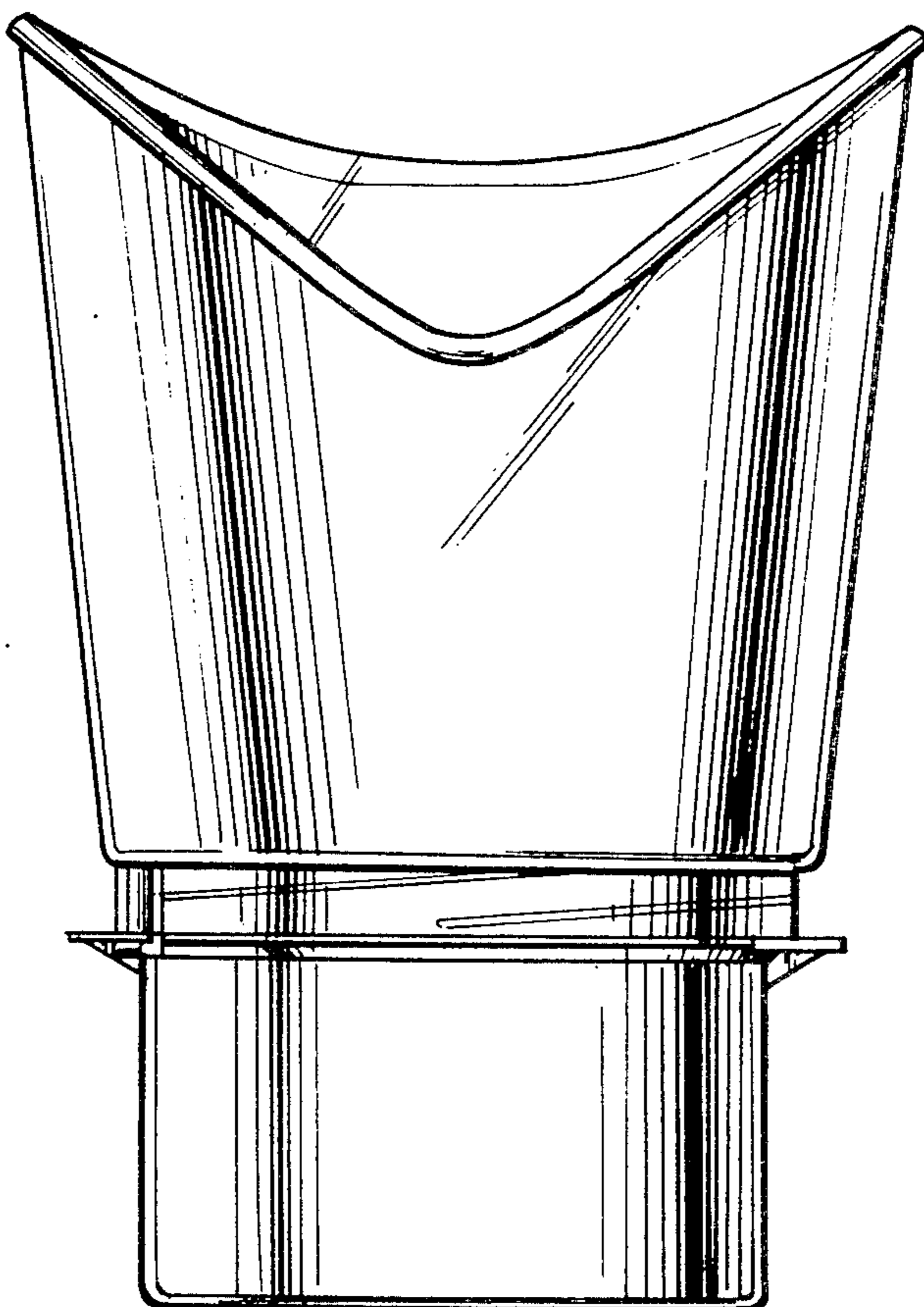

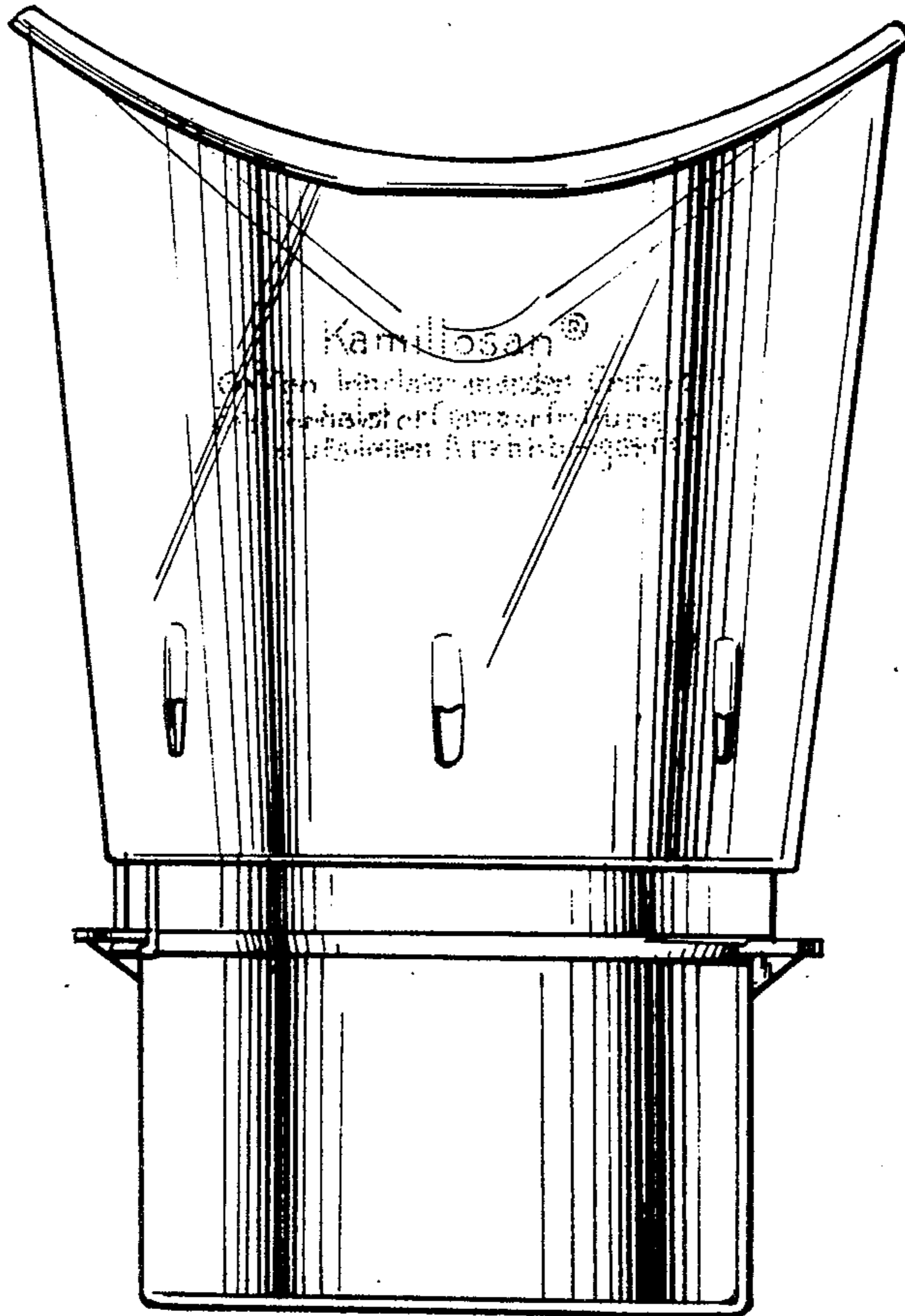
