[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a stocking holder, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a stocking holder showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof the rear being a mirror image;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the design of FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is a top plan view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of FIG. 7, the rear being a mirror image;

FIG. 12 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 7.
