DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a bottle embodying our new design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view looking from the left of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view looking from the right of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view;
 FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1; and
 FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.










