DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear elevational view of a menu printer showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a top right perspective view thereof; and
 FIG. 8 is a top left perspective view thereof, the broken line showing of card and paper being illustrative of environment only.

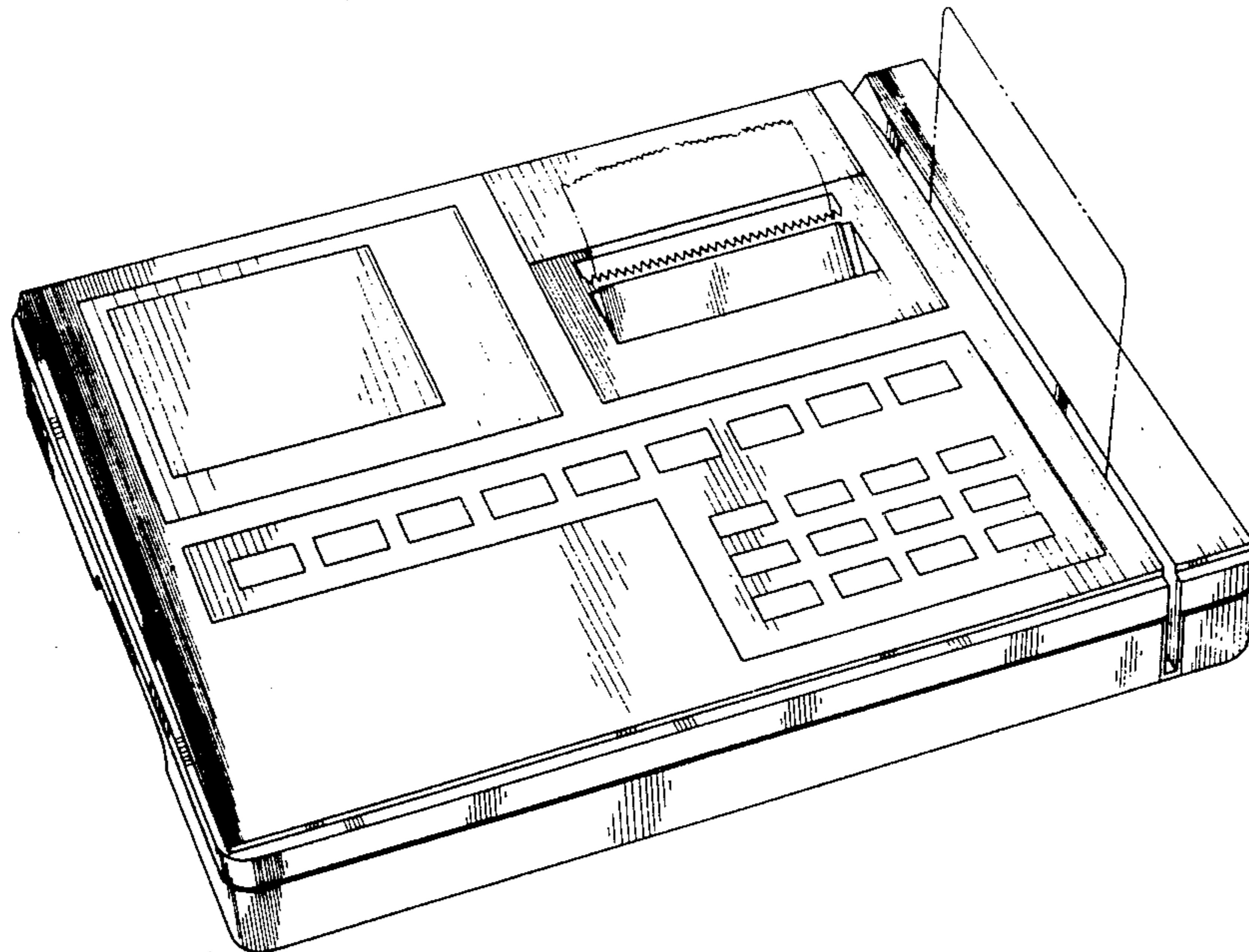

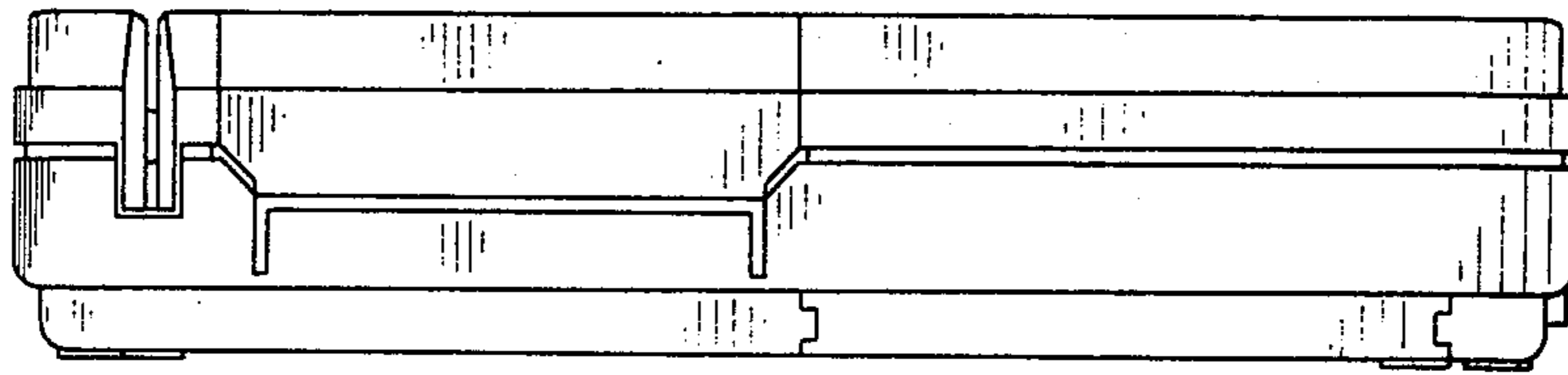

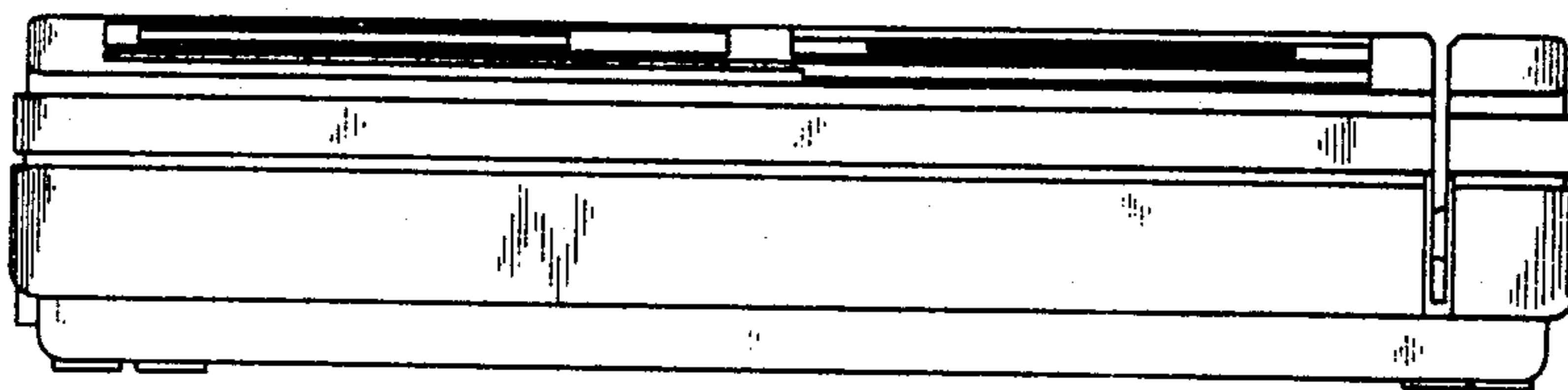

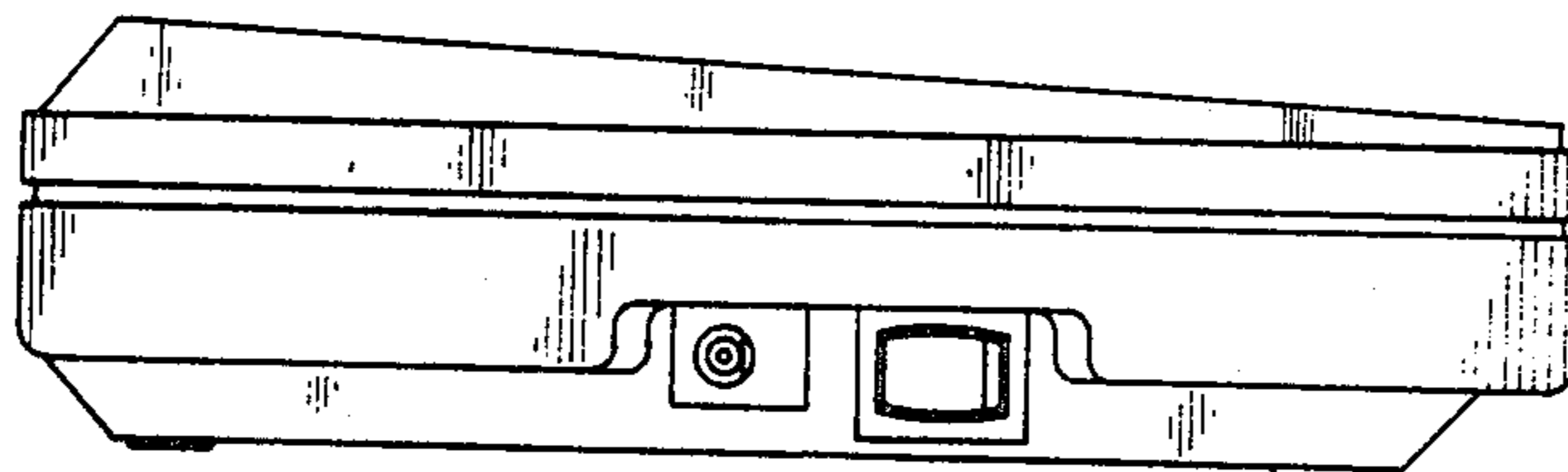

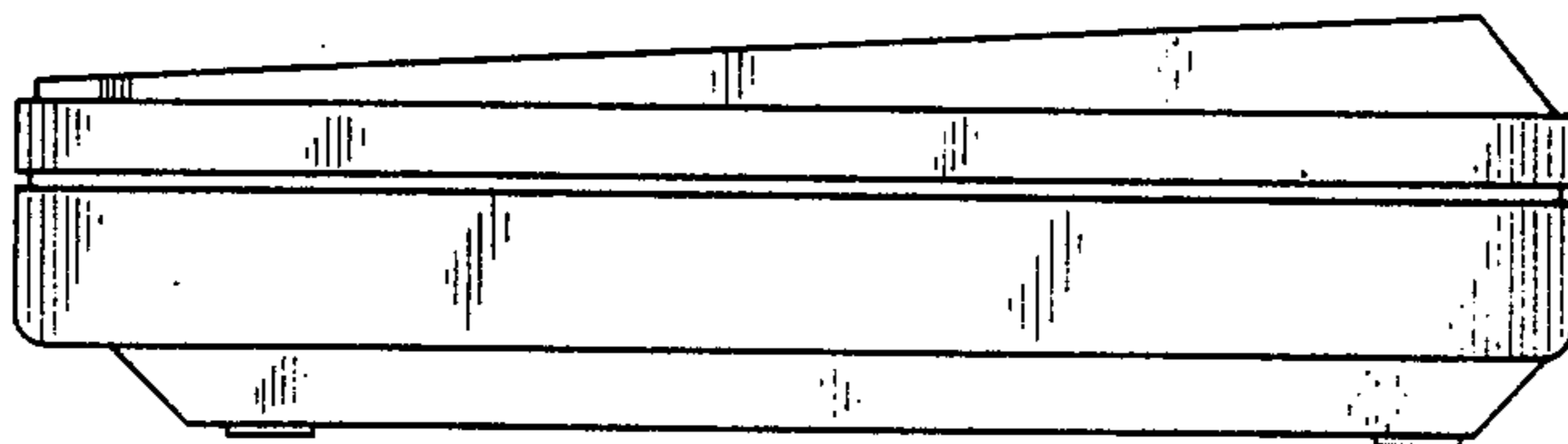

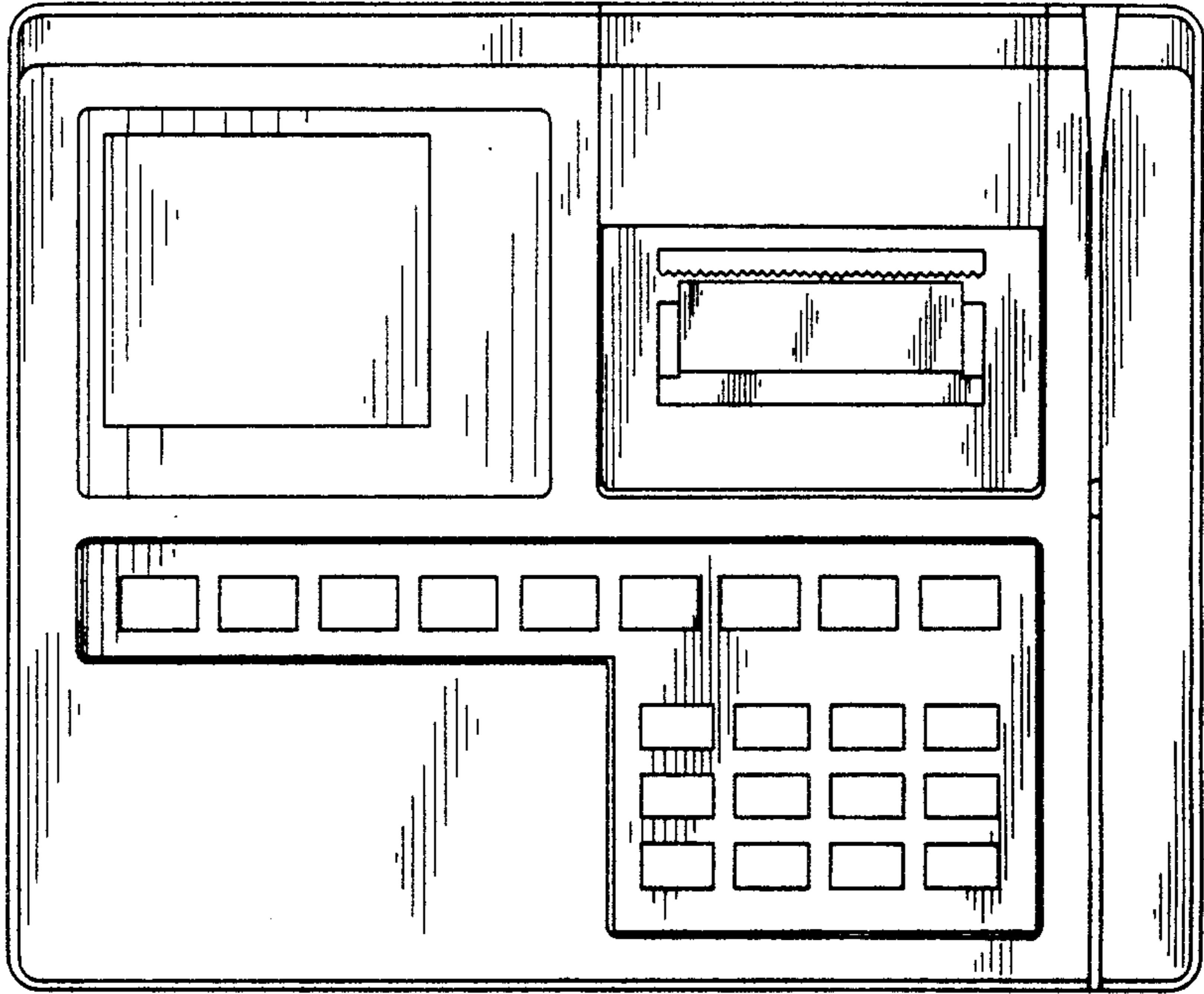
