[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an embossing device, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an embossing device showing my new design and depicted in a closed position;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 8 is an enlarged, sectional view taken generally along the line of FIG. 1.
FIG. 9 is a perspective view of the device in open position.

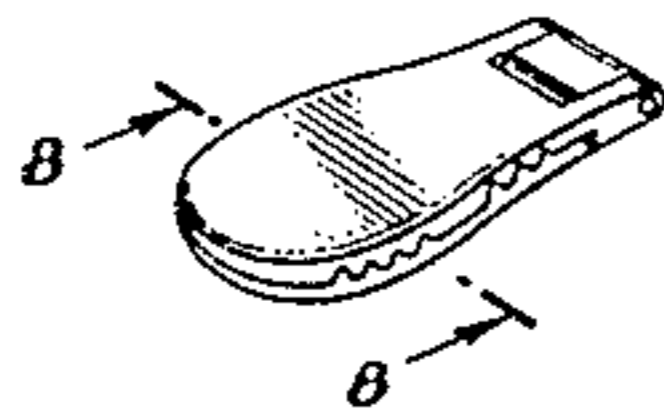

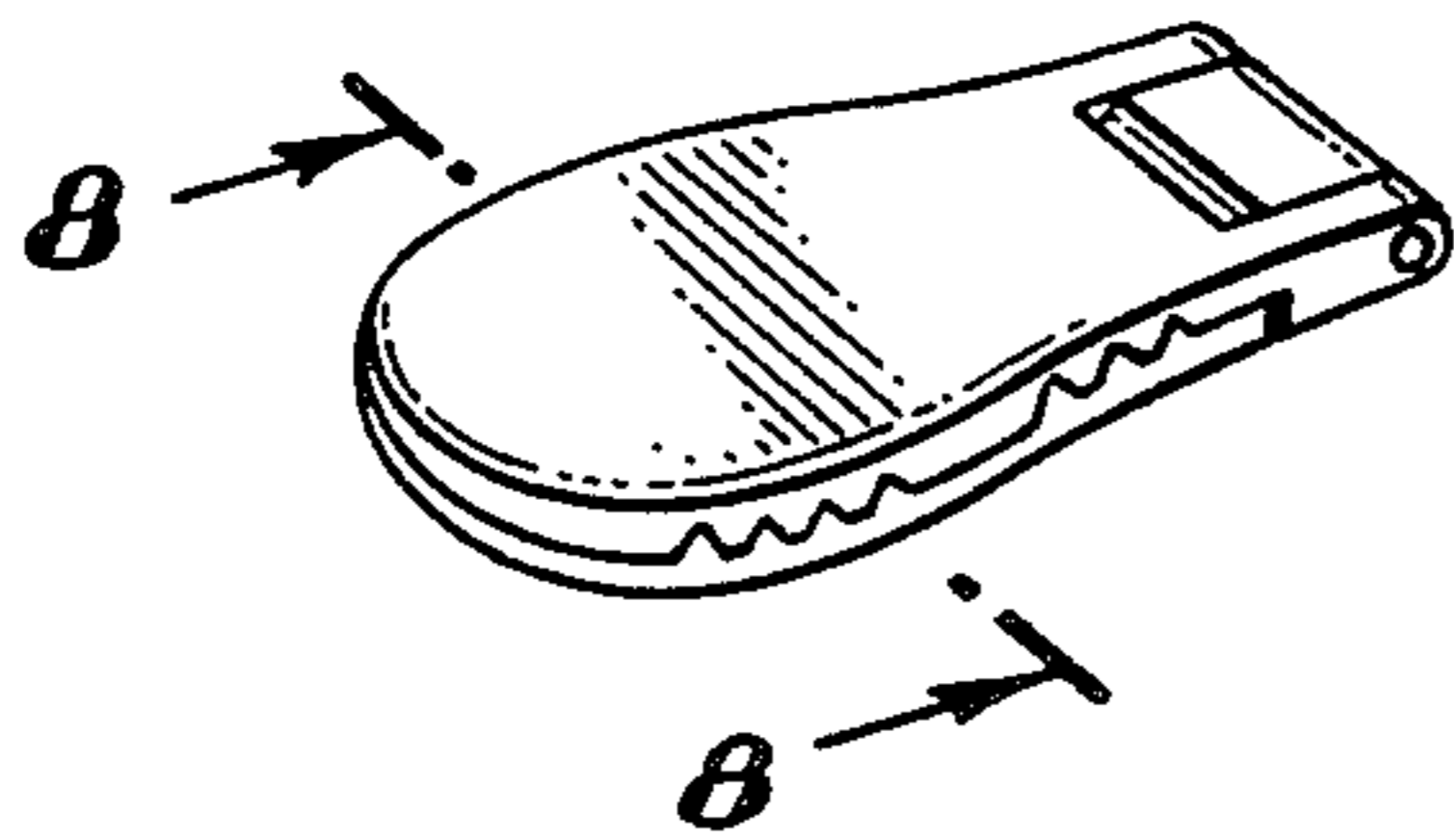

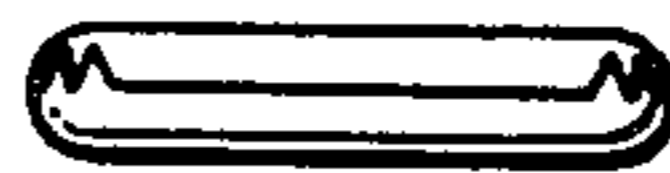

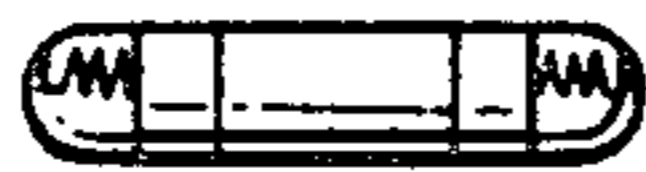

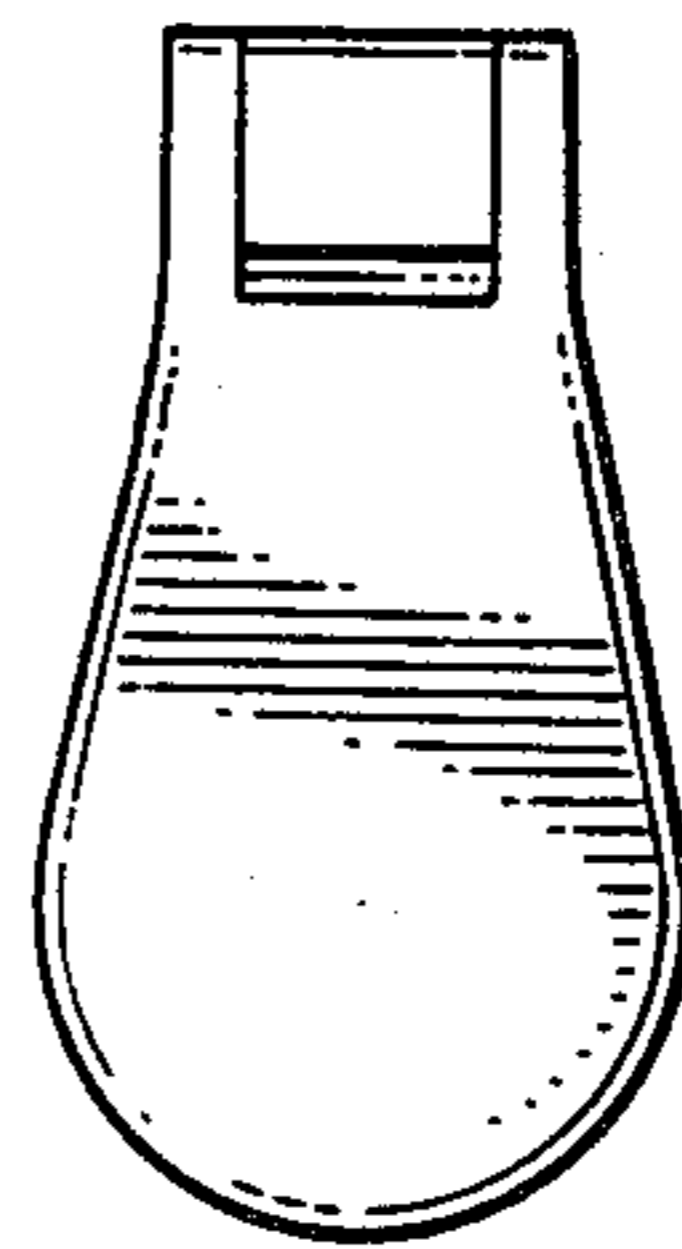

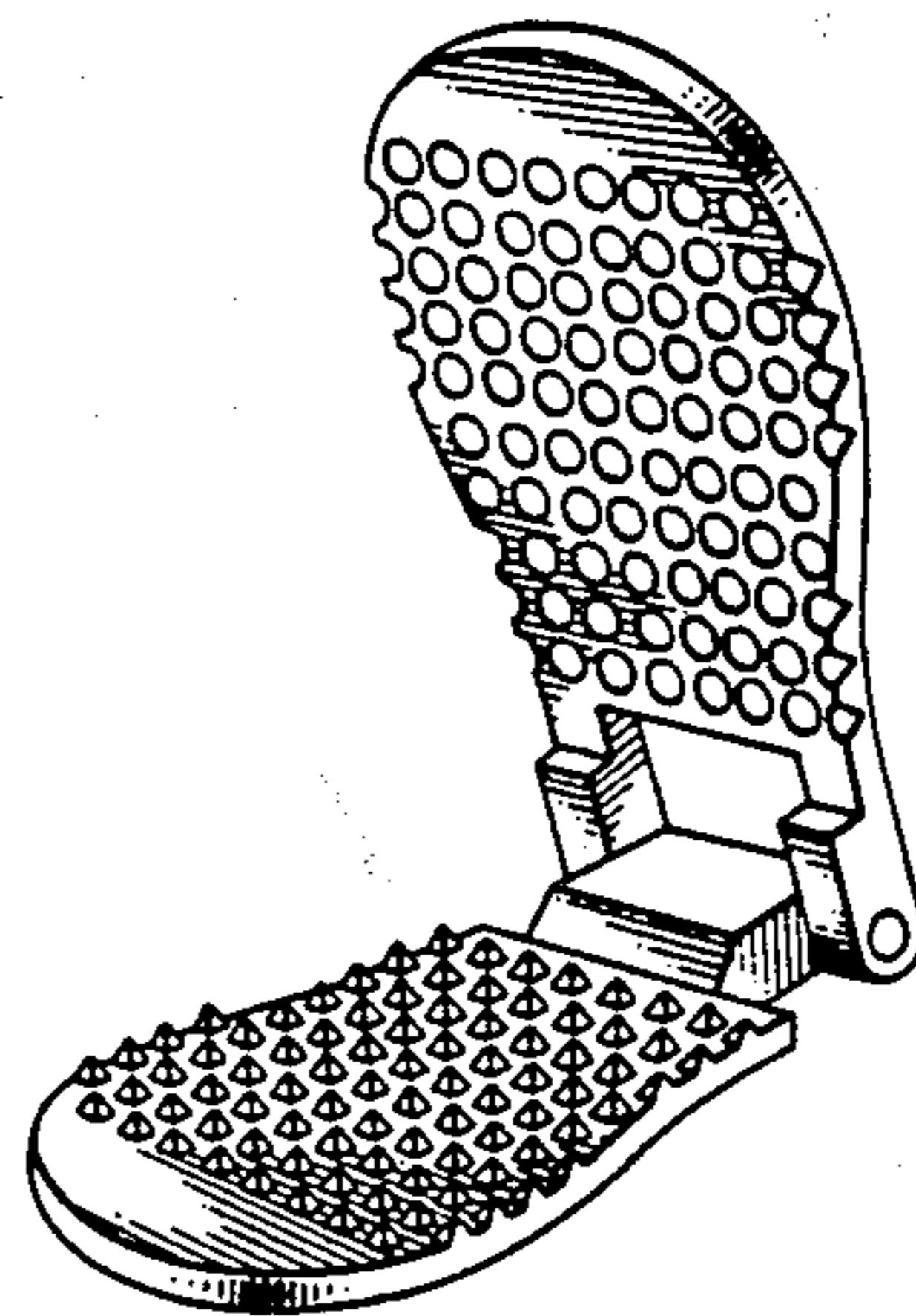
