

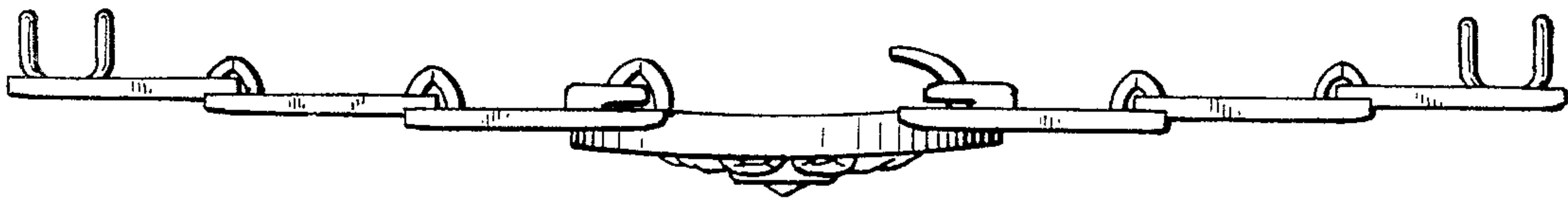

[57] CLAIM
The ornamental design for a belt buckle, as shown and
described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the belt buckle embodying
my new design, the bottom plan view being a mirror
image;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left-side view thereof, the right-side view
being similar; and
FIG. 5 is a fragmentary front elevation showing the belt
buckle in open condition.



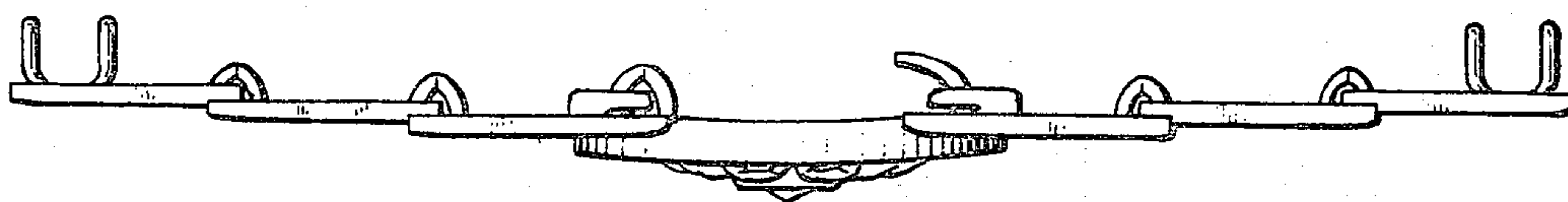

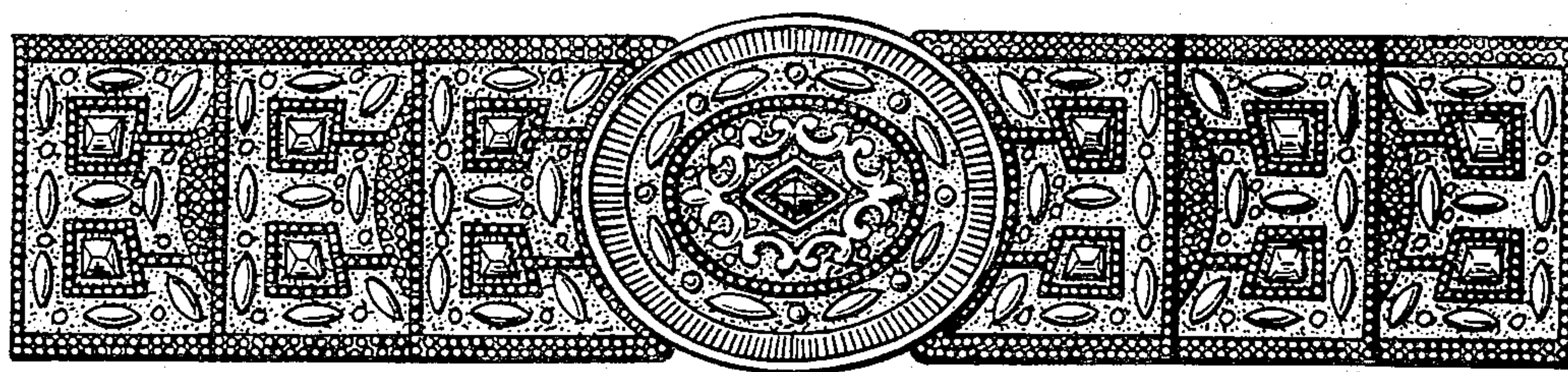

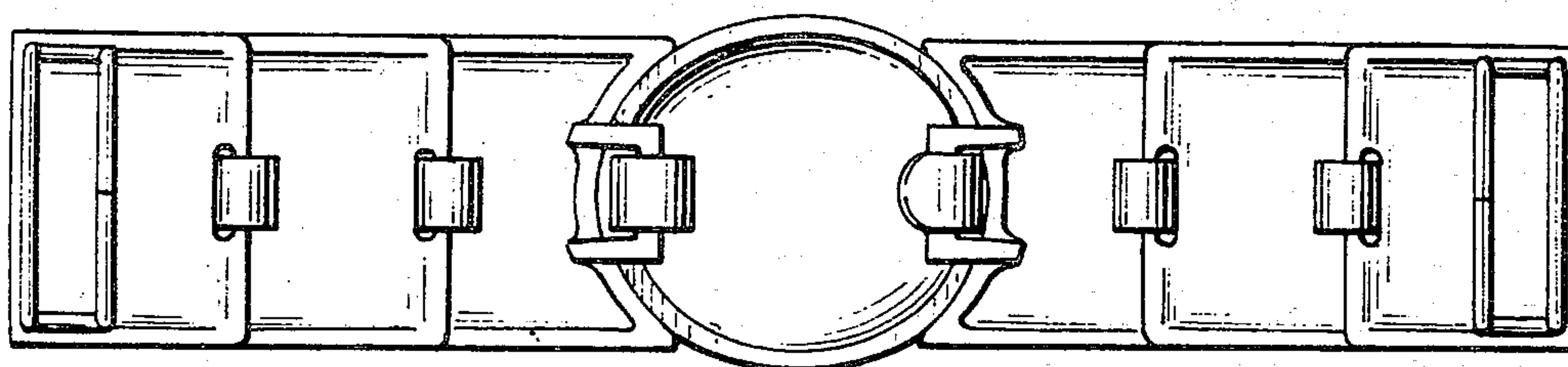

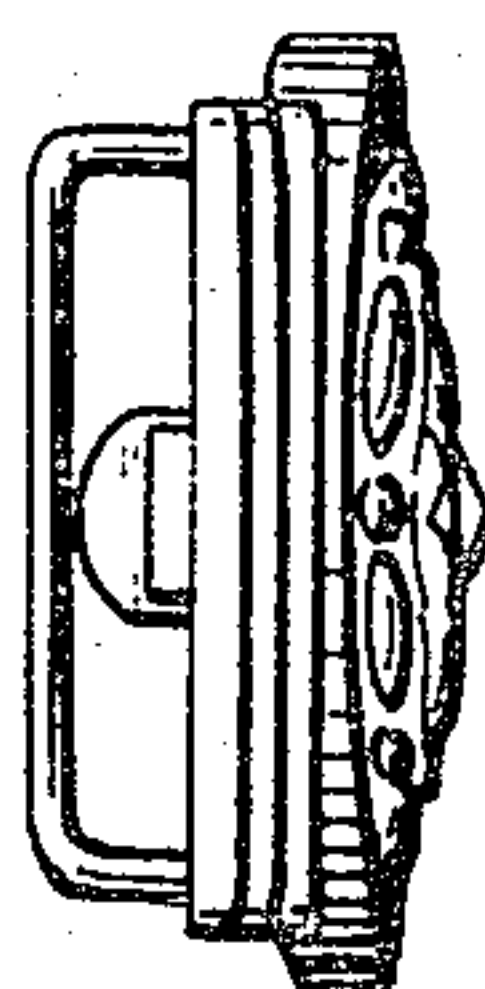

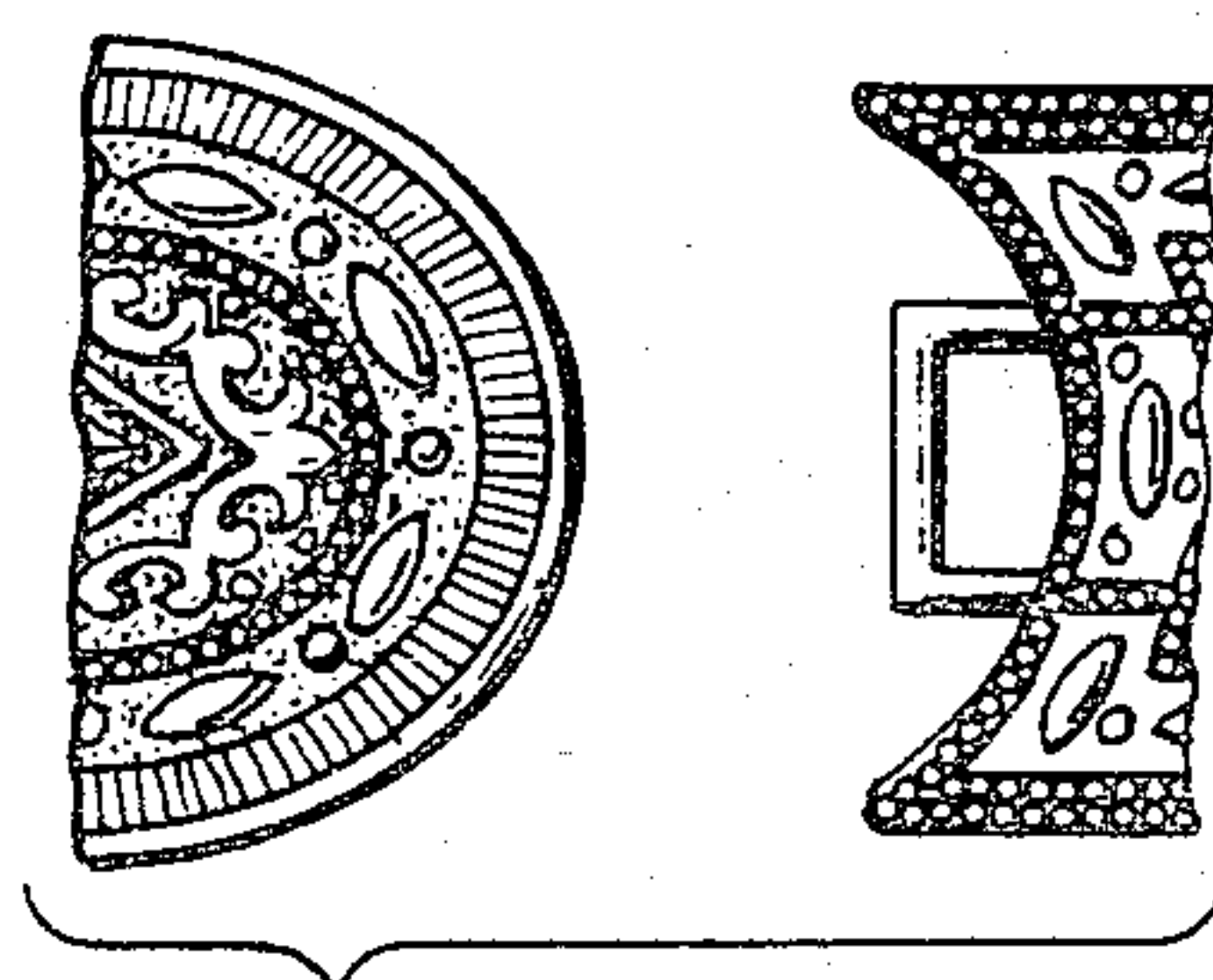
