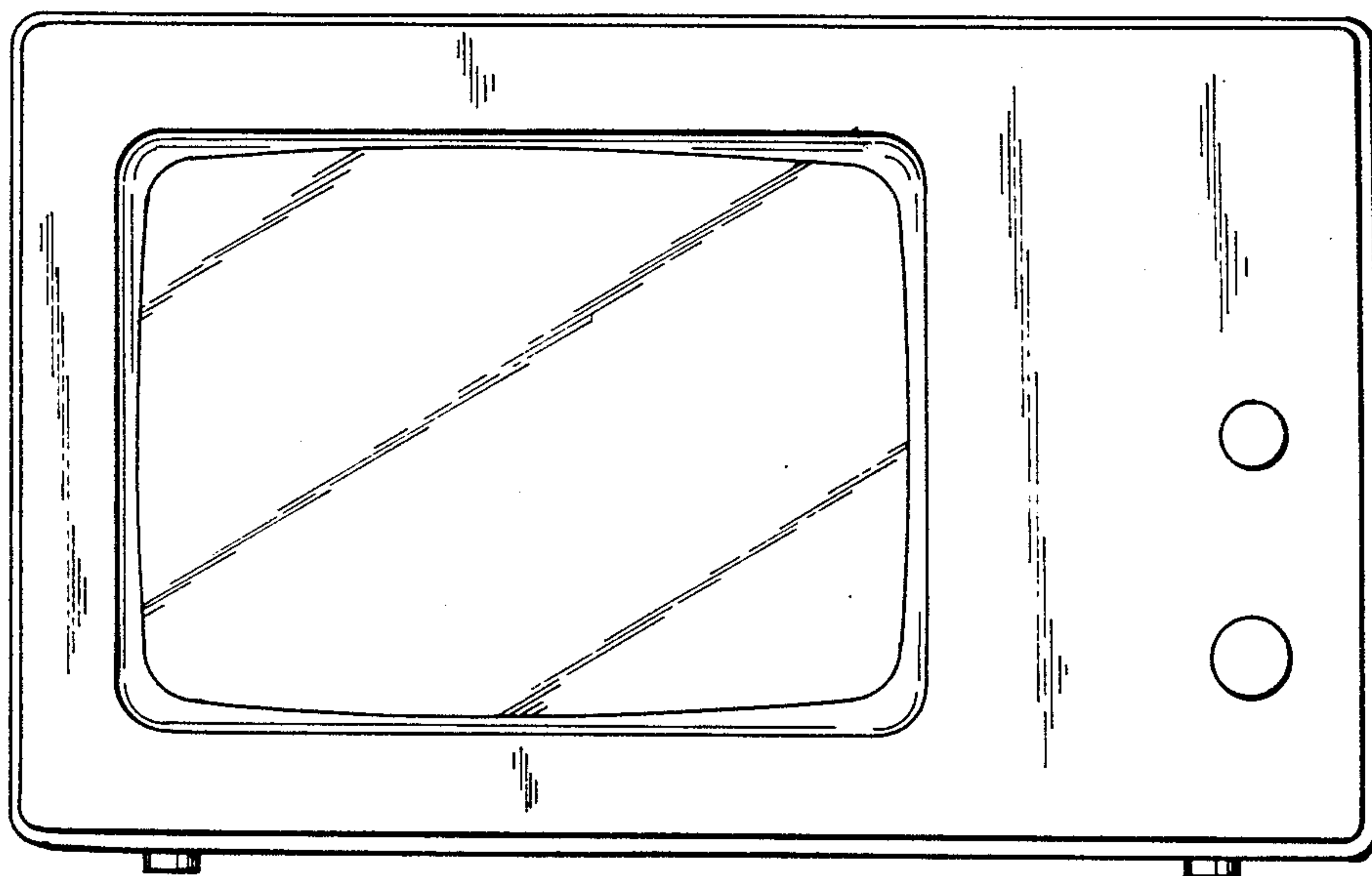

The ornamental design for computer display monitor
for use in testing electric and electronic circuitry, sub-
stantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a computer display
monitor for use in testing electric and electronic cir-
cuitry showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;

disclosed in FIG. 4-6.



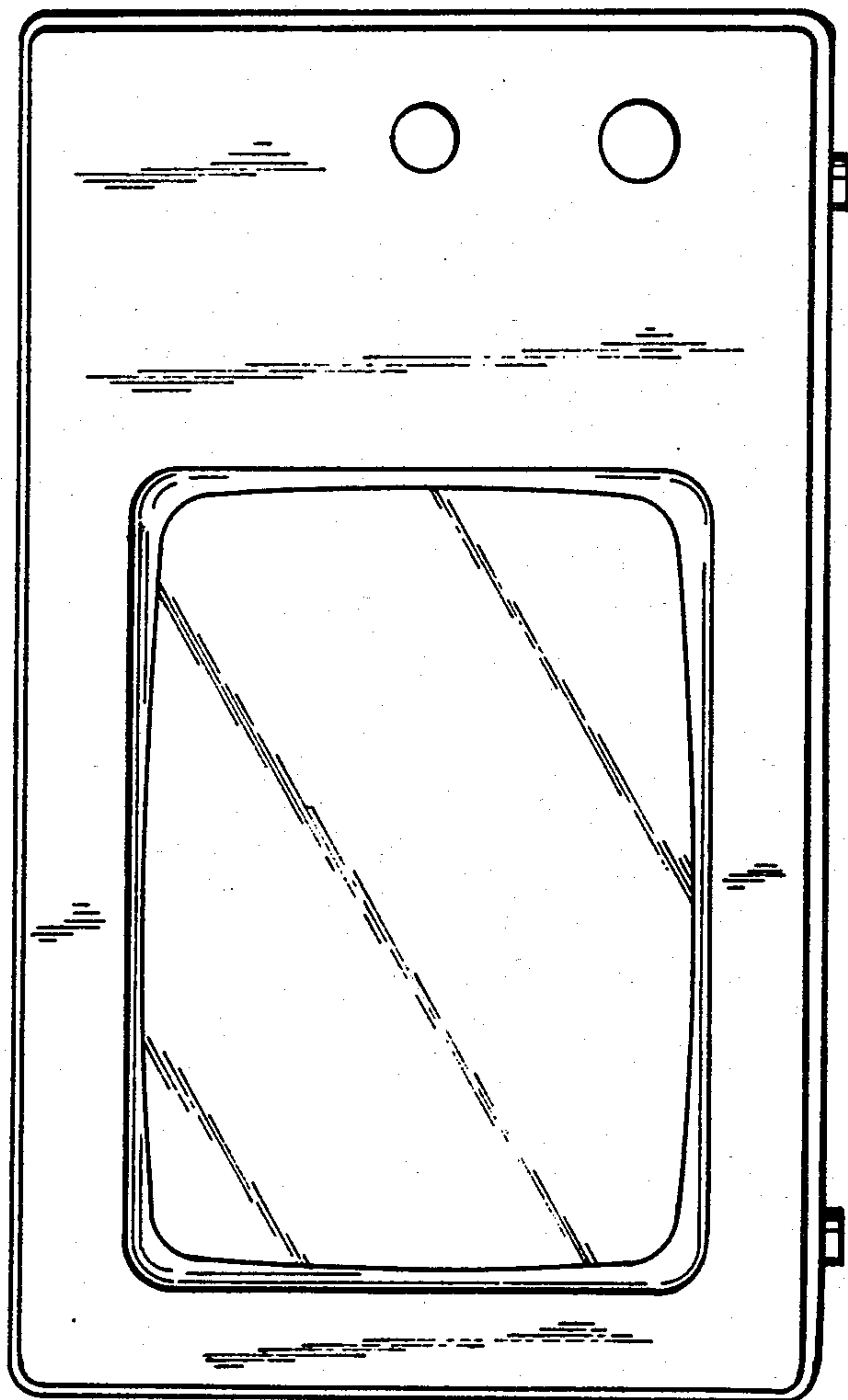

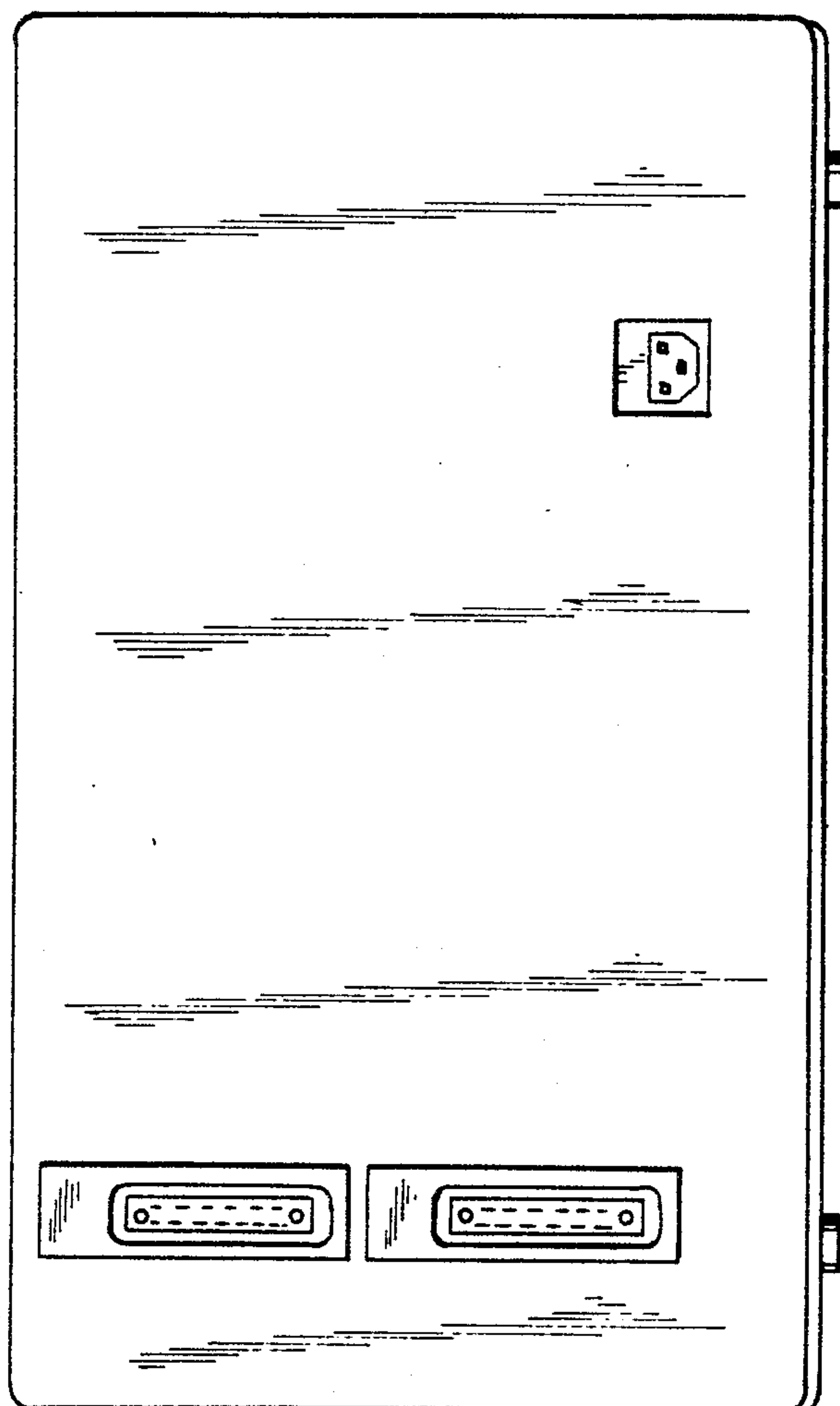

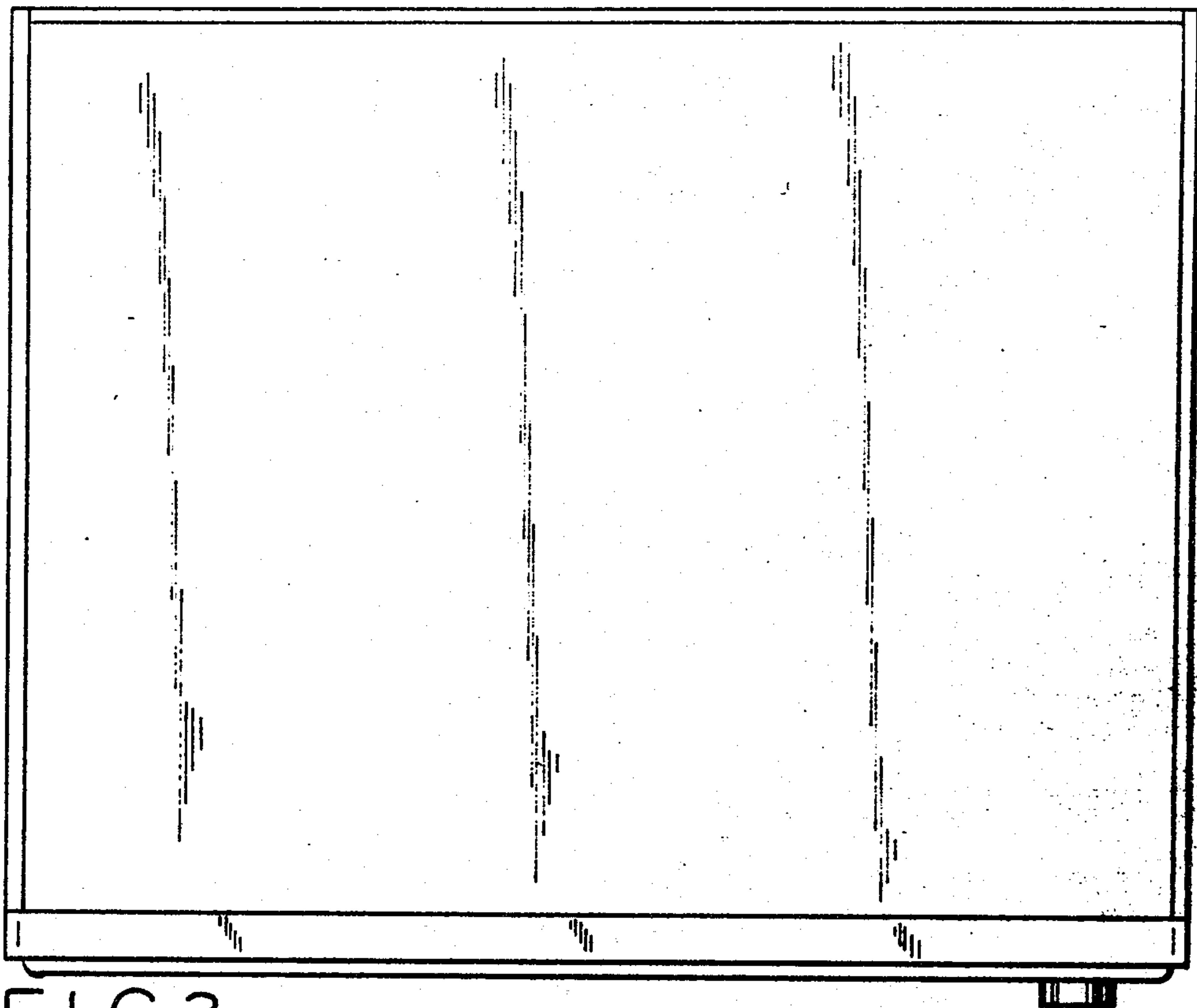

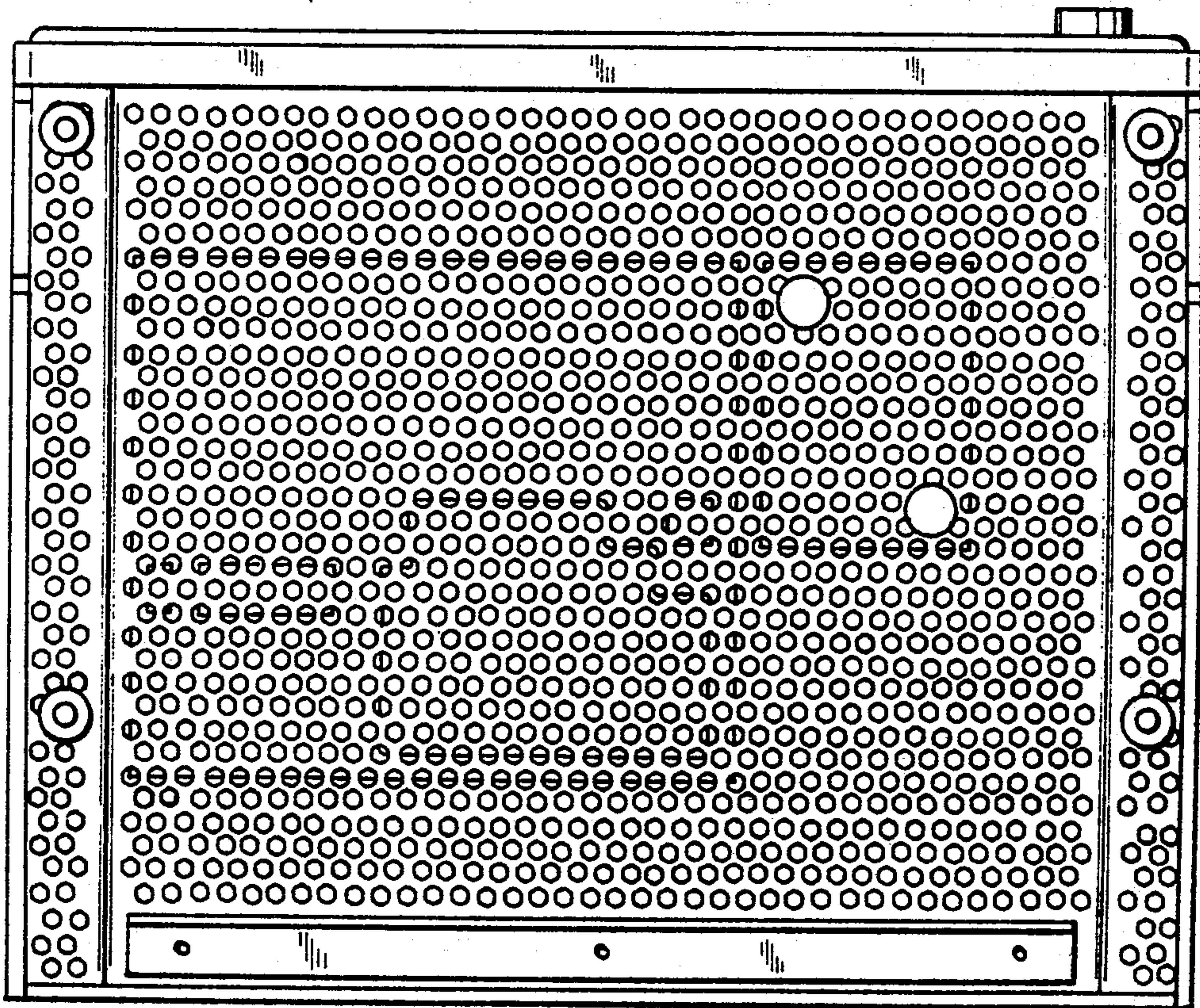

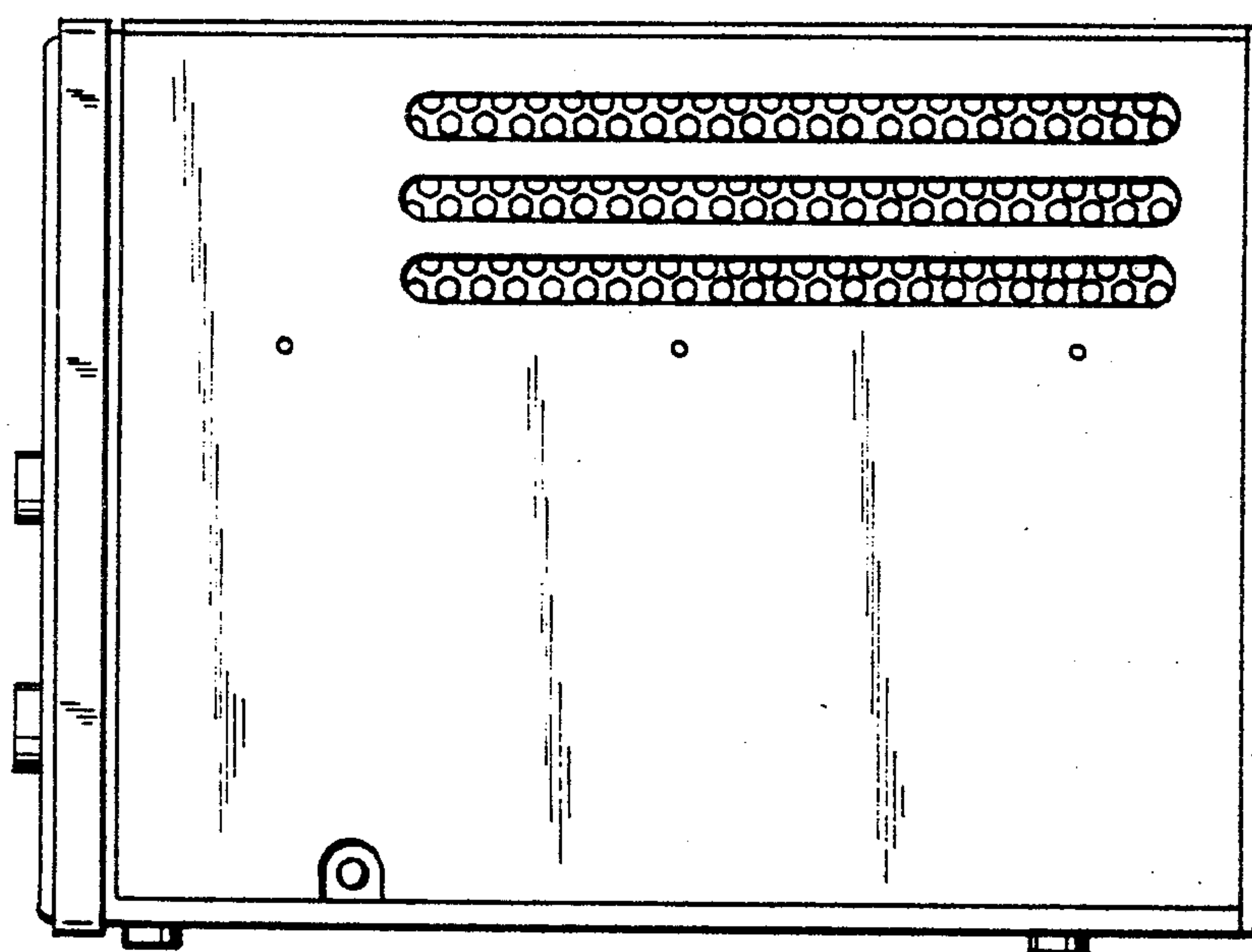

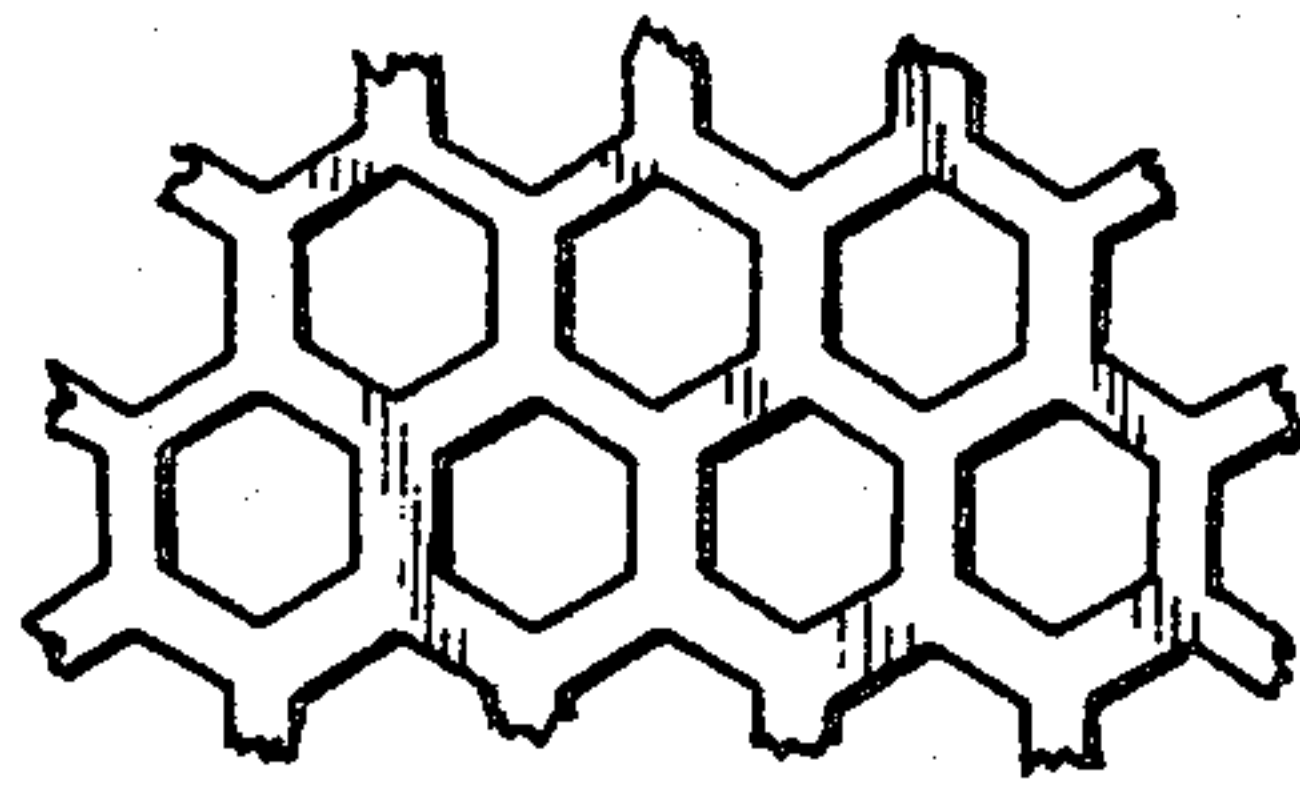
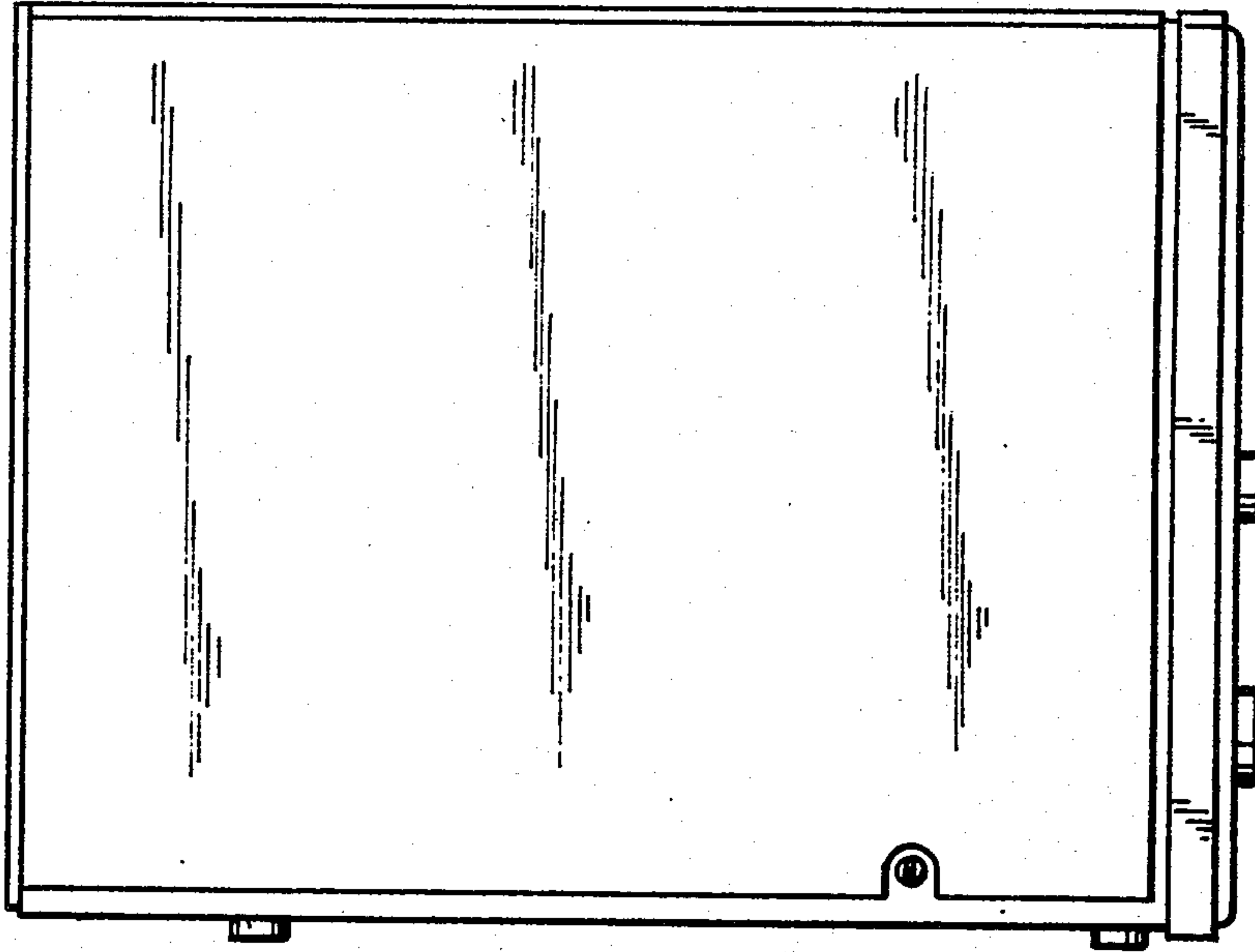
