[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a removable sunshade for glasses, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a removable sunshade for glasses showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a side view thereof, with the glasses shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.

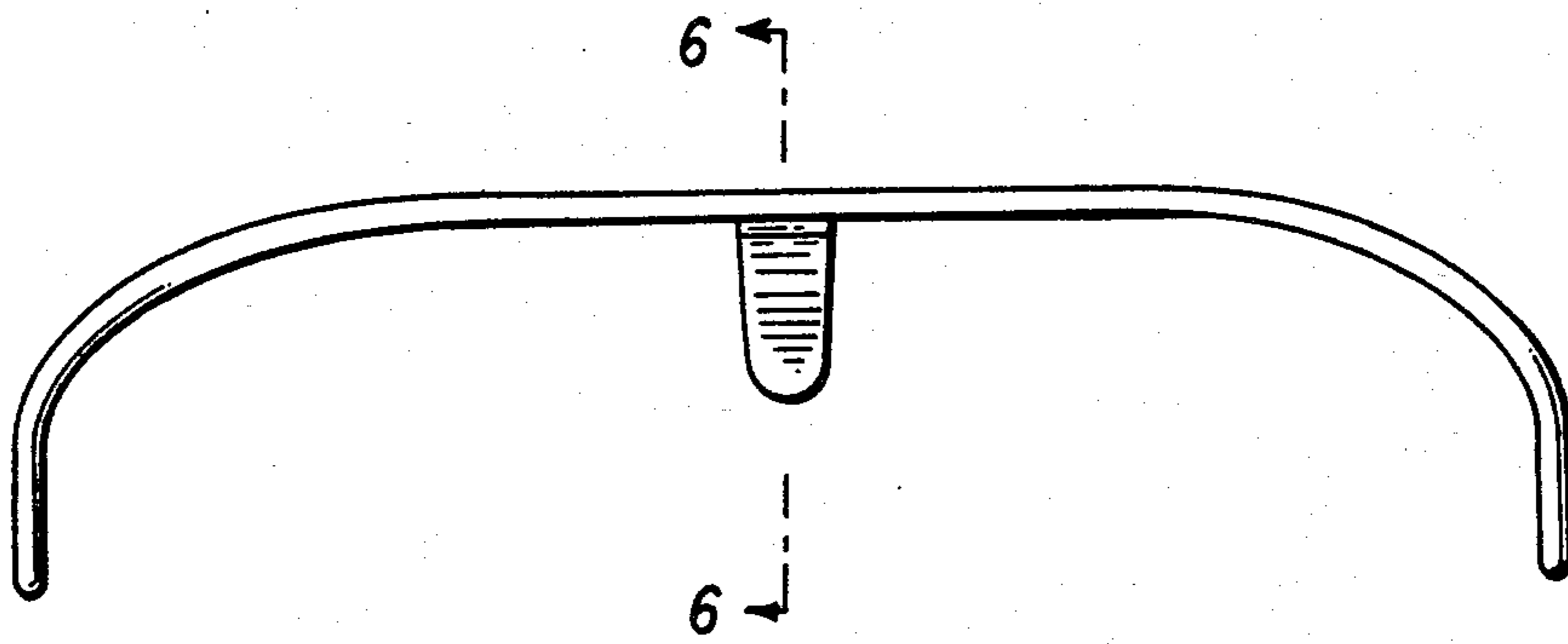

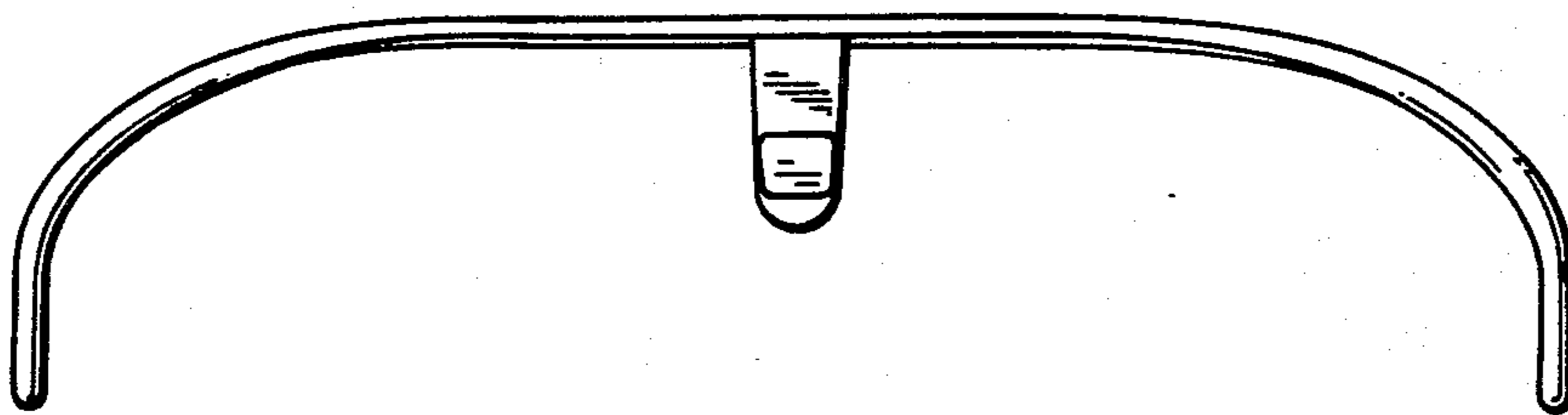

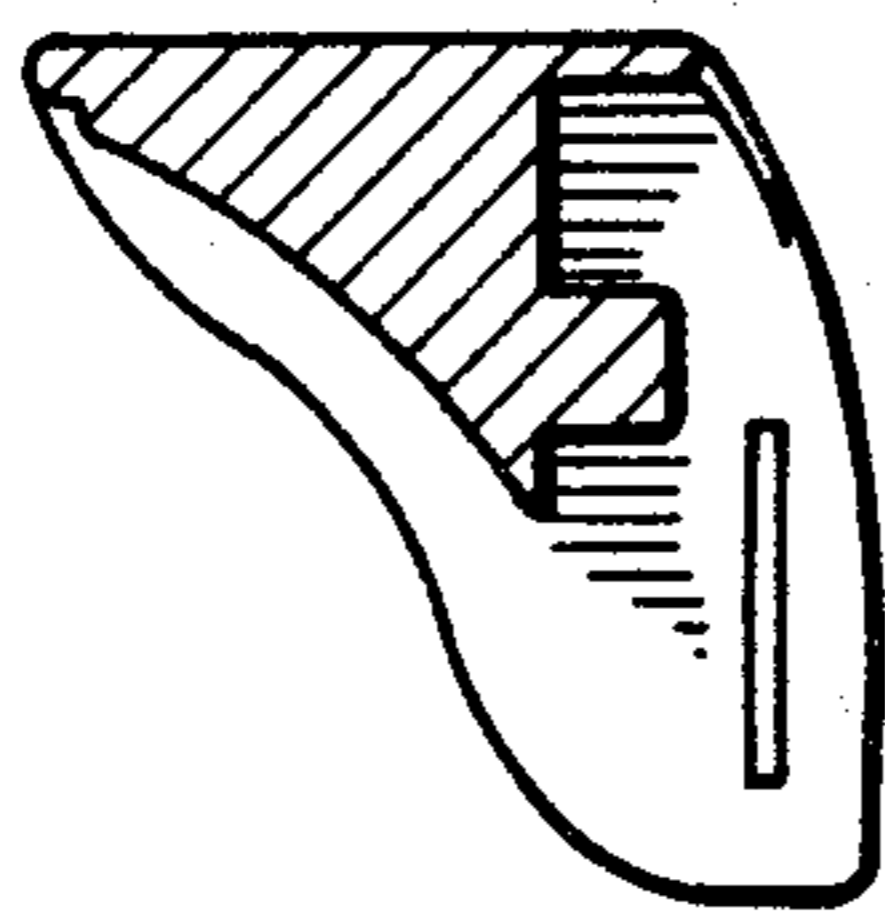

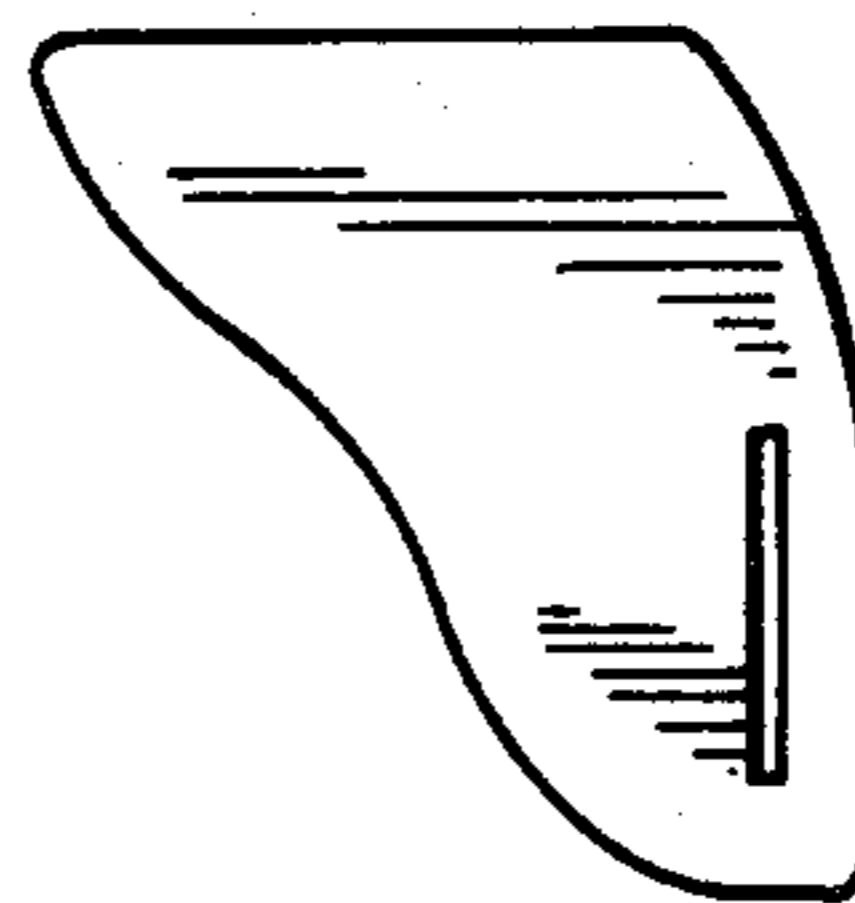

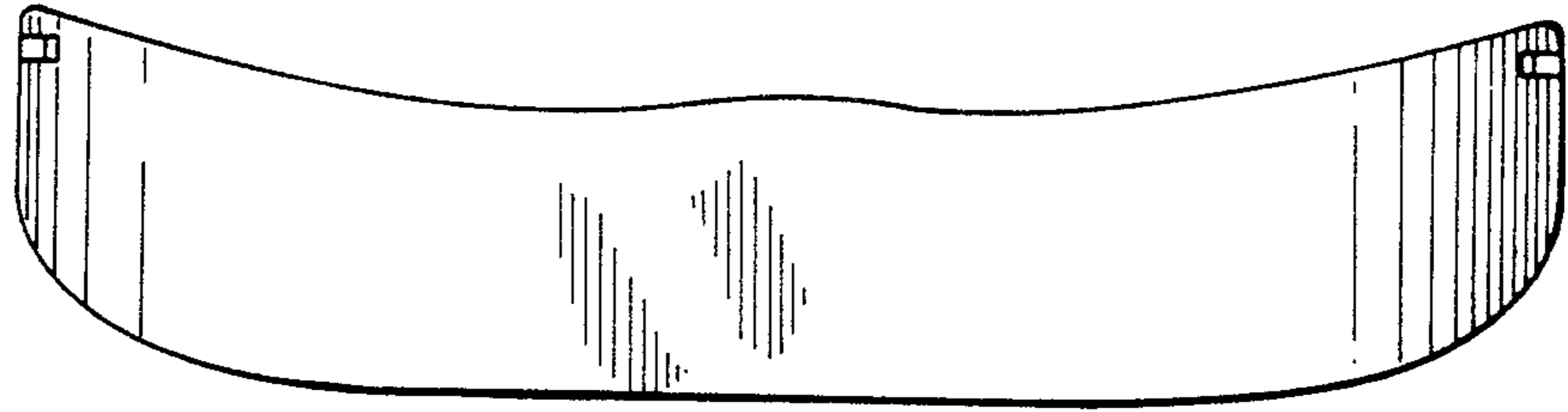

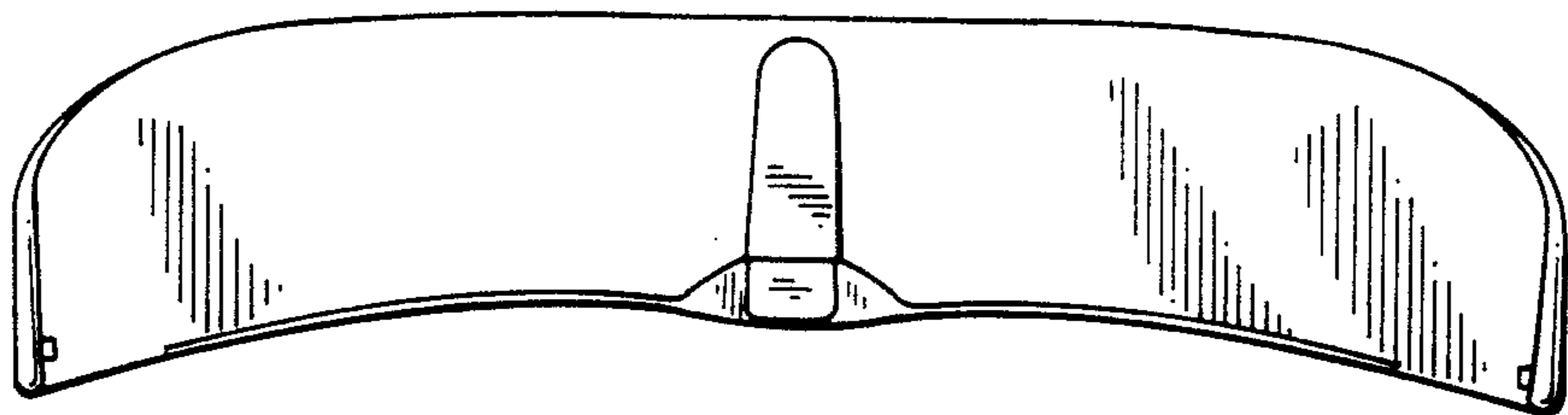
