CLAIM

[57] The ornamental design for a securable strap for ski boot or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of a securable strap for ski boot or the like showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being substantially a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the side opposite that shown in FIGS. 3; and,
FIG. 5 is an end elevational view thereof, the end opposite being substantially a mirror image.
FIG. 6 is a side view of the first member taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 4.
FIG. 7 is an end view of the first member taken along line 7—7 of FIG. 4.
FIG. 8 is a front view of the deployed second member.
FIG. 9 is a top view of the second member taken along line 9—9 of FIG. 8.
FIG. 10 is a bottom view of the second member taken along line 10—10 of FIG. 8.
The broken line showing of environment in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
