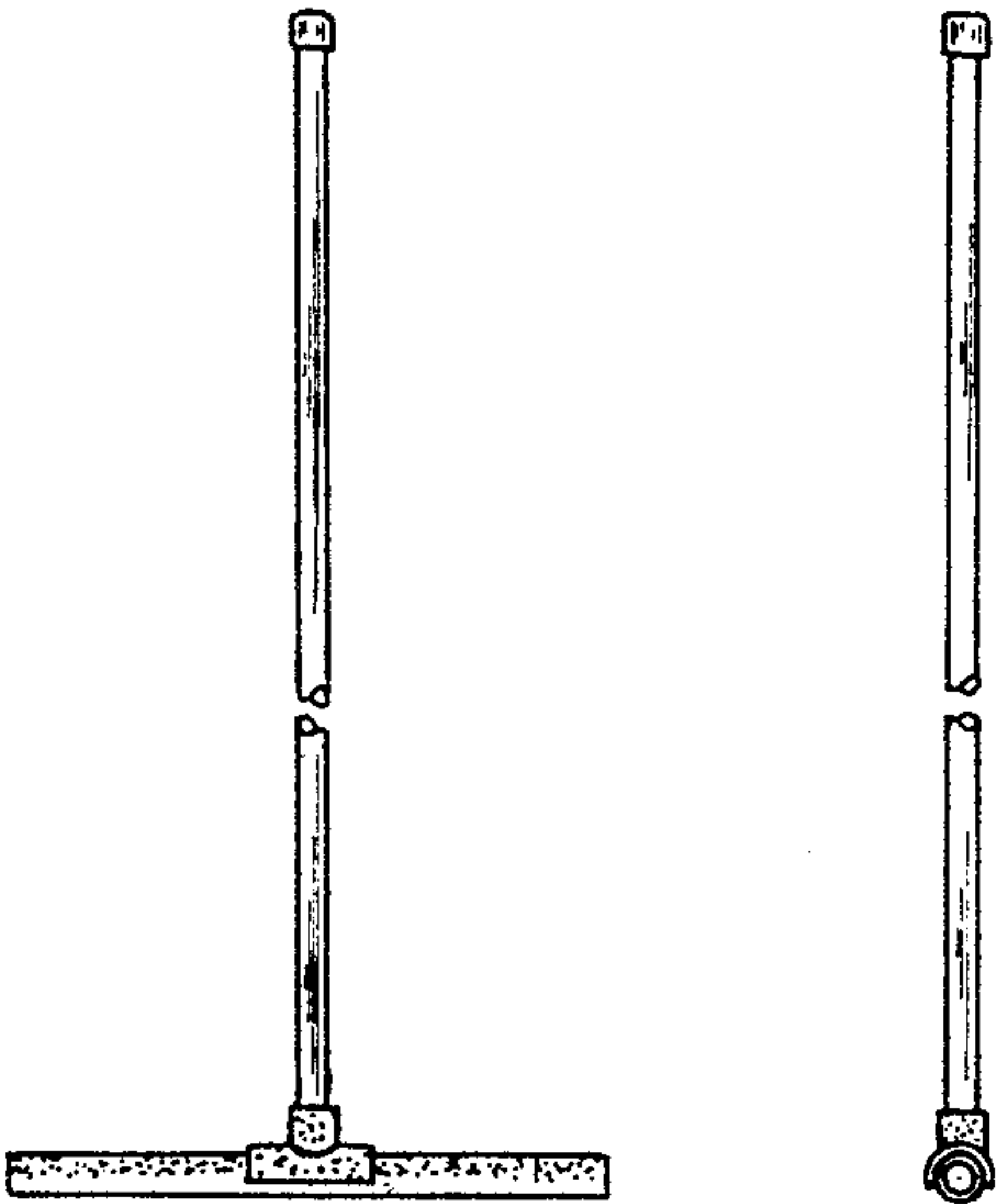

The ornamental design for a mop, as shown and de-
scribed.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a mop, showing my
new design, with the rear elevation being identical;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view, the left side being
identical thereto;
FIG. 3 is an enlarged partial front elevational view
thereof;
FIG. 4 is an enlarged bottom view thereof;
FIG. 5 is an enlarged partial right side elevational view
thereof;
FIG. 6 is an enlarged partial front elevational view of a
second embodiment of a mop, with the rear elevation
being identical;
FIG. 7 is an enlarged partial view of the right side of
FIG. 6 with the left side being identical thereto;
FIG. 8 is an enlarged partial front elevational view of a
third embodiment of a mop, with the rear elevation
being identical;
FIG. 9 is an enlarged partial view of the right side of
FIG. 8 with the left side being identical thereto.



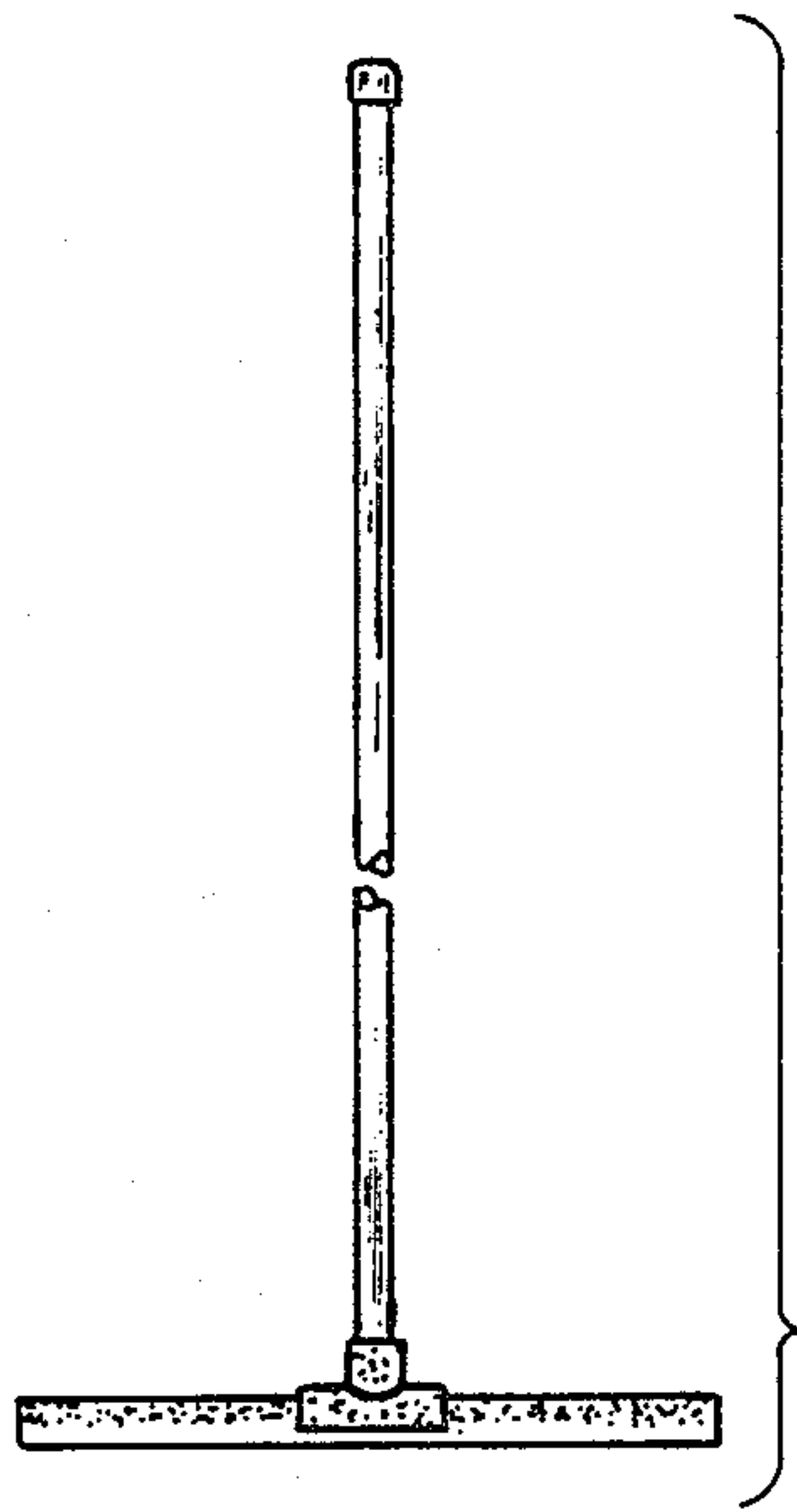

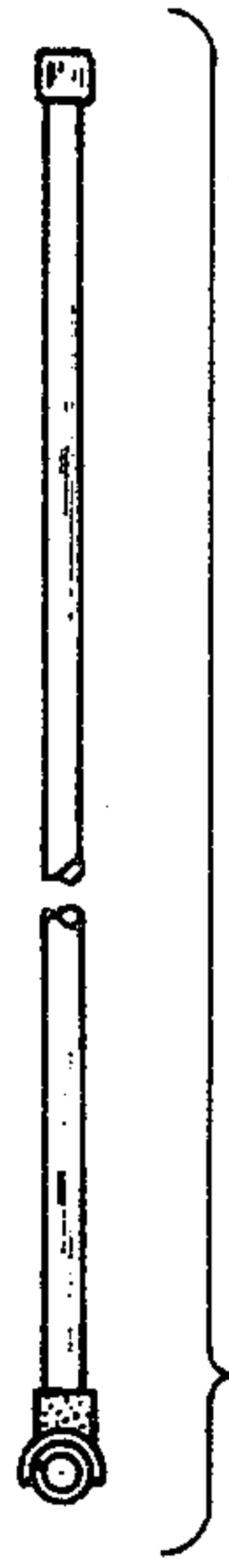

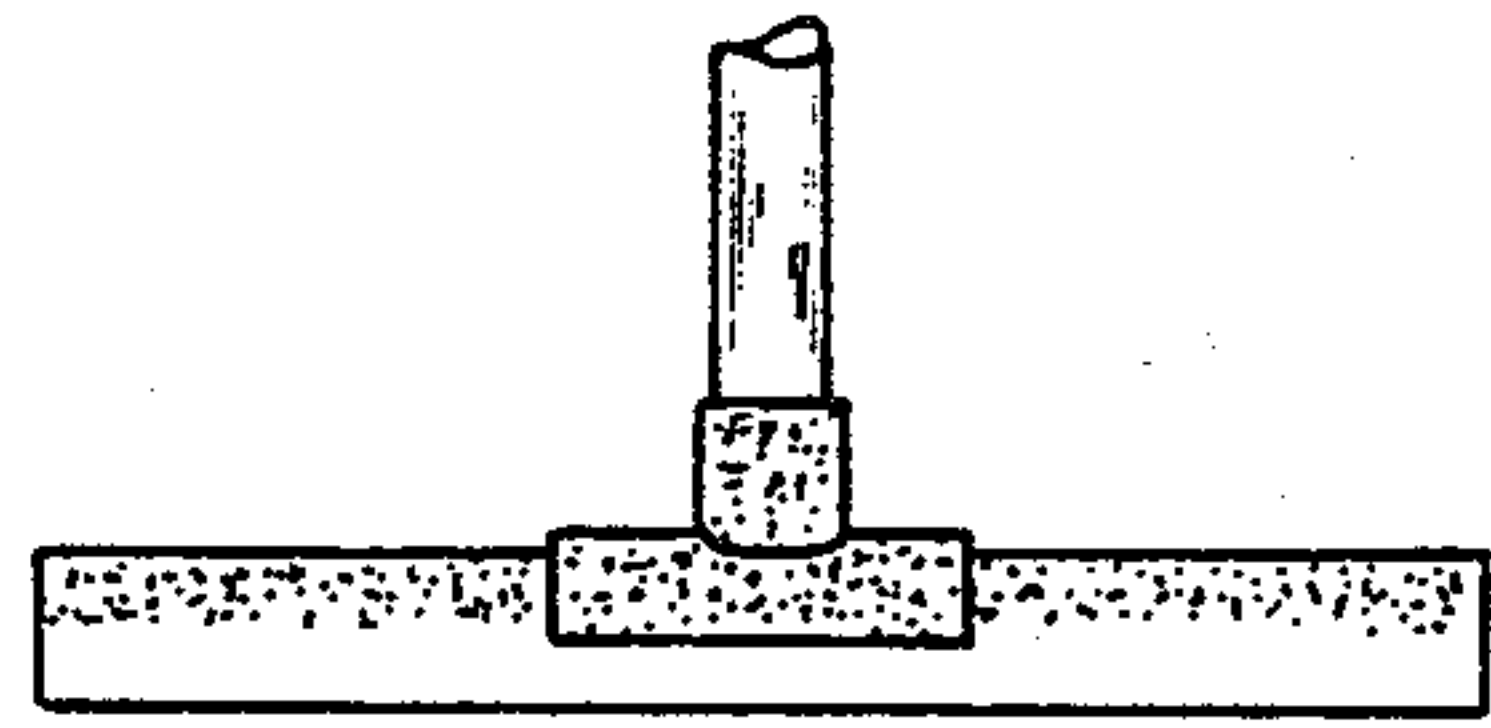

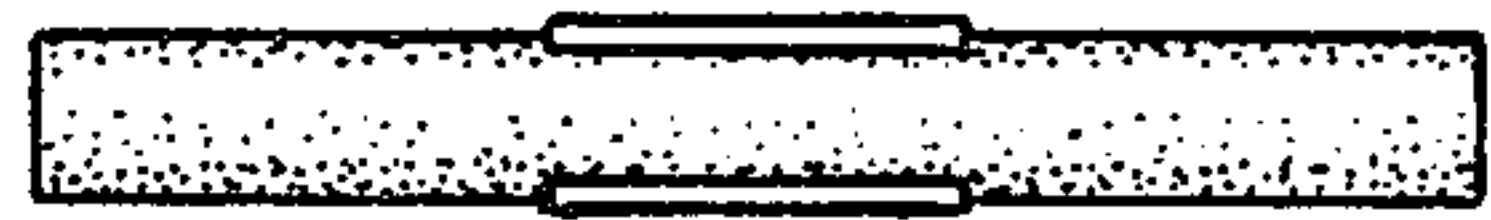

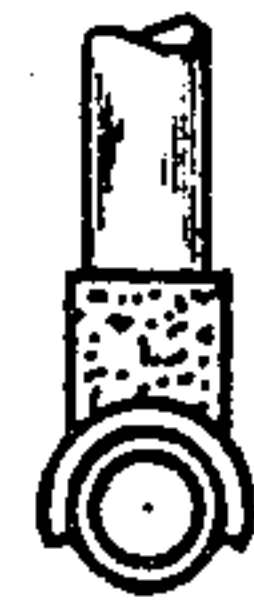

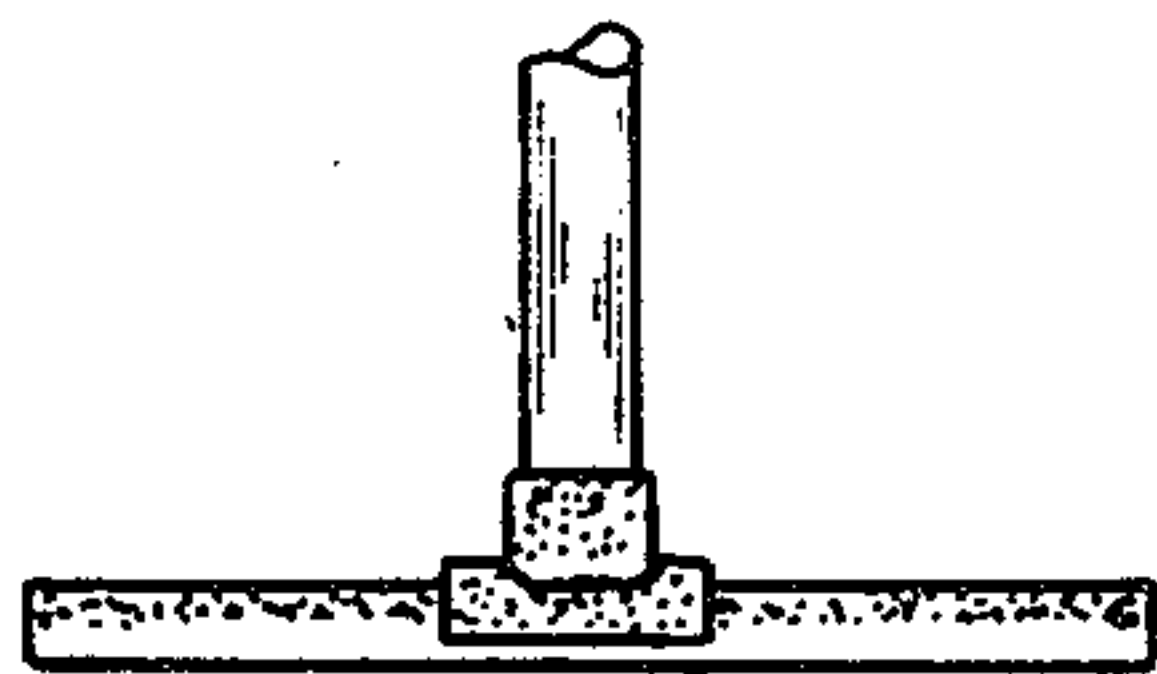

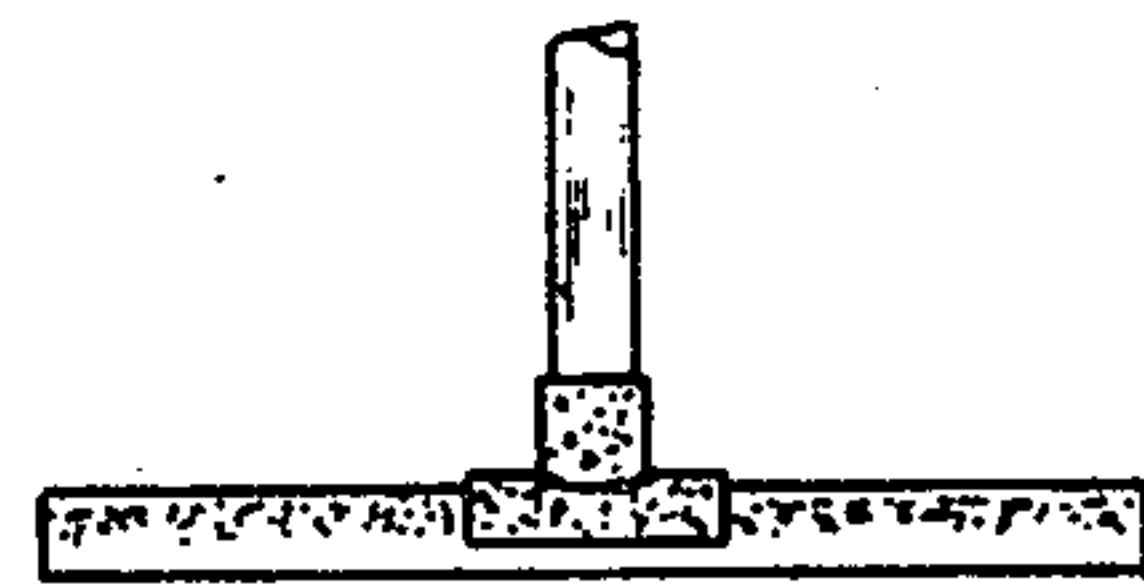
