FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair showing our design;

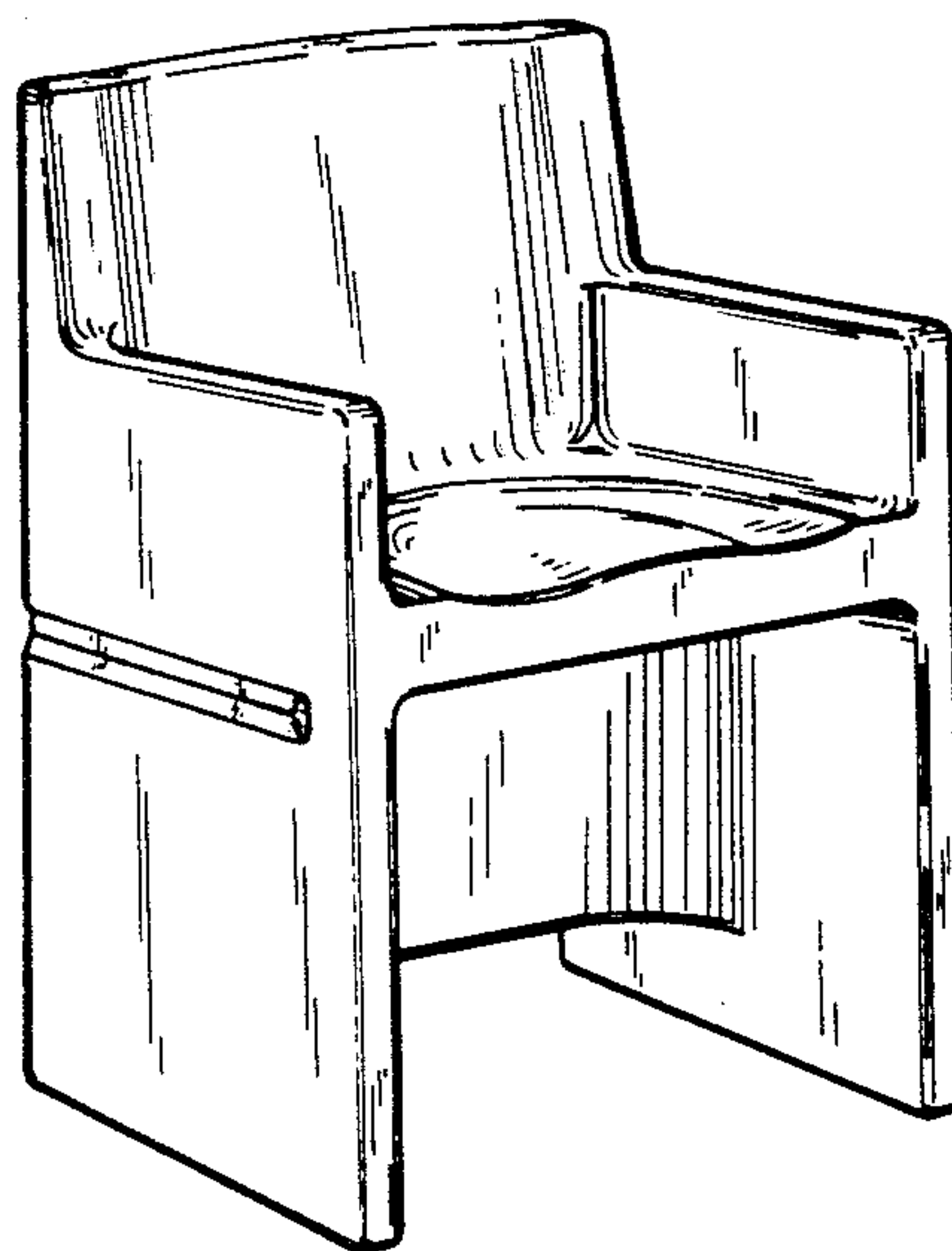
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the chair of FIG. 1 wherein the same has been drawn to a reduced scale;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



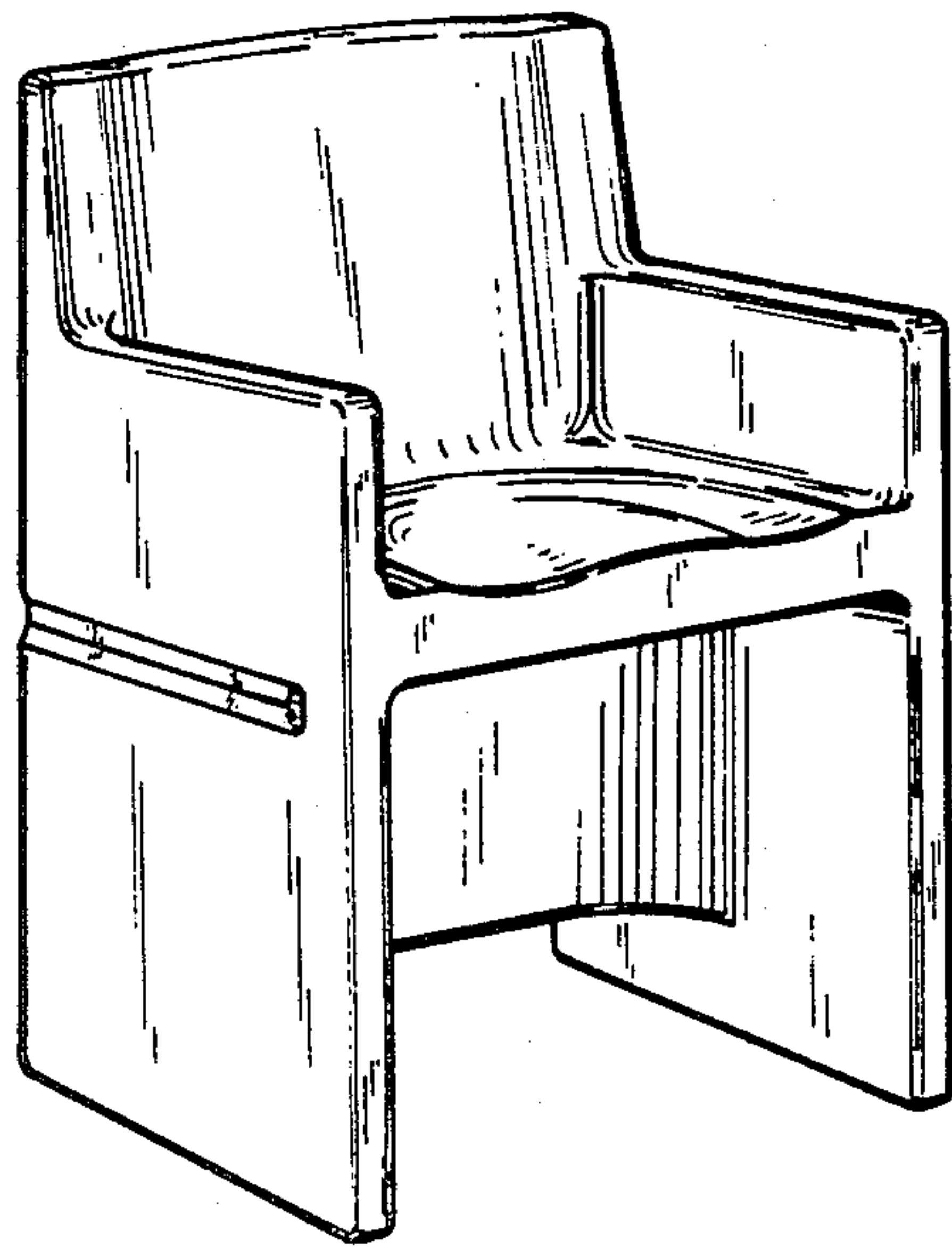

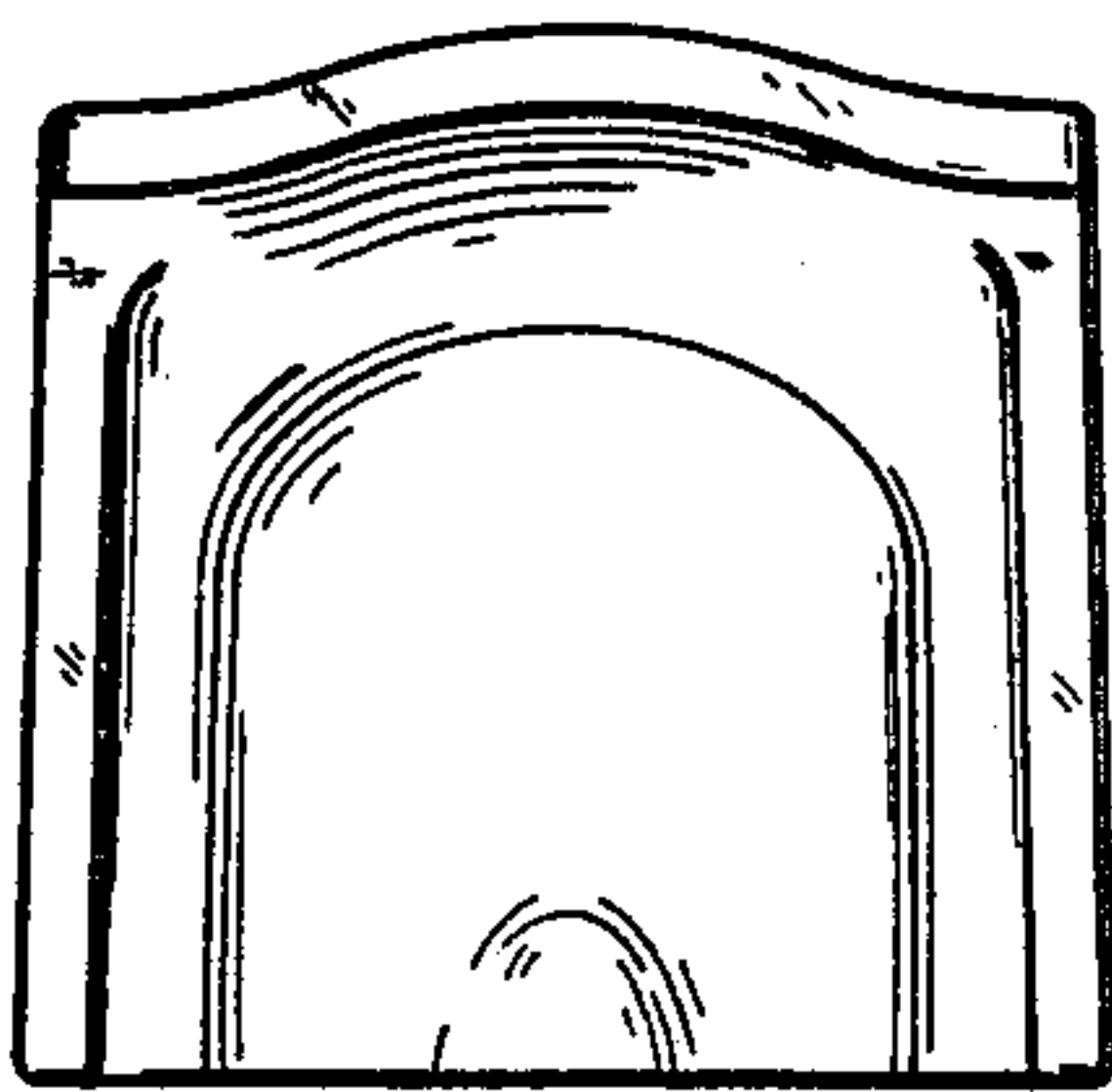

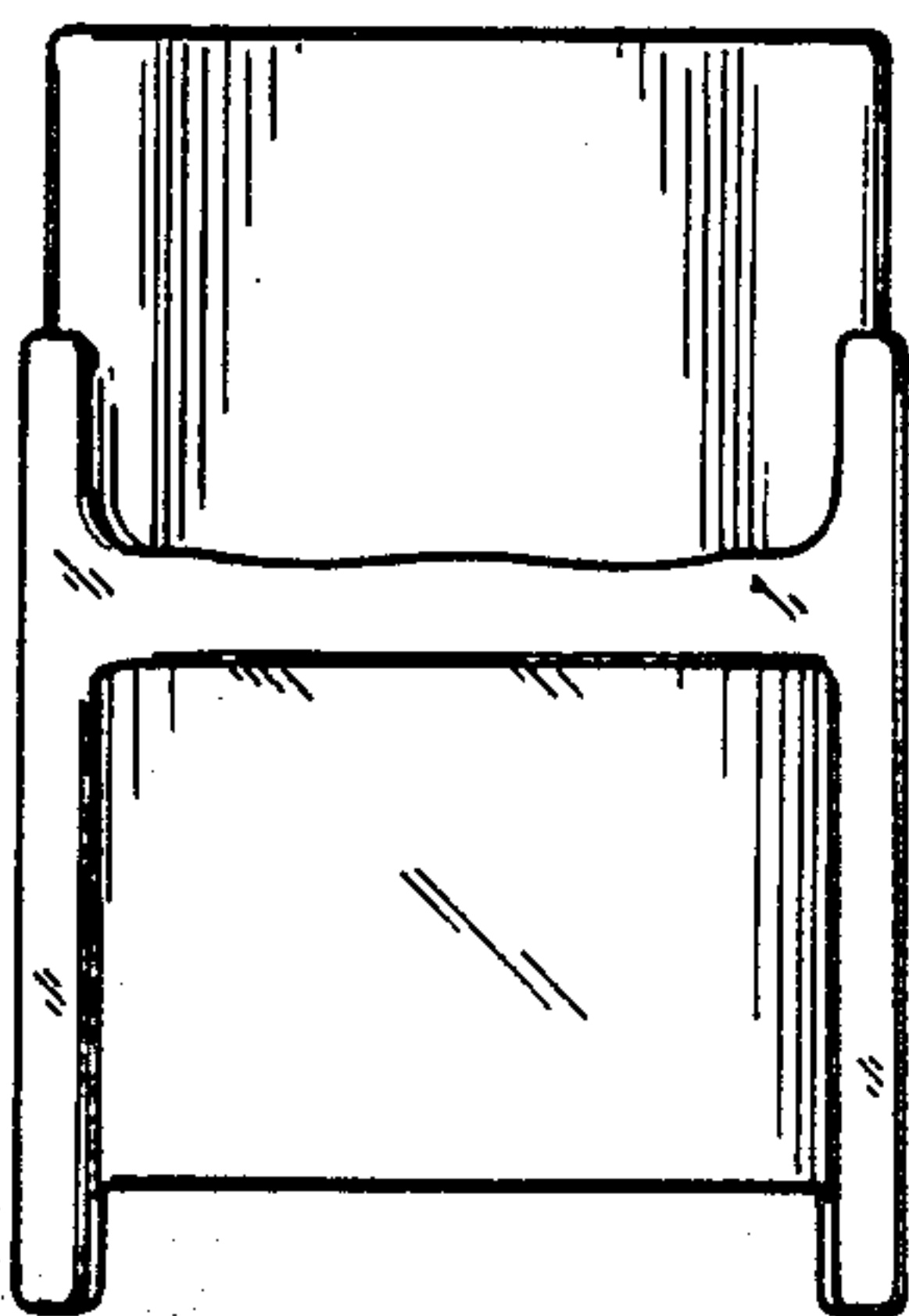

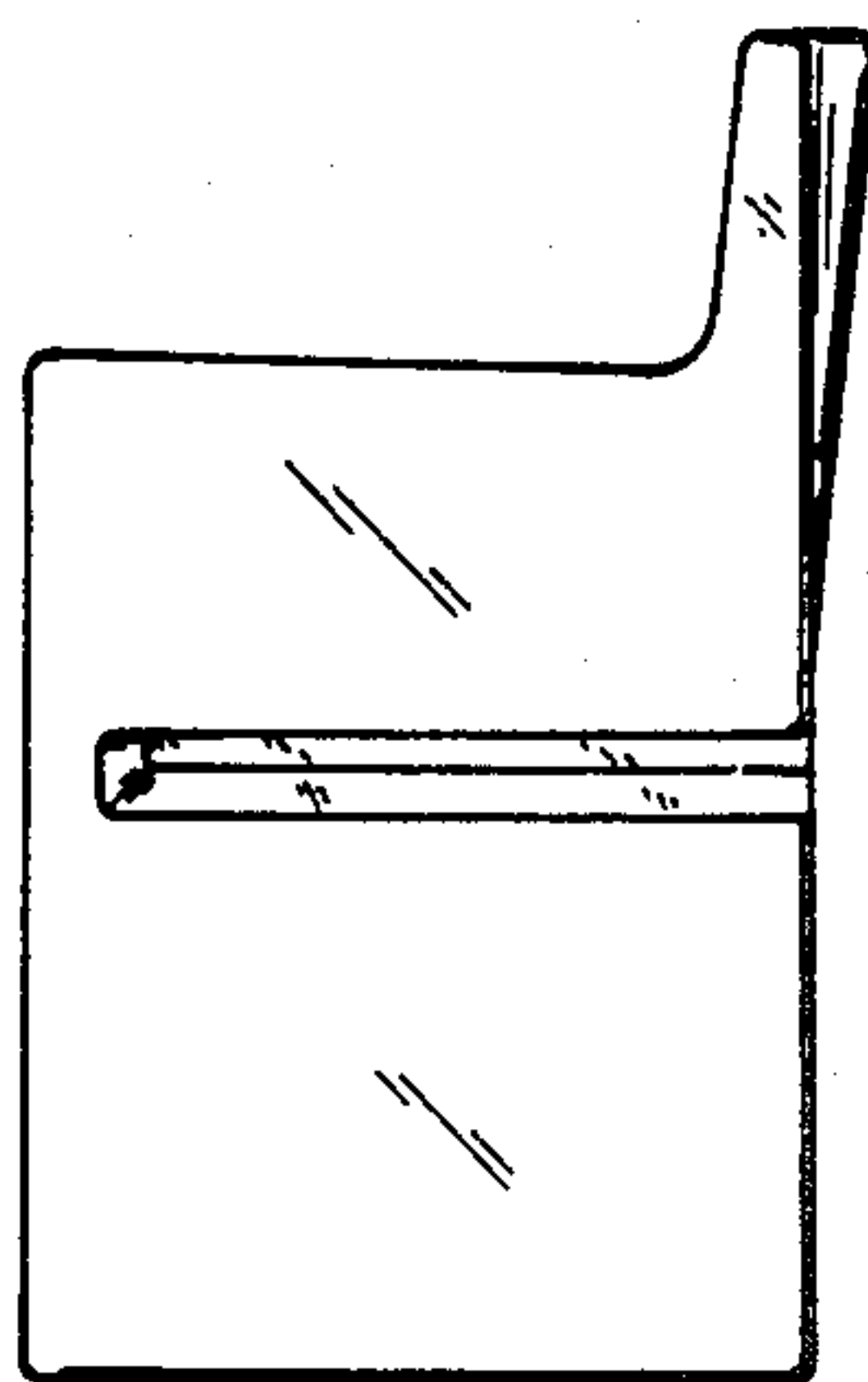

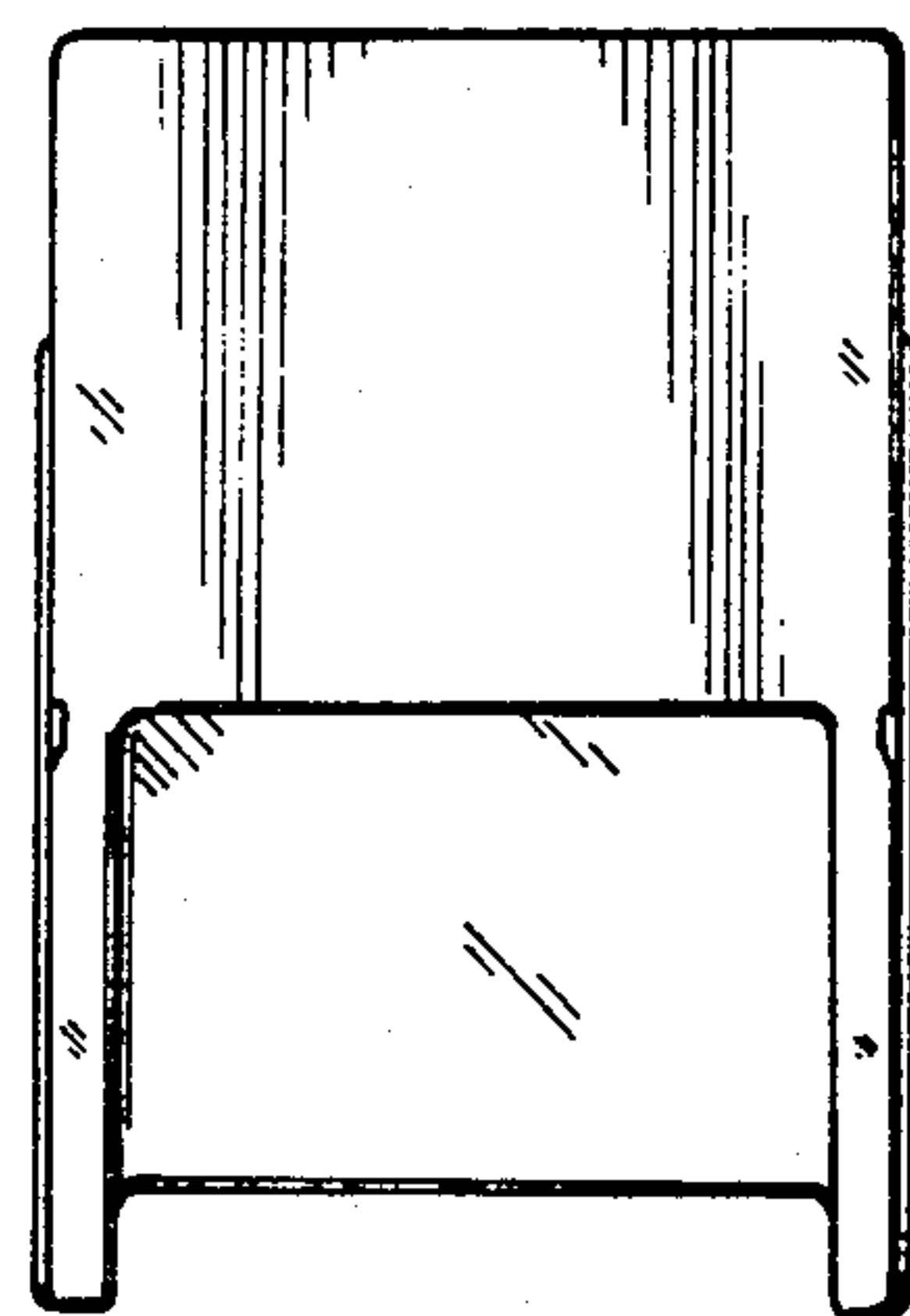

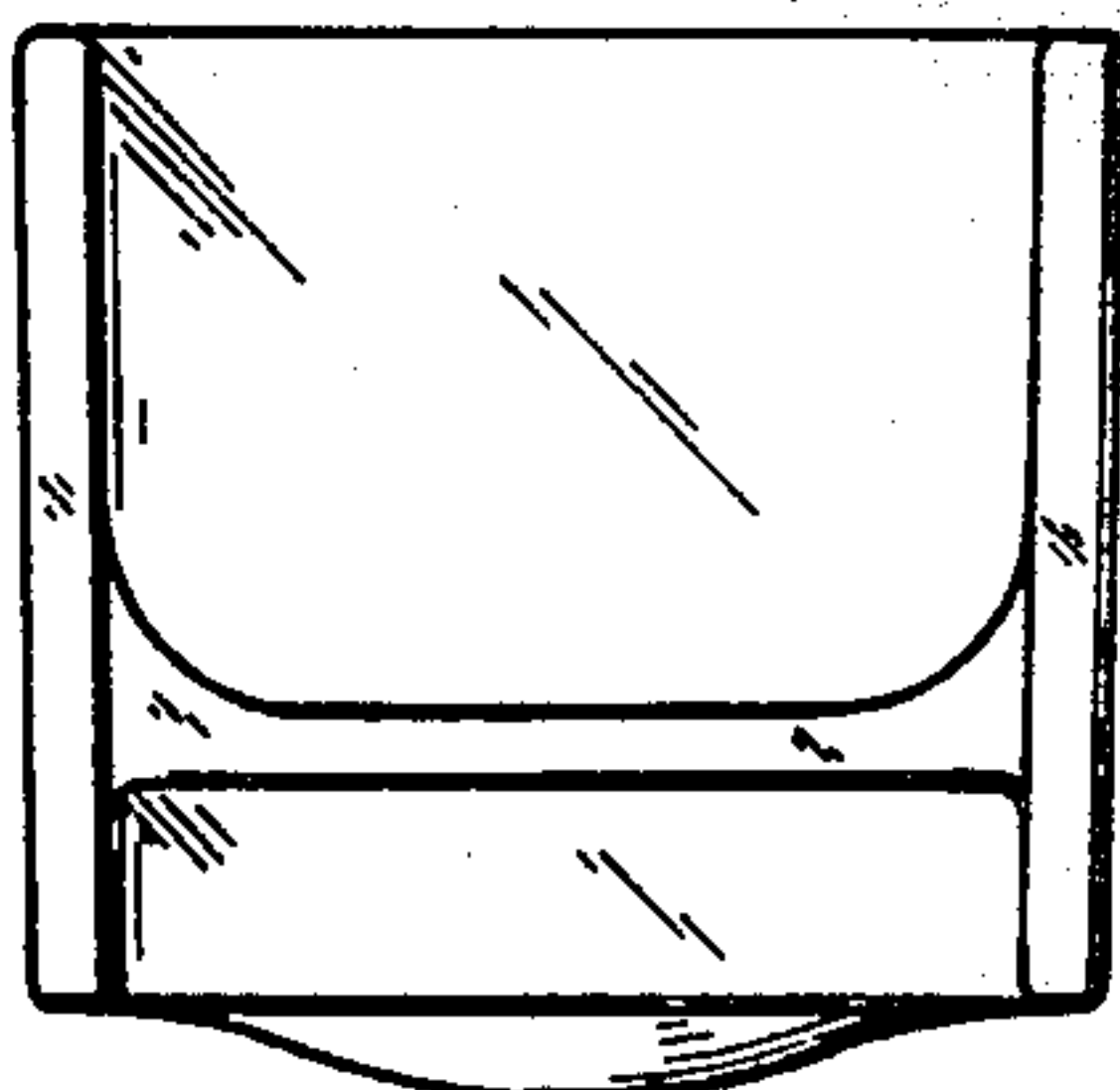
