**DESCRIPTION**

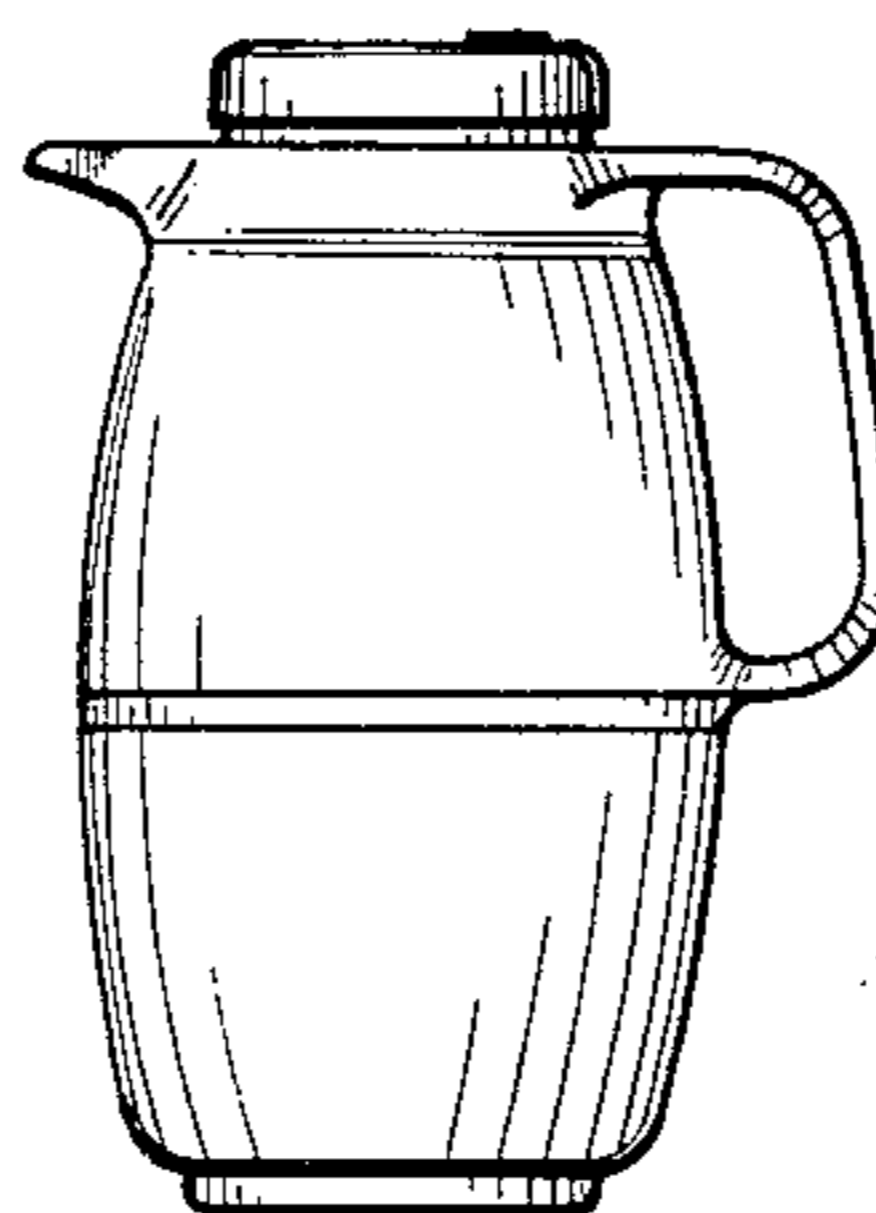
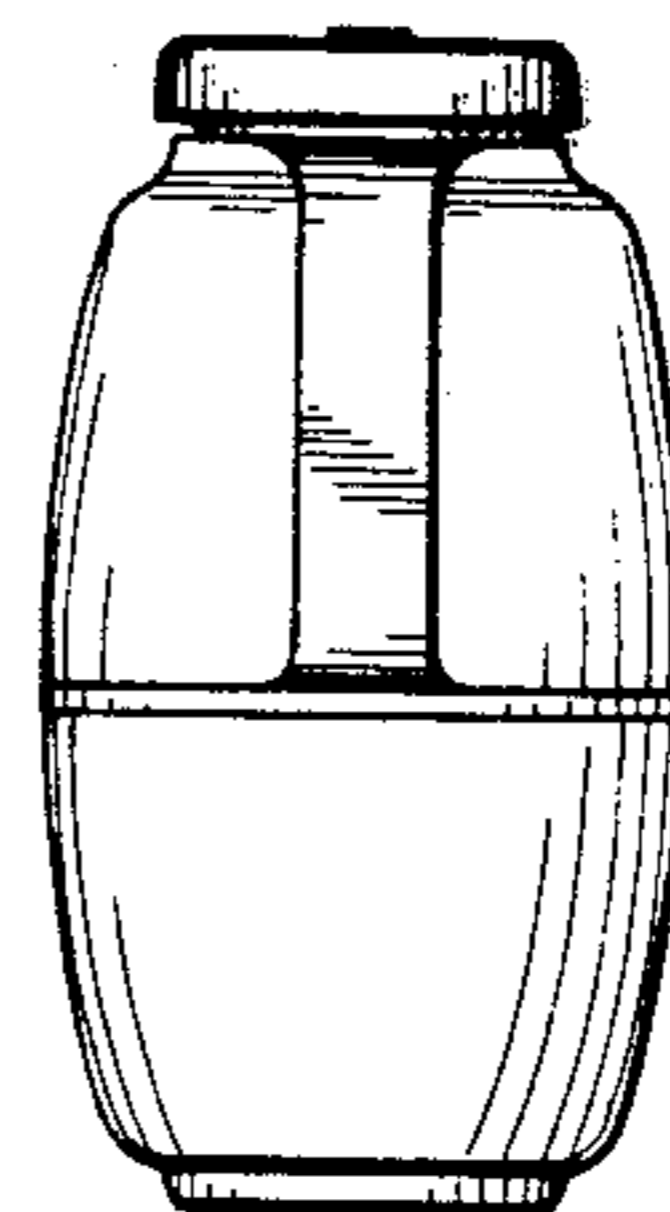
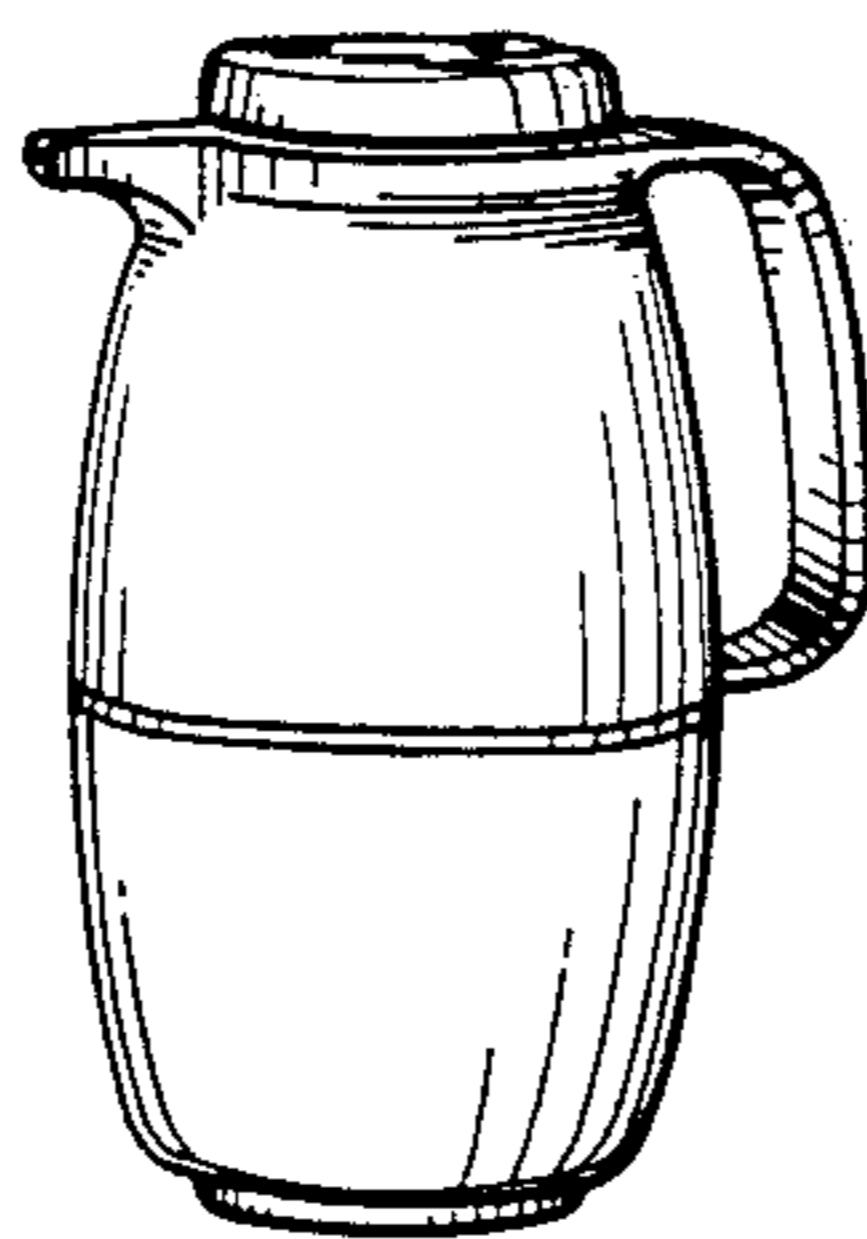
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an insulated jug showing

void of ornamentation.



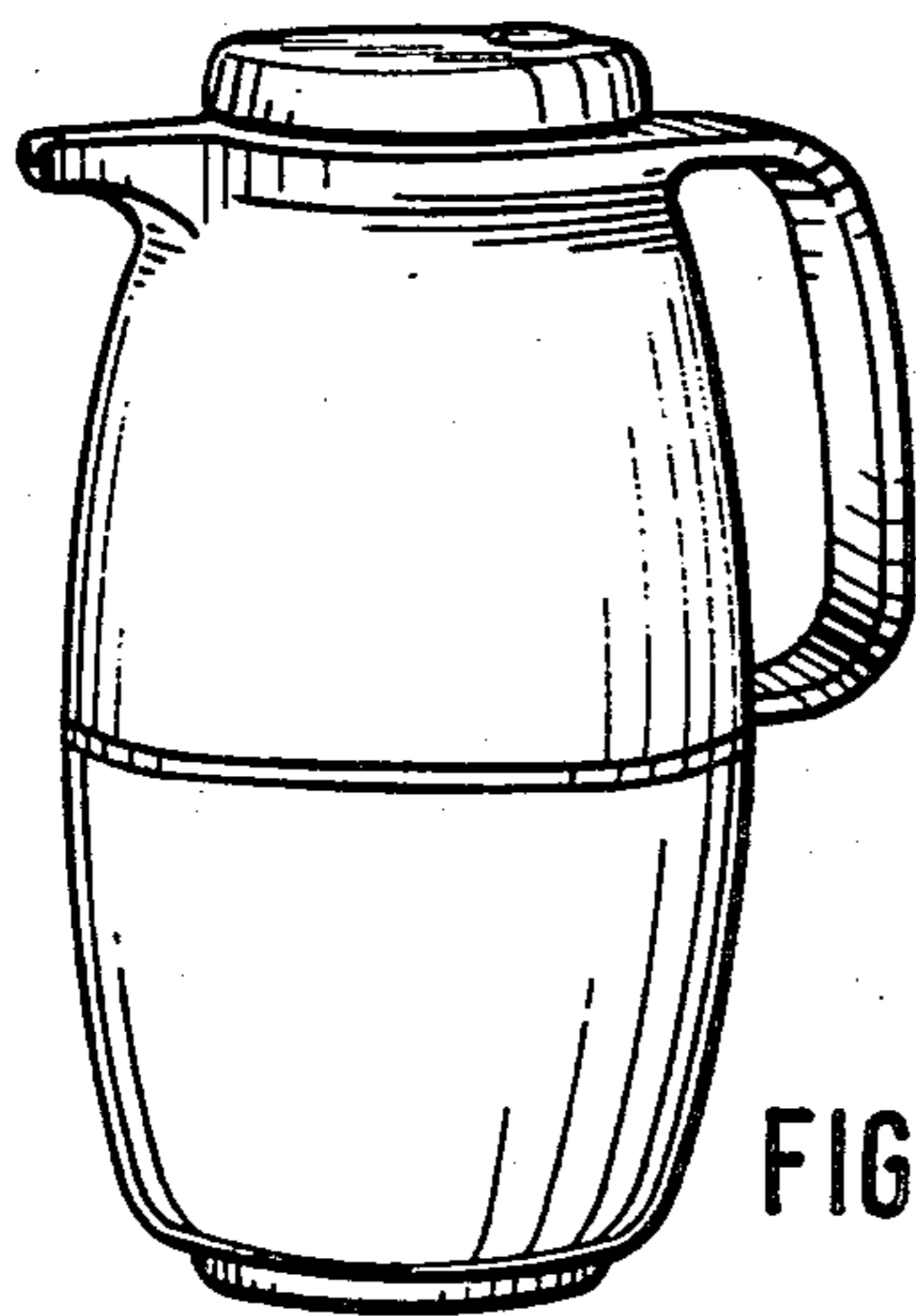

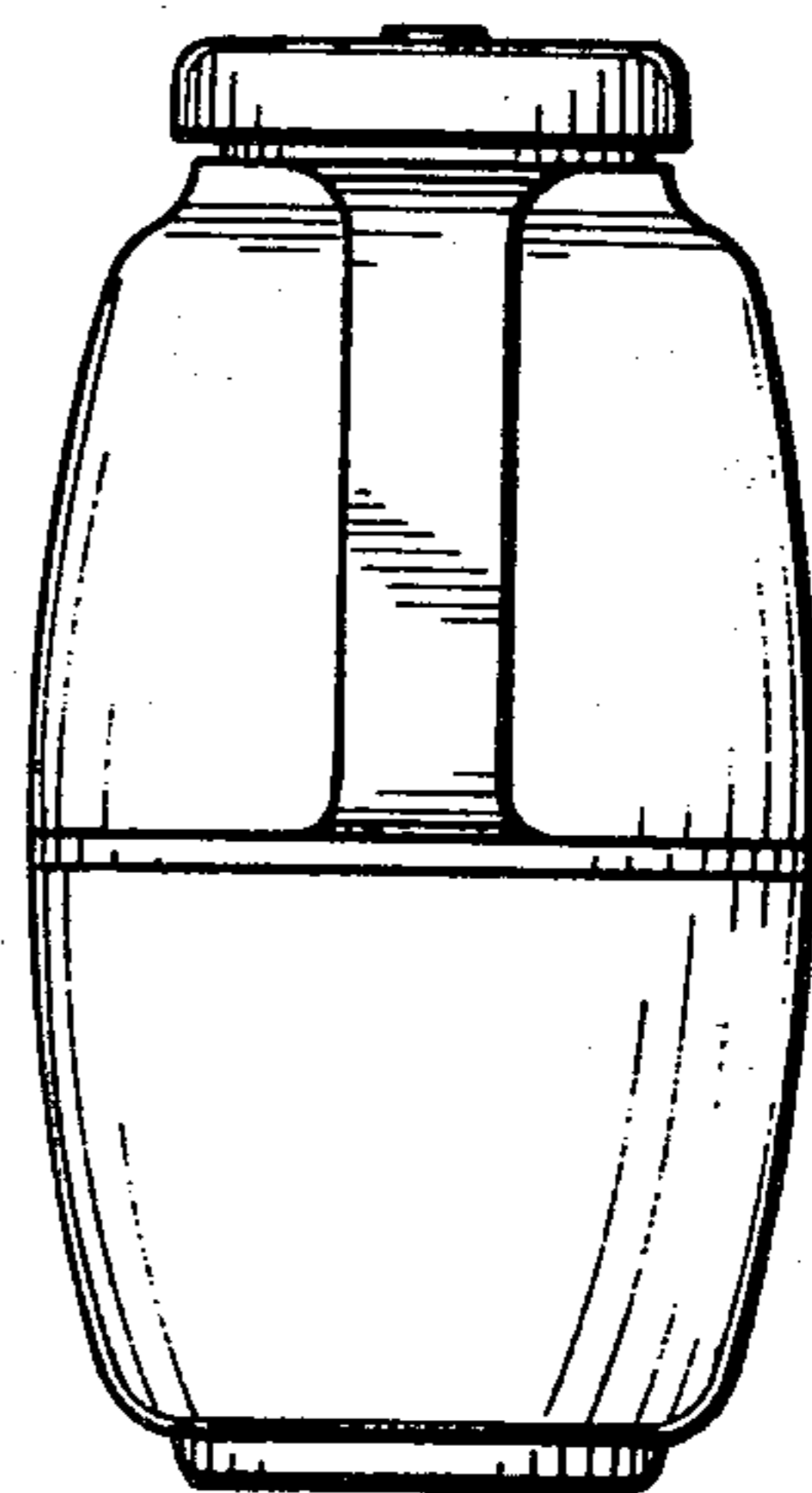

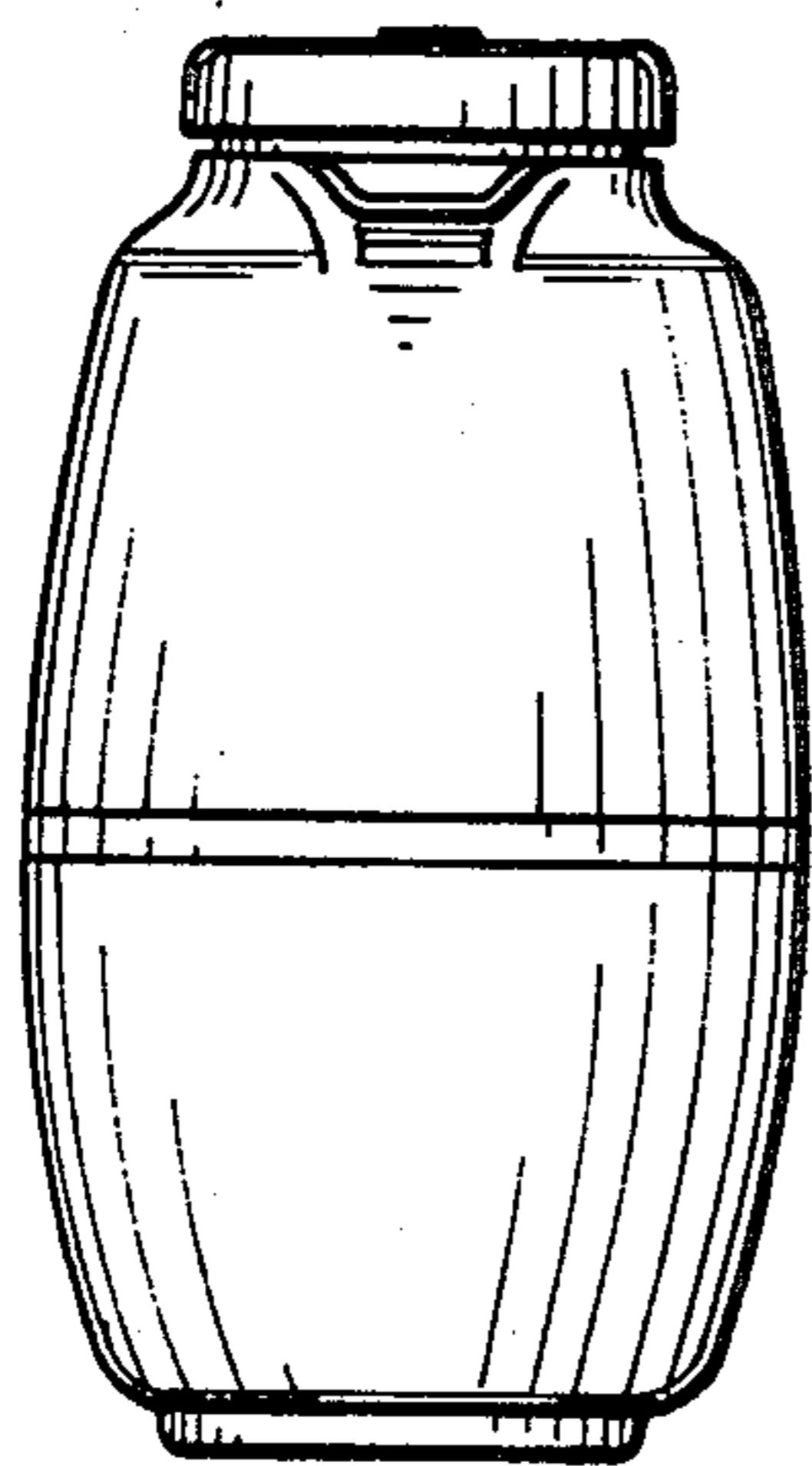

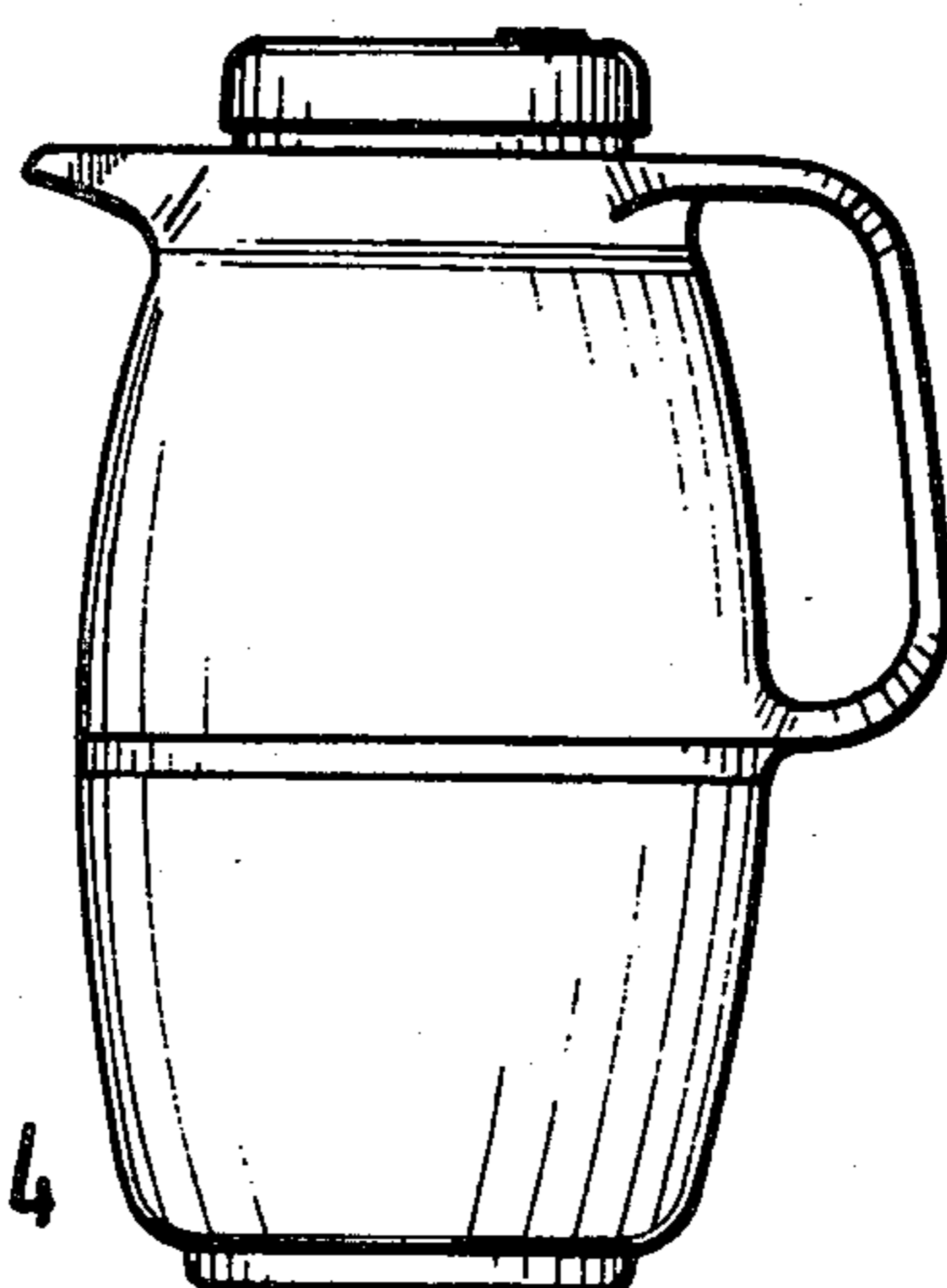

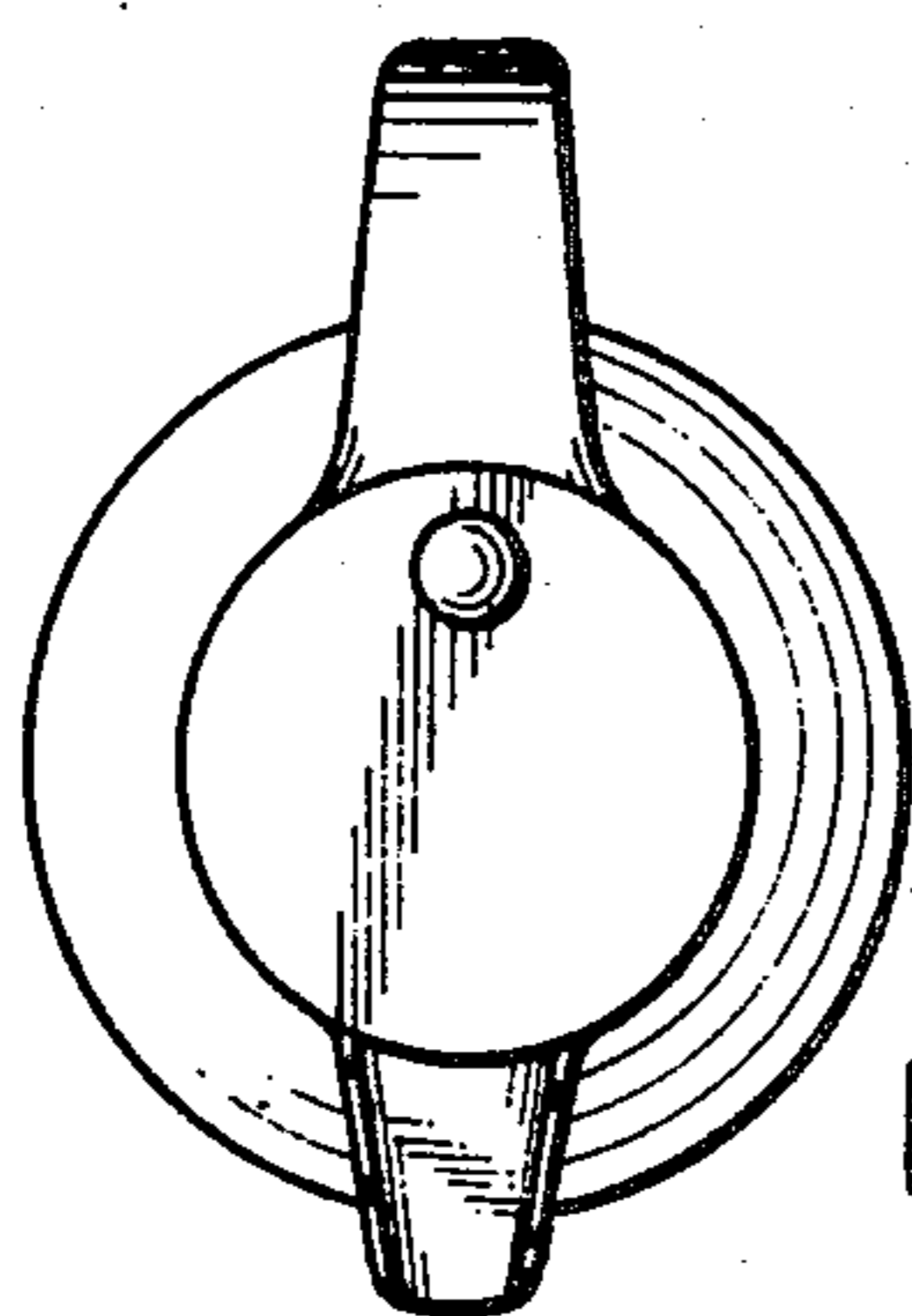
