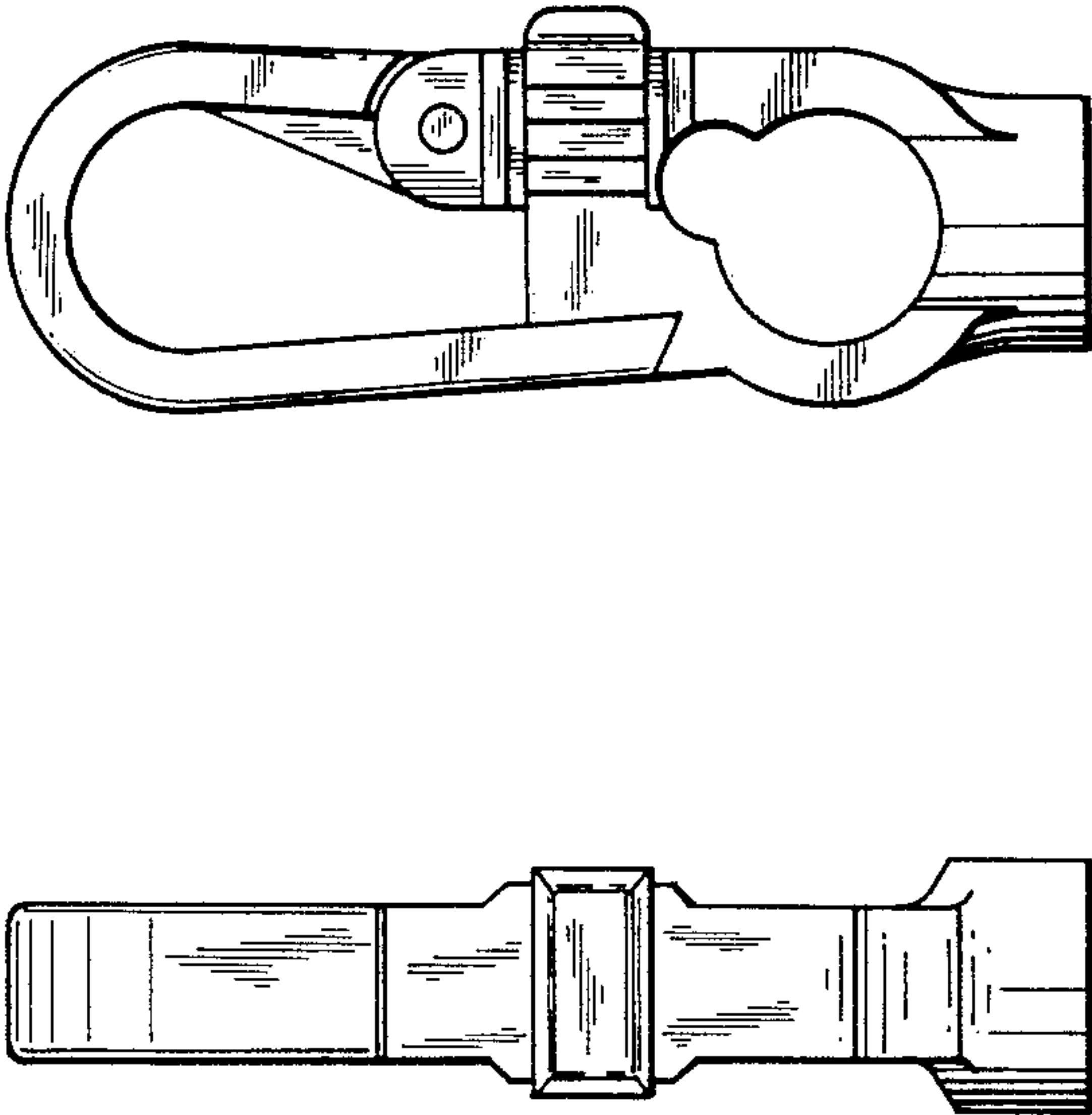

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 15 is a right end view of FIG. 11.



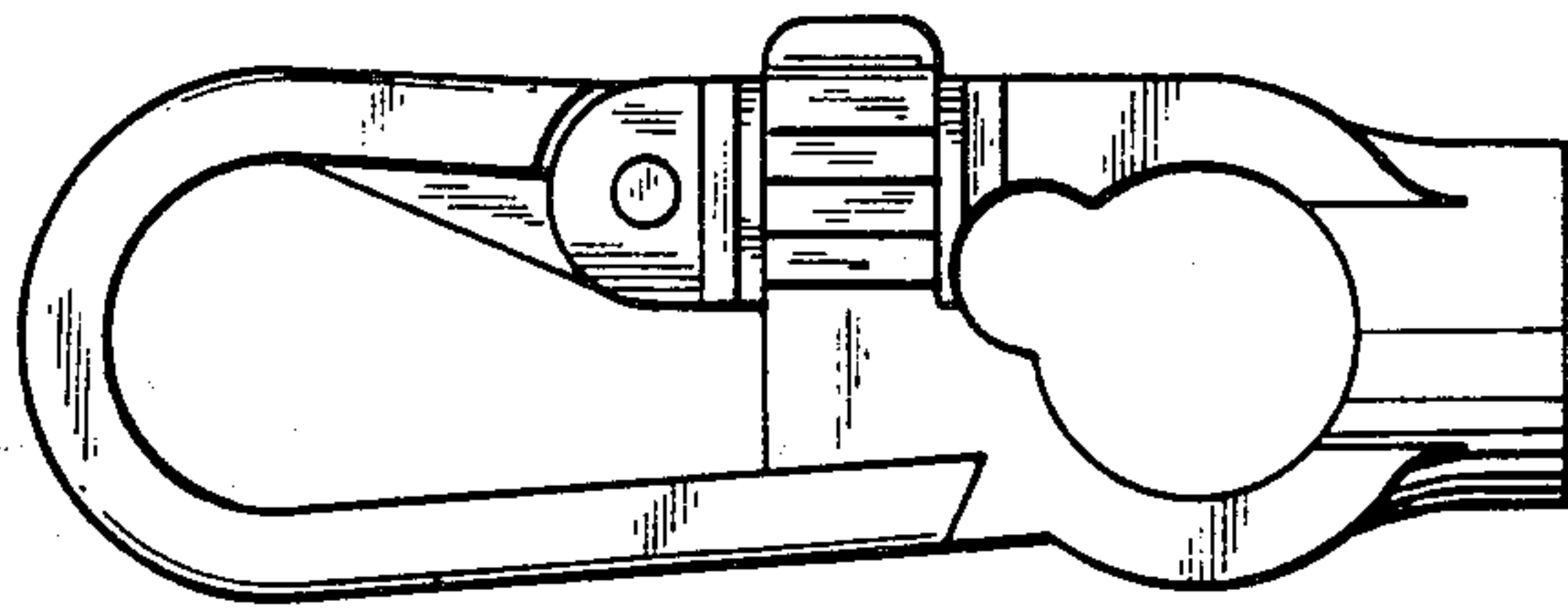

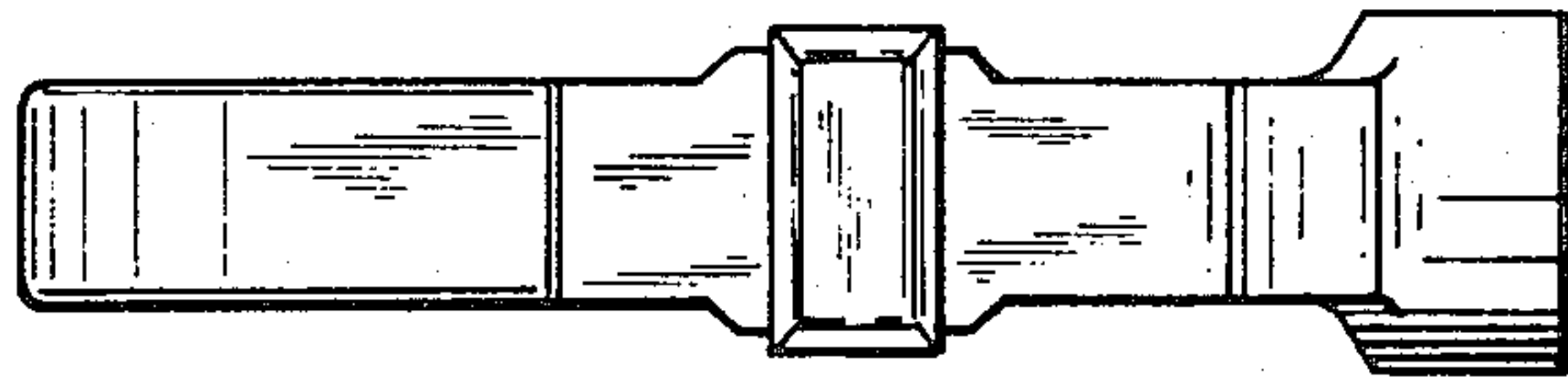

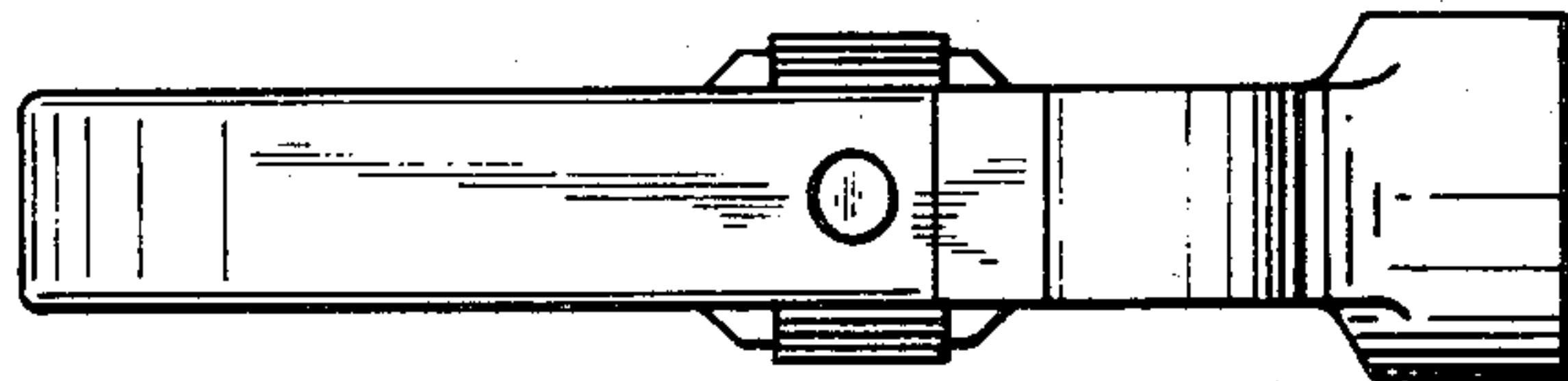

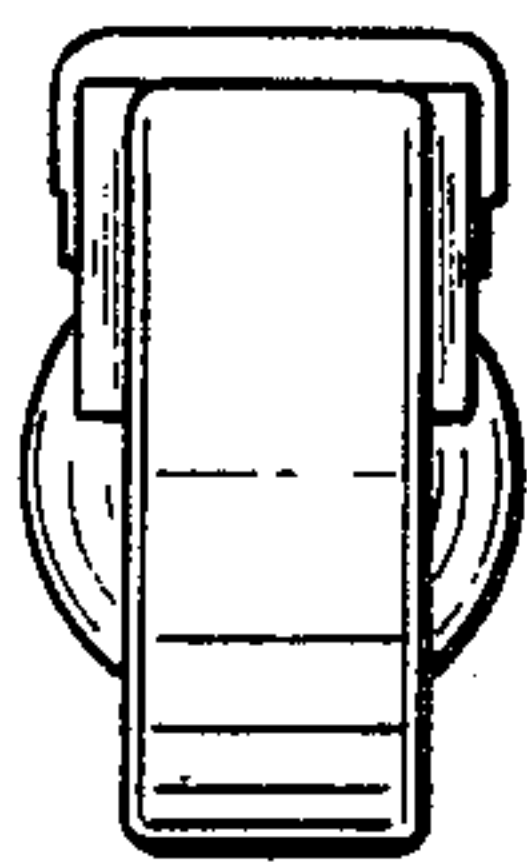

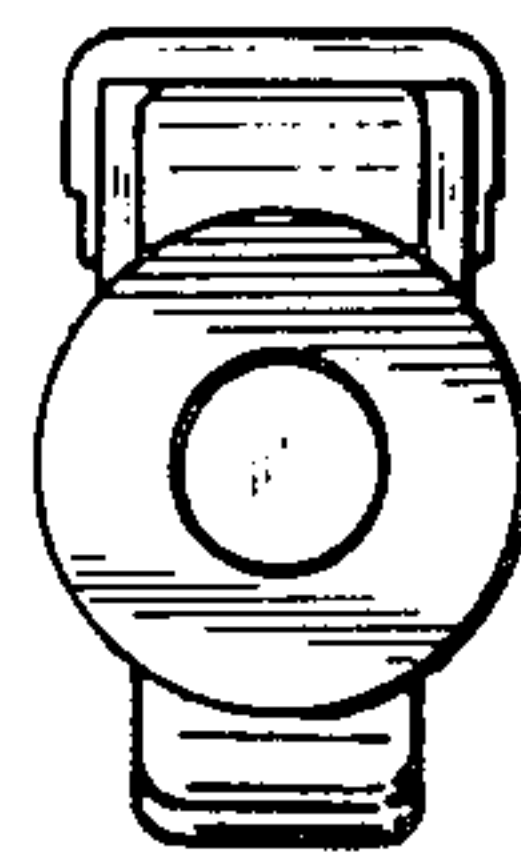

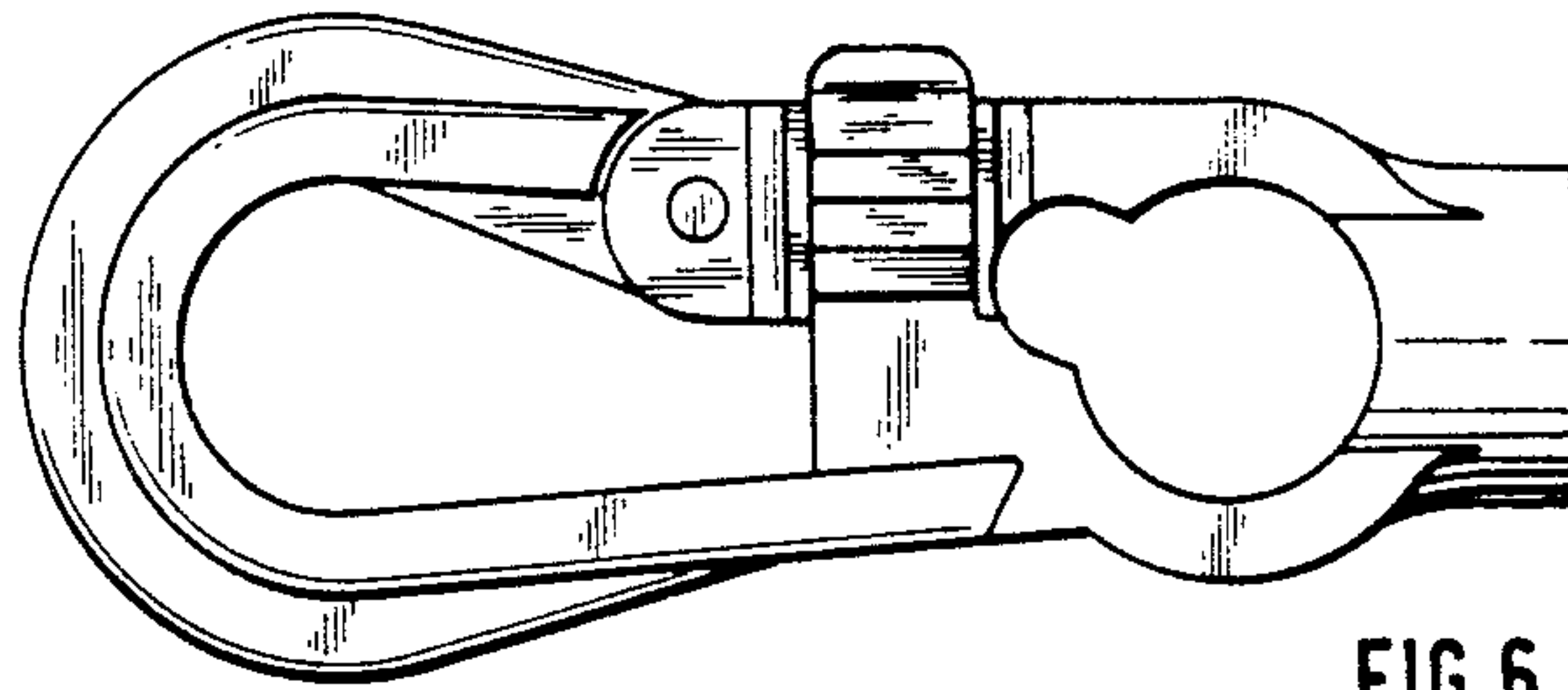

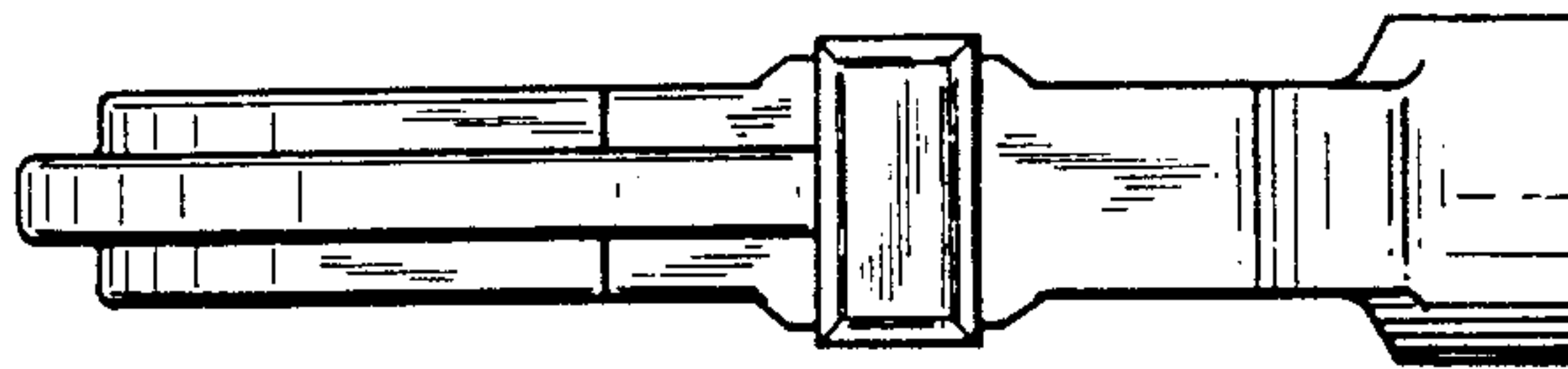

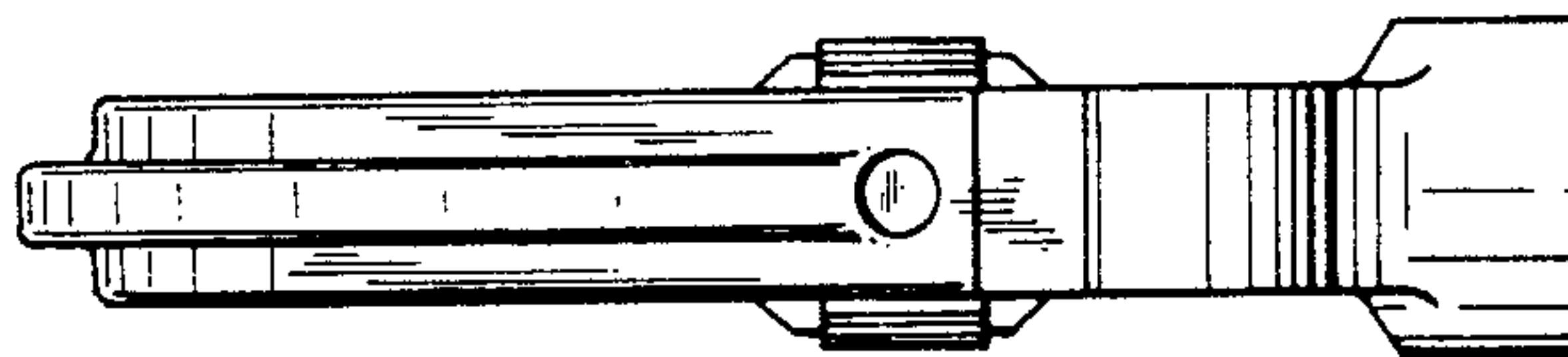

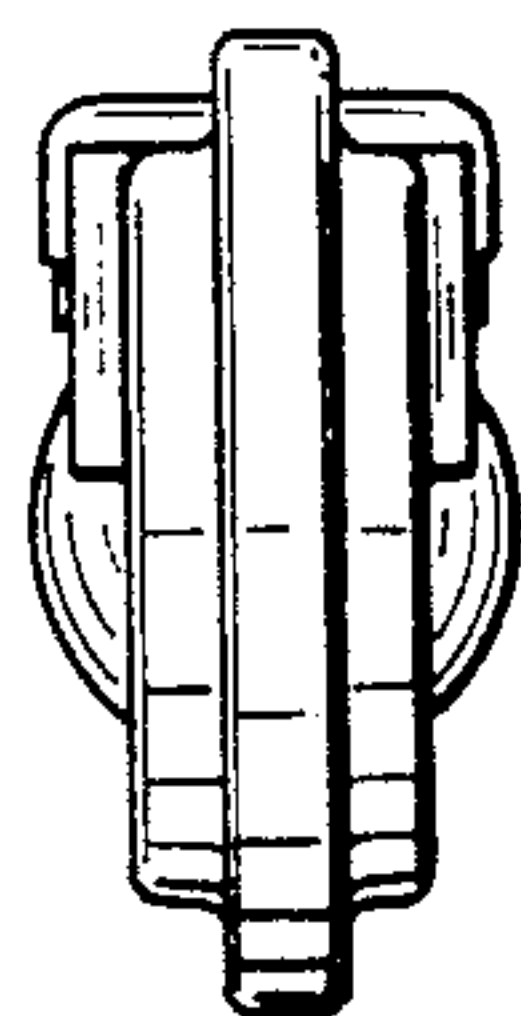

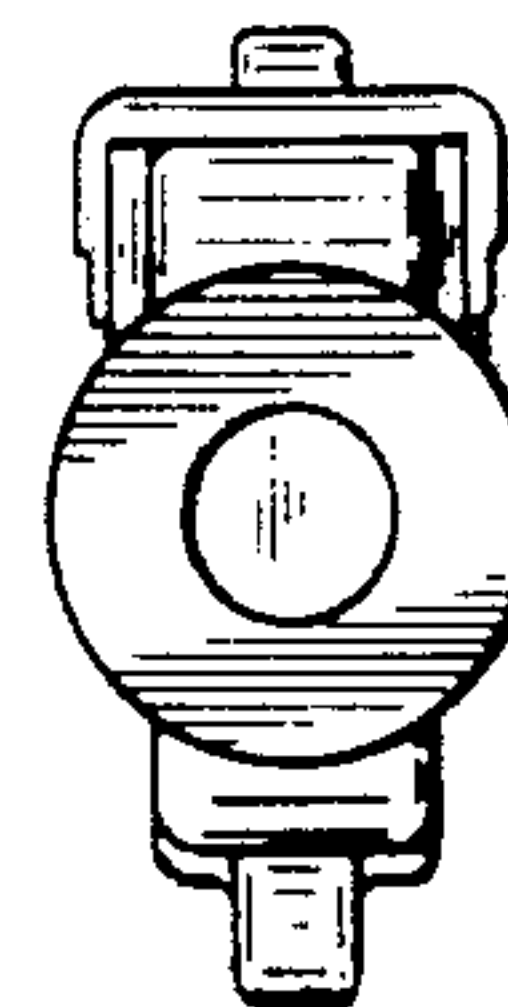
