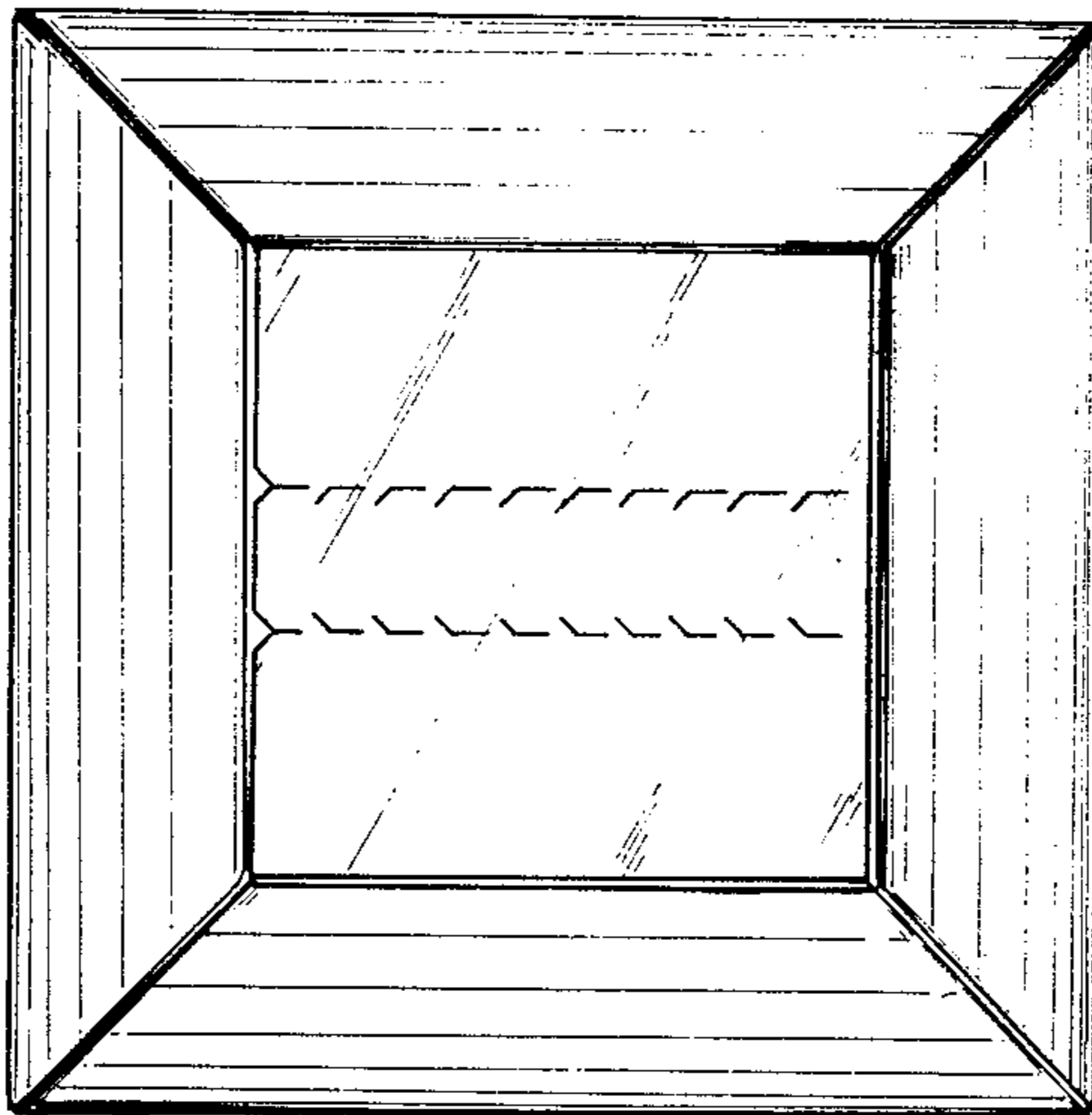

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a microwave cooking carton showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side and rear being the same in appearance;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



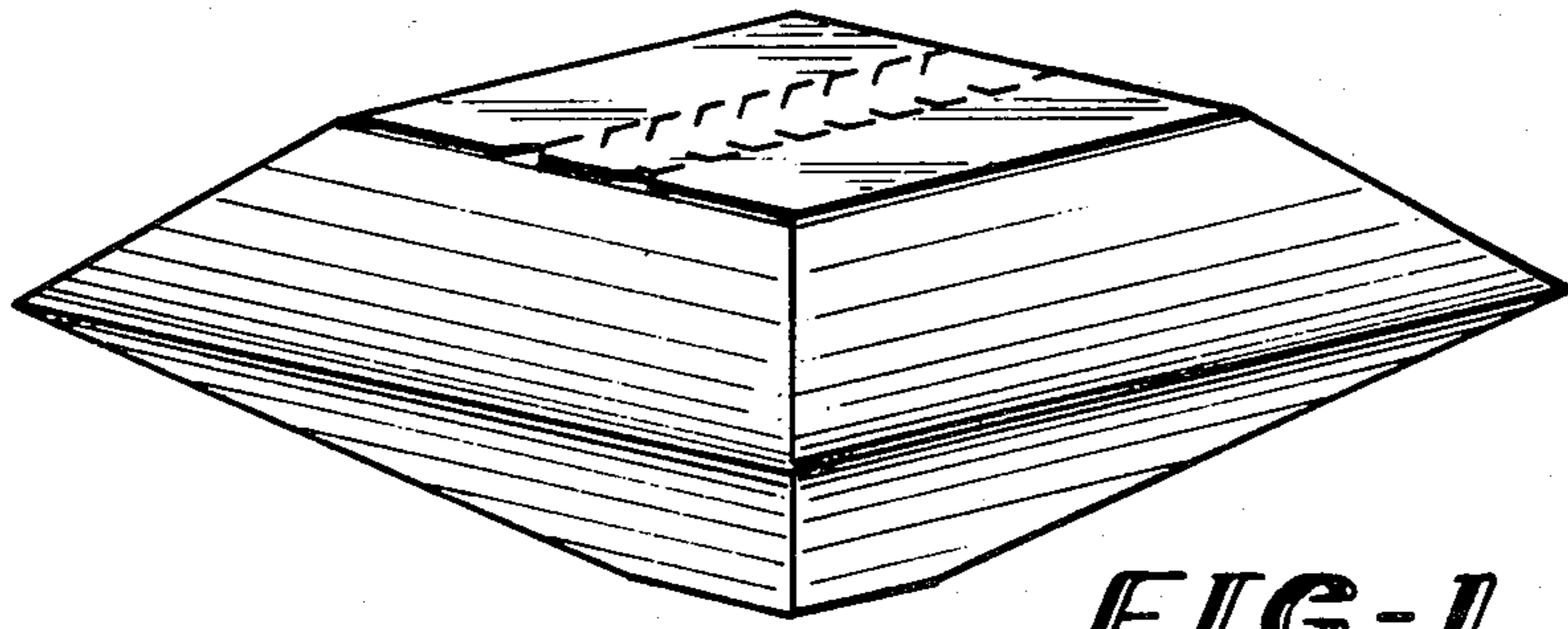

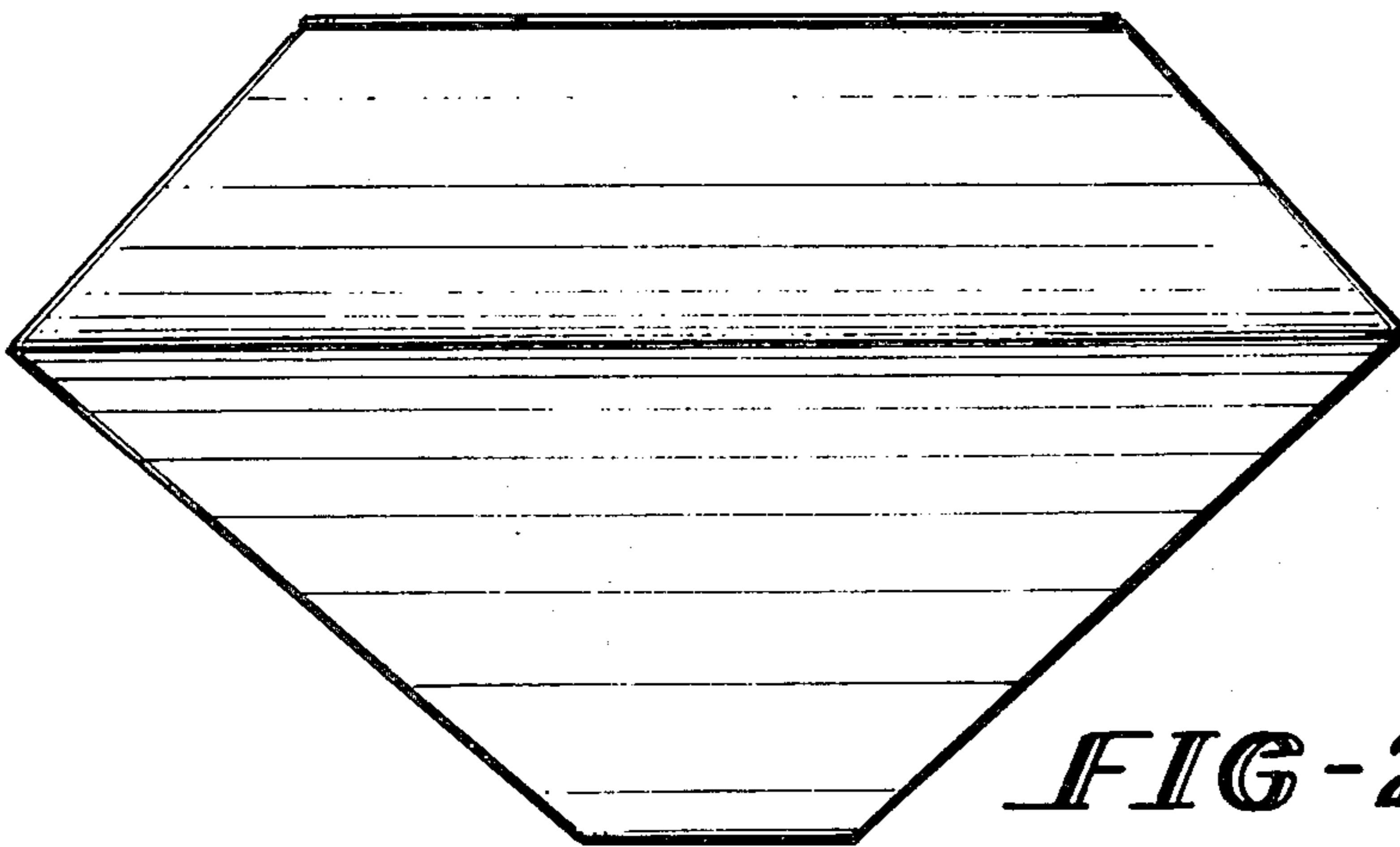

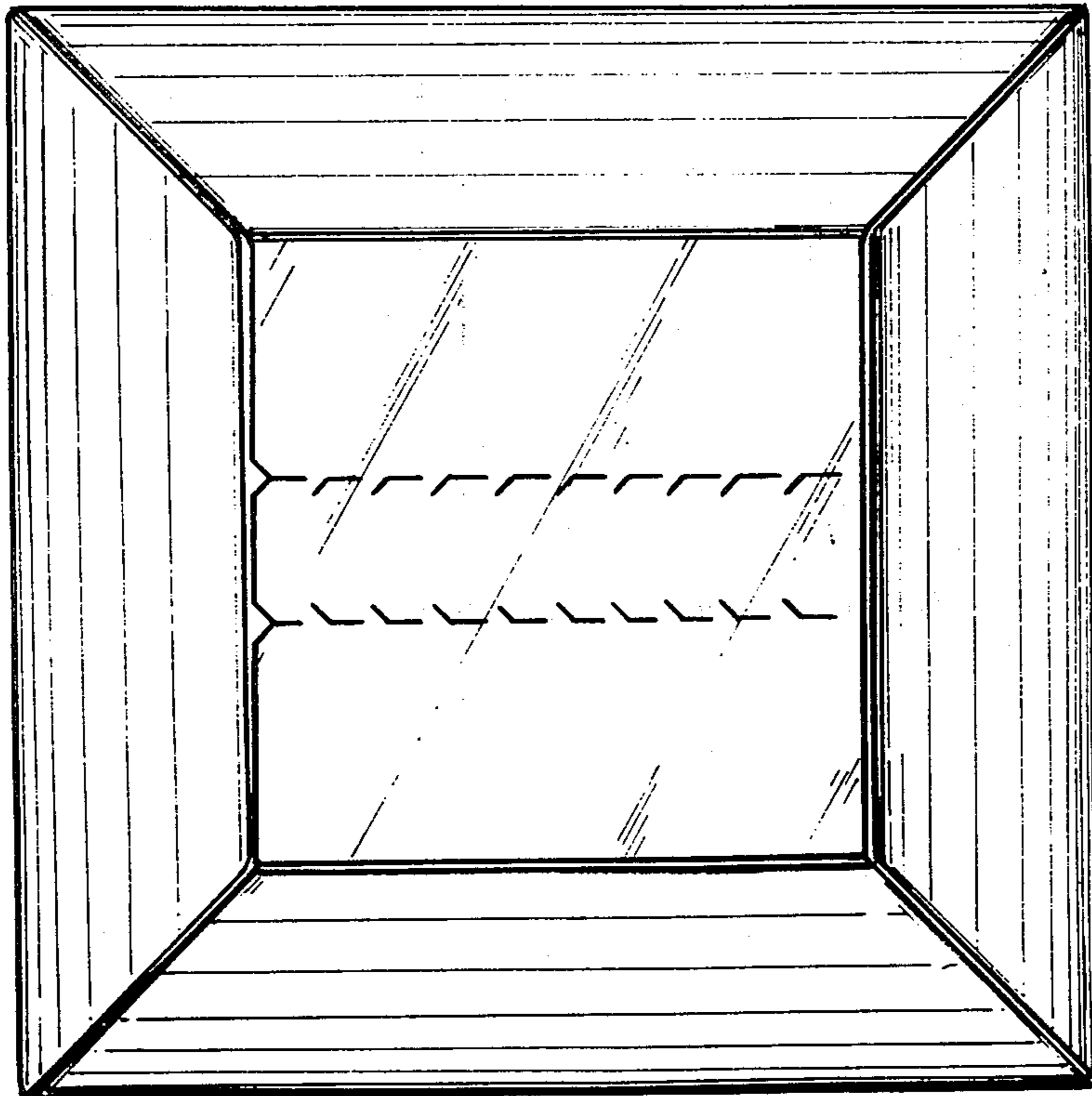

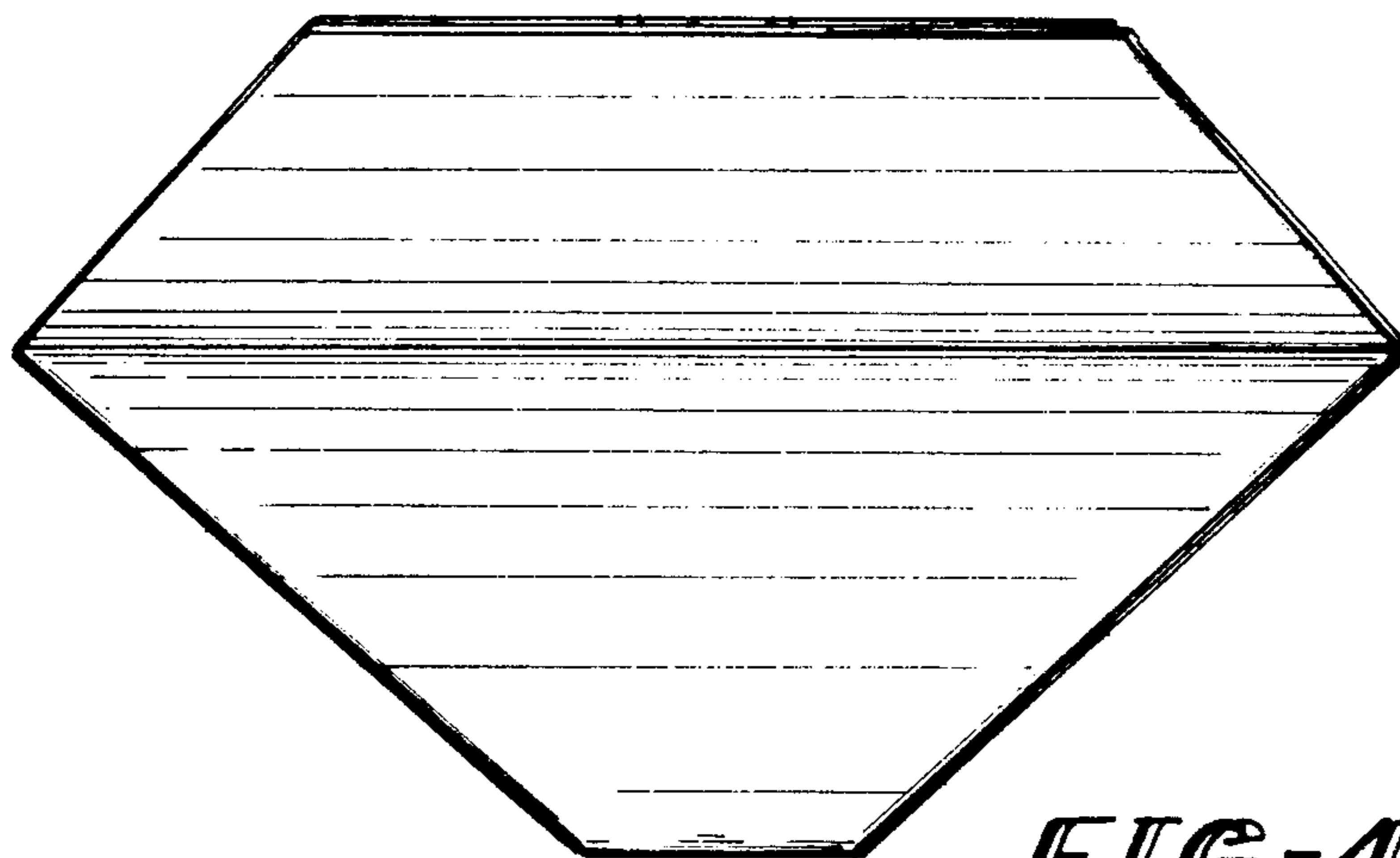

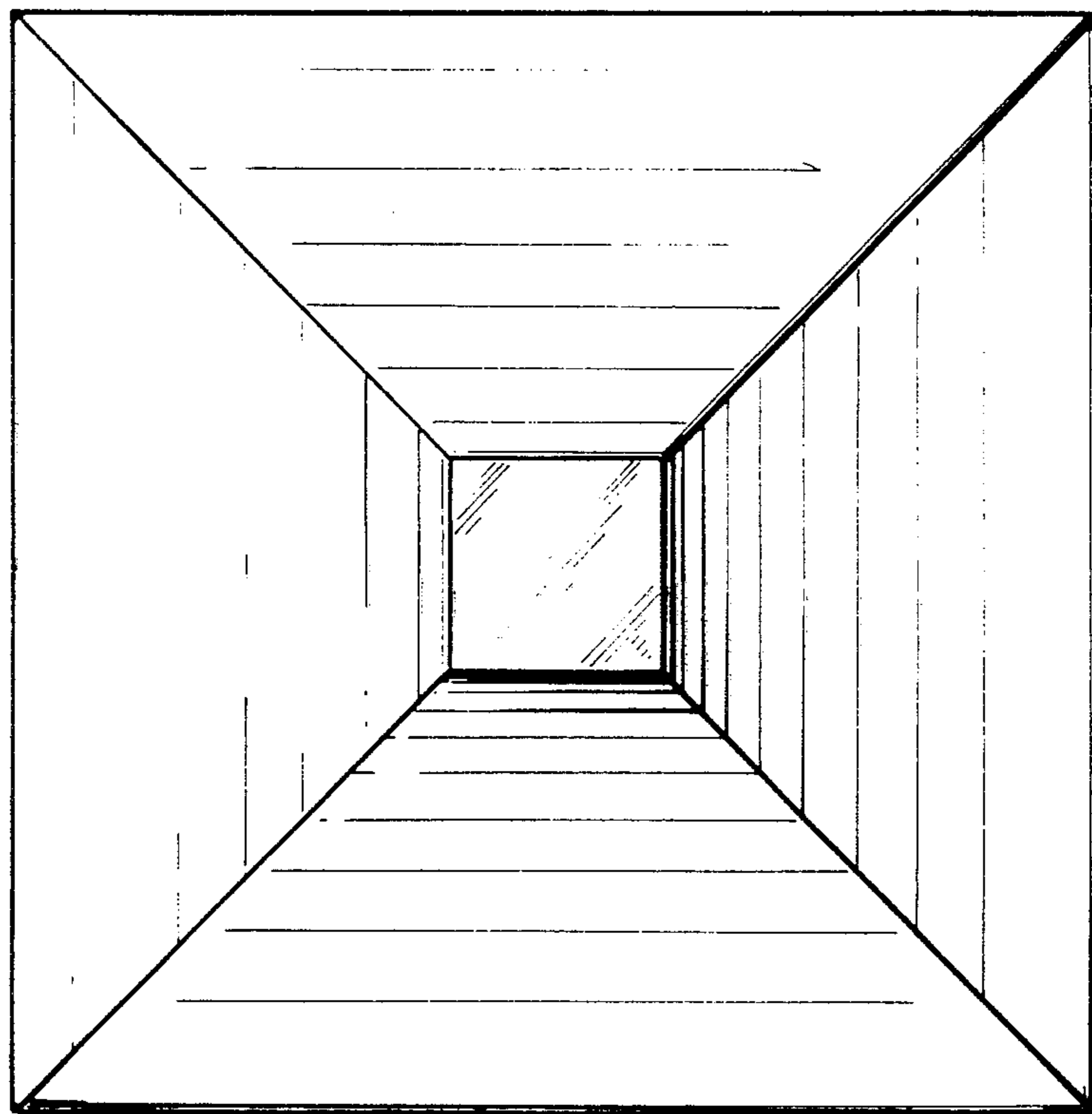
