DESCRIPTION

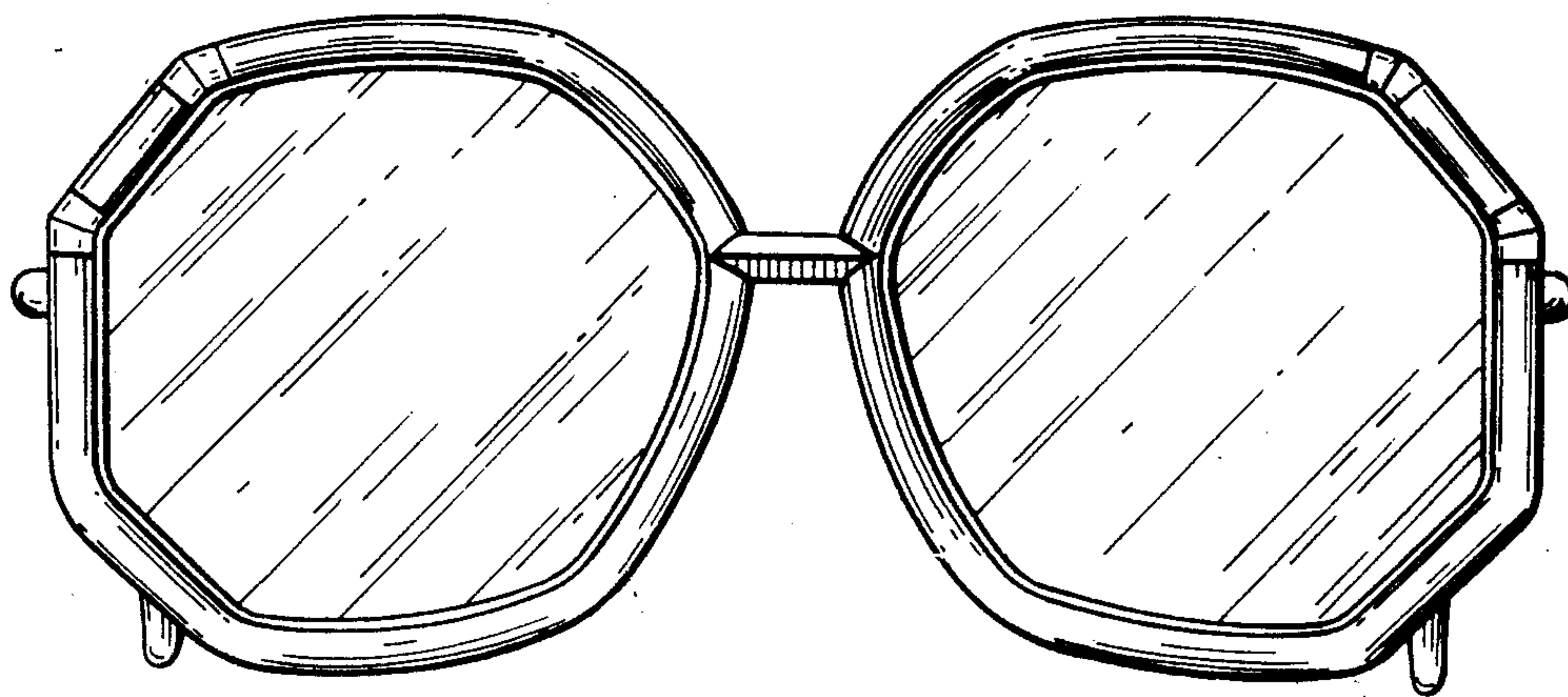
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of sunglasses showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof shown on a reduced scale, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof.



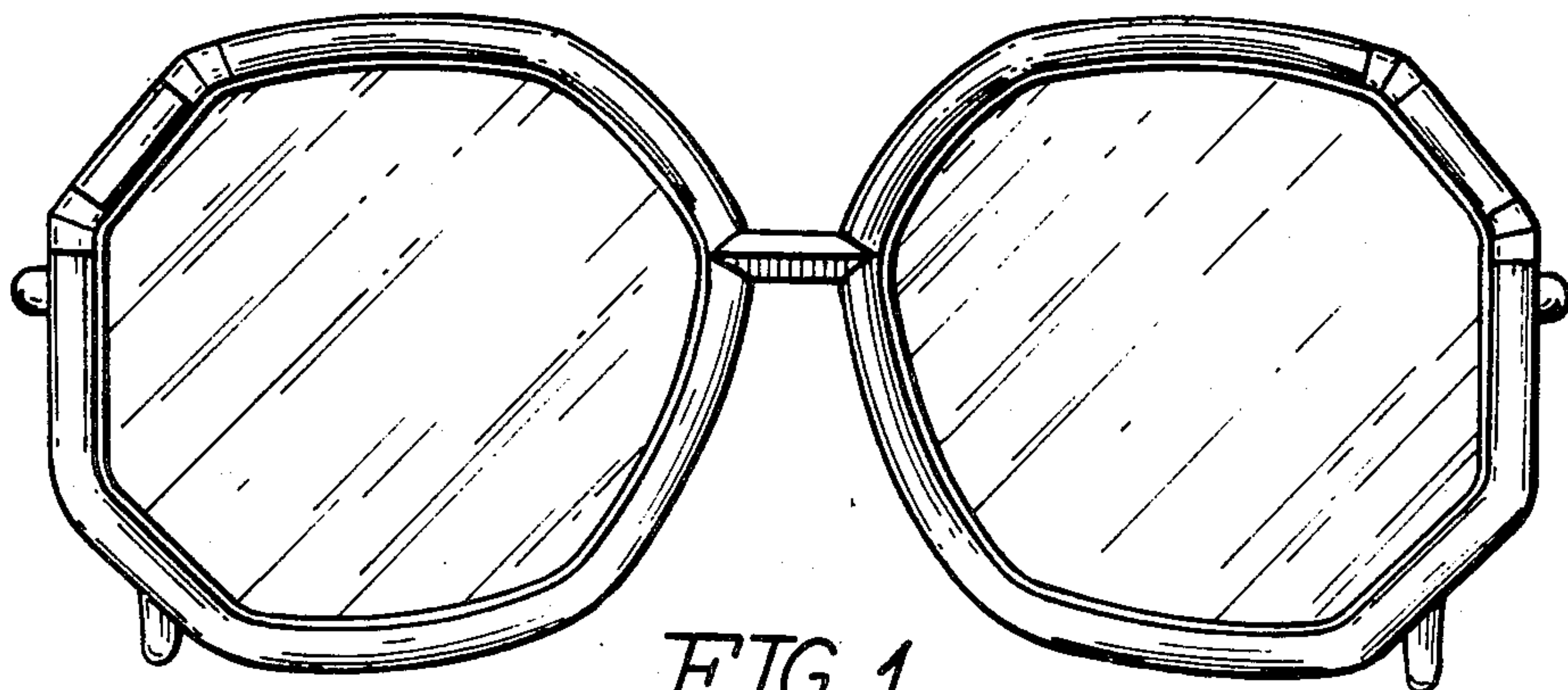

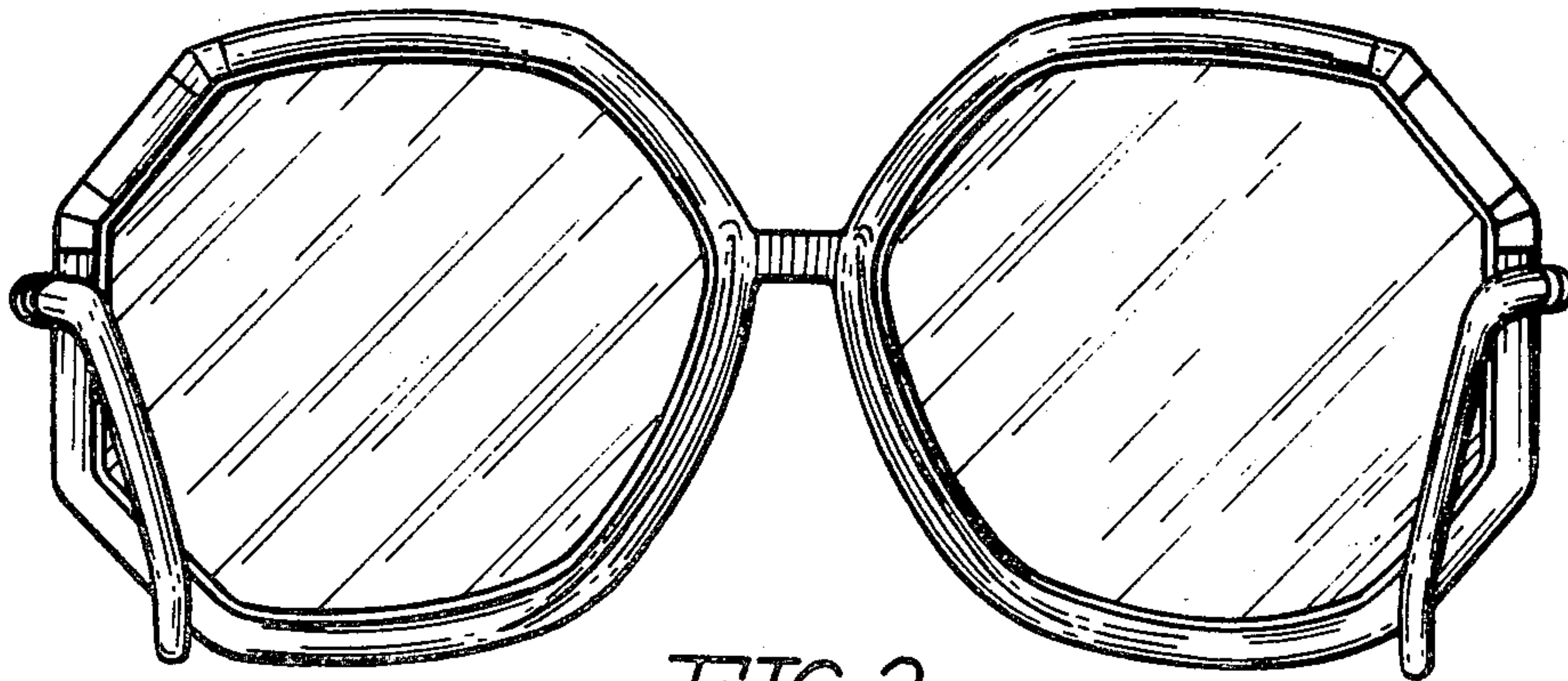

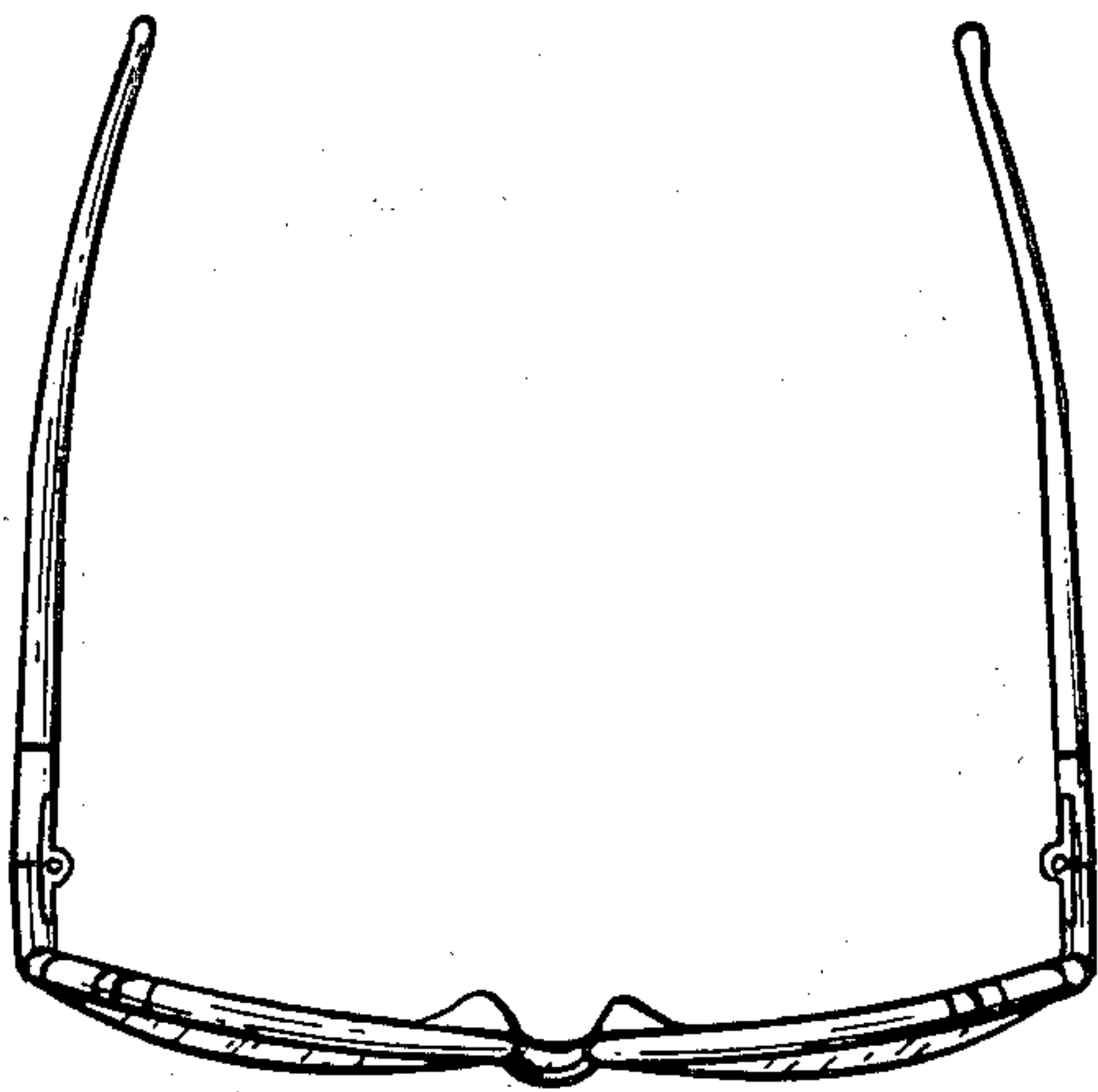

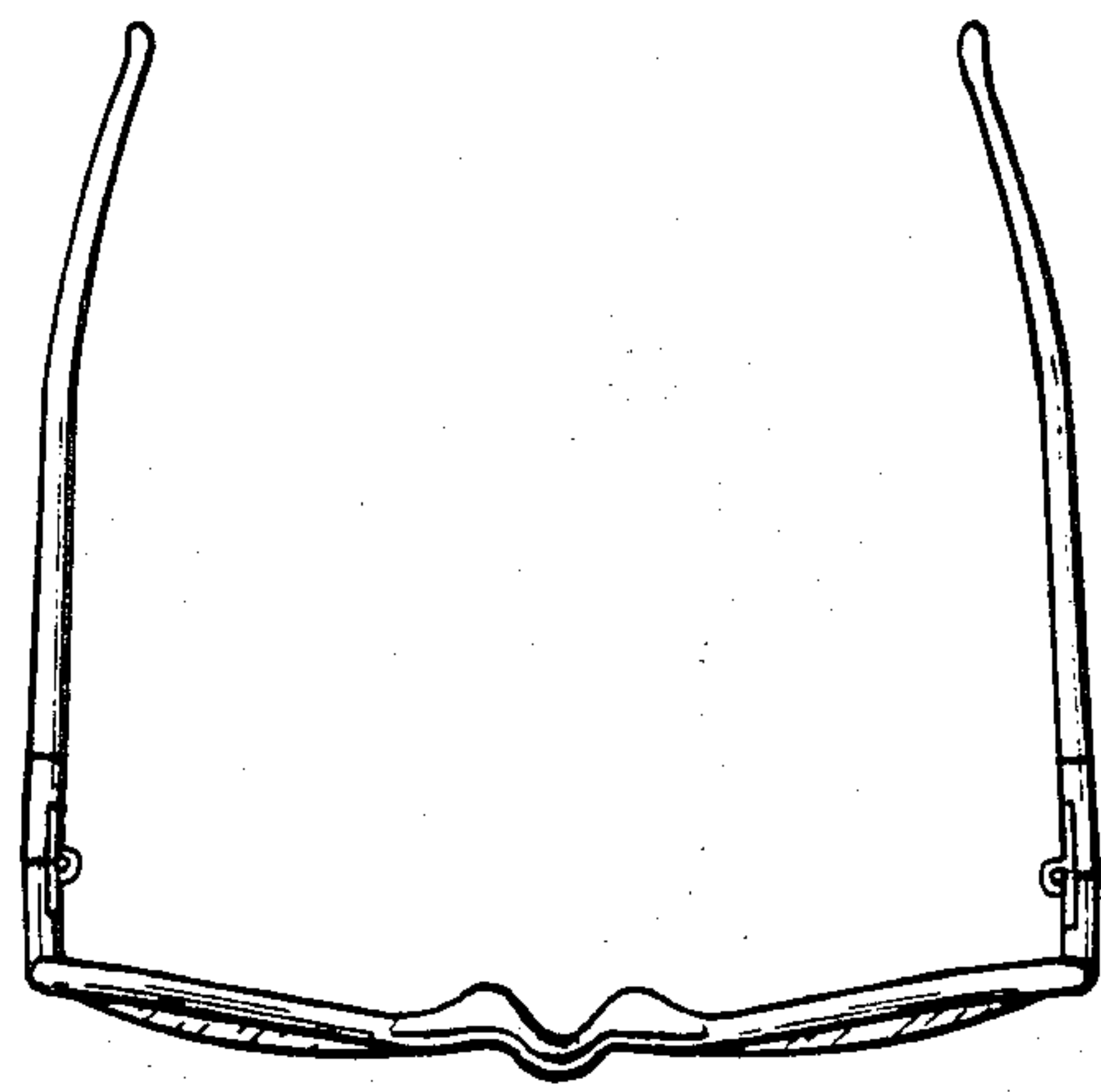

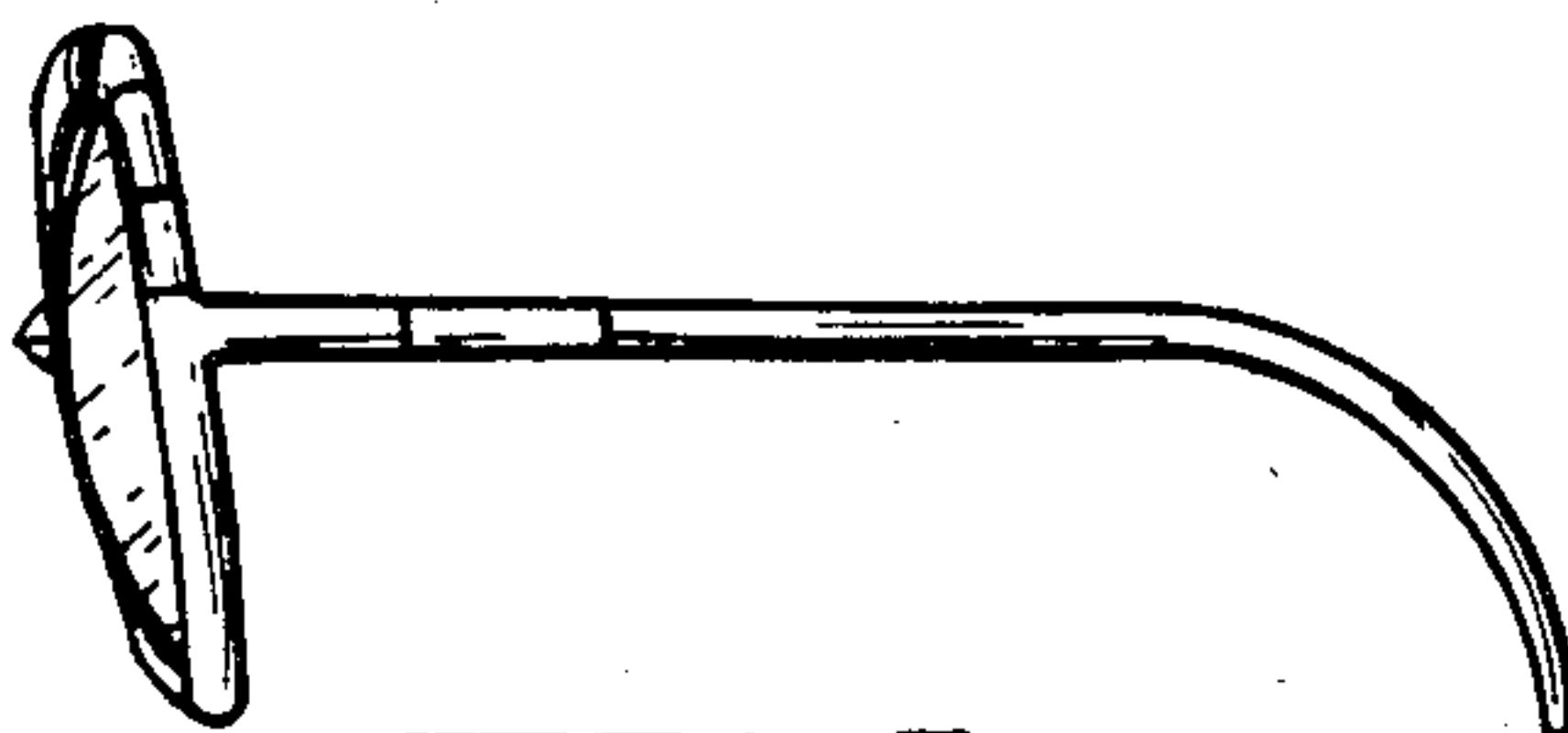
