creeper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of the foldable and
convertible creeper showing my new design, in its ex-
tended condition with the seat folded.

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

folded condition, with the seat extended.



















