DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of the eyeglass temple showing my new design with the lens portion shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof with the lens portion shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front end elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear end elevational view thereof.
