DESCRIPTION

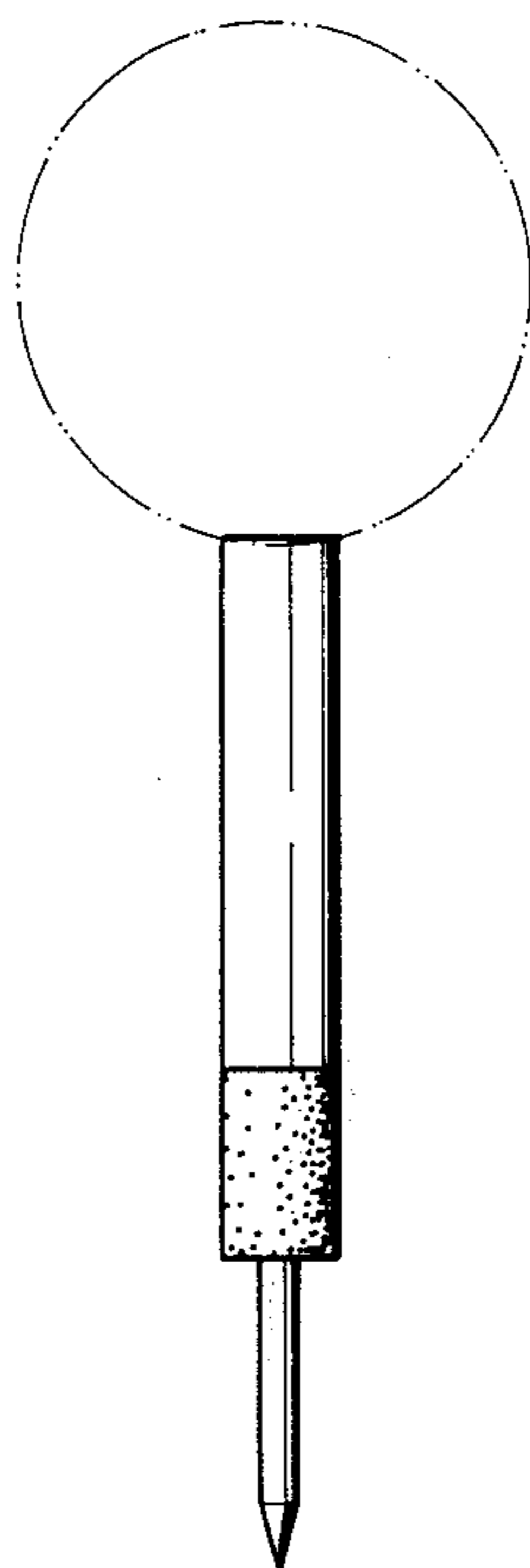
FIG. 1 is a perspective of the golf tee resembling cigarette showing my new design;

The broken line showing of a golf ball is for illustrative purposes only.



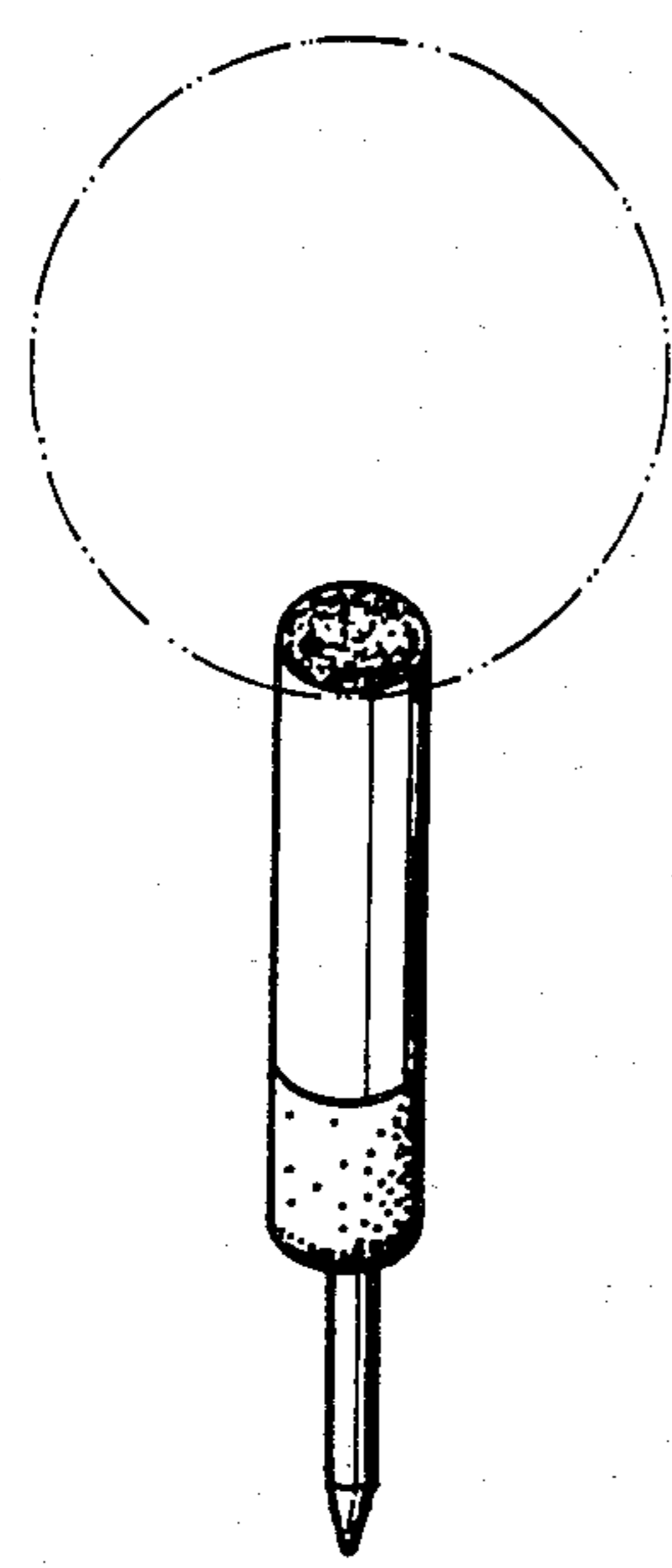

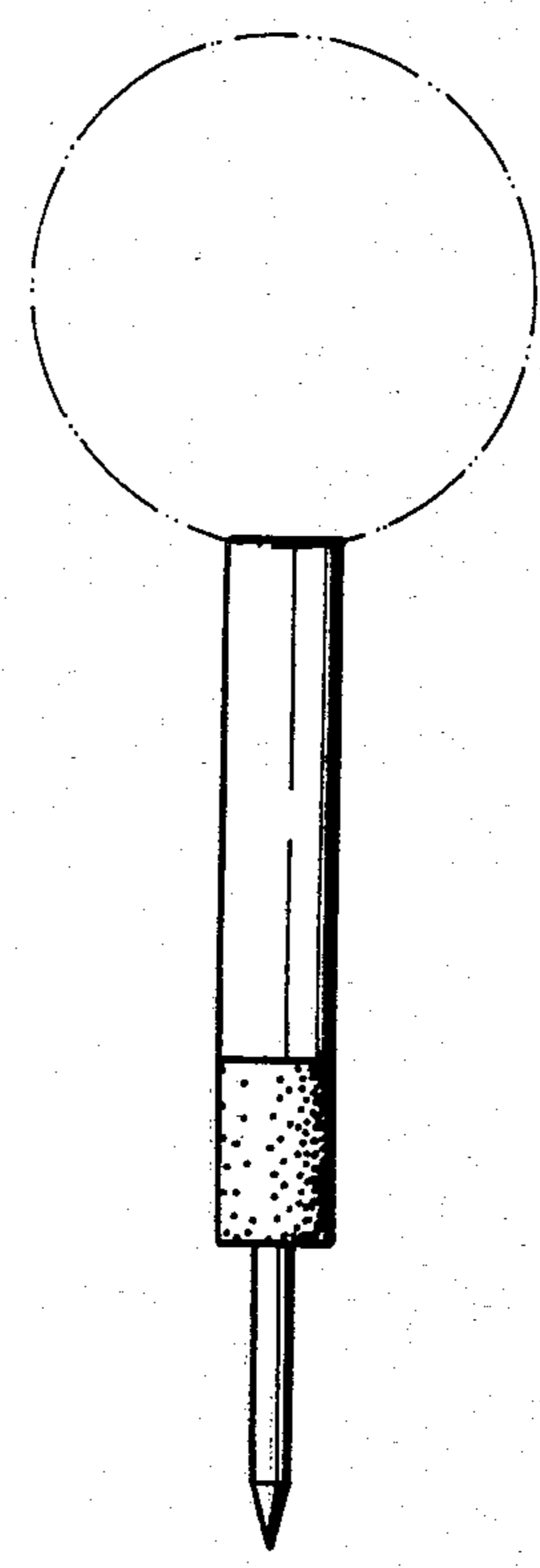
