FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

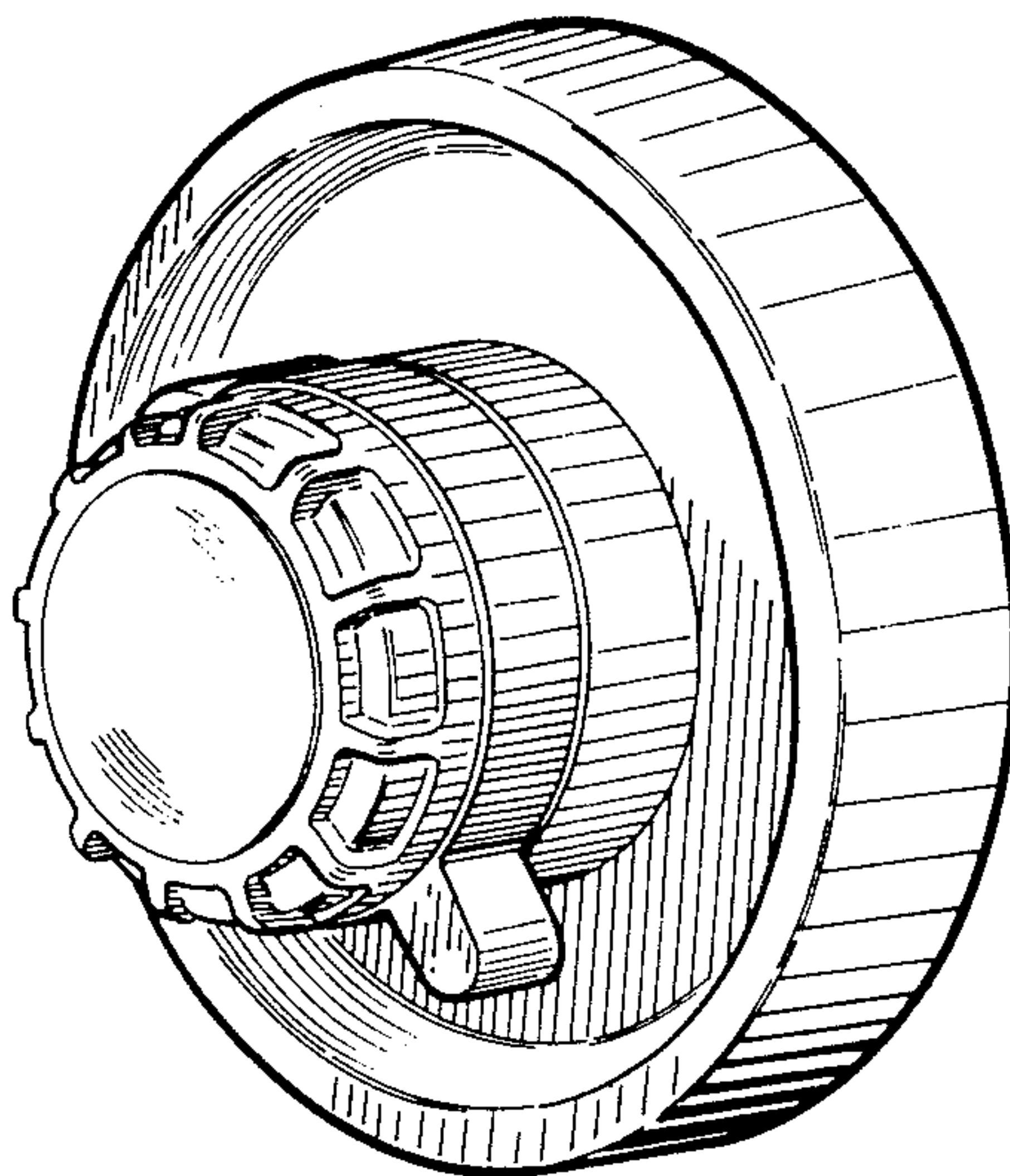
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

and left side thereof.



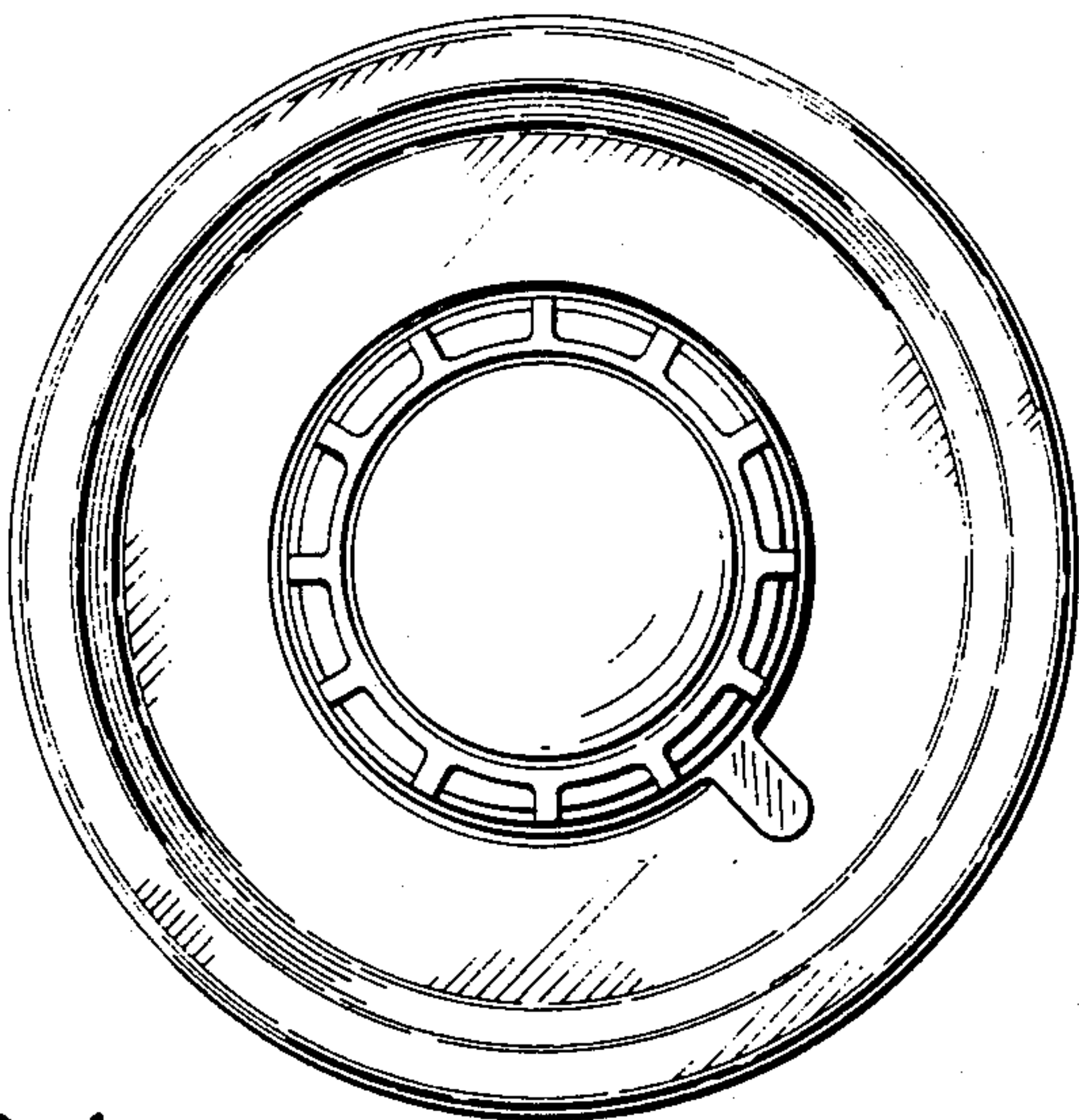

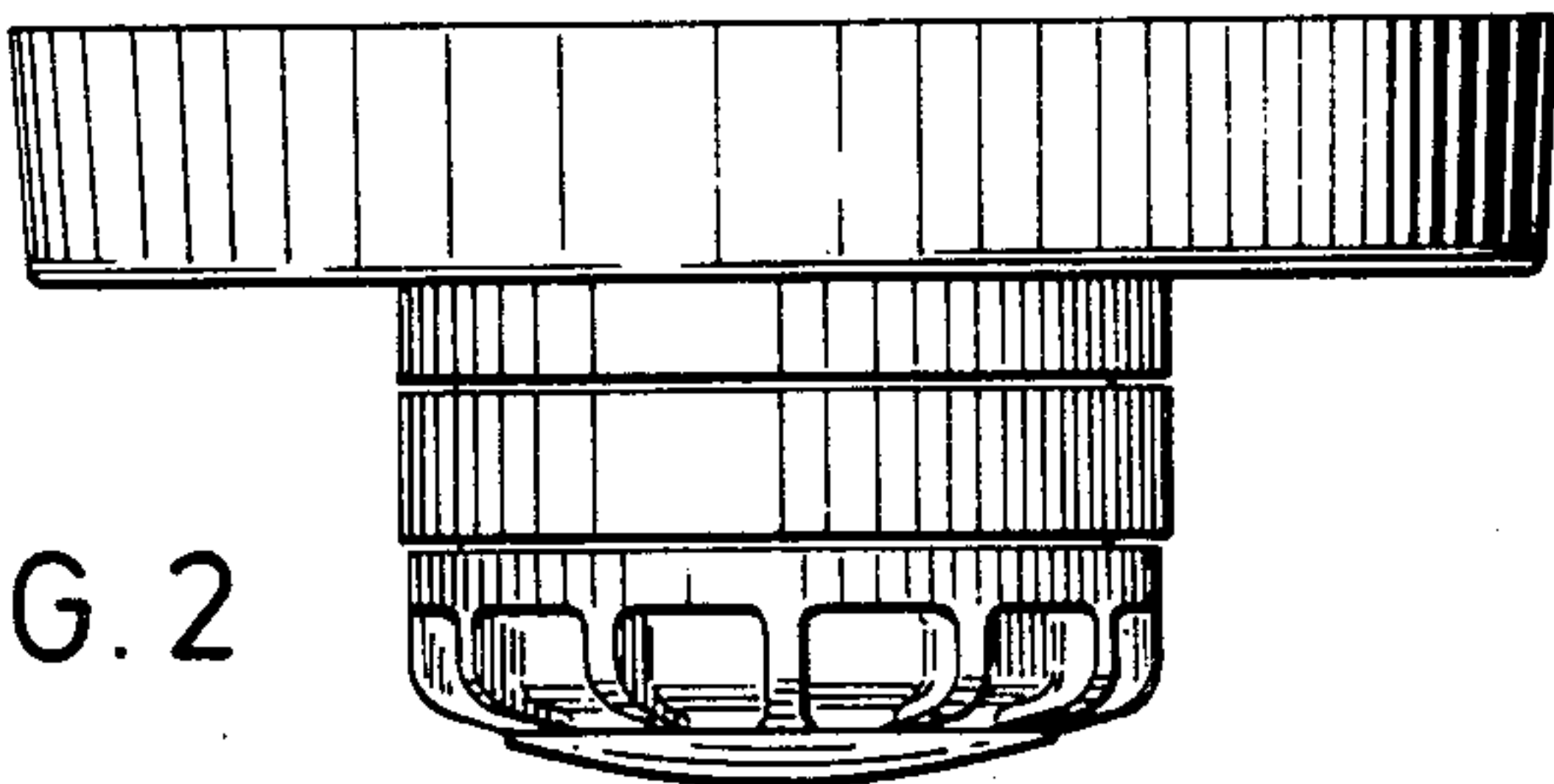

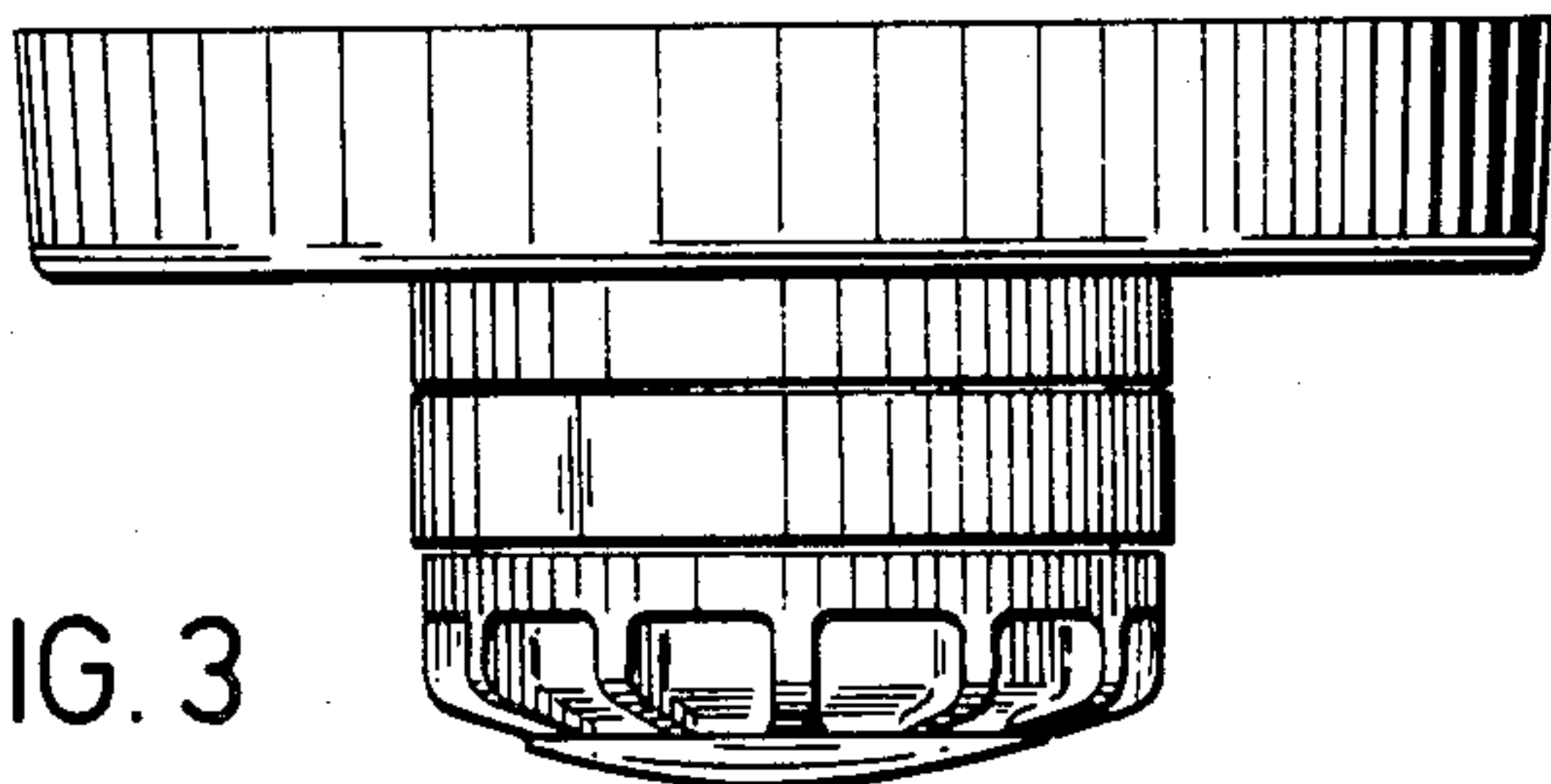

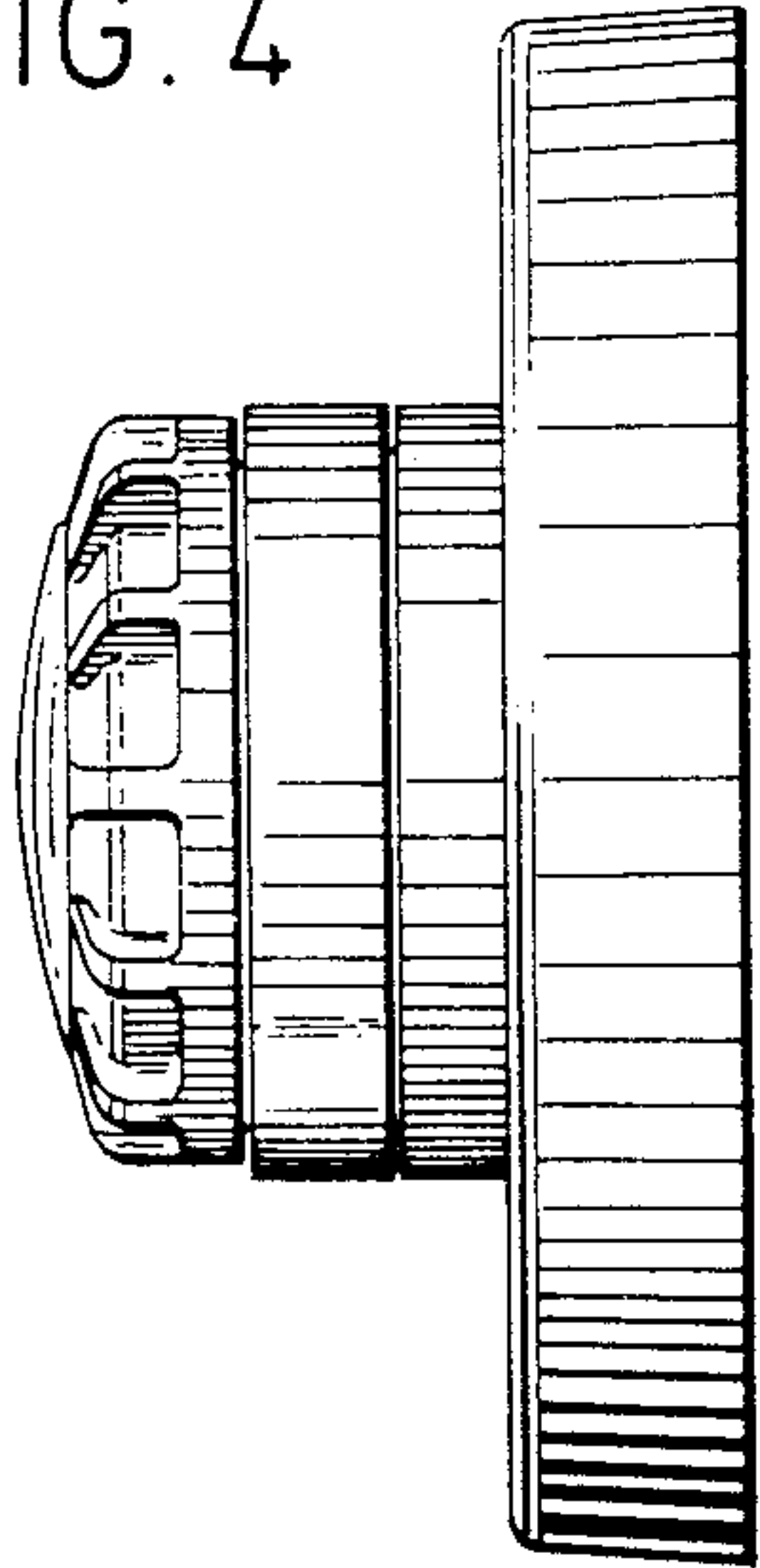

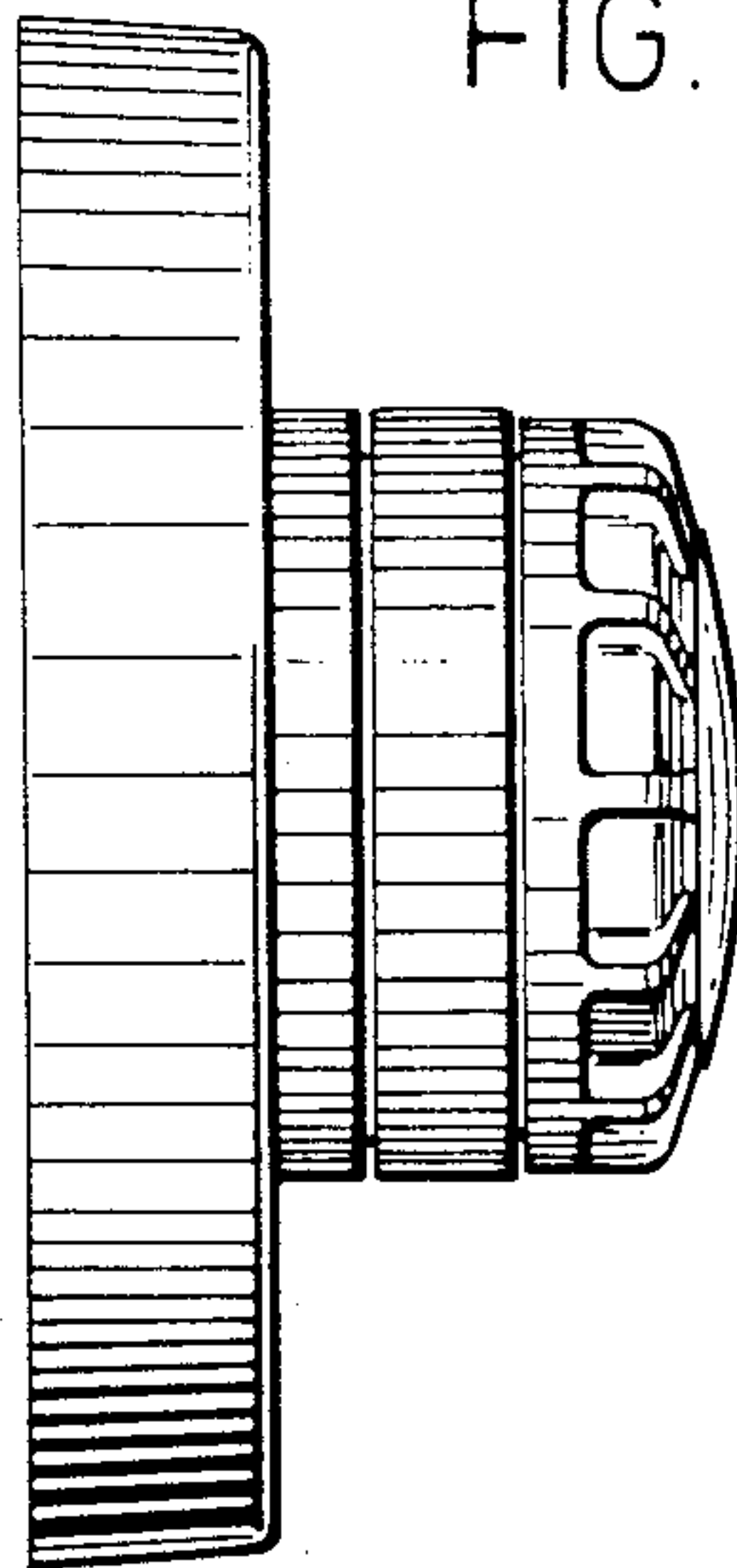
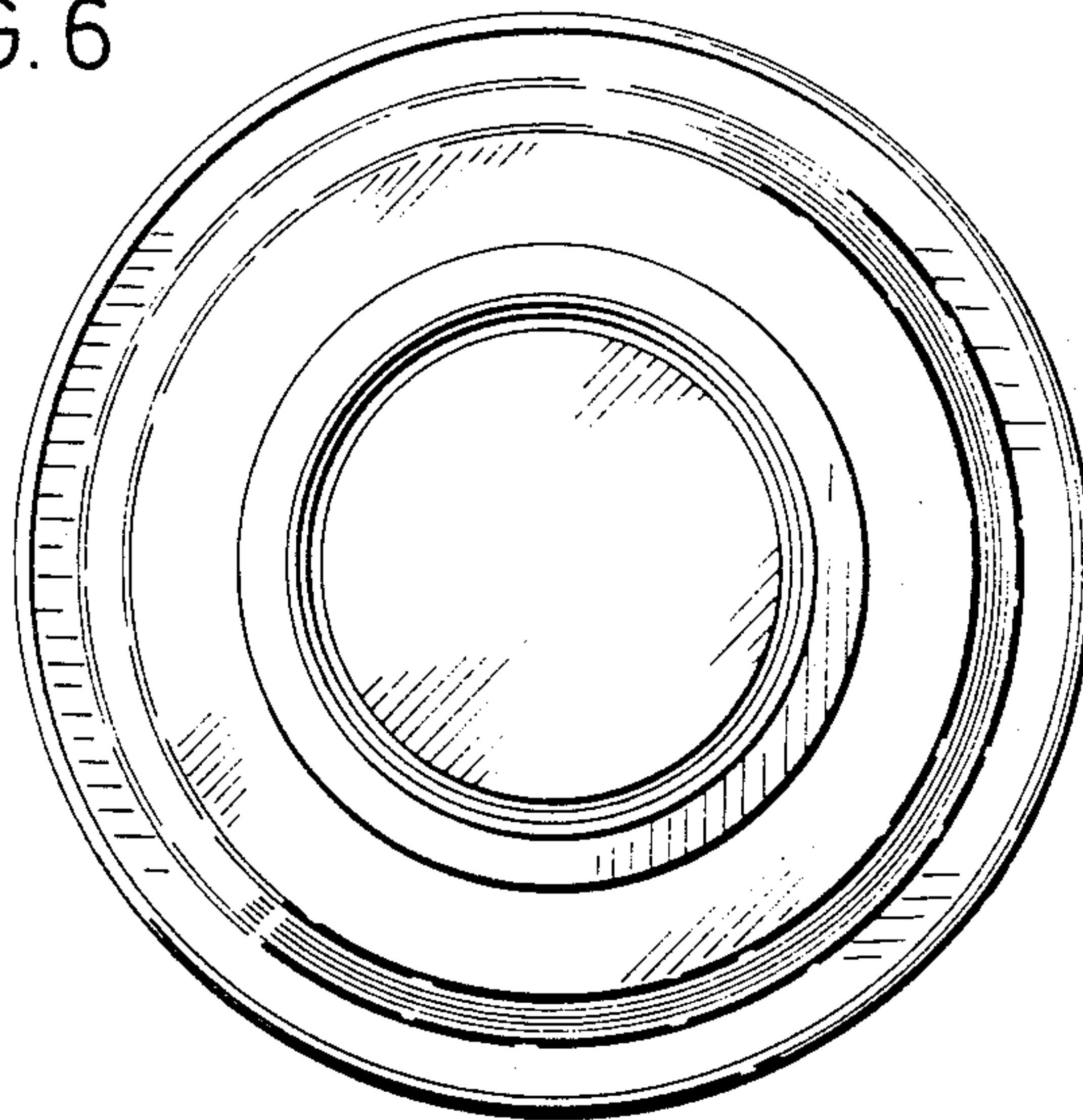

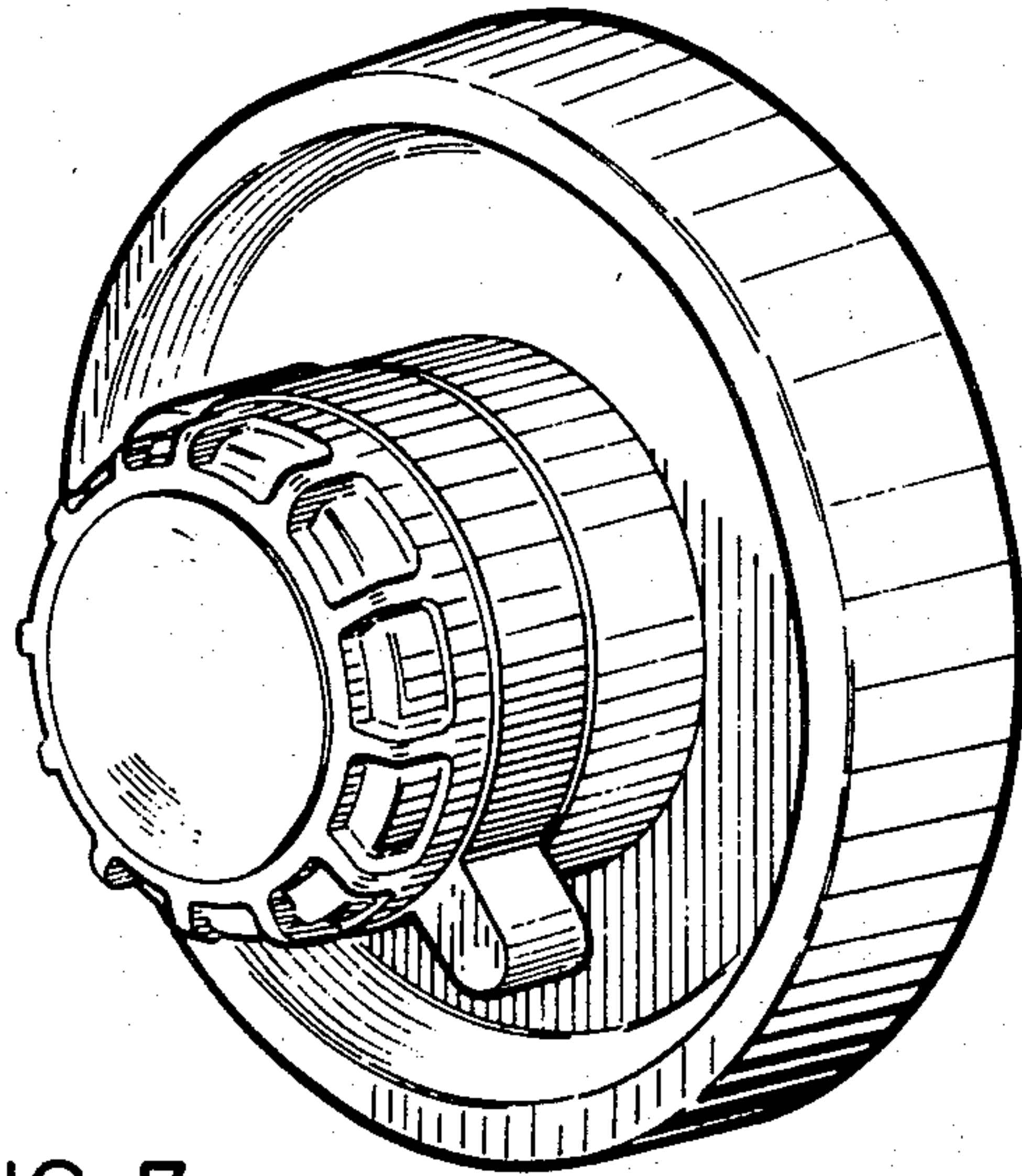

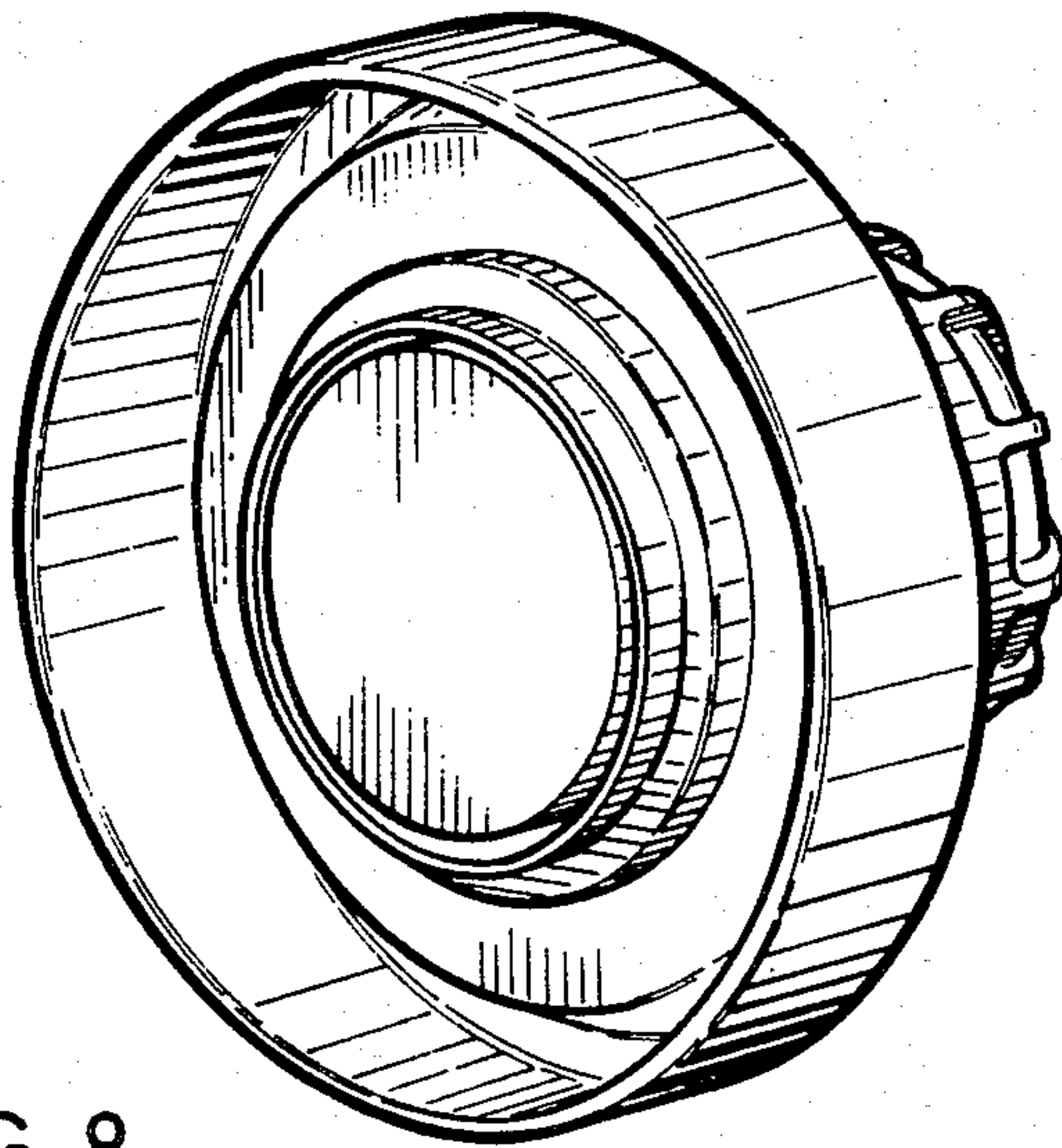
