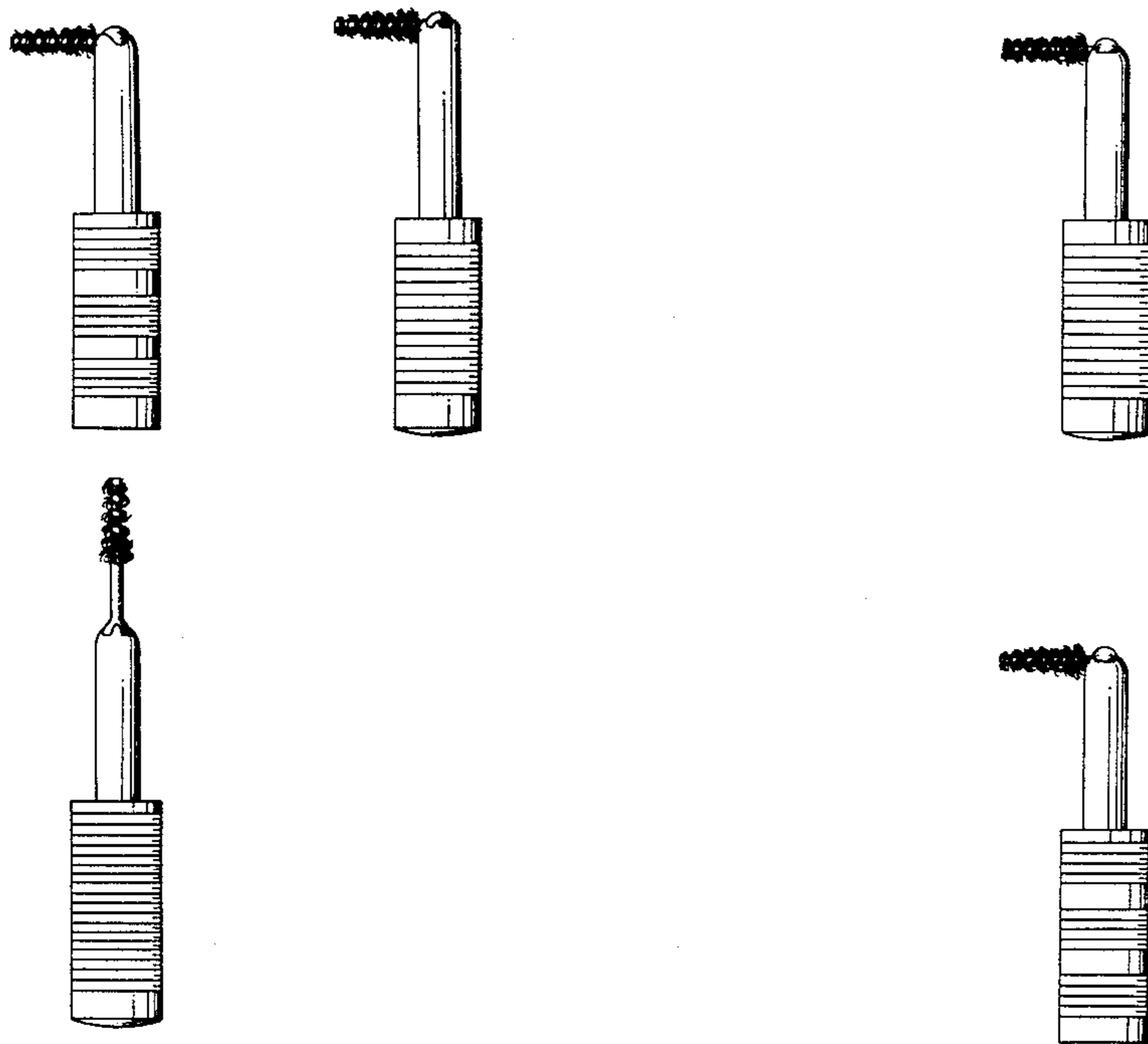
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an adjustable cosmetic applicator, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an adjustable cosmetic applicator showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an elevational view rotated 45% with the tip in an alternate position; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of an adjustable cosmetic applicator showing a second embodiment of our new design wherein the container top handle design is modified; FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 8 is an elevational view rotated 45% with the tip in an alternate position; FIG. 9 is a top plan view of an adjustable cosmetic applicator showing a third embodiment of our new design wherein the tip is modified; FIG. 10 is a top plan view of an adjustable cosmetic applicator showing a fourth embodiment of our new design with another modification of the tip; FIG. 11 is a top plan view of an adjustable cosmetic applicator showing a fifth embodiment of our new design wherein the ball socket receptacle is modified; FIG. 12 is a side elevational view showing FIG. 1 with embodiment modification FIG. 11; FIG. 13 is another side elevational view showing FIG. 6 with embodiment modification FIG. 11; FIG. 14 is a top plan view of an adjustable cosmetic applicator showing a sixth embodiment of our new design with another ball socket receptacle modification; FIG. 15 is a side elevational view showing FIG. 1 with embodiment modification FIG. 14; FIG. 16 is another side elevational view showing FIG. 6 with embodiment modification FIG. 14; FIG. 17 is a side elevational view of adjustable cosmetic applicator FIG. 1, showing a seventh embodiment of our new design wherein the tip is extended; and FIG. 18 is another side elevational view showing FIG. 6 with embodiment modification FIG. 17.



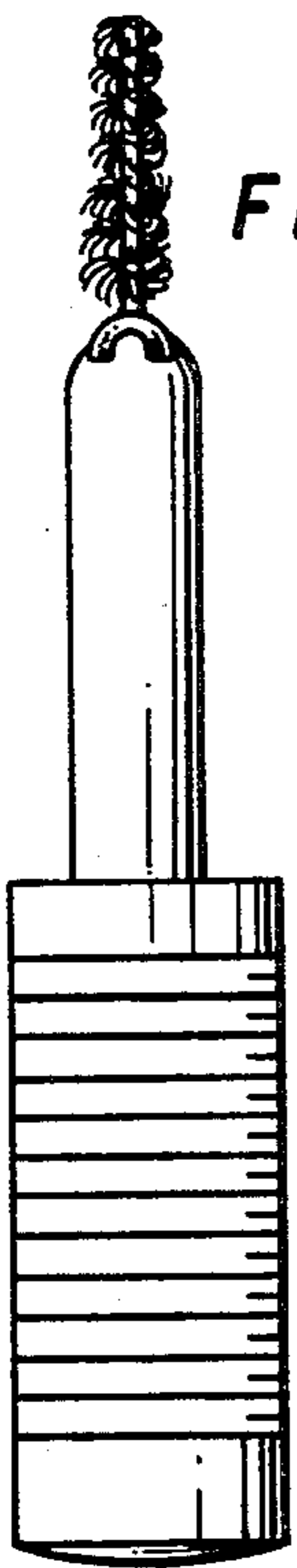

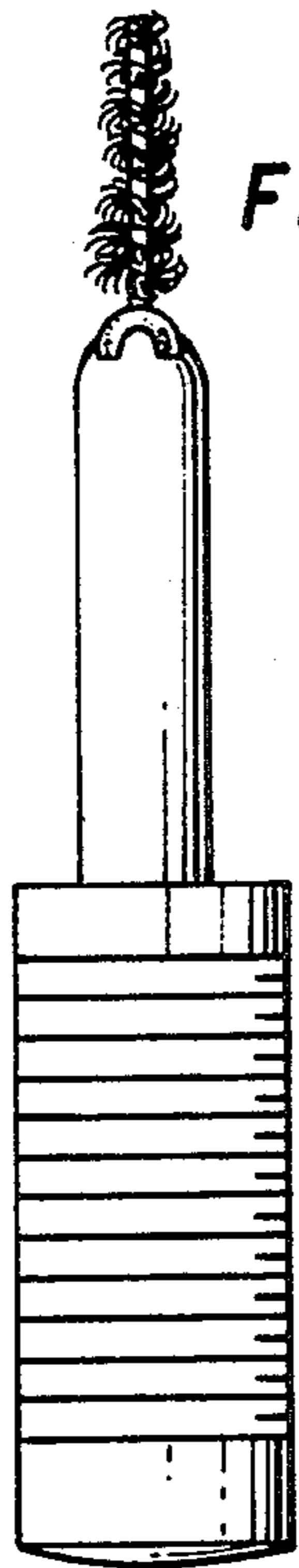

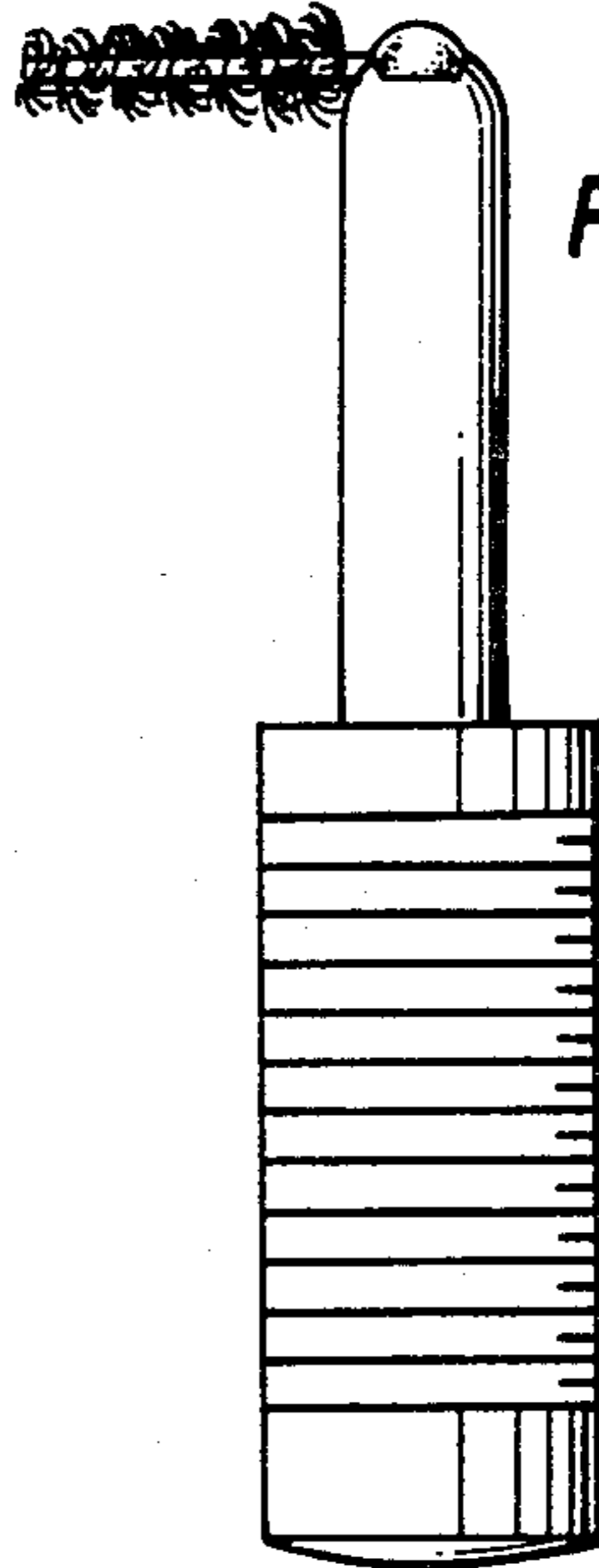

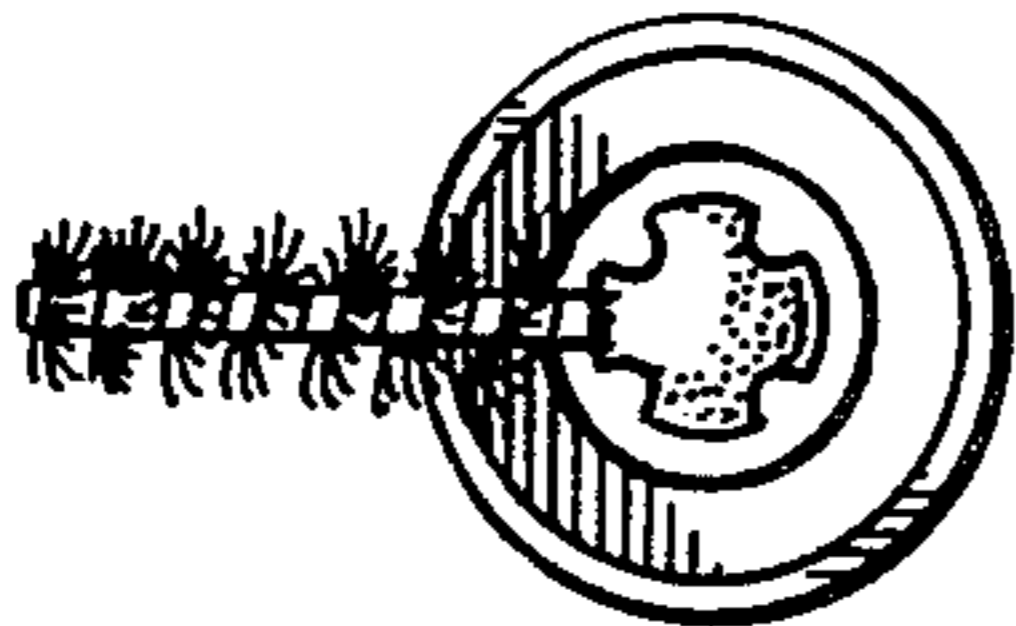

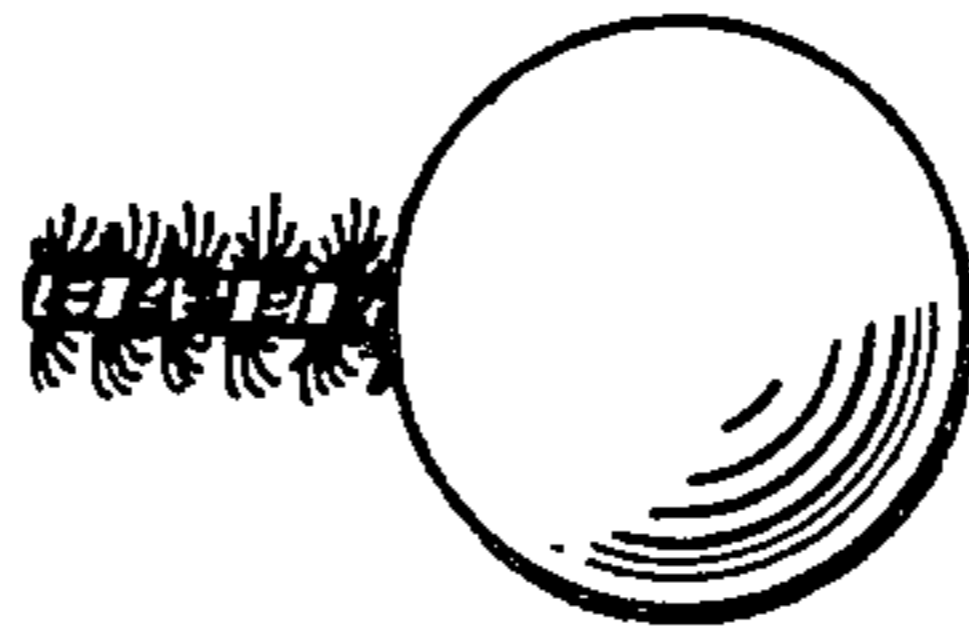

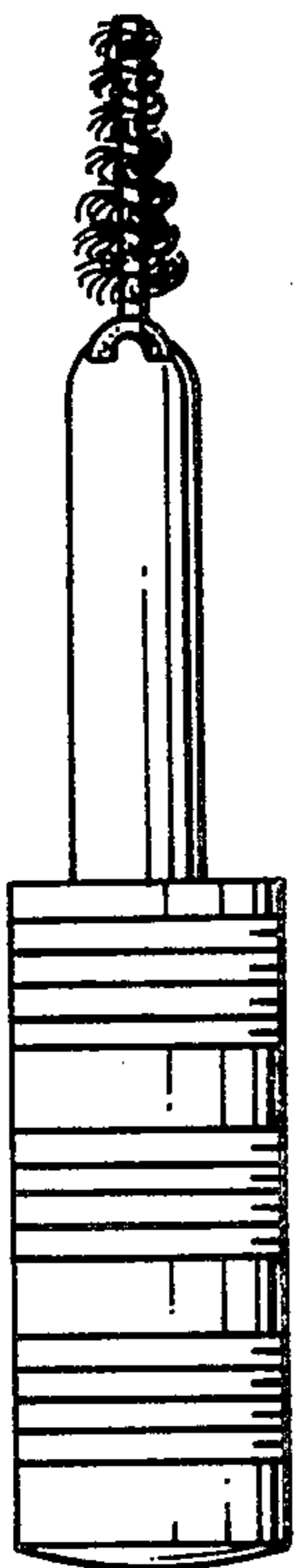

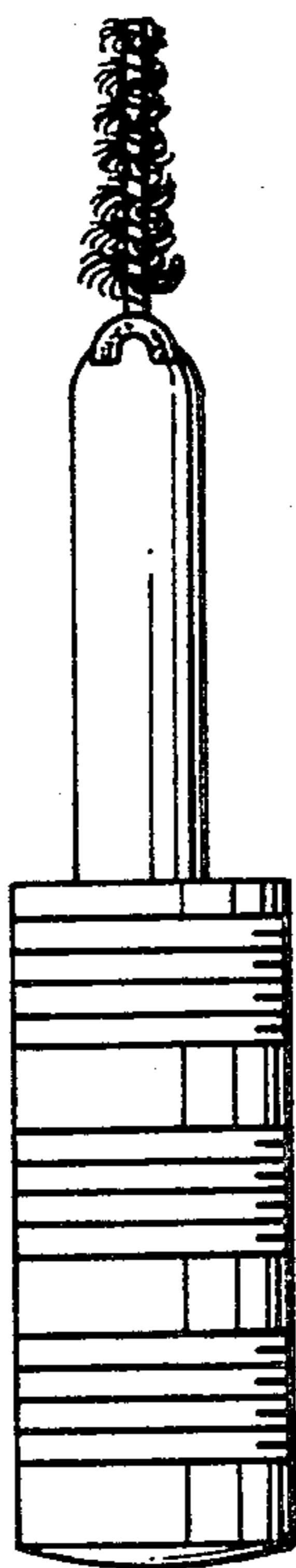

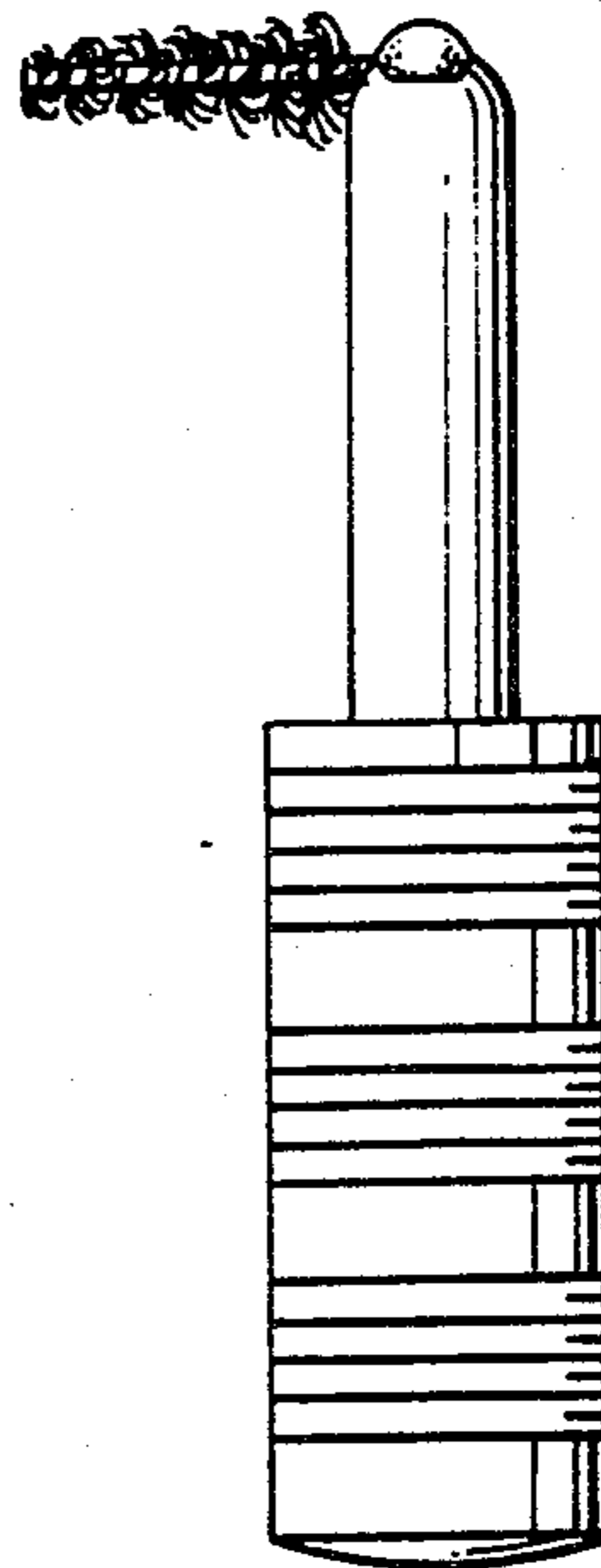

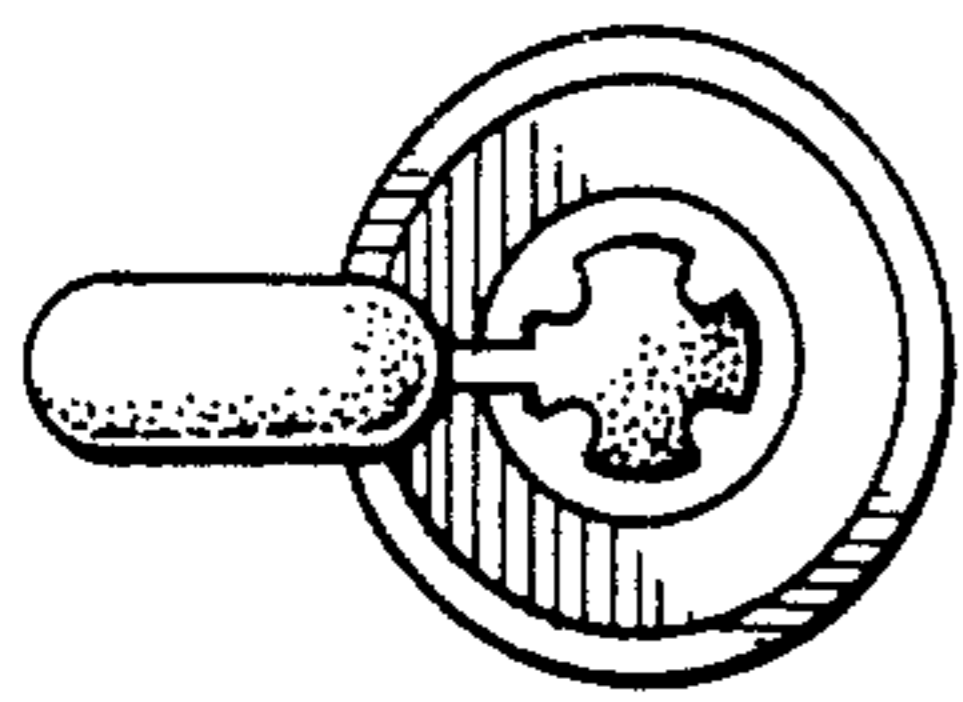

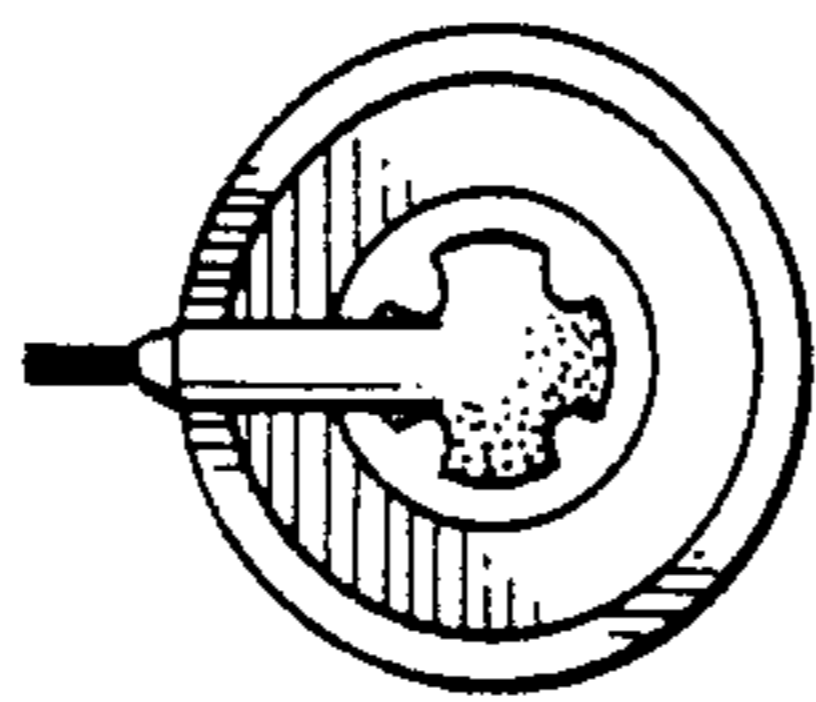

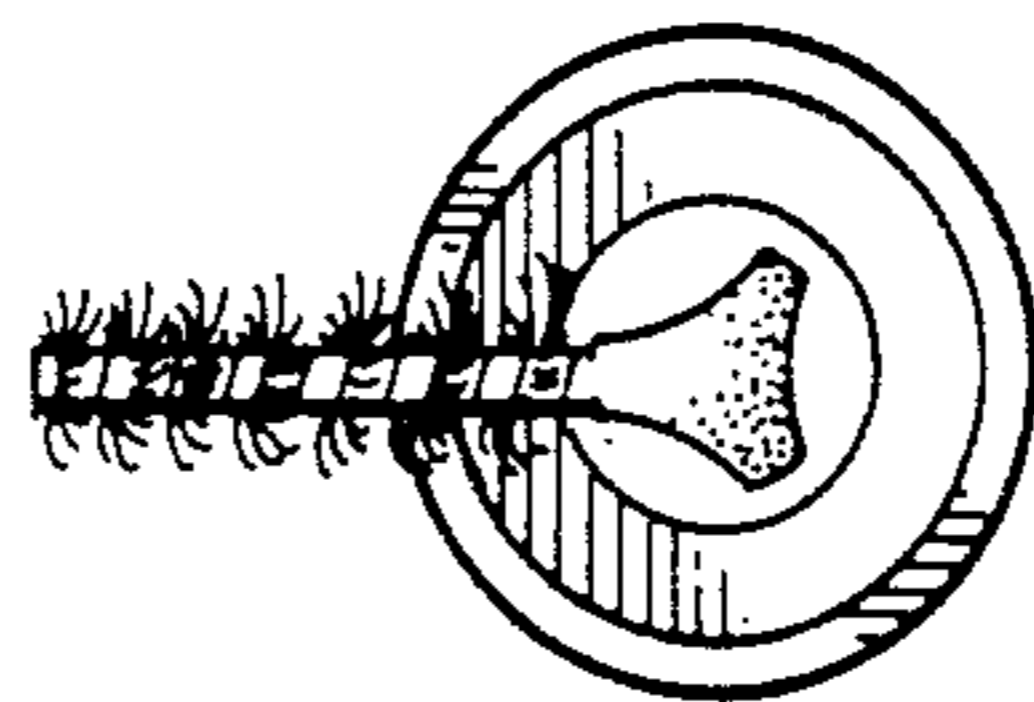

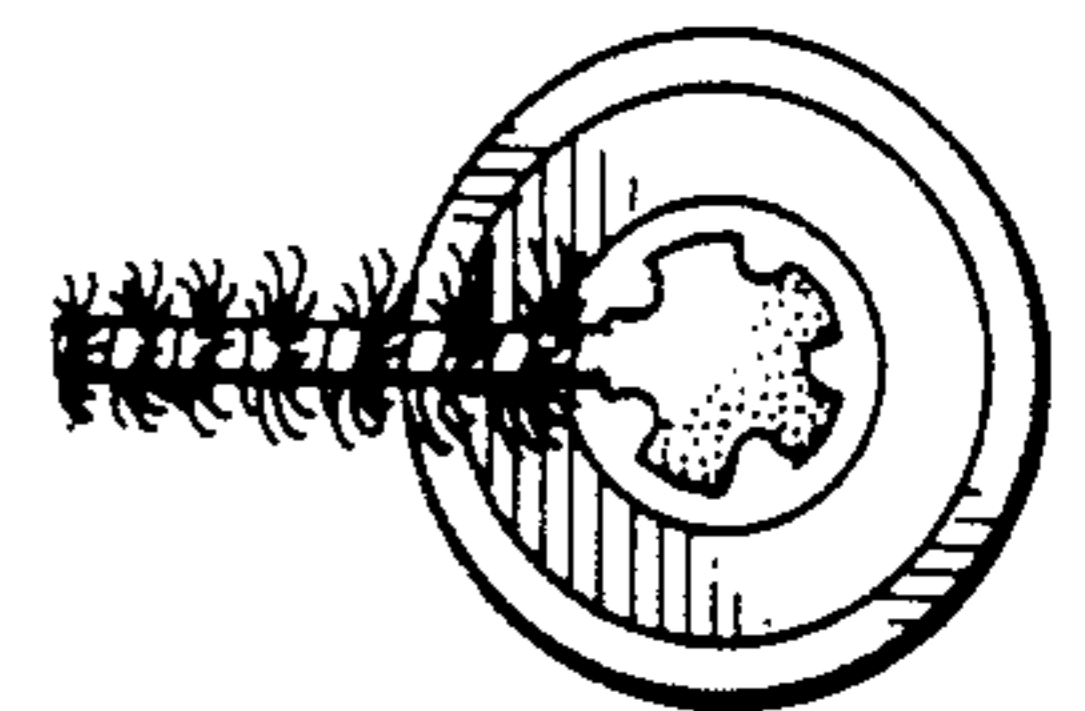

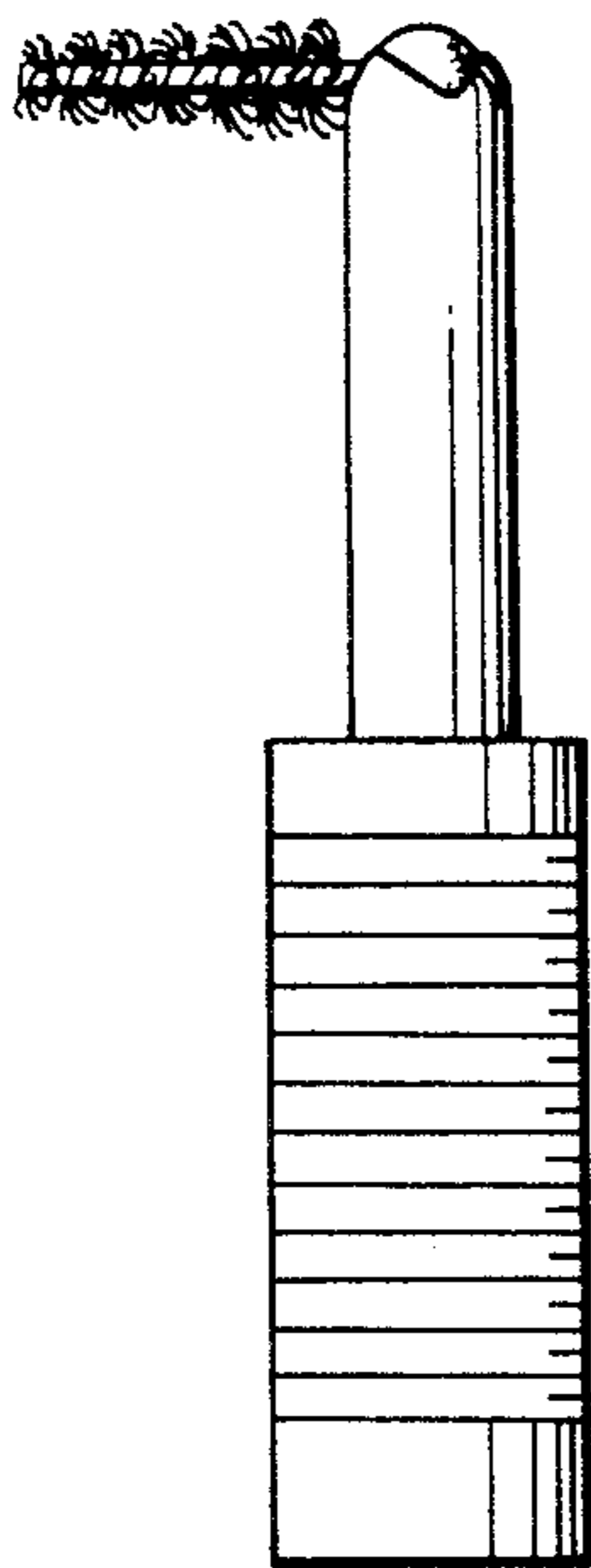

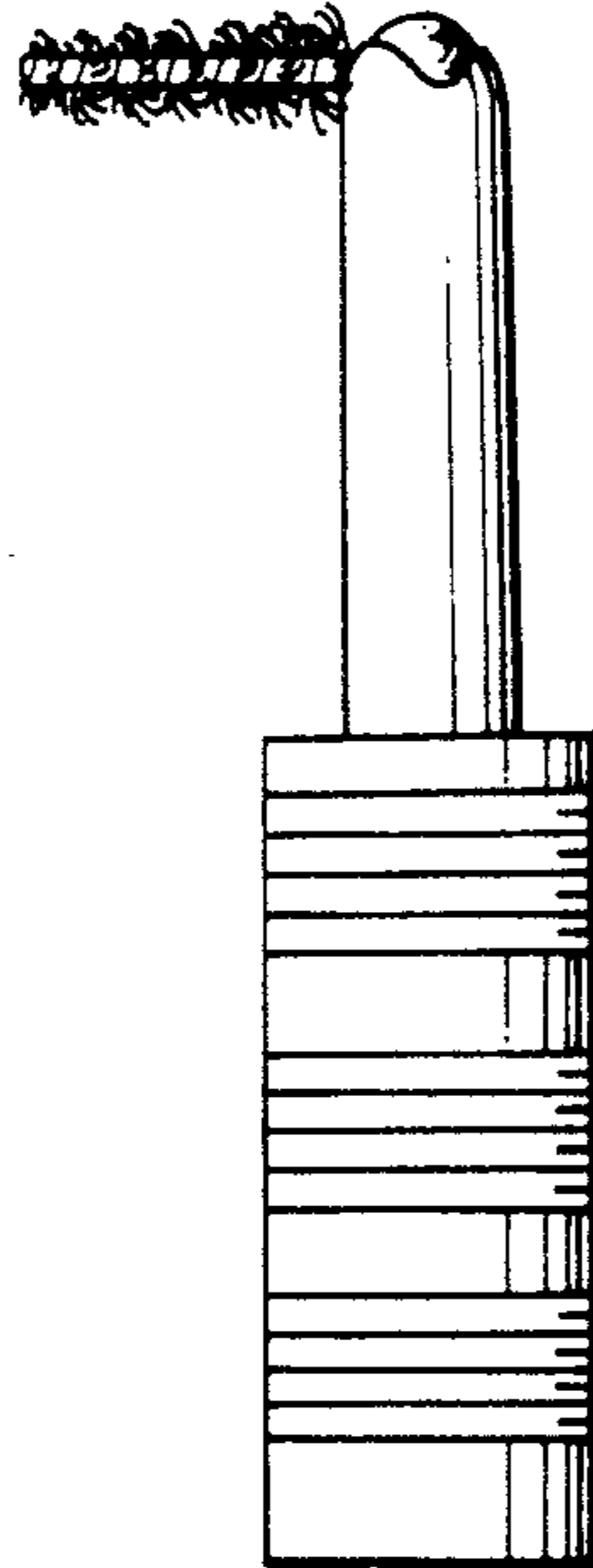

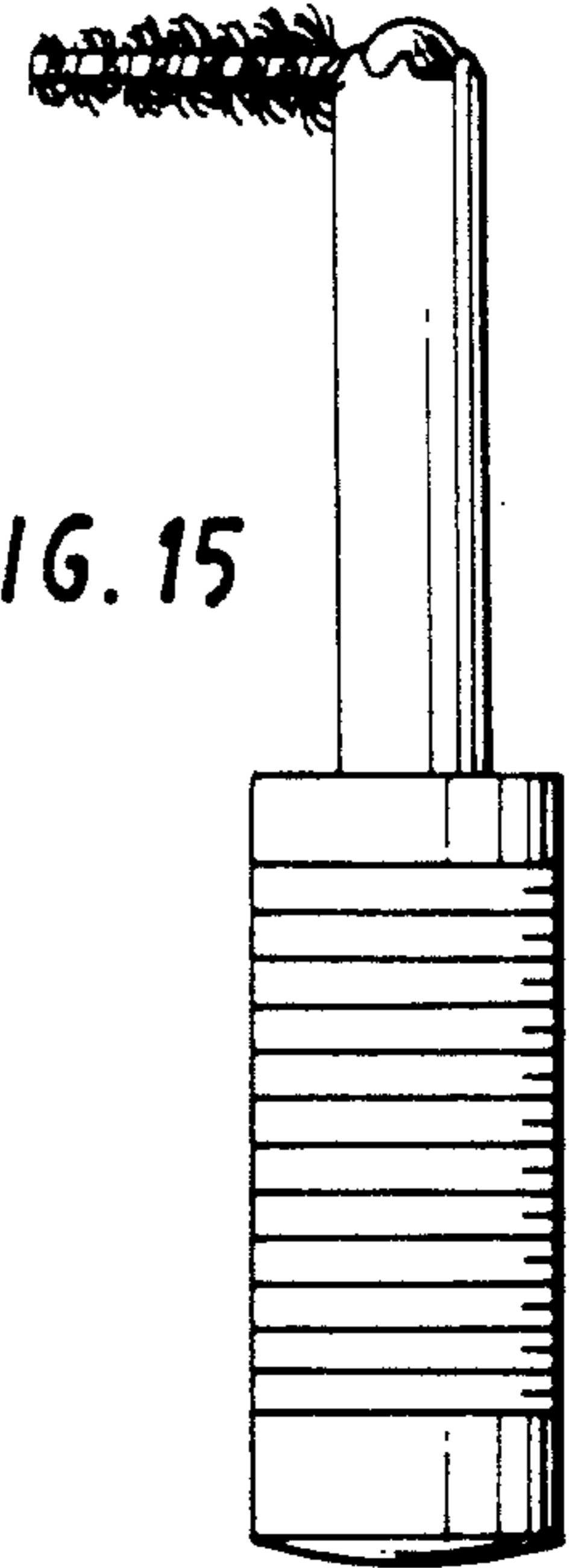

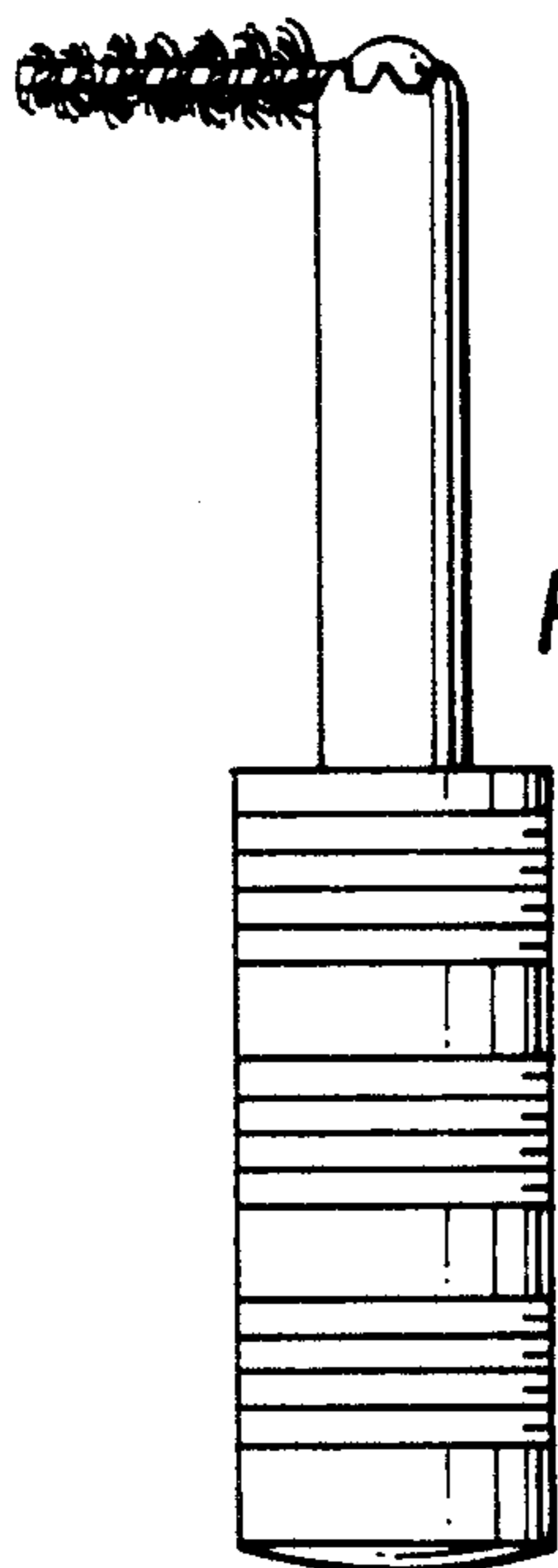

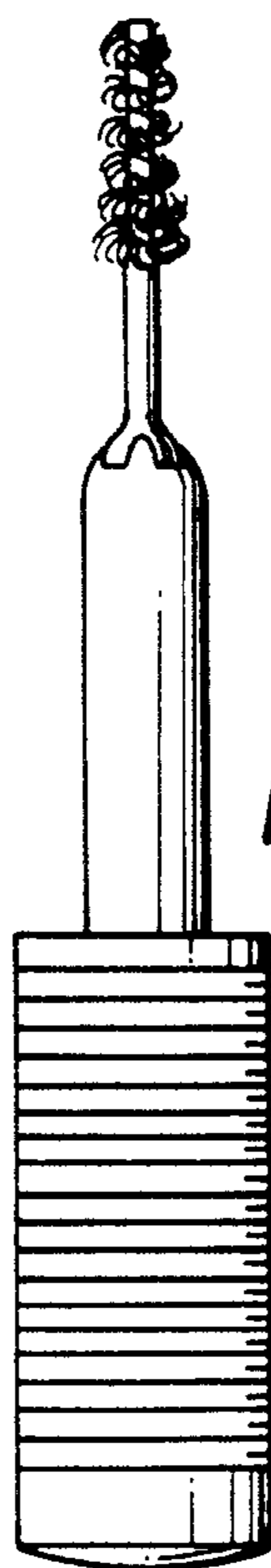

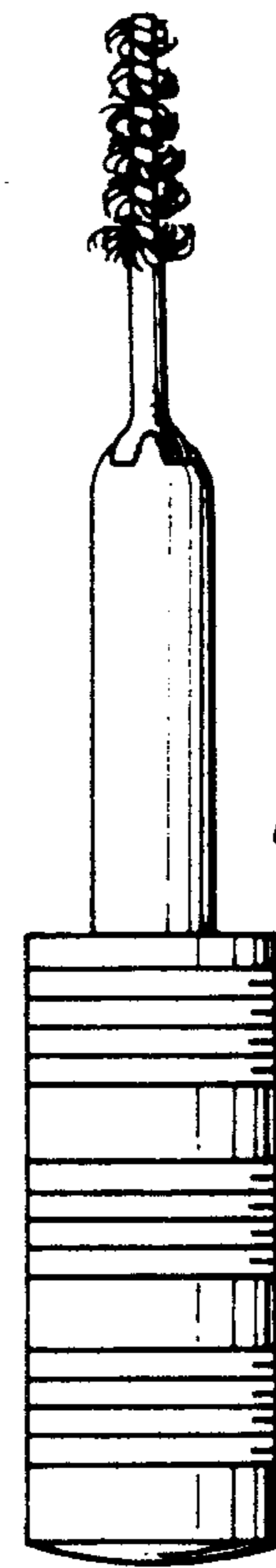
