[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a modular container for dispensing caps and vials, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a modular container for dispensing caps and vials showing my new design, with the broken lines being for the purposes of showing environmental use only;

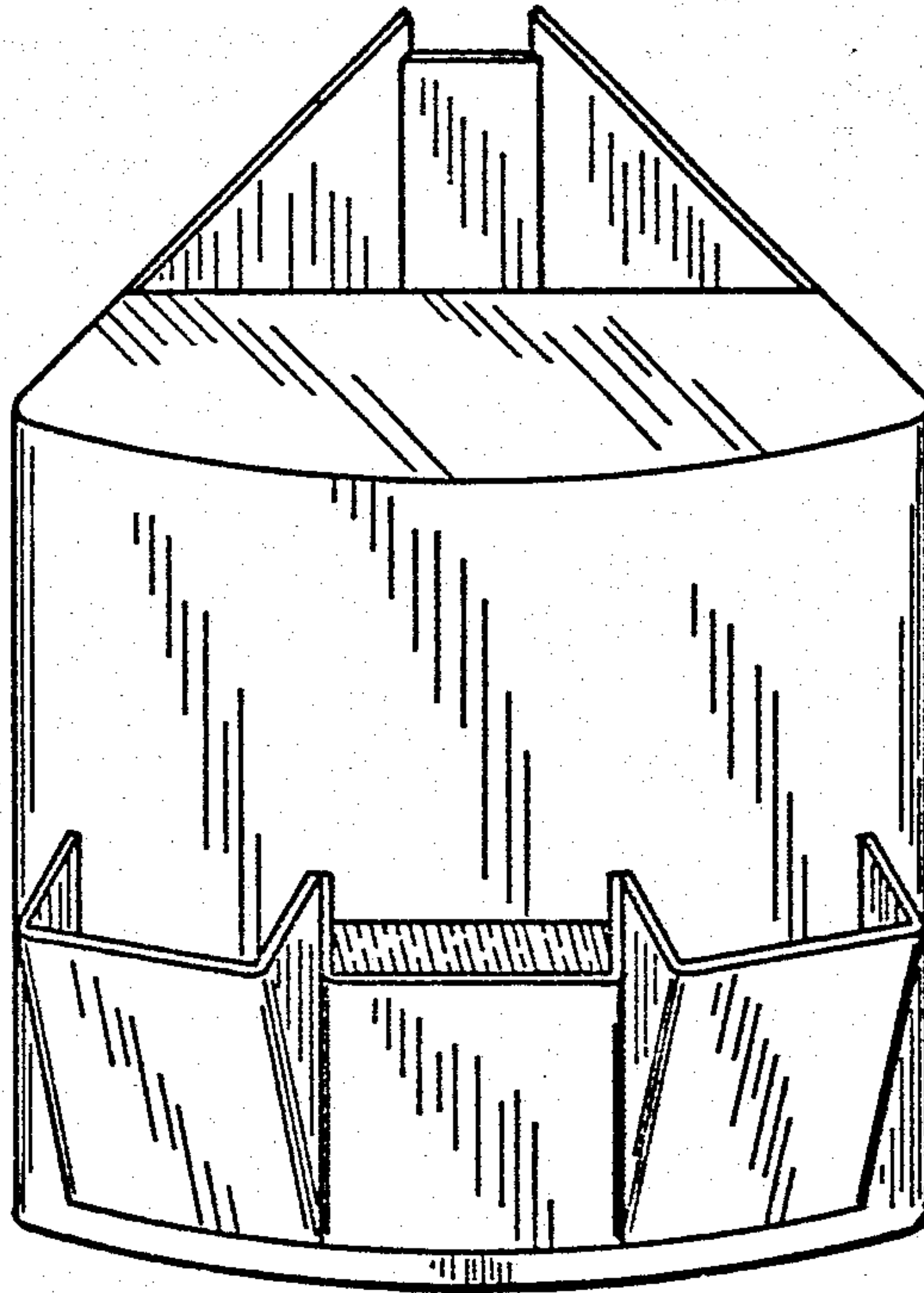
FIG. 2 is another top perspective view on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof.



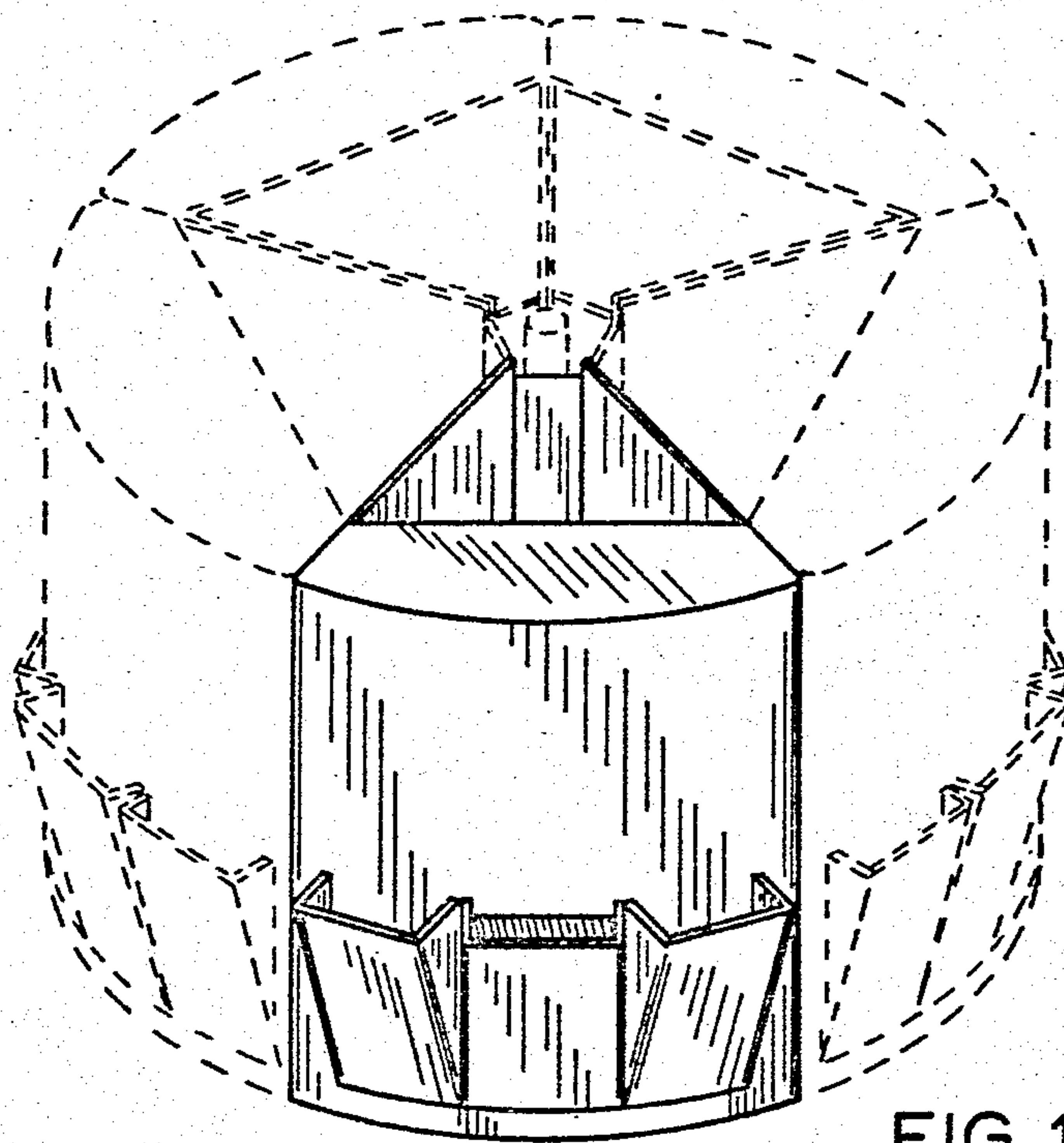

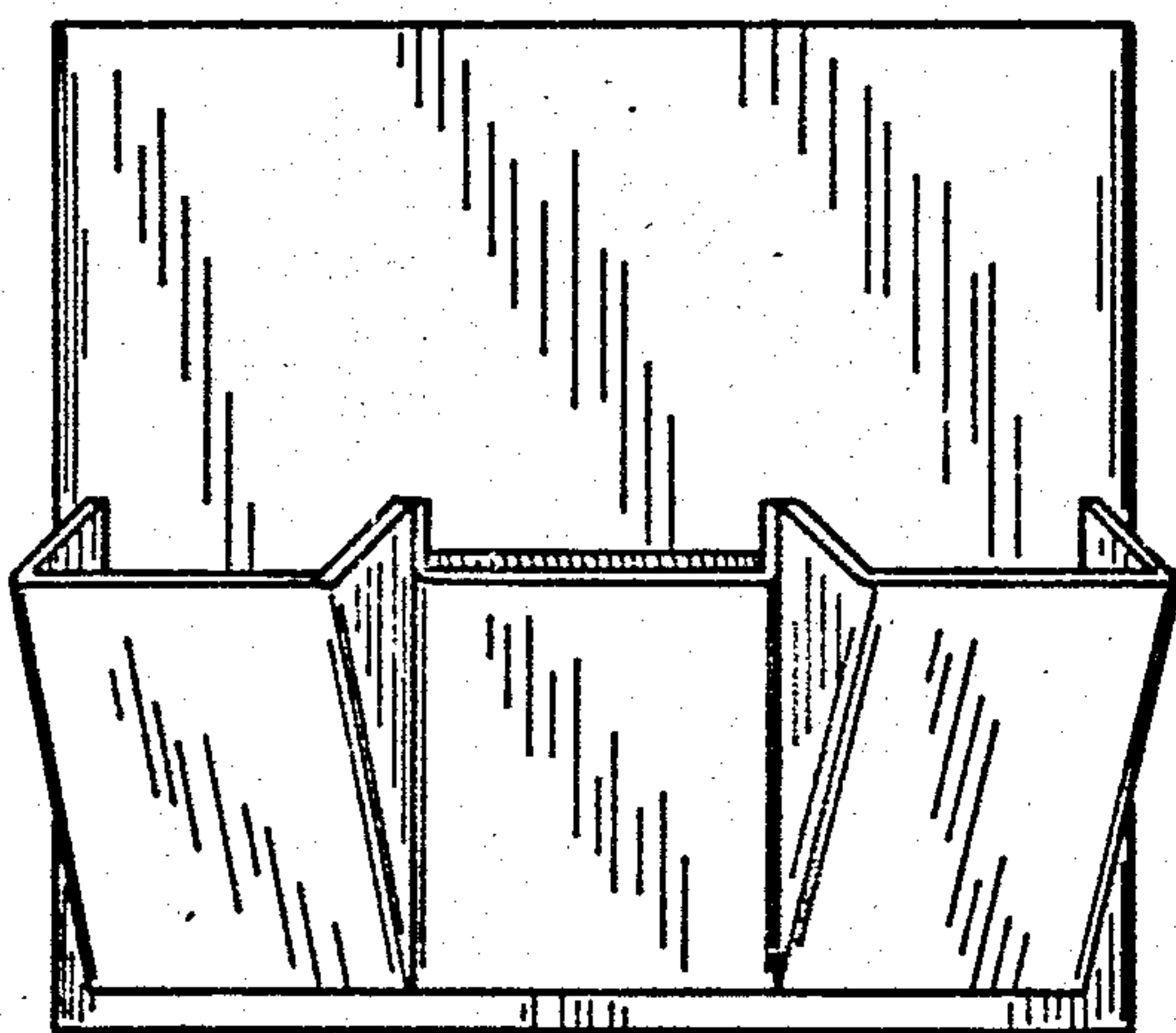

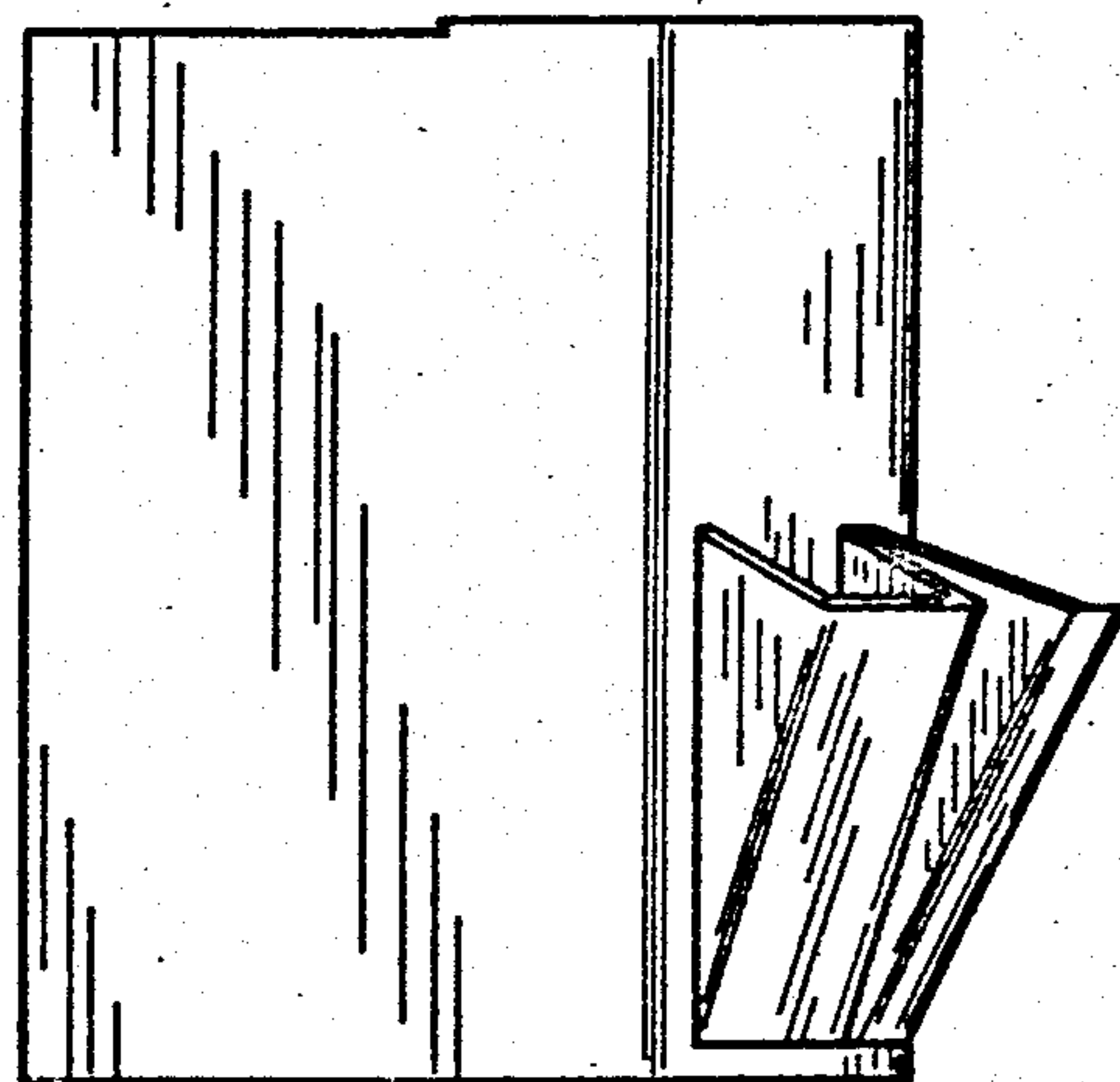

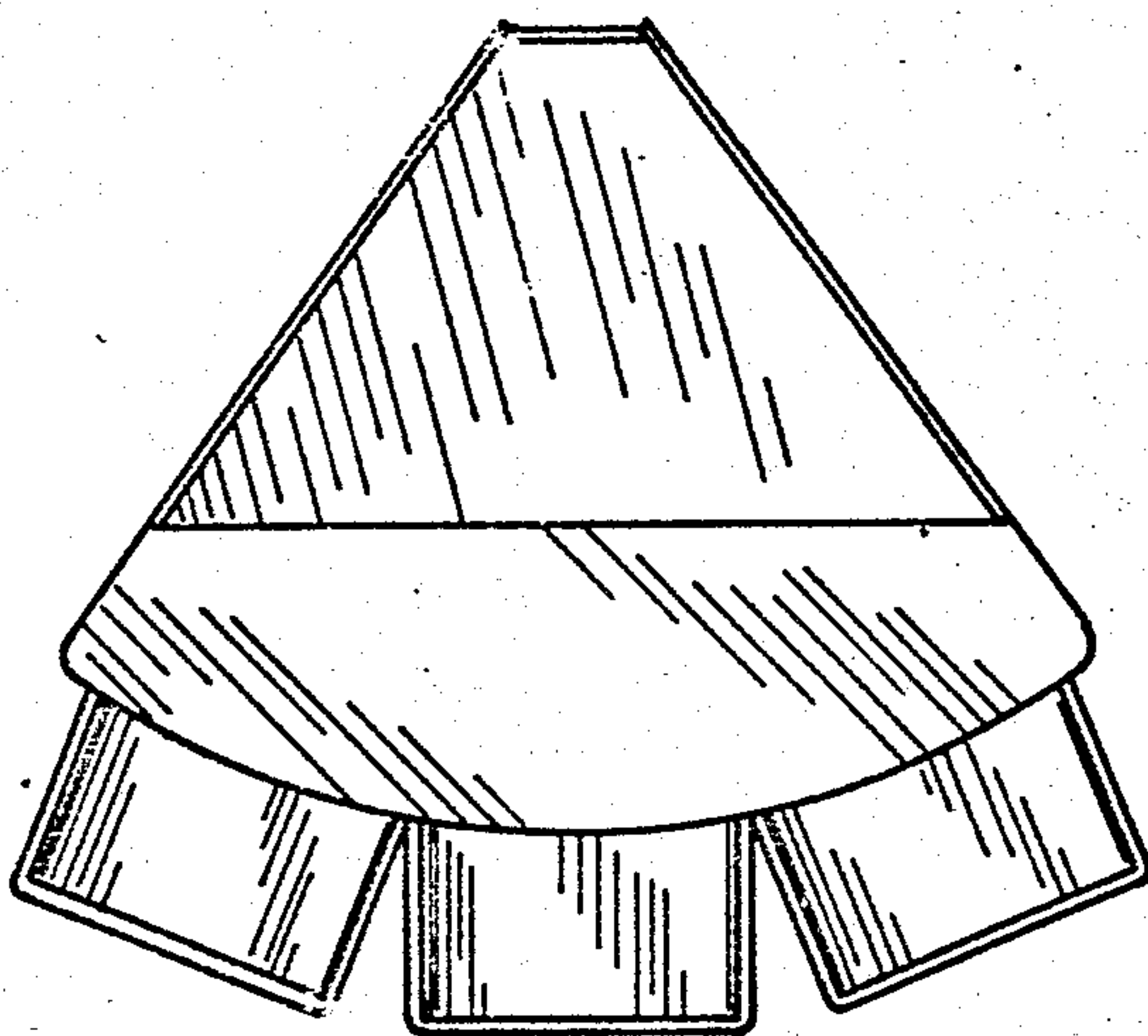
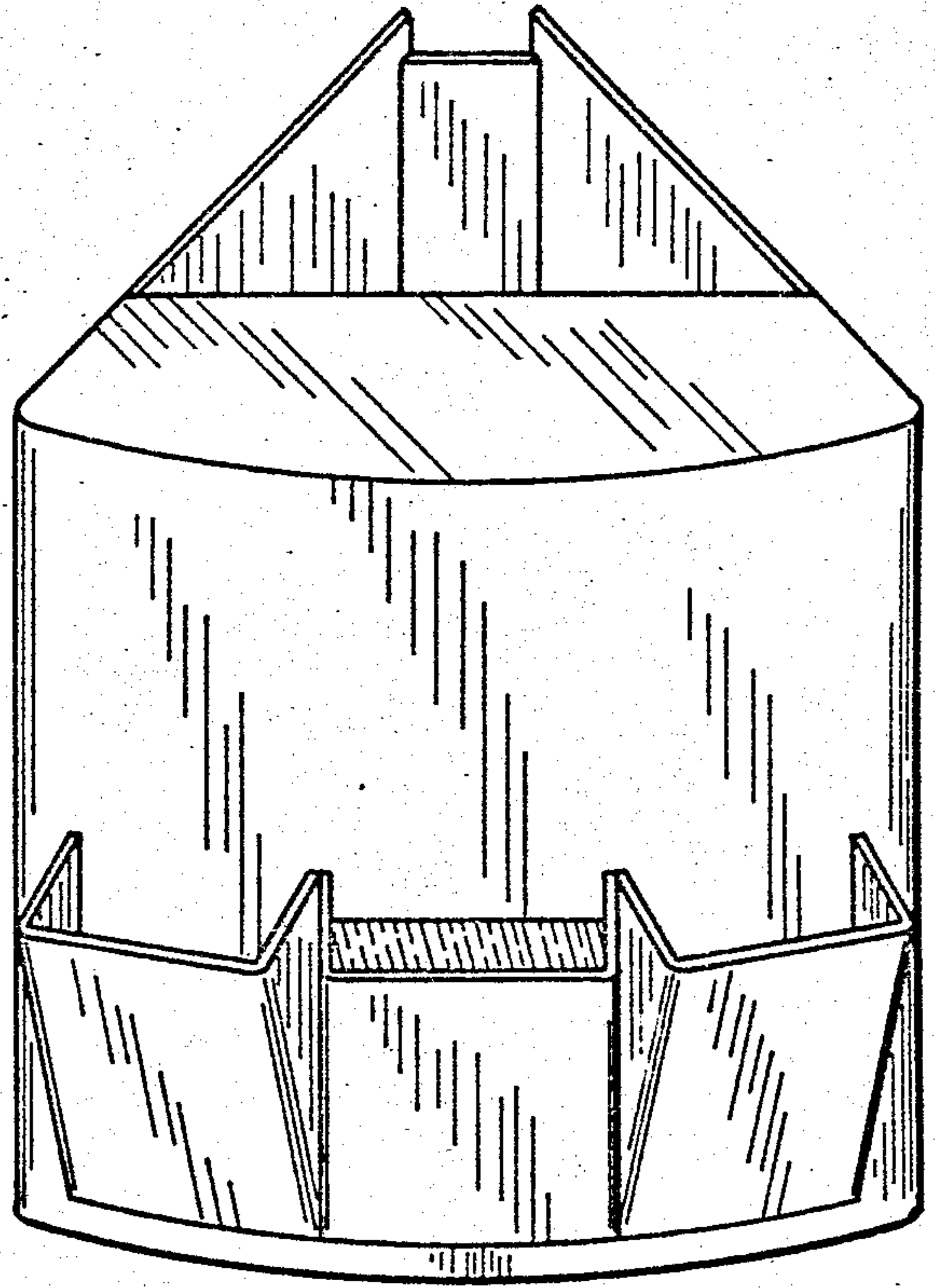

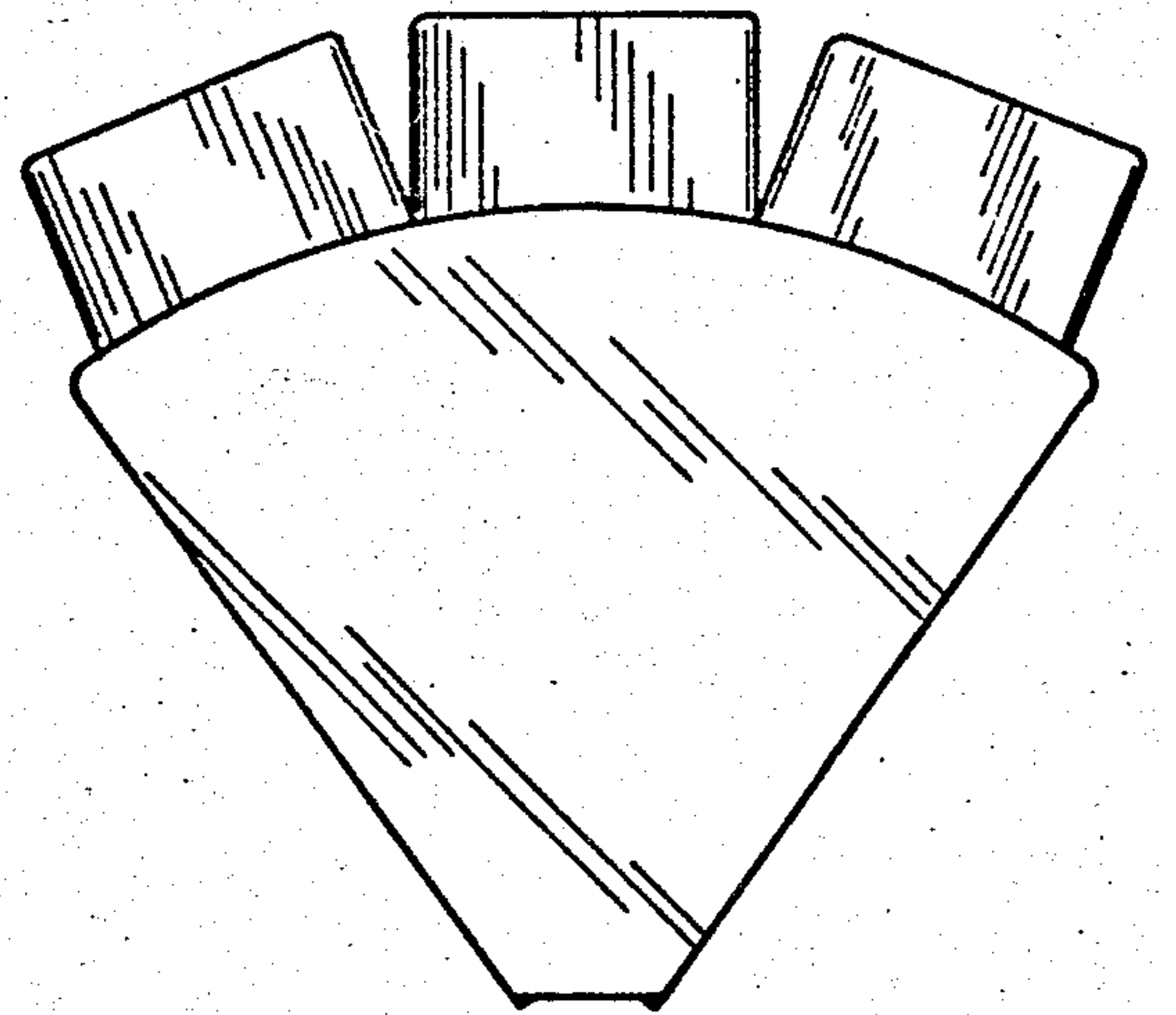
