[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined jar and cap, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combined jar and cap showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an elevational view, the opposite side being the same in appearance;

FIG. 3 is a view looking from the right of FIG. 2, the opposite side being the same in appearance;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the jar with the cap removed;

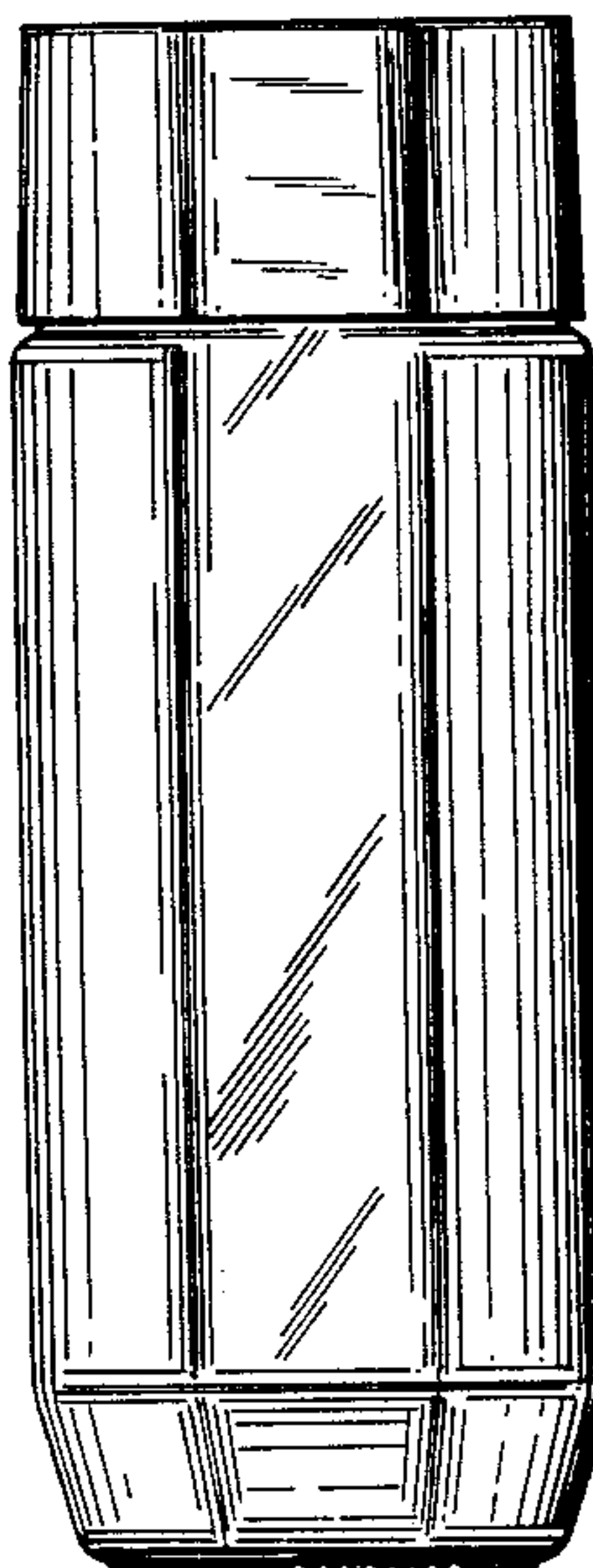
FIG. 6 is a fragmentary elevational view with the cover removed, the opposite side being the same in appearance;

FIG. 7 is a view looking from the right of FIG. 6, the opposite side being the same in appearance;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of the cover;

FIG. 9 is a sectional view taken on the line 9—9 of FIG. 8; and

FIG. 10 is a sectional view taken on the line 10—10 of FIG. 9.



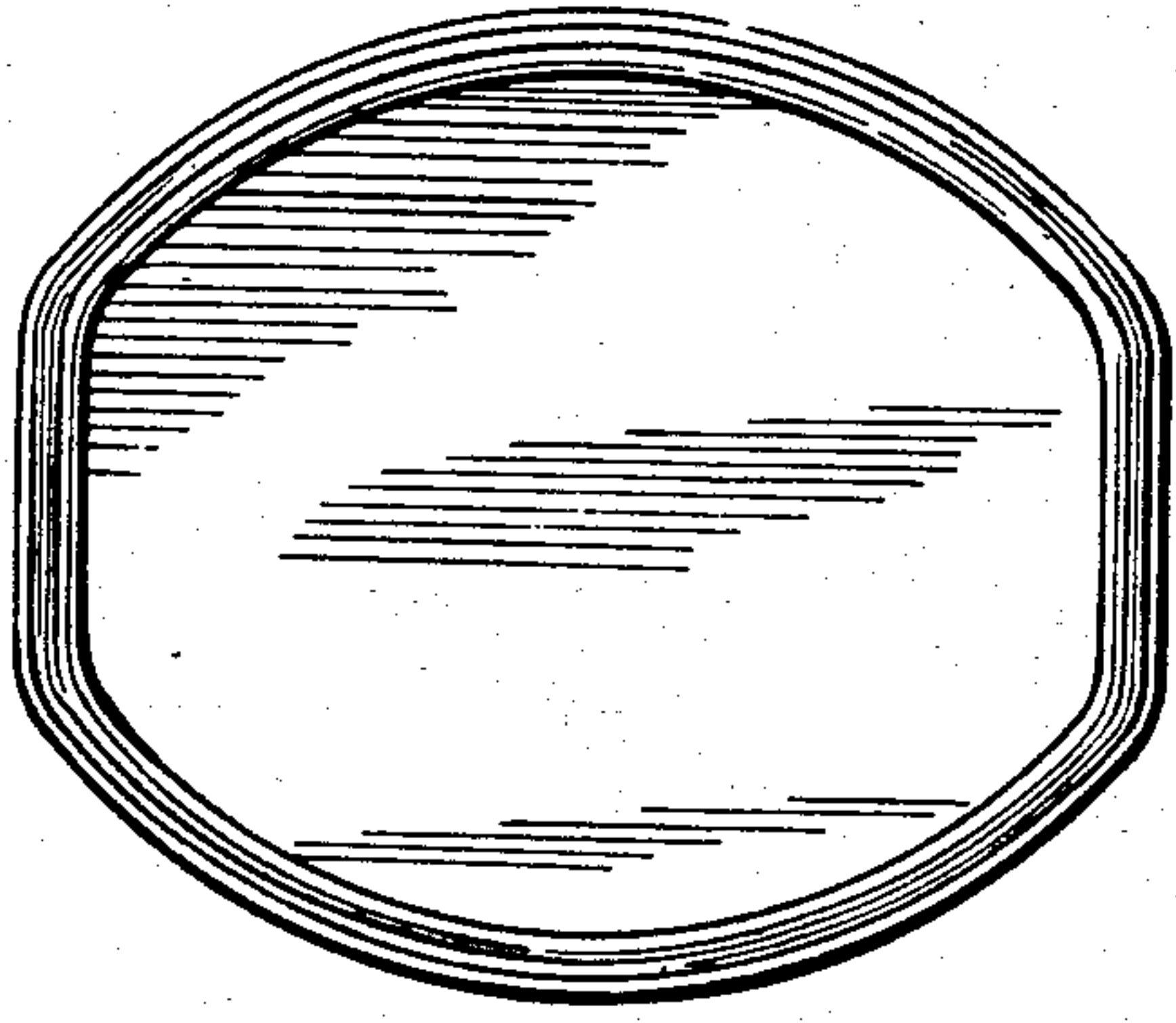

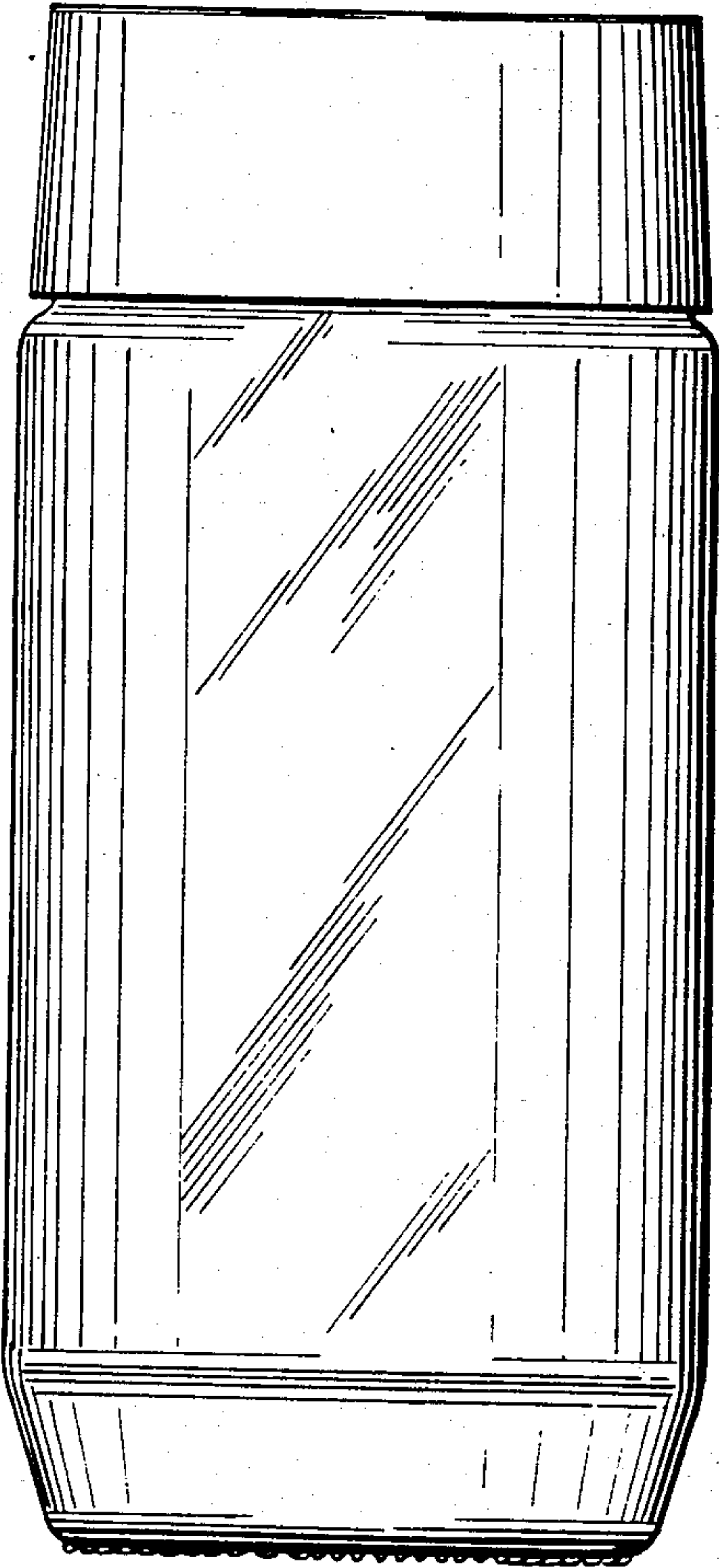

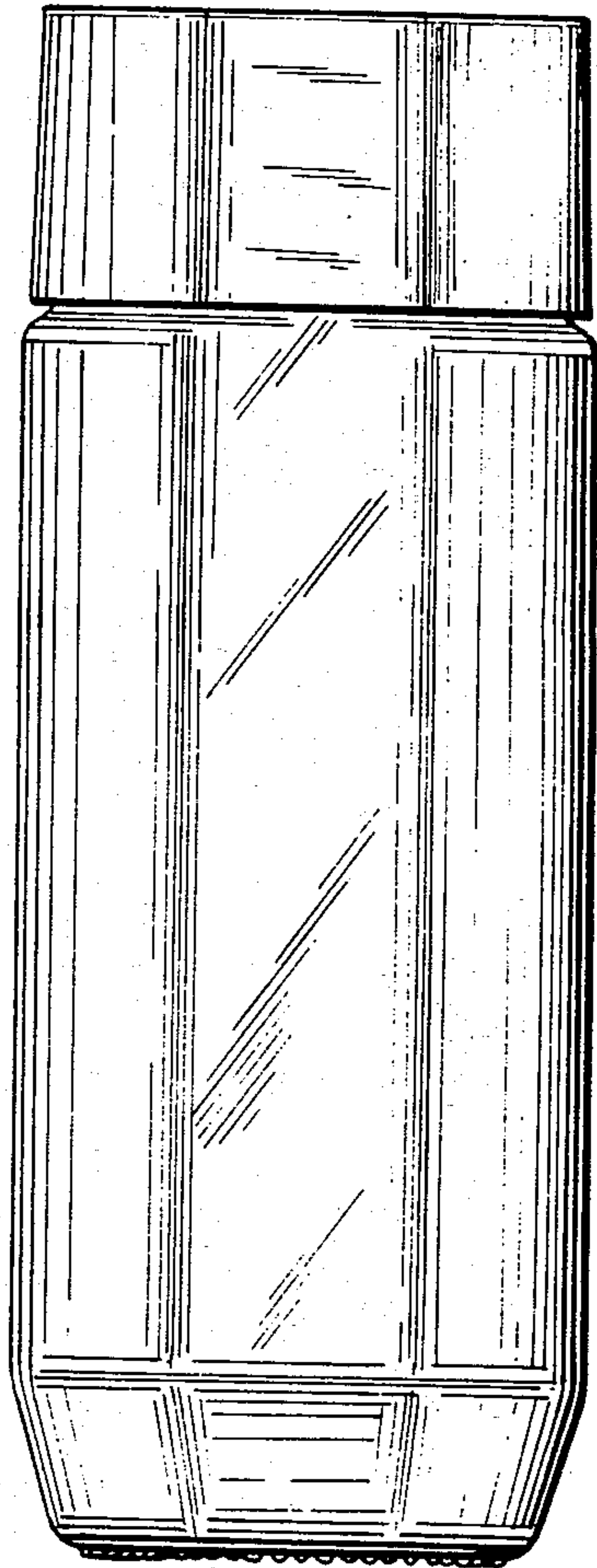

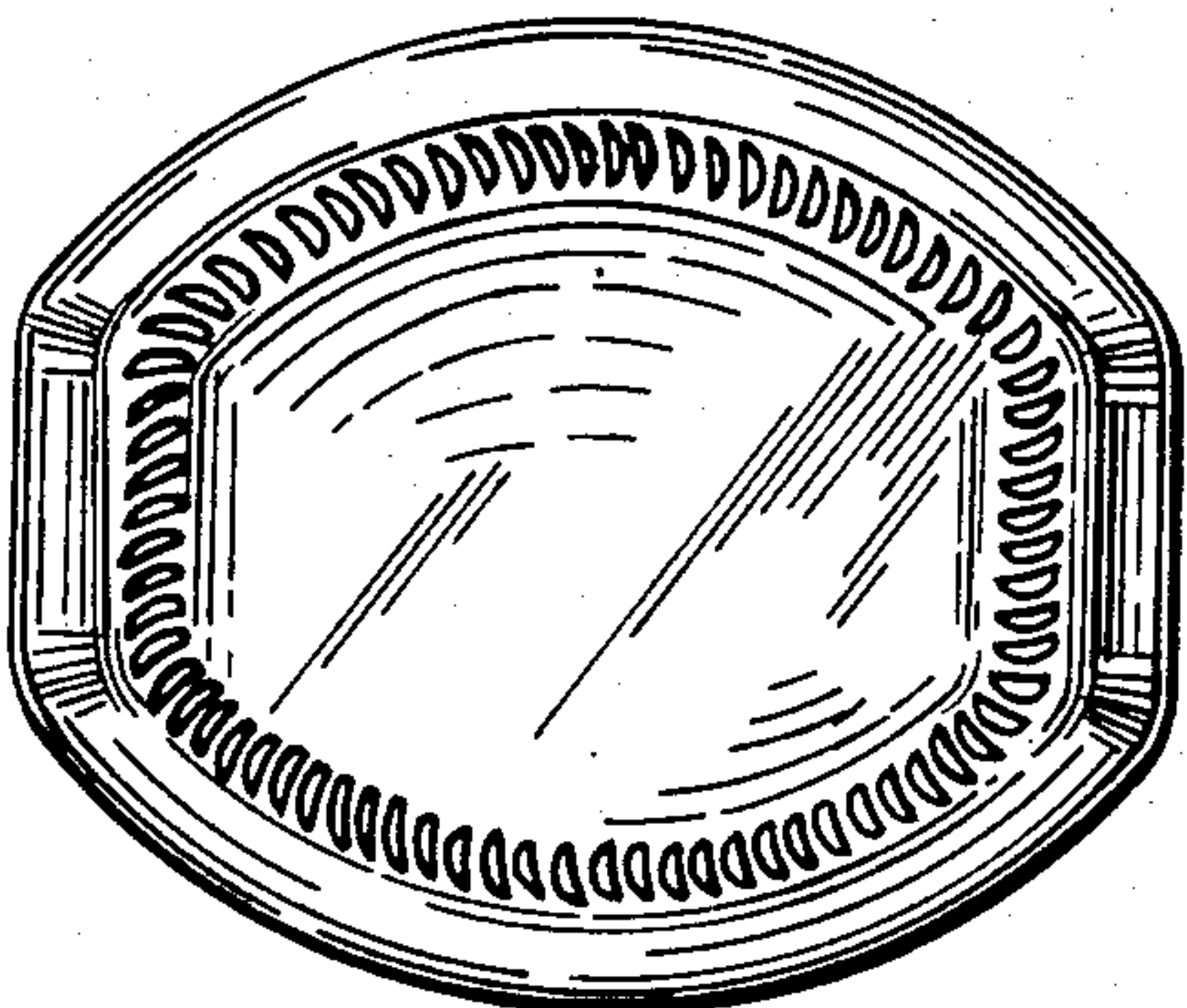

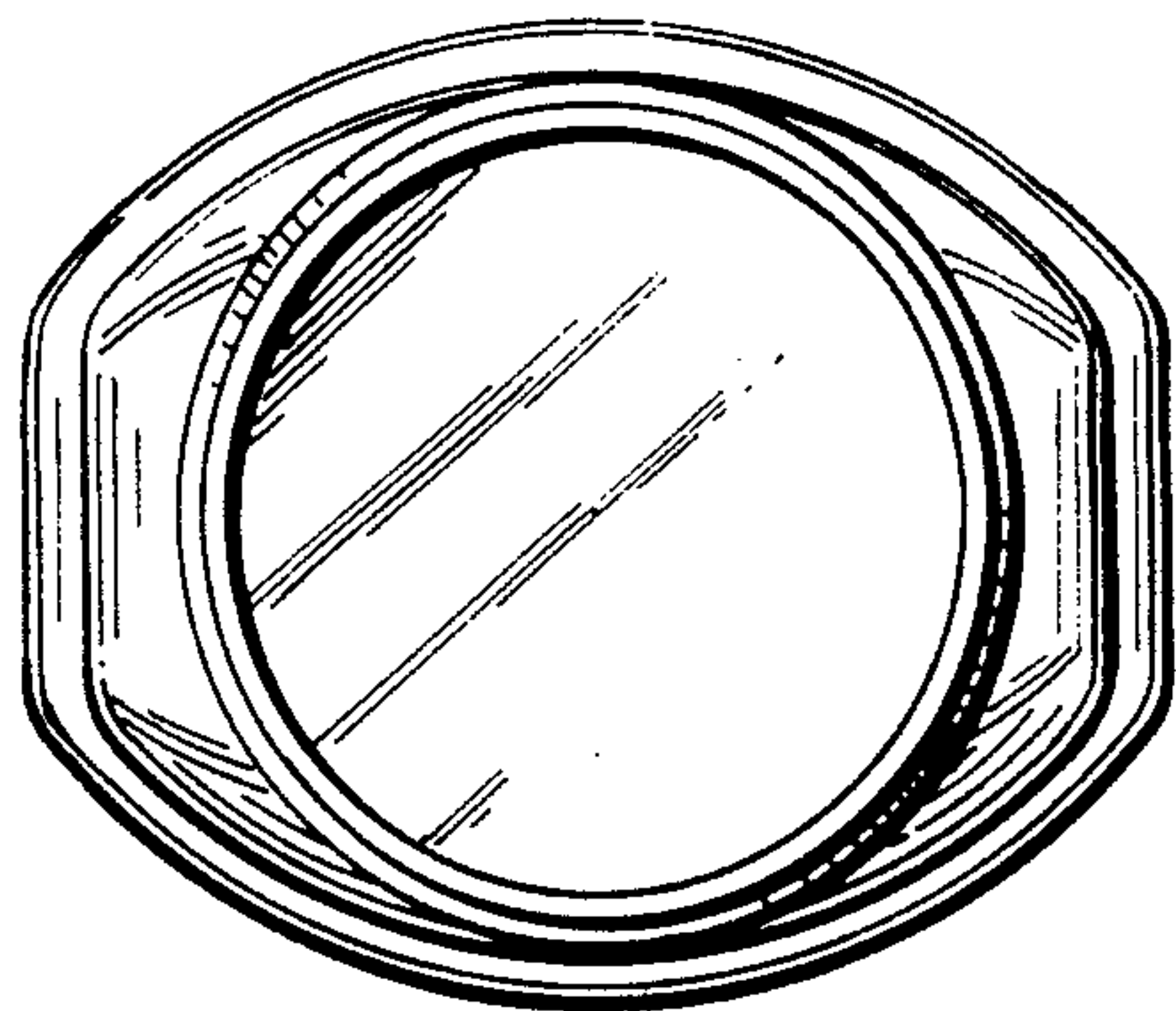

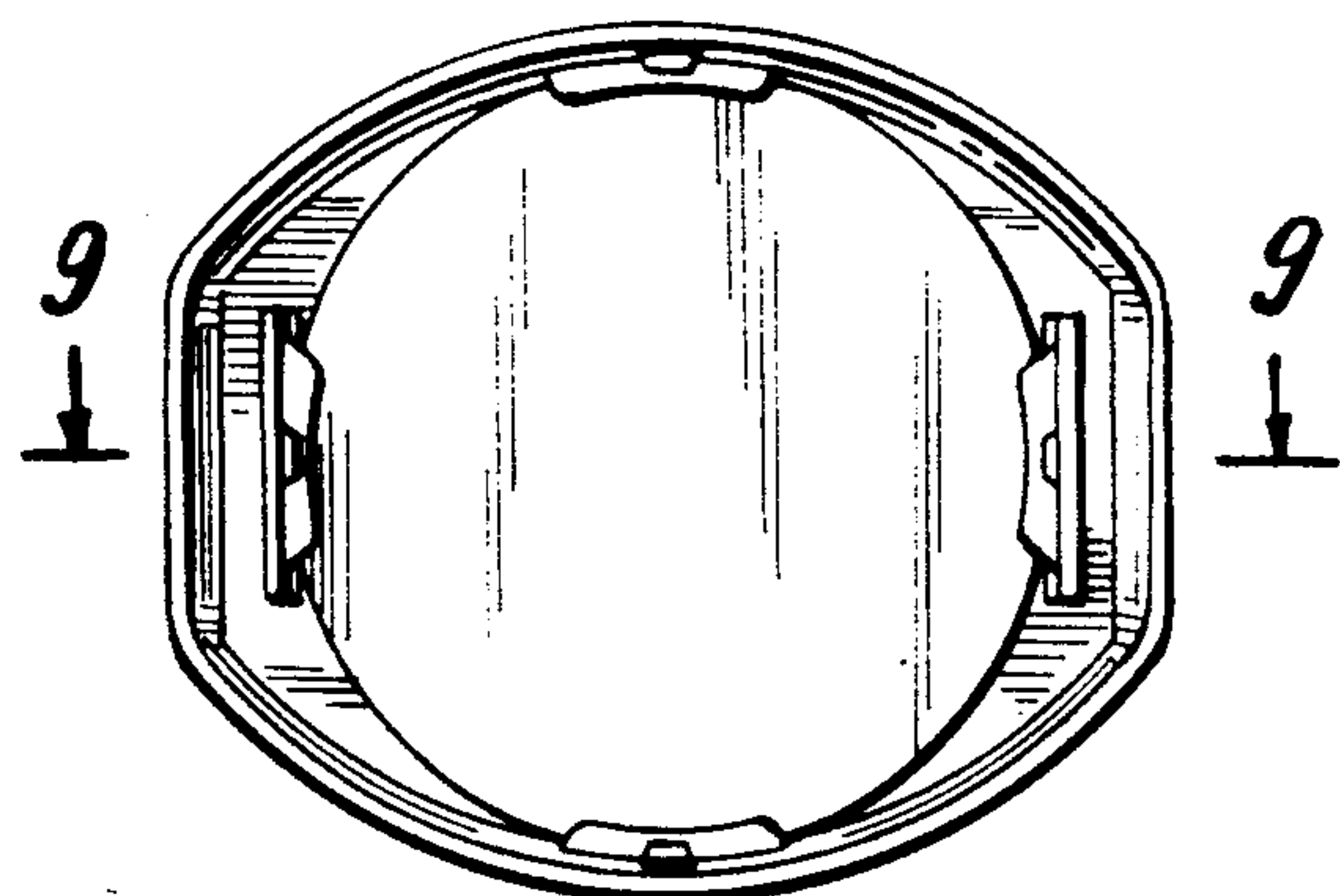

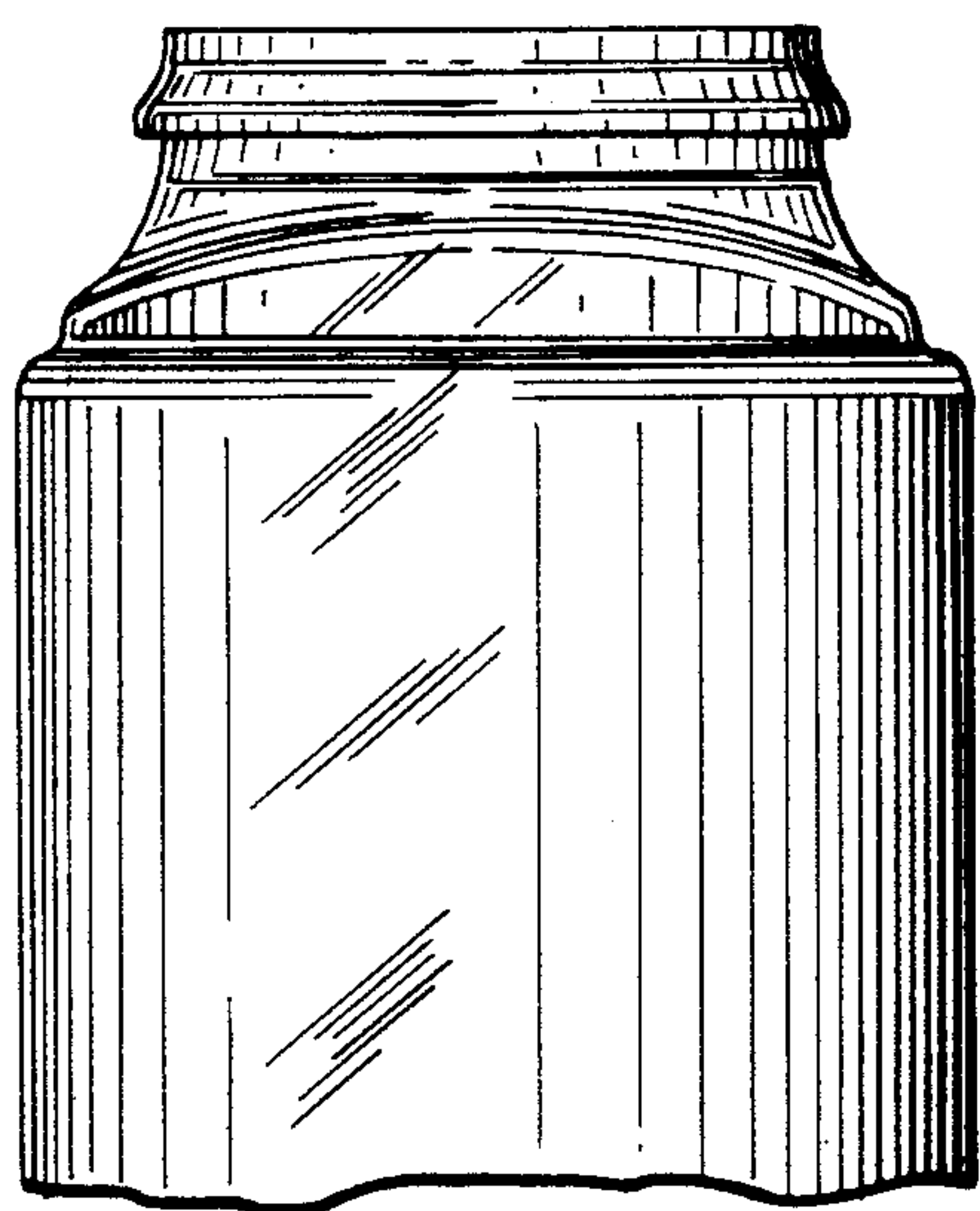

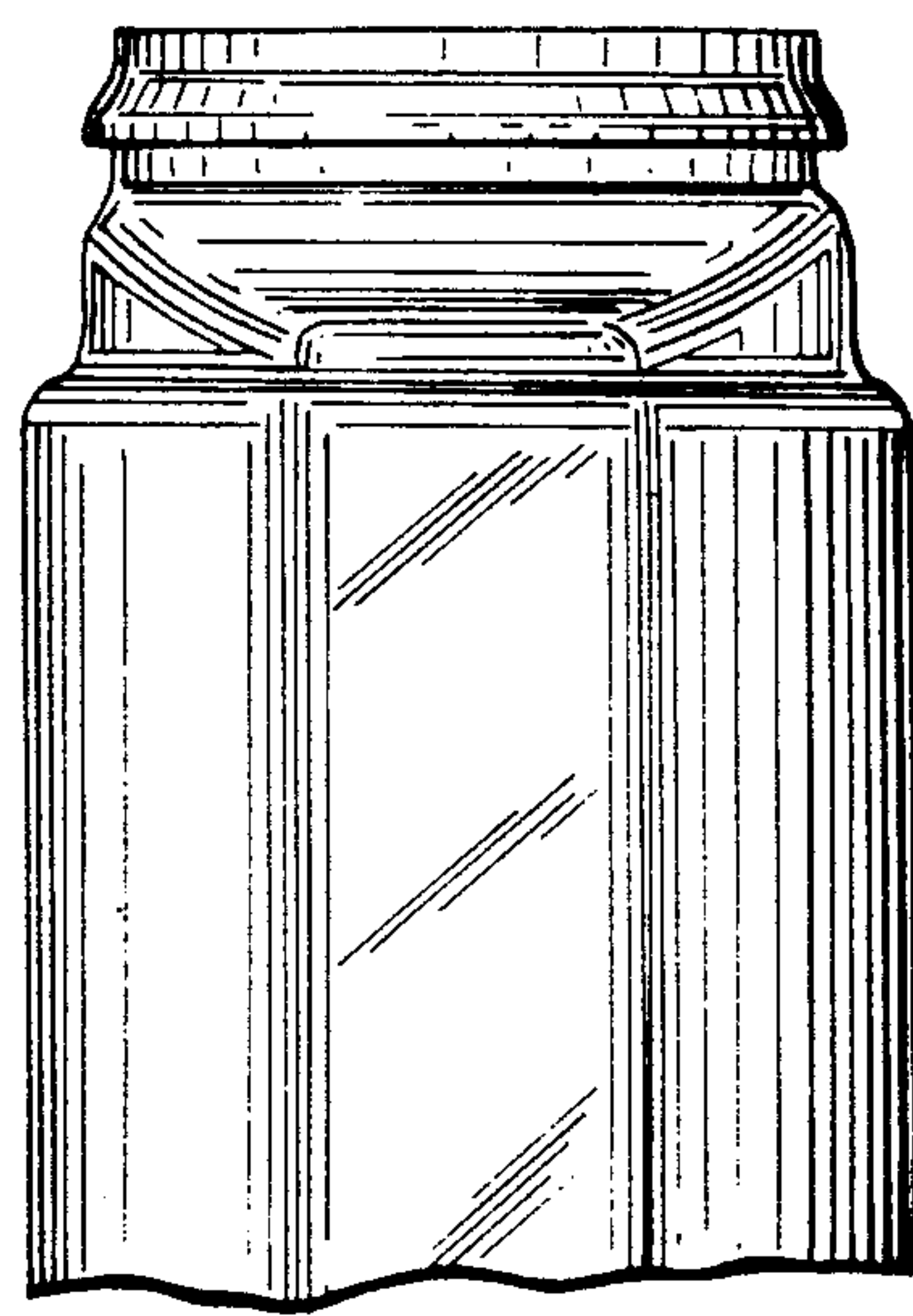

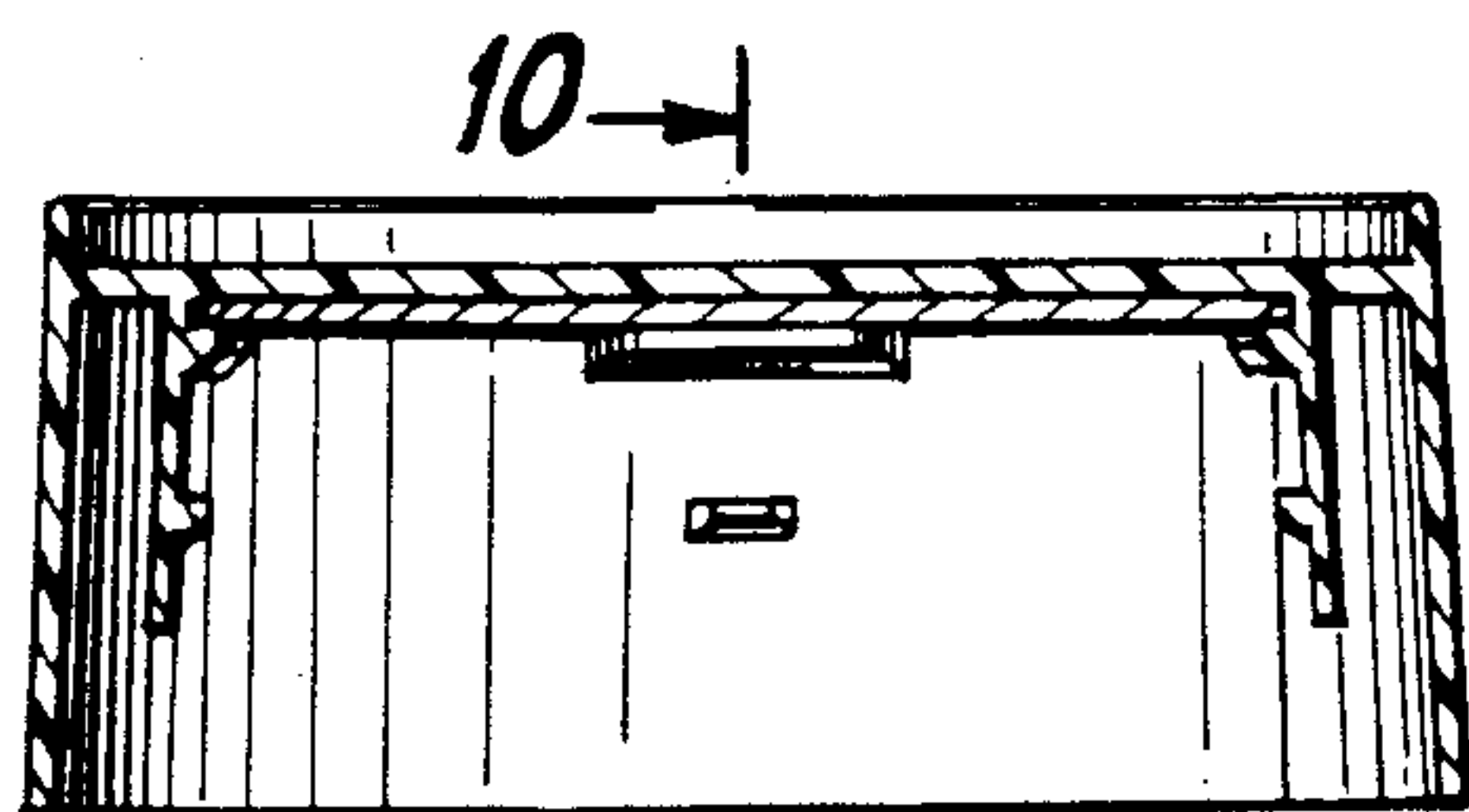

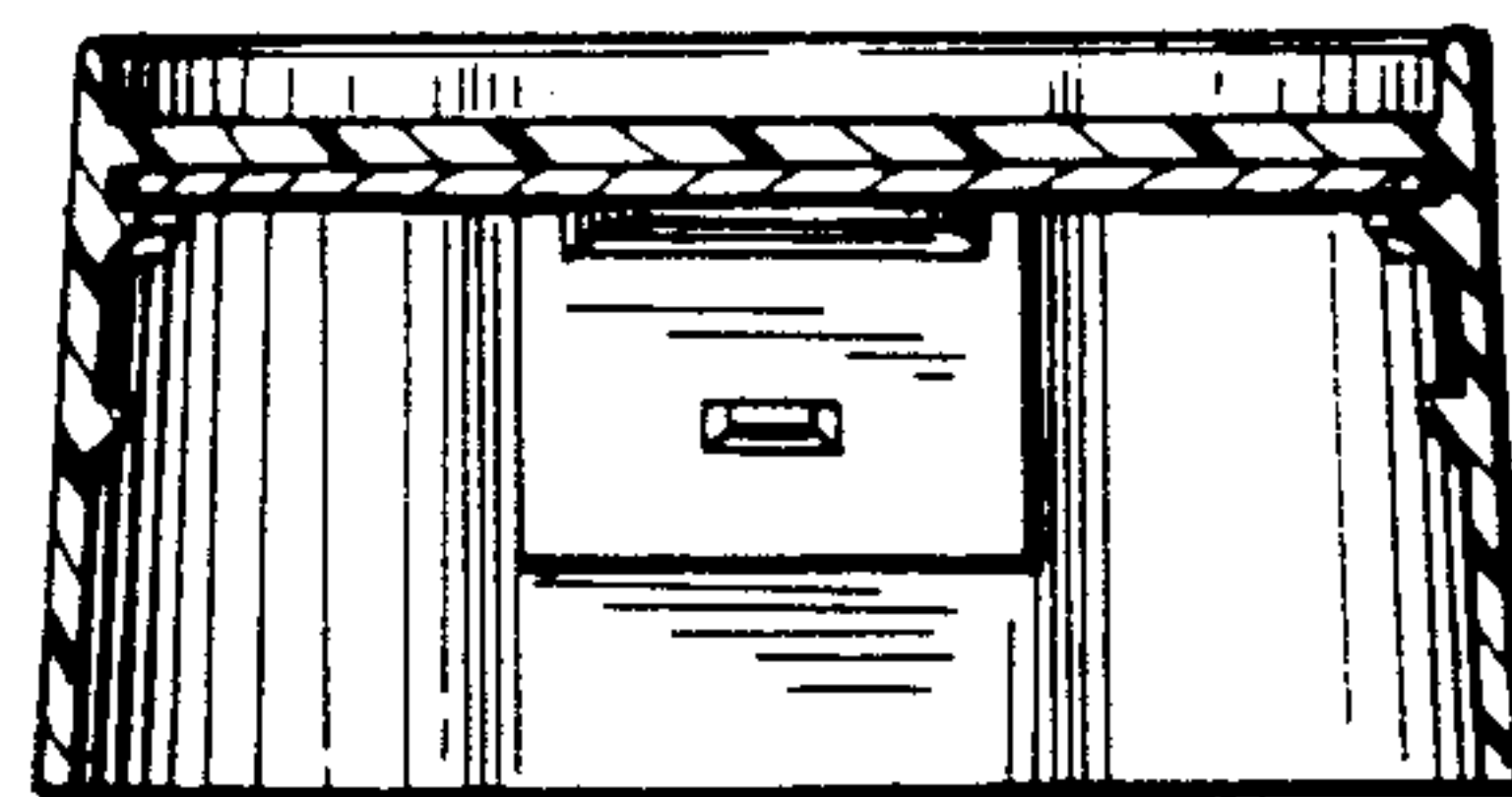
